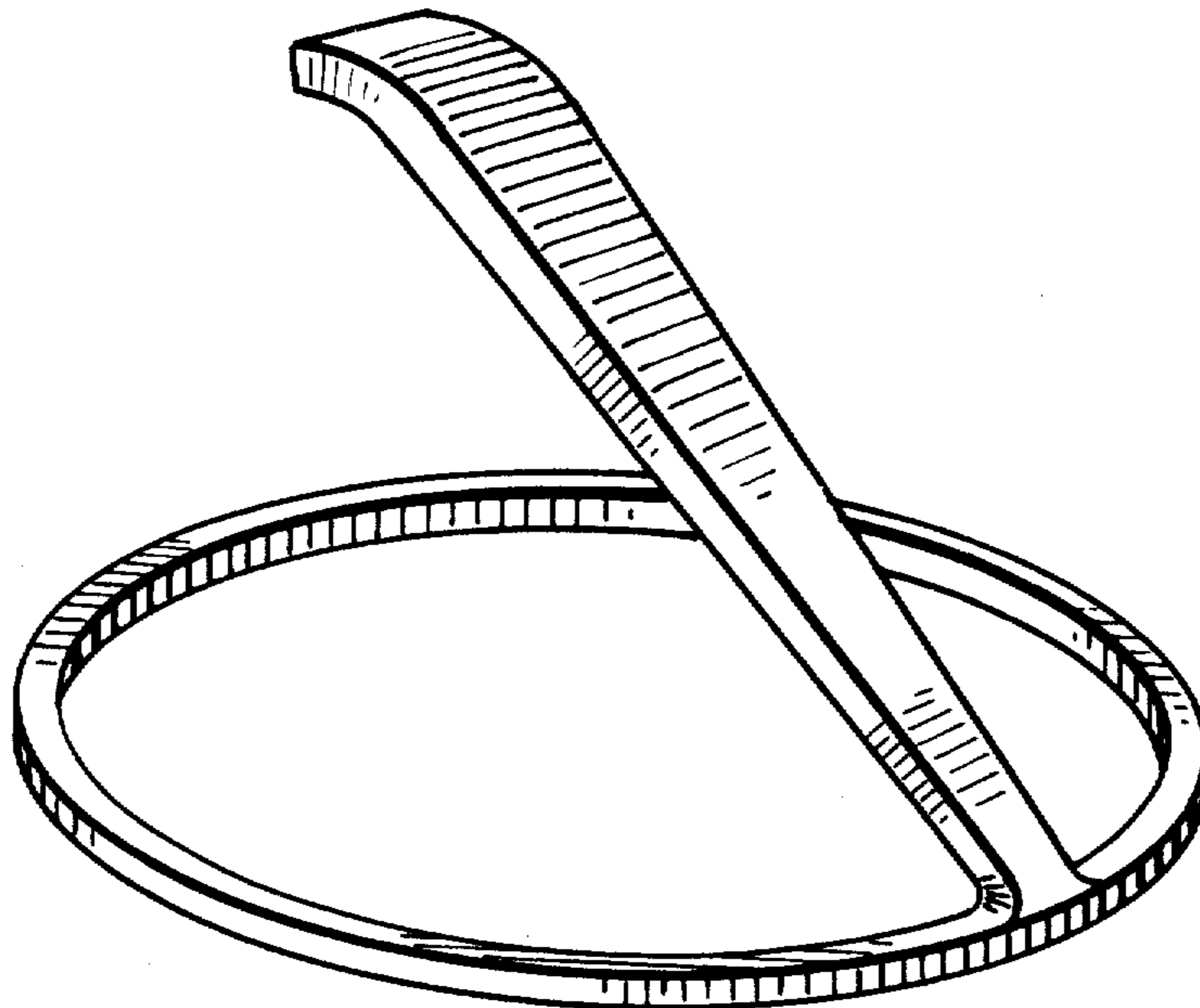

The broken lines representing a telephone handset are shown for illustrative purposes only.



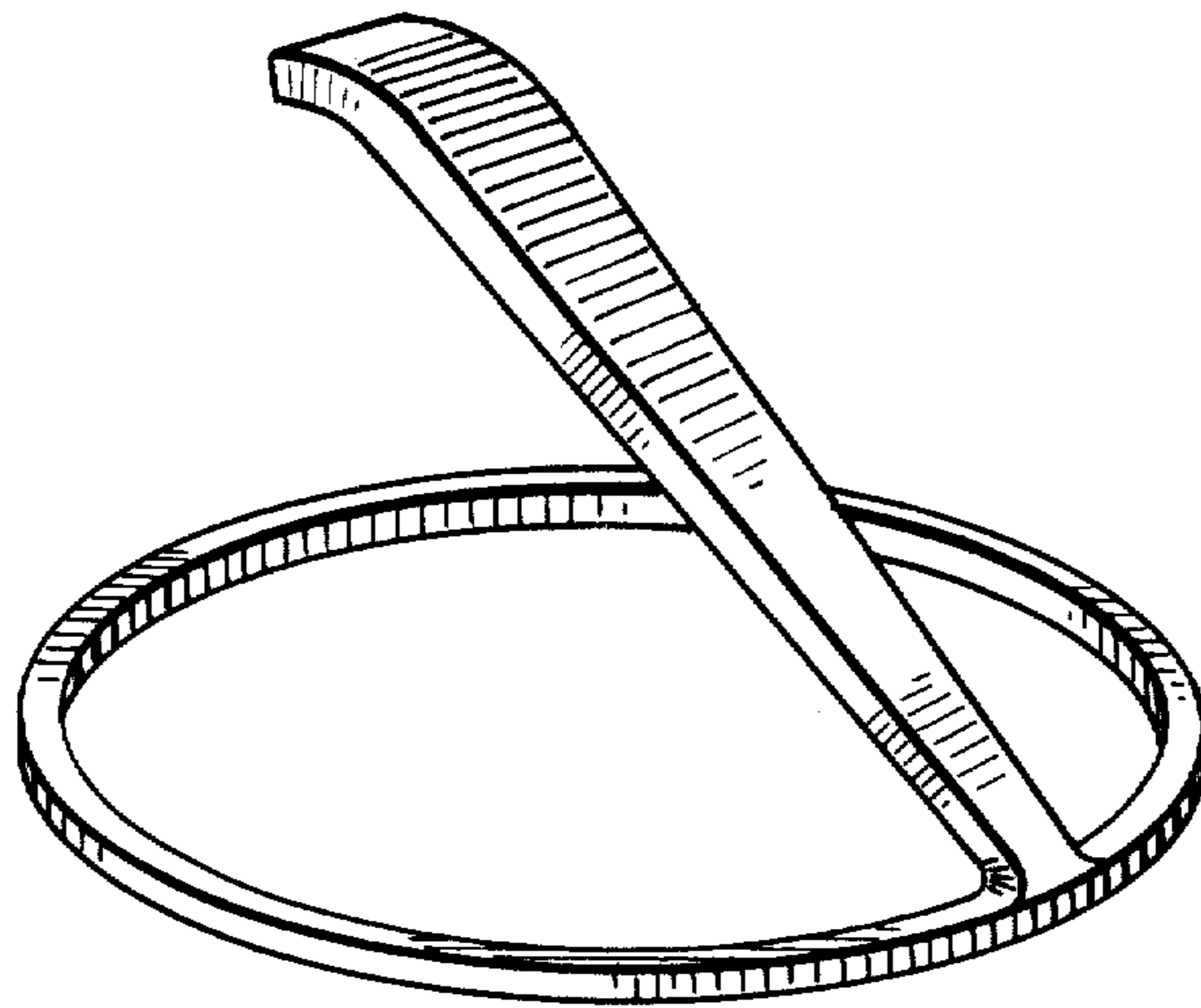

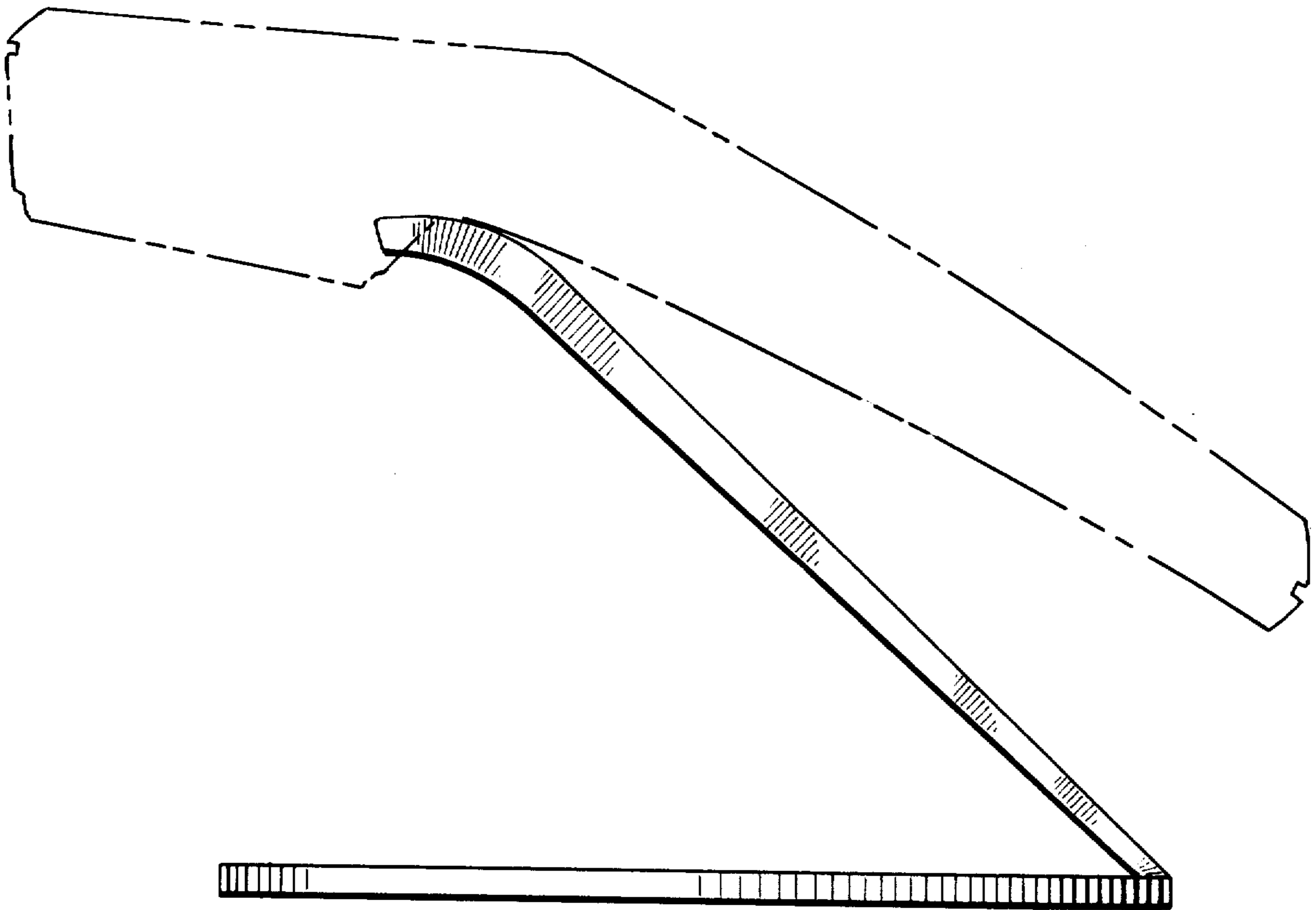

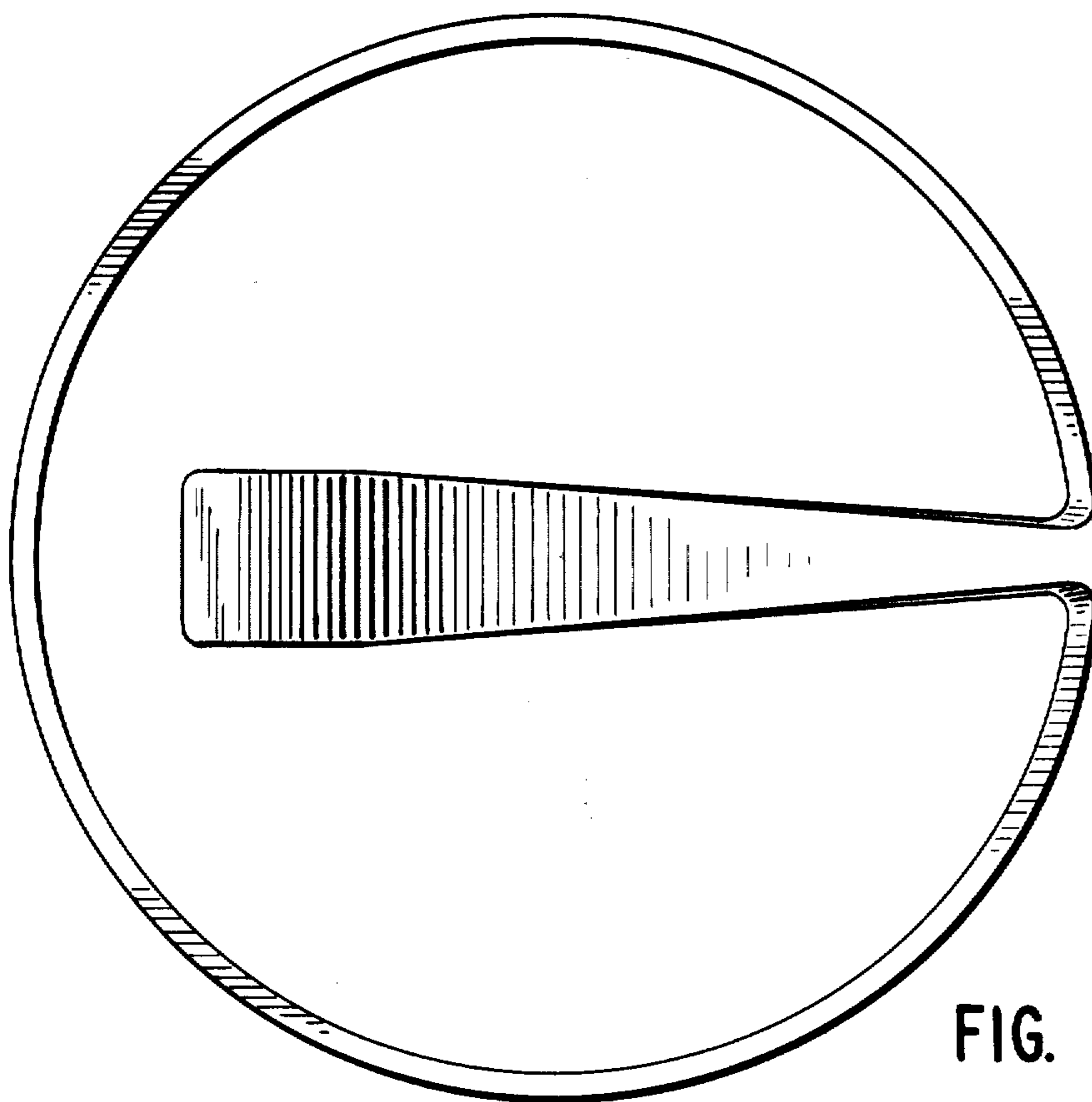

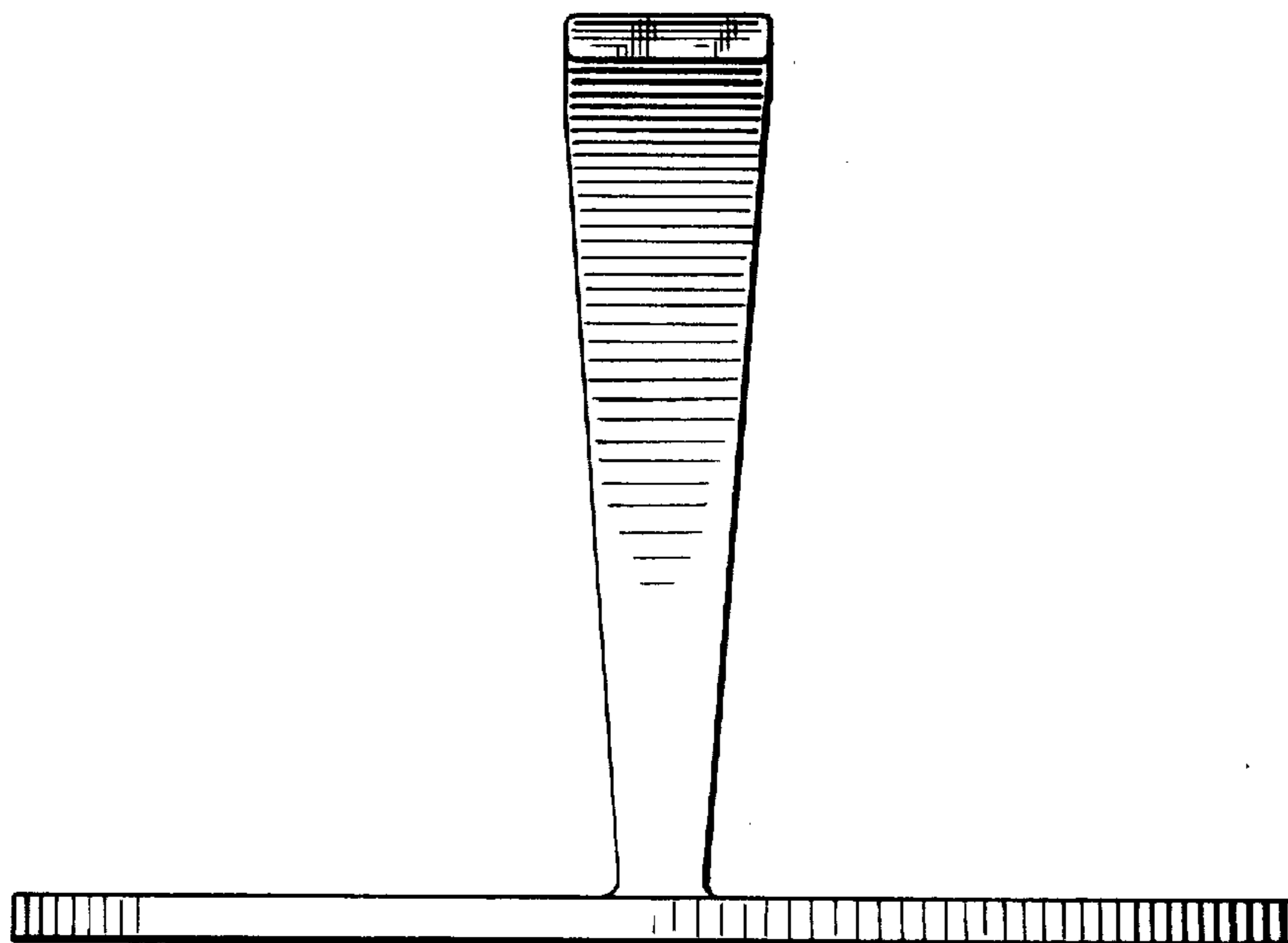
