end shown in FIG. 5.

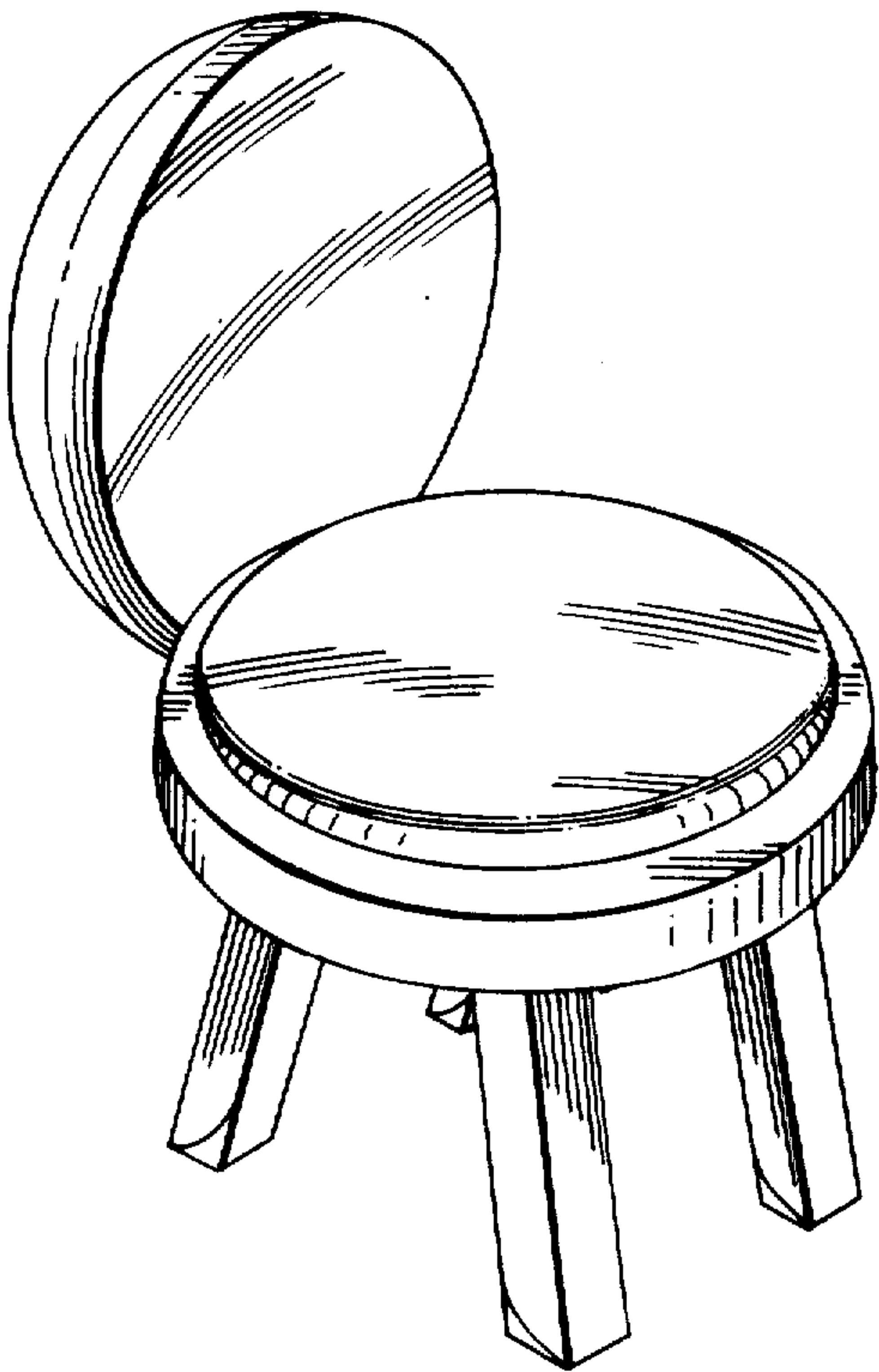

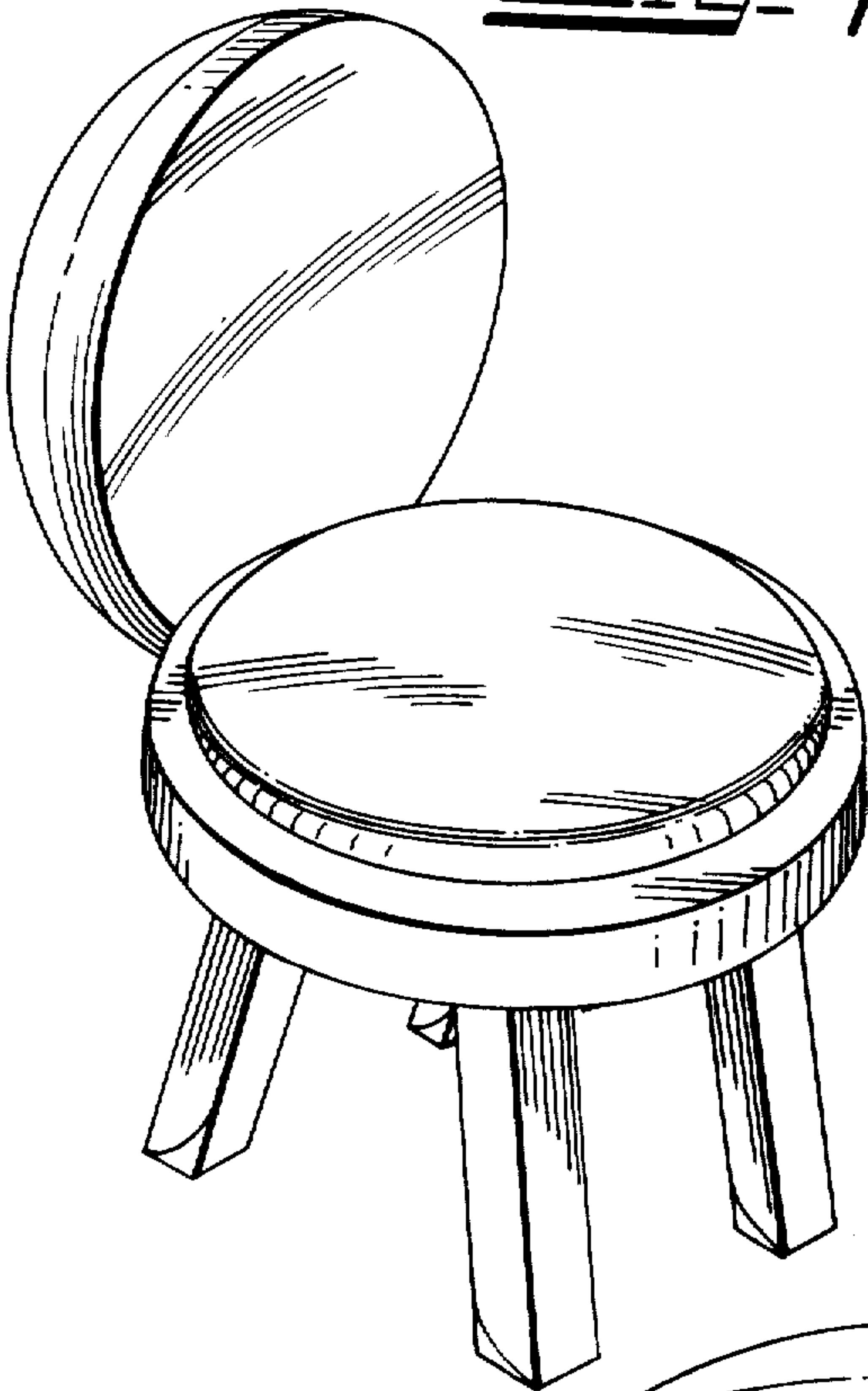

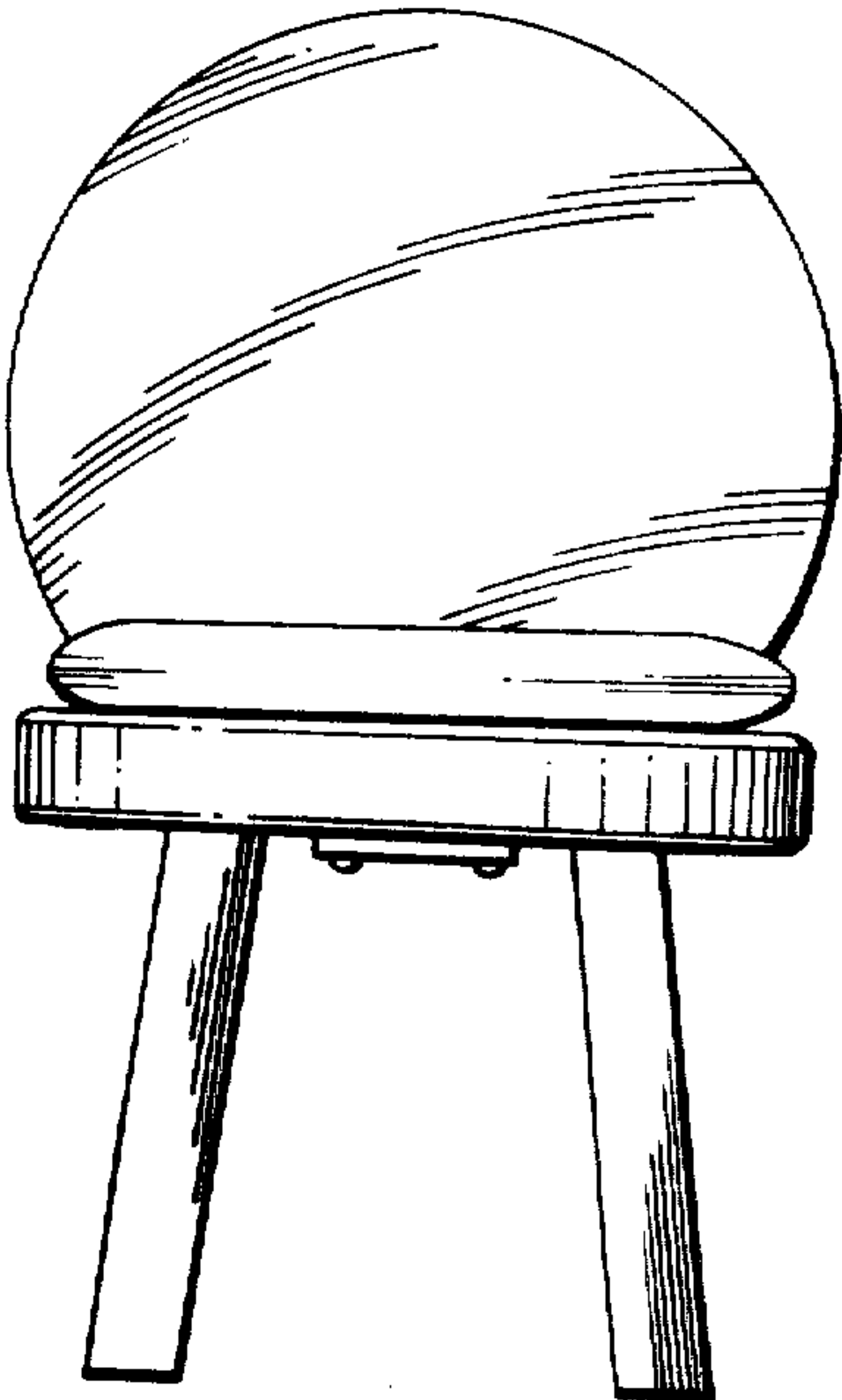

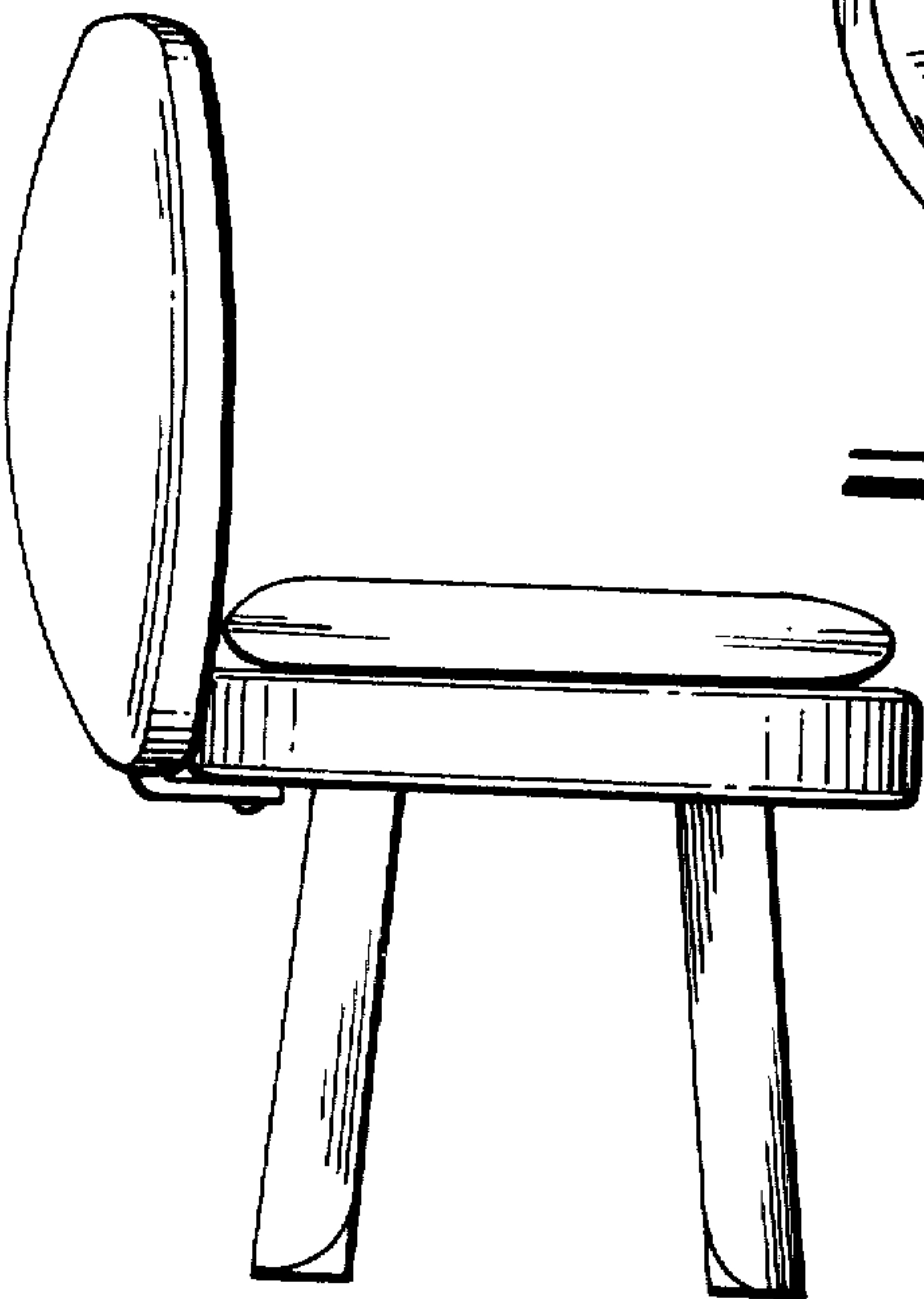

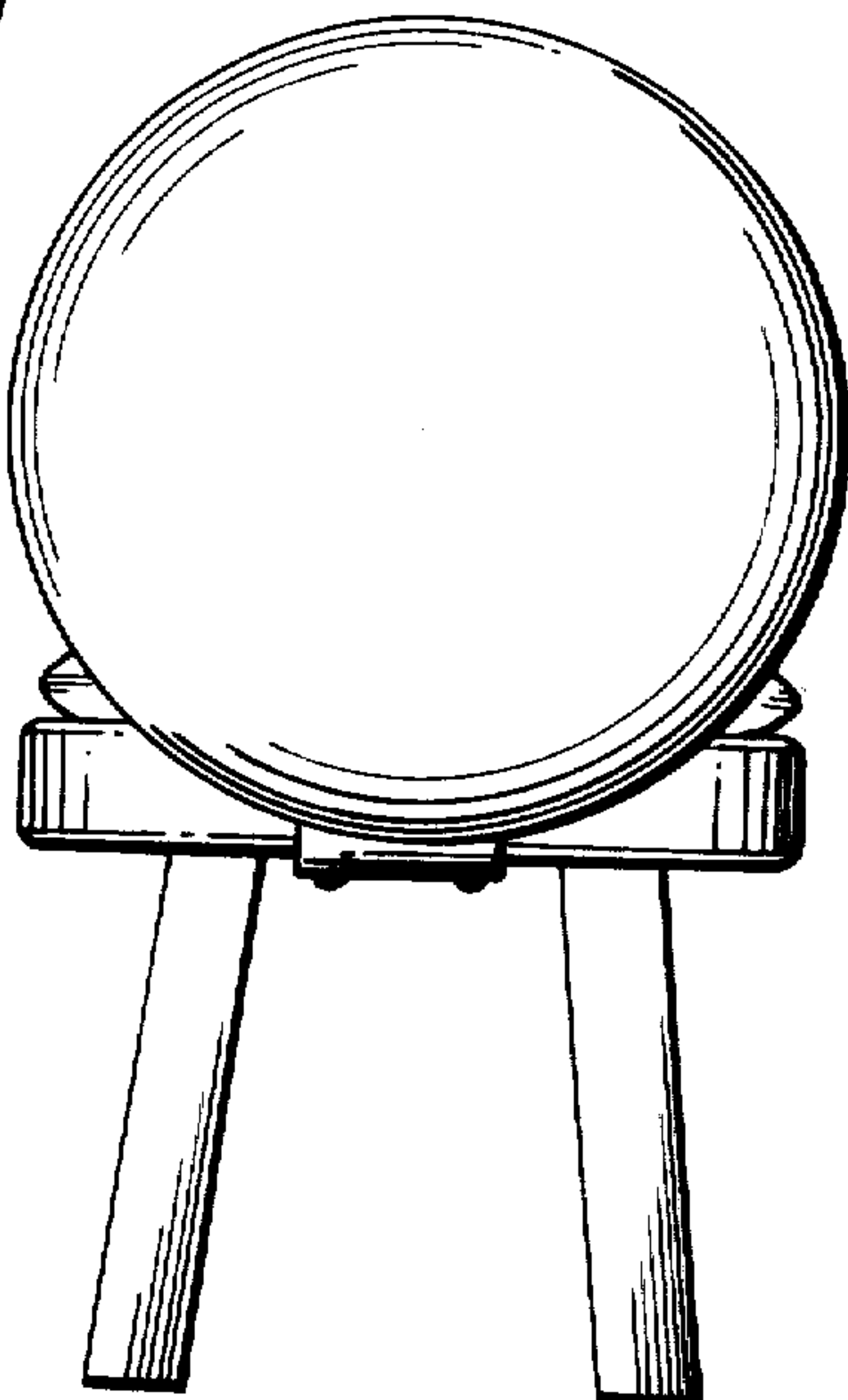
