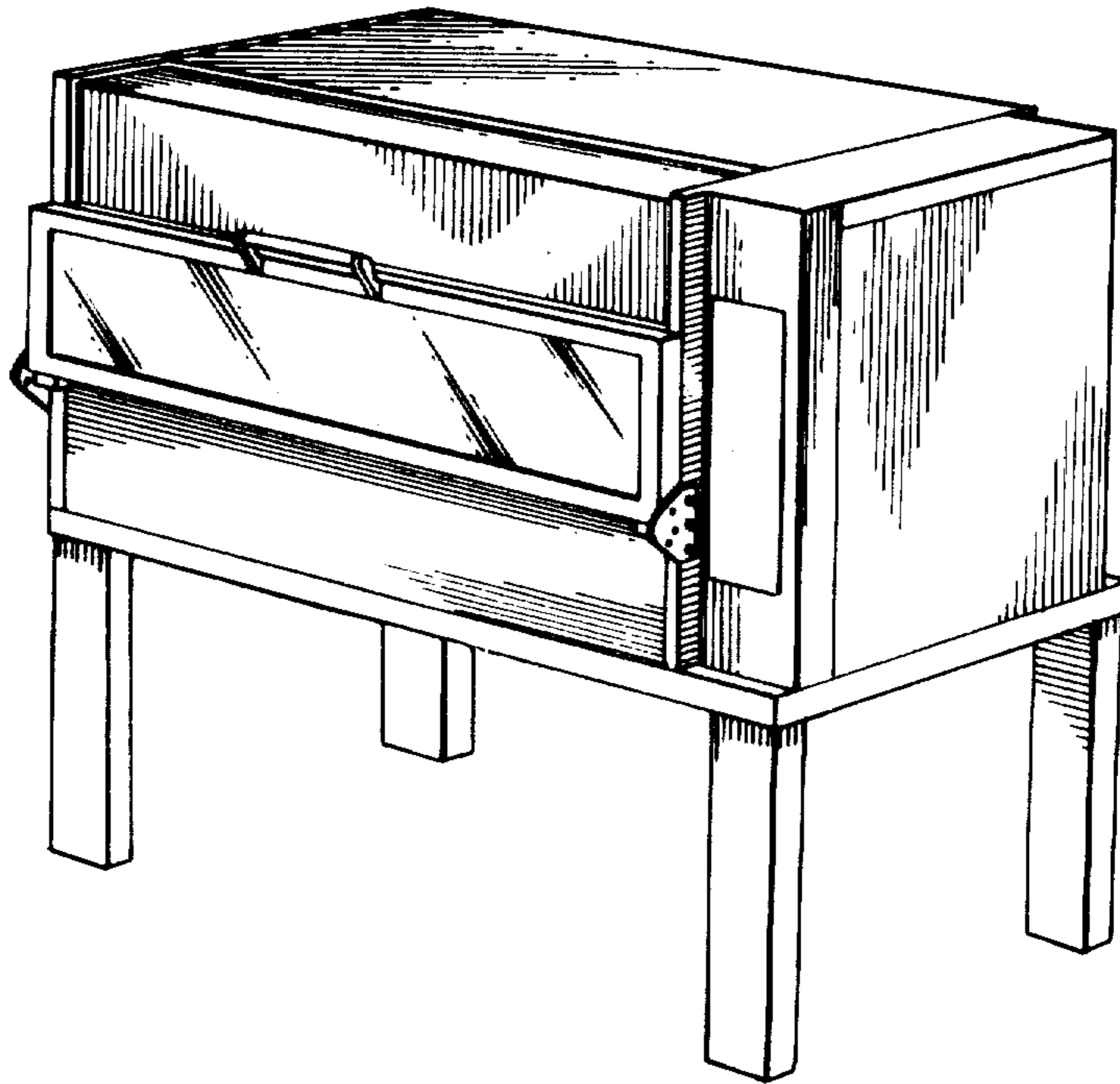

 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



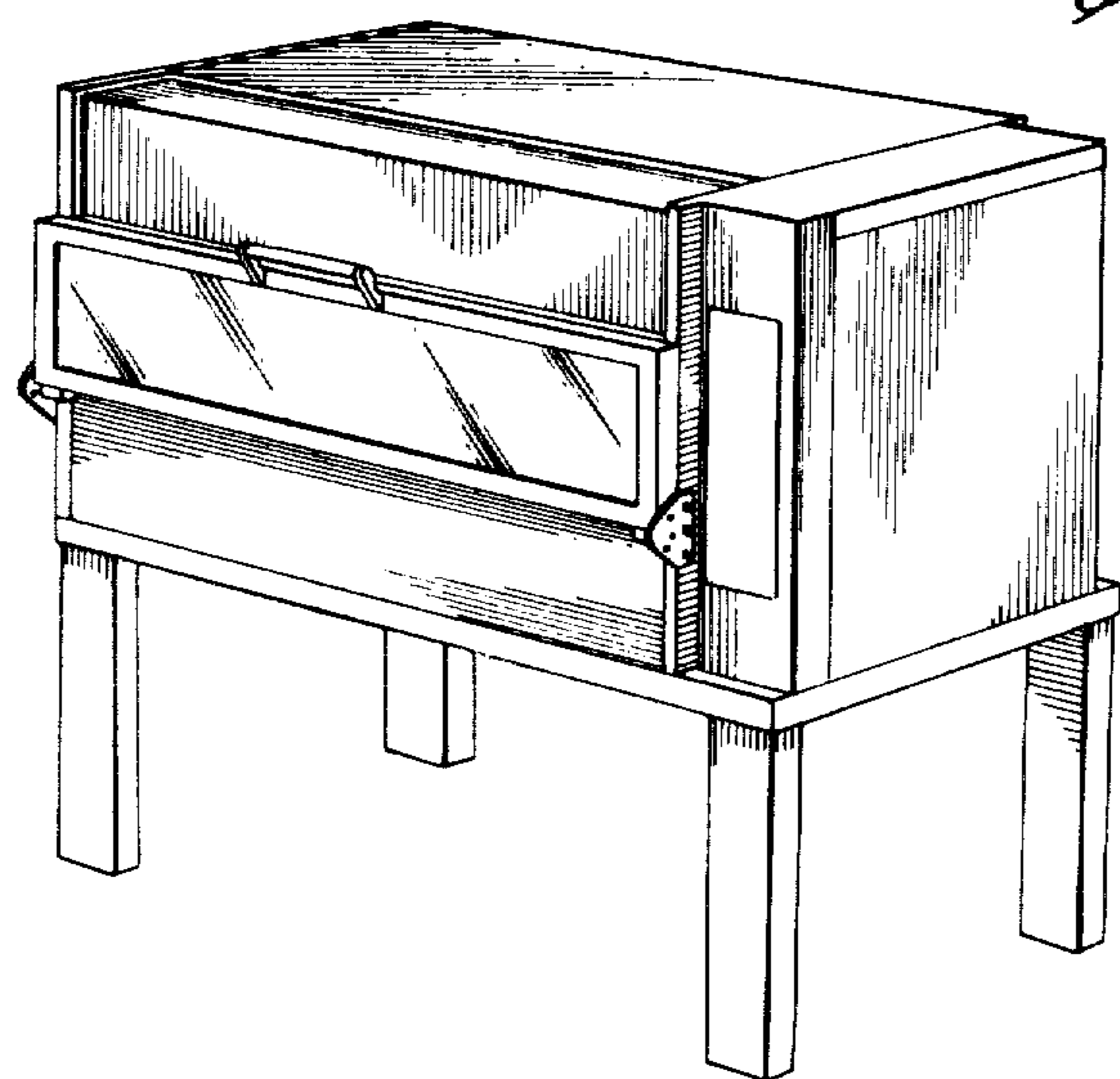

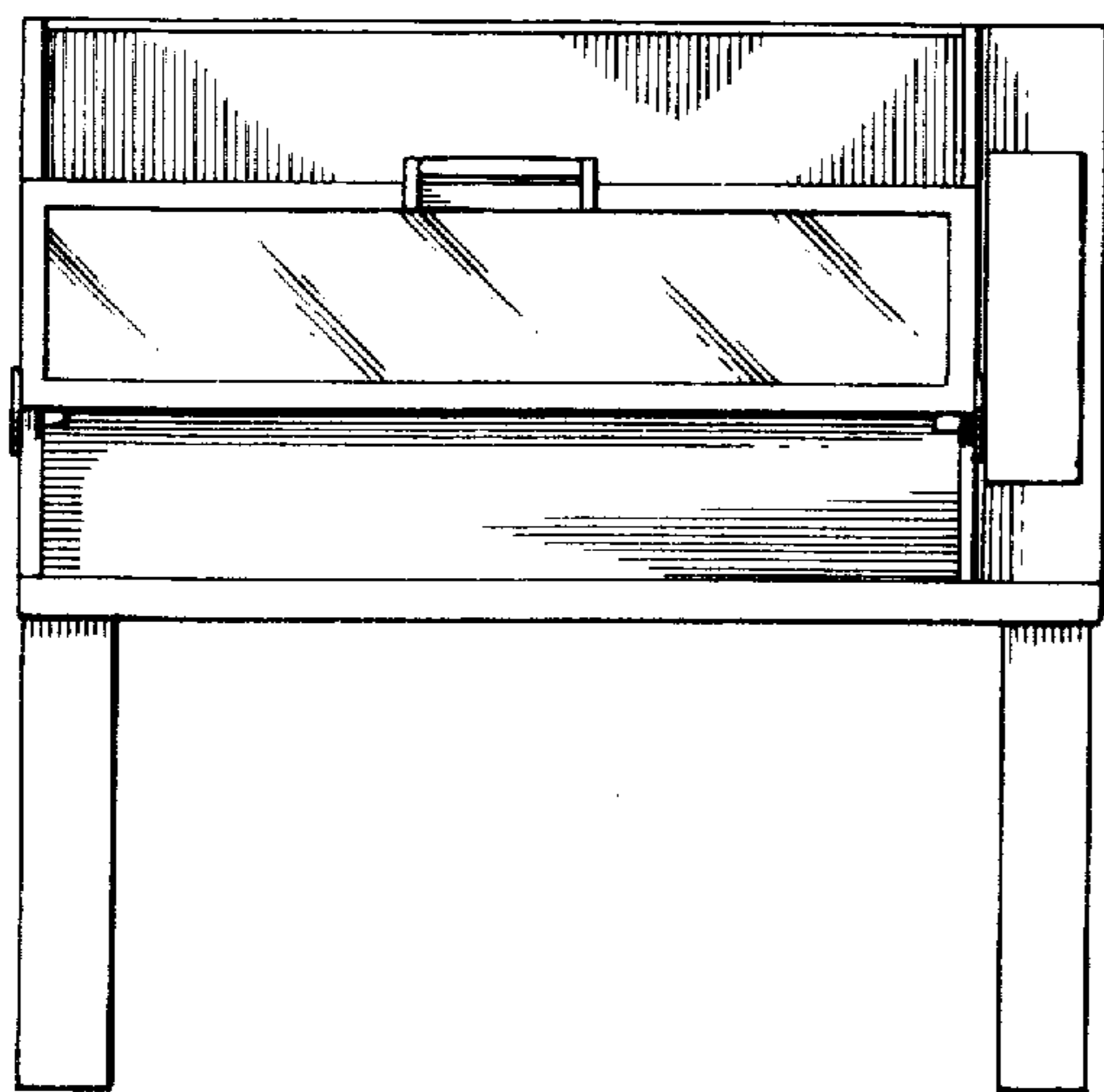

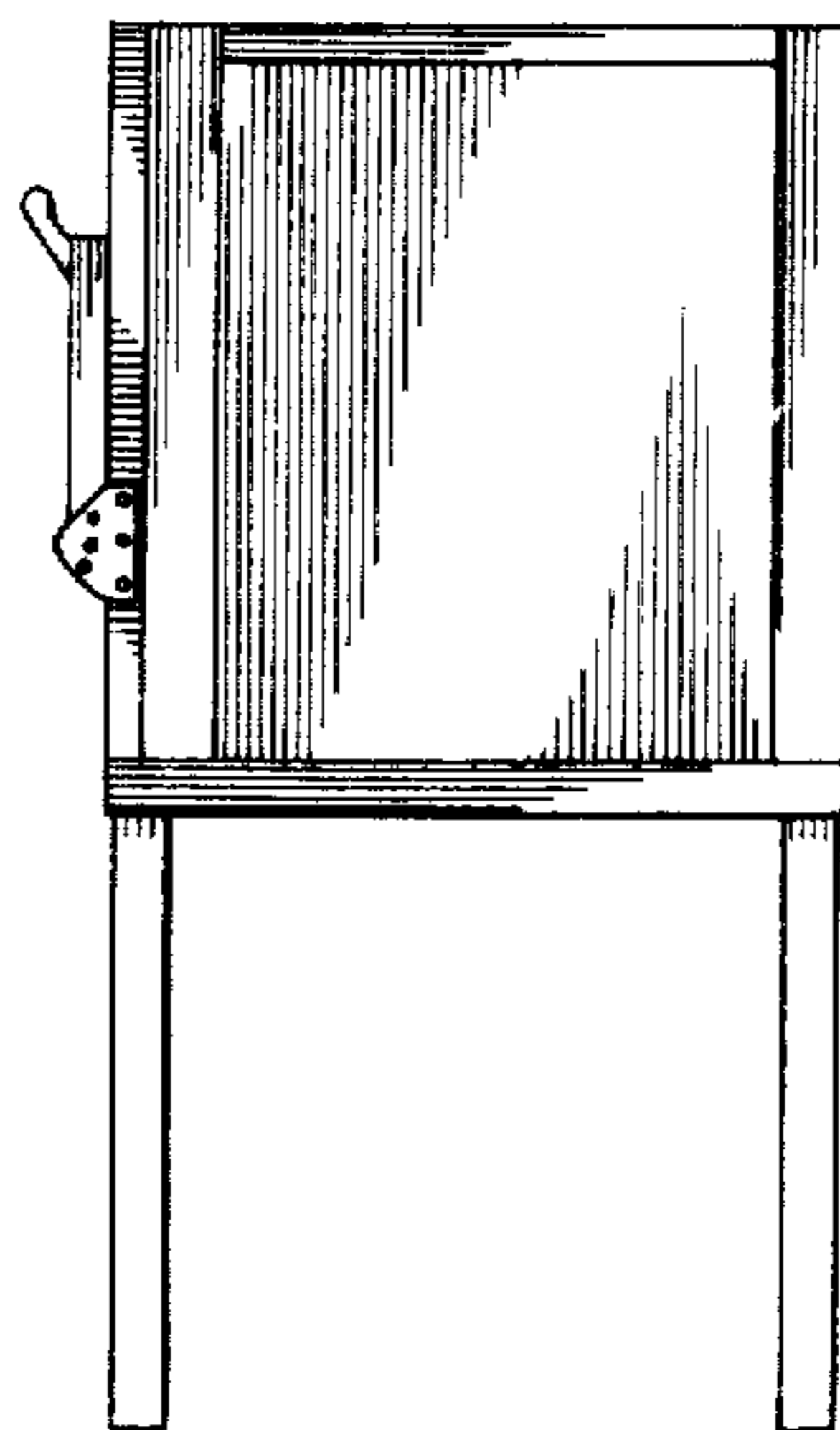

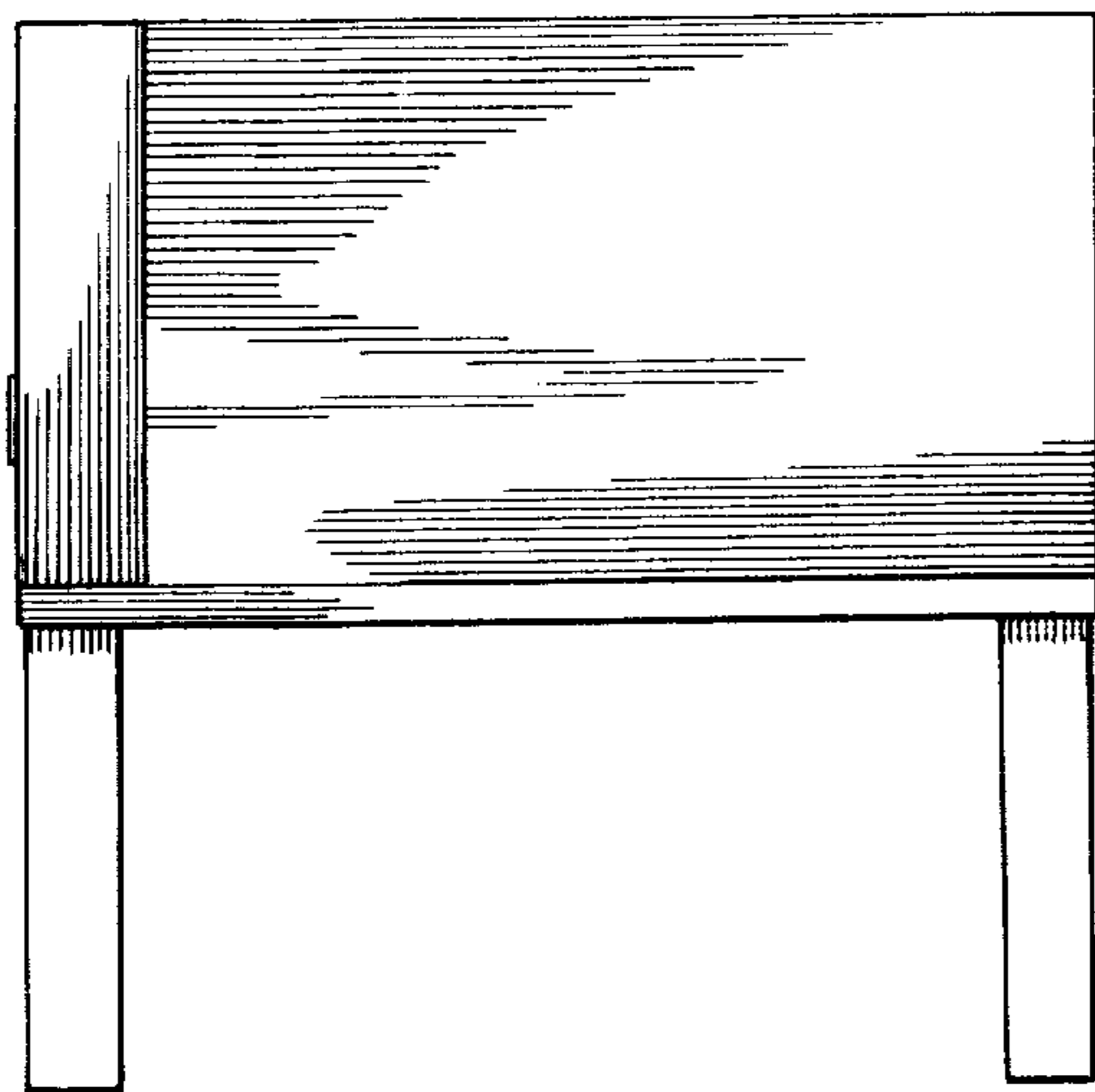

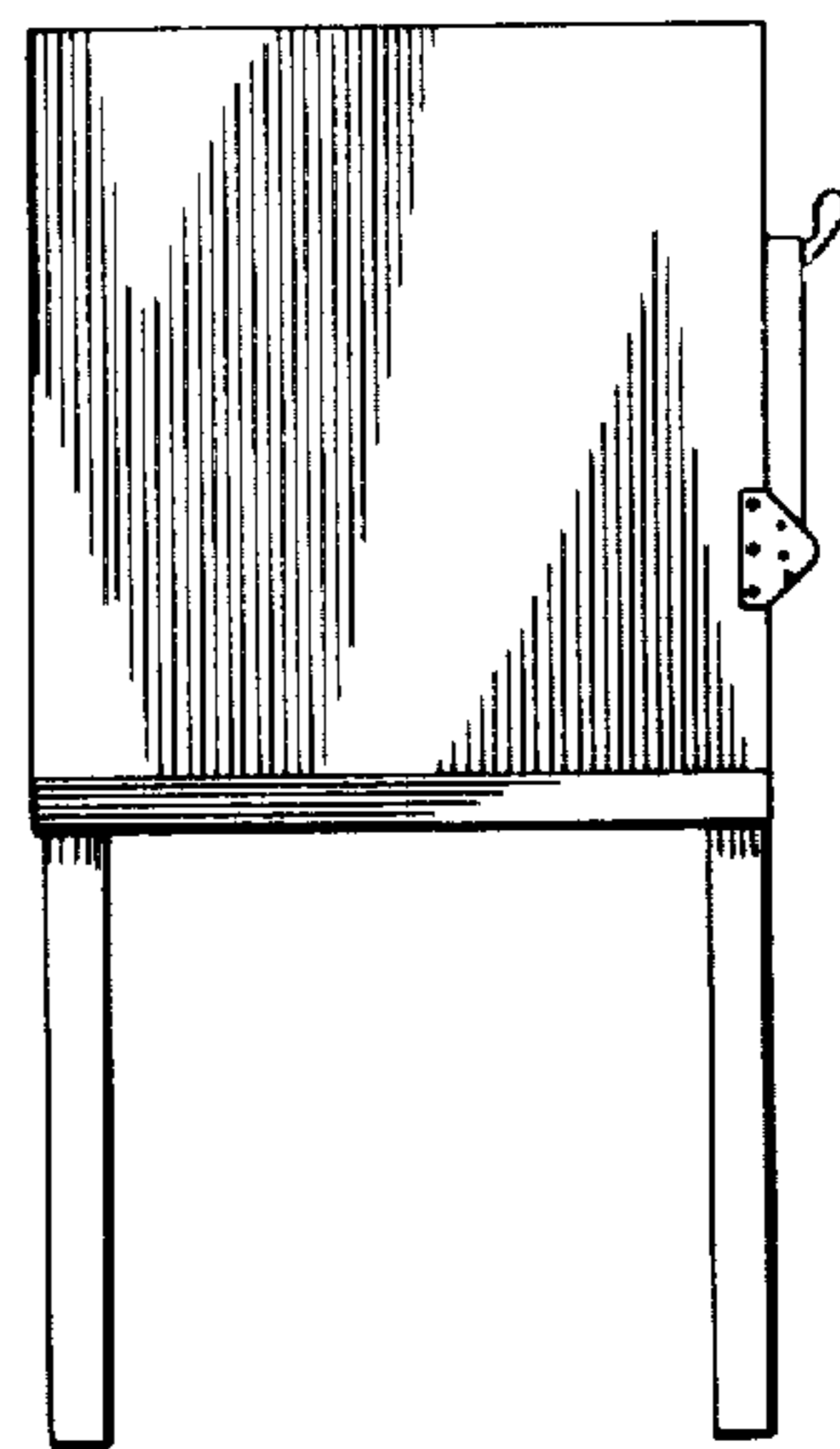

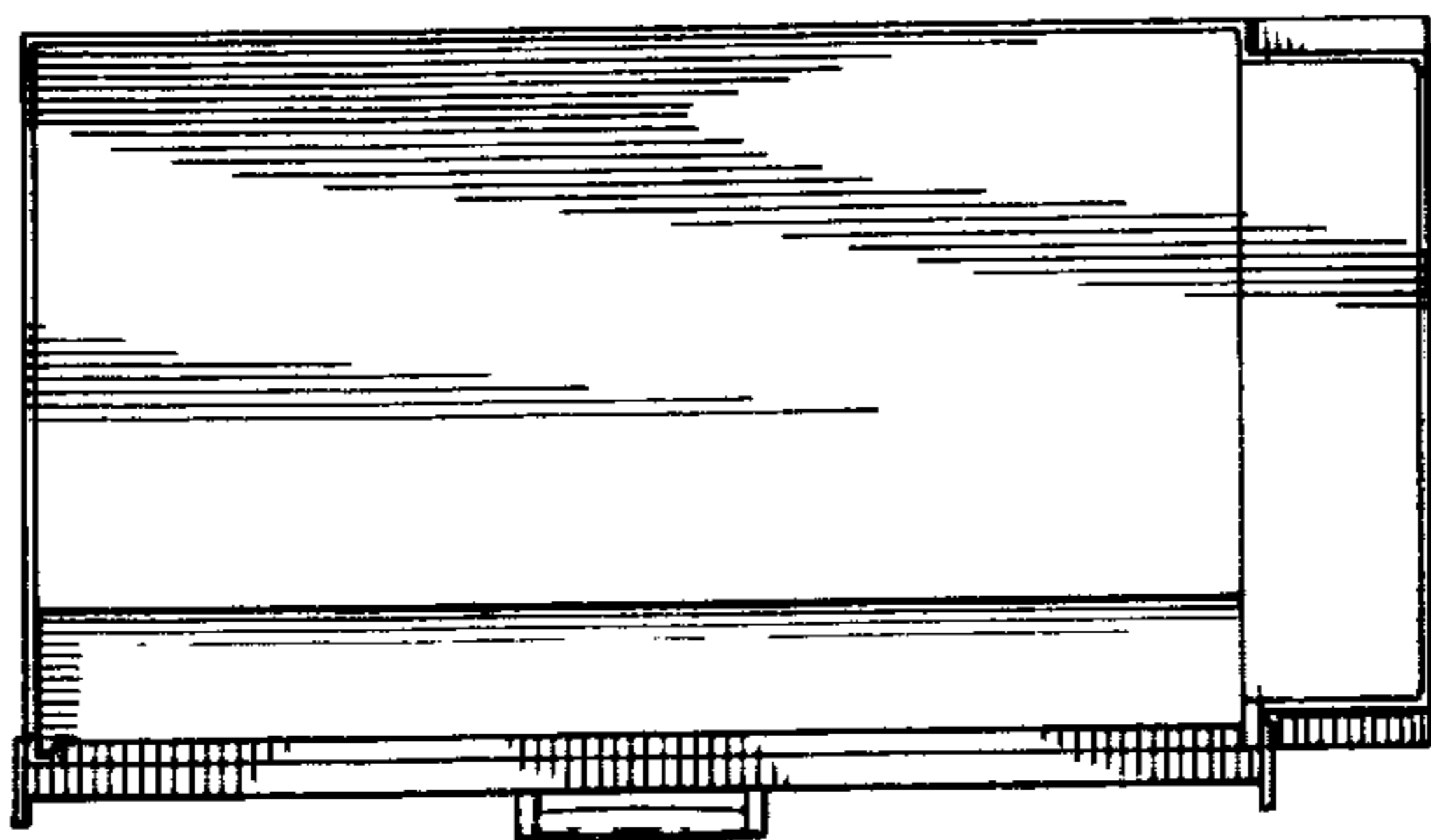
