CLAIM

The ornamental design for a gem with cross crown, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a gem with cross crown showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the other side being a mirror view, thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a gem with cross crown showing a modified form of my new design;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view, the other side being a mirror image, thereof;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 12 is a rear end elevational view of the gem with cross crown shown in FIG. 7.





