[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined dispensing container and cap, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined dispensing container and cap showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view looking from the right of

FIG. 2, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a back elevational view; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
