The ornamental design for a shoe unitsole, as shown.

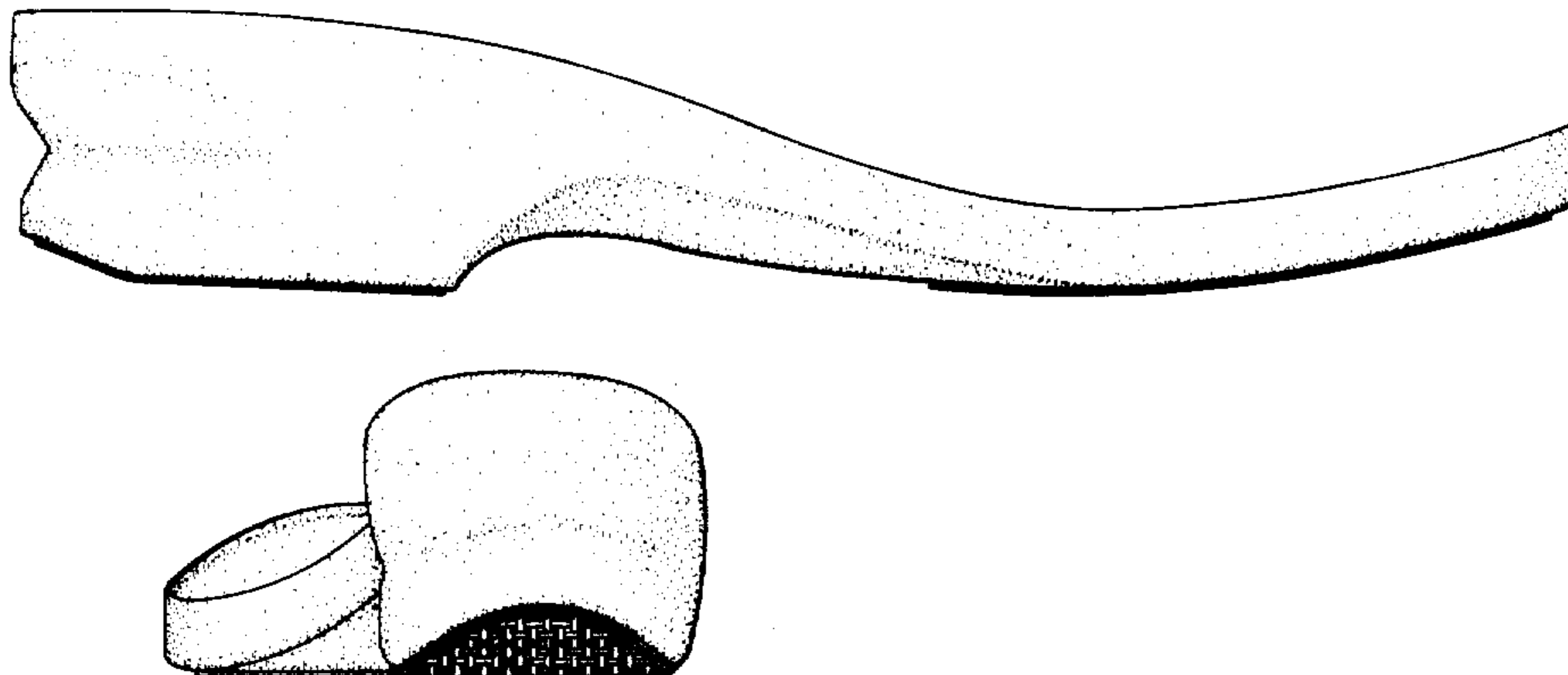
DESCRIPTION

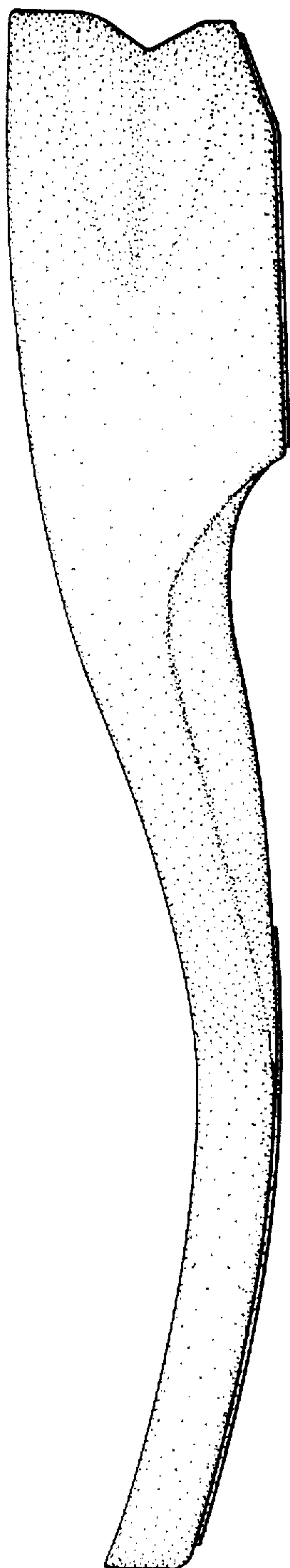

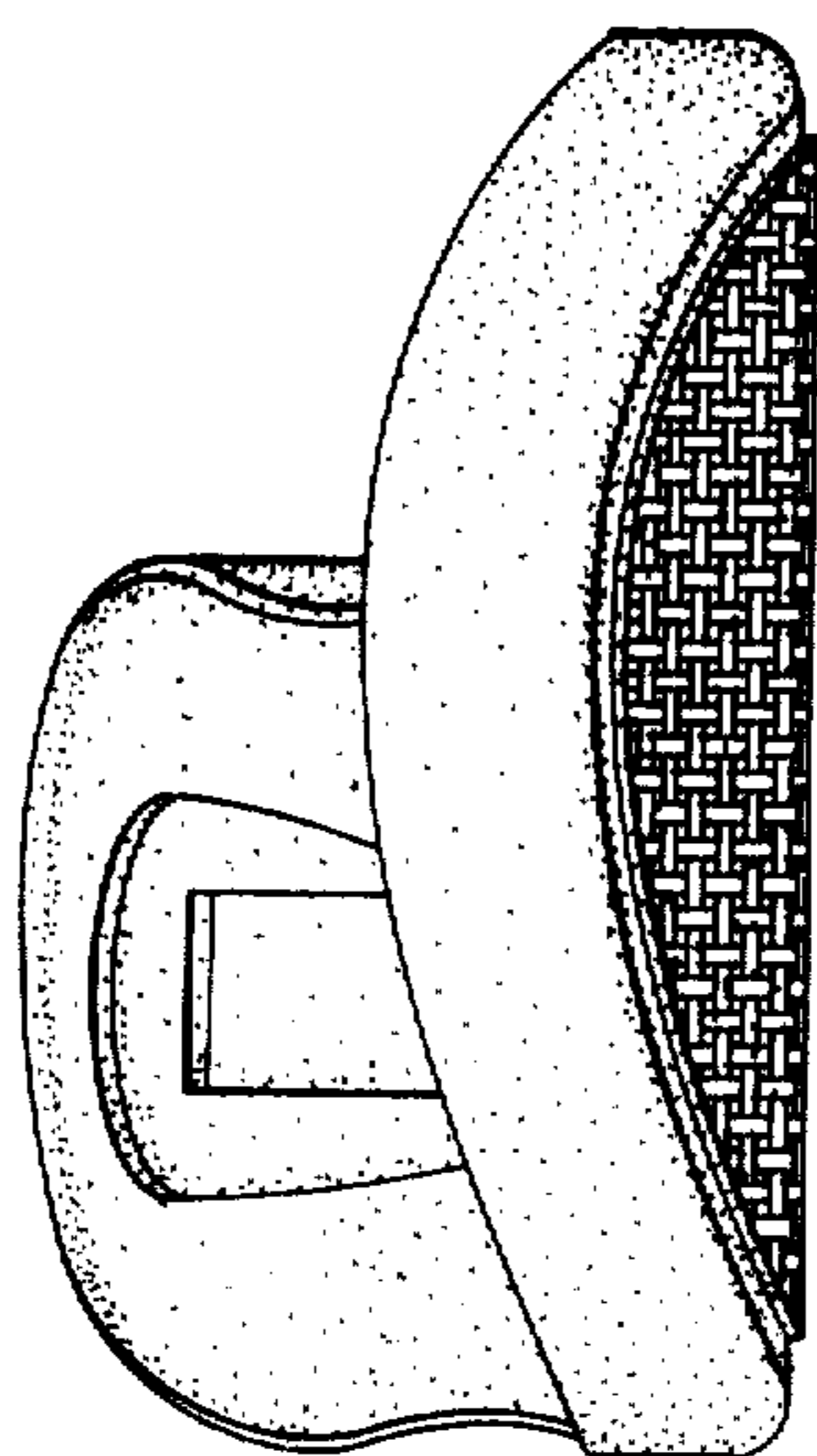

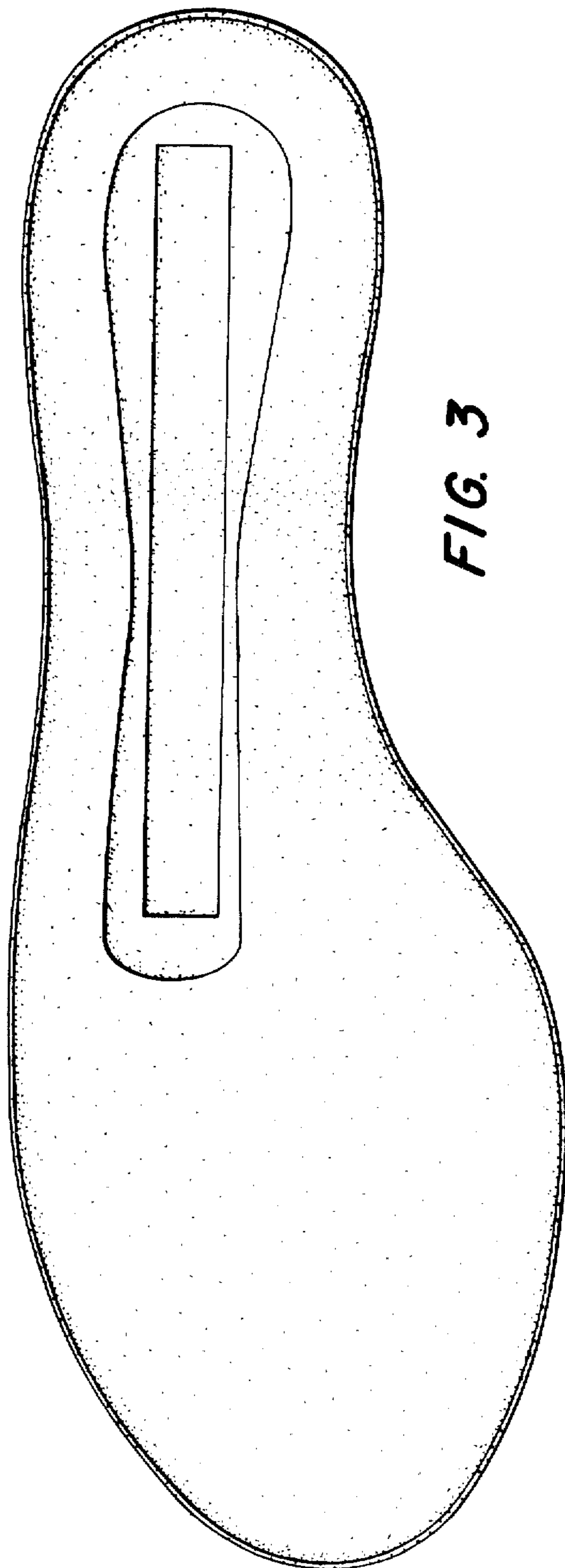

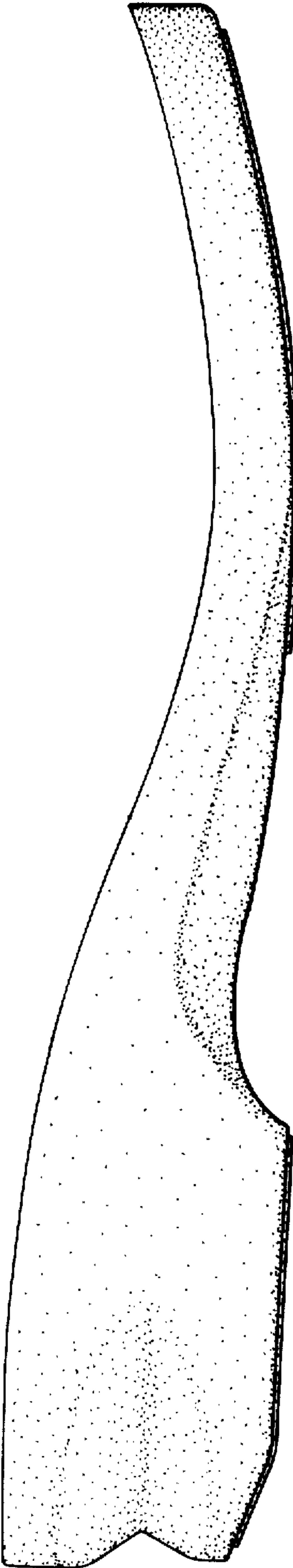

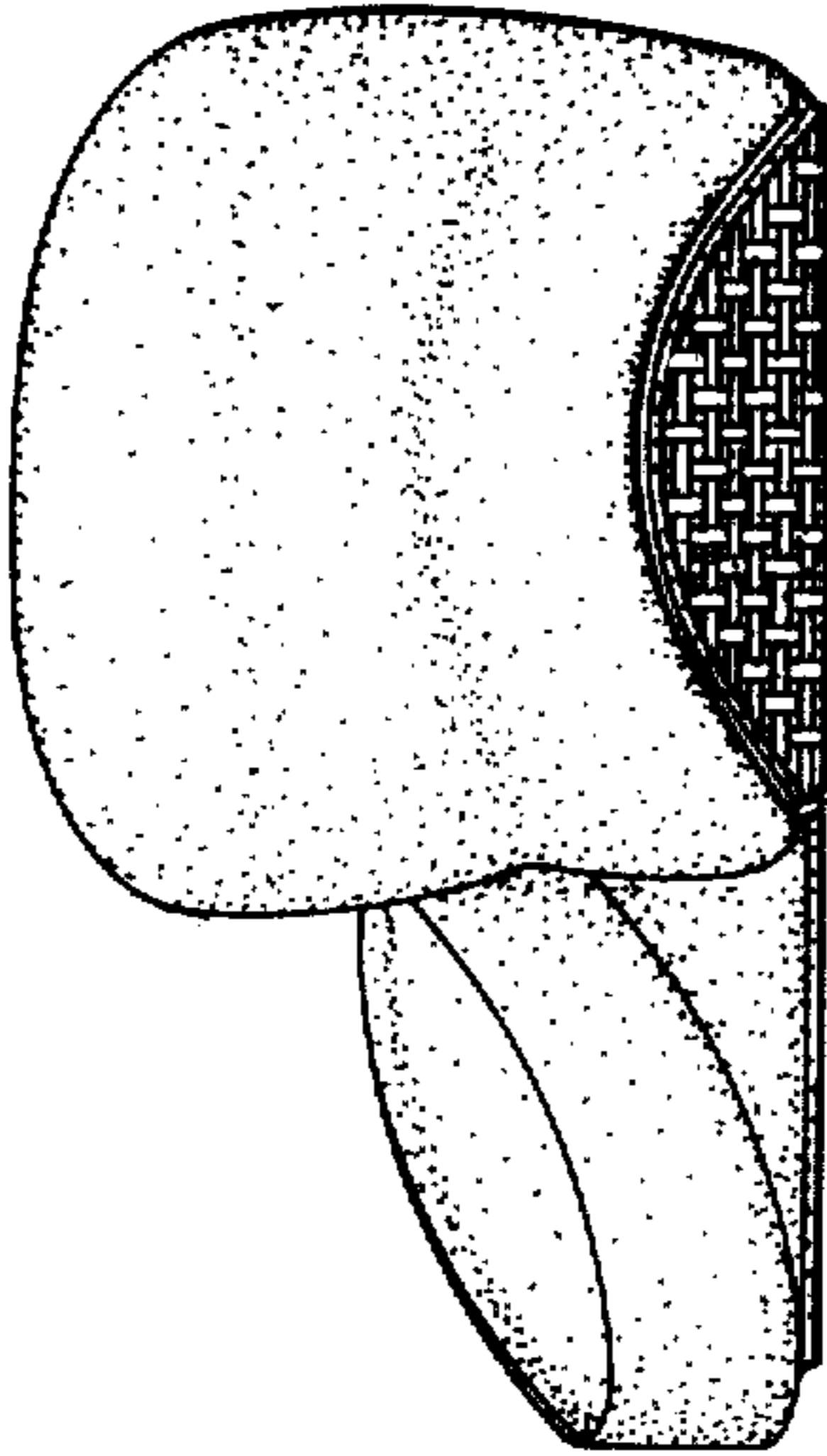

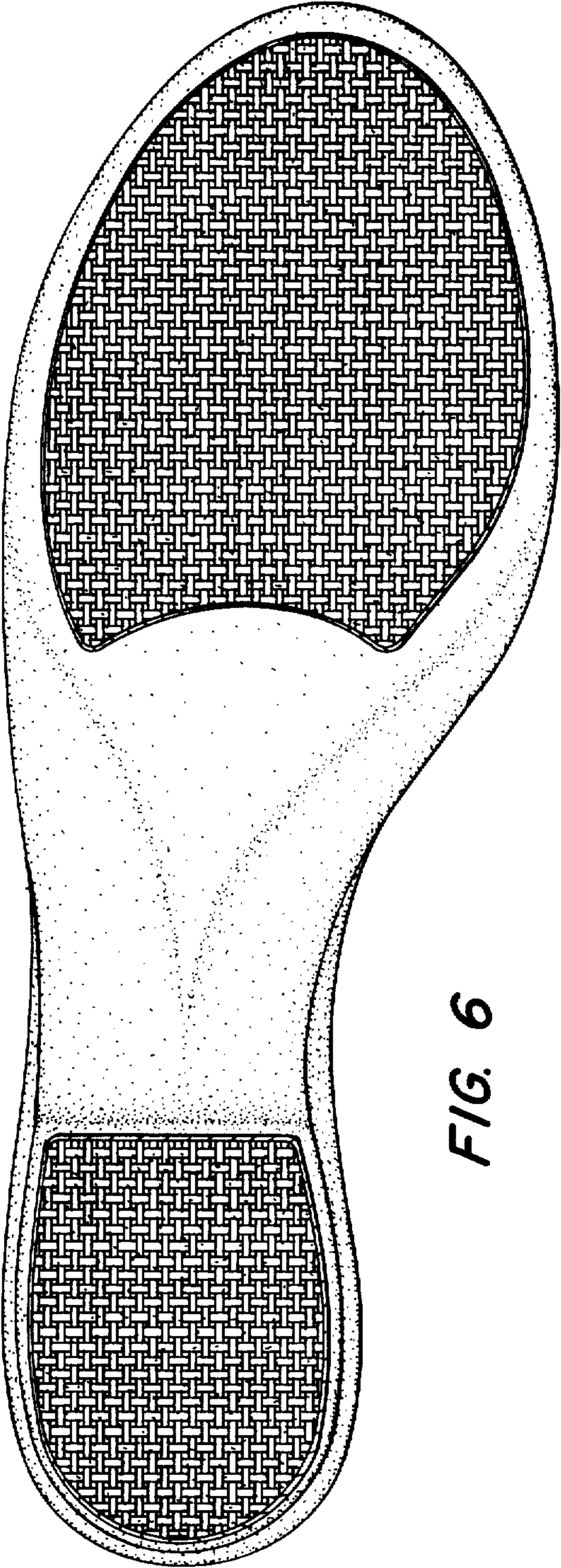
