DESCRIPTION

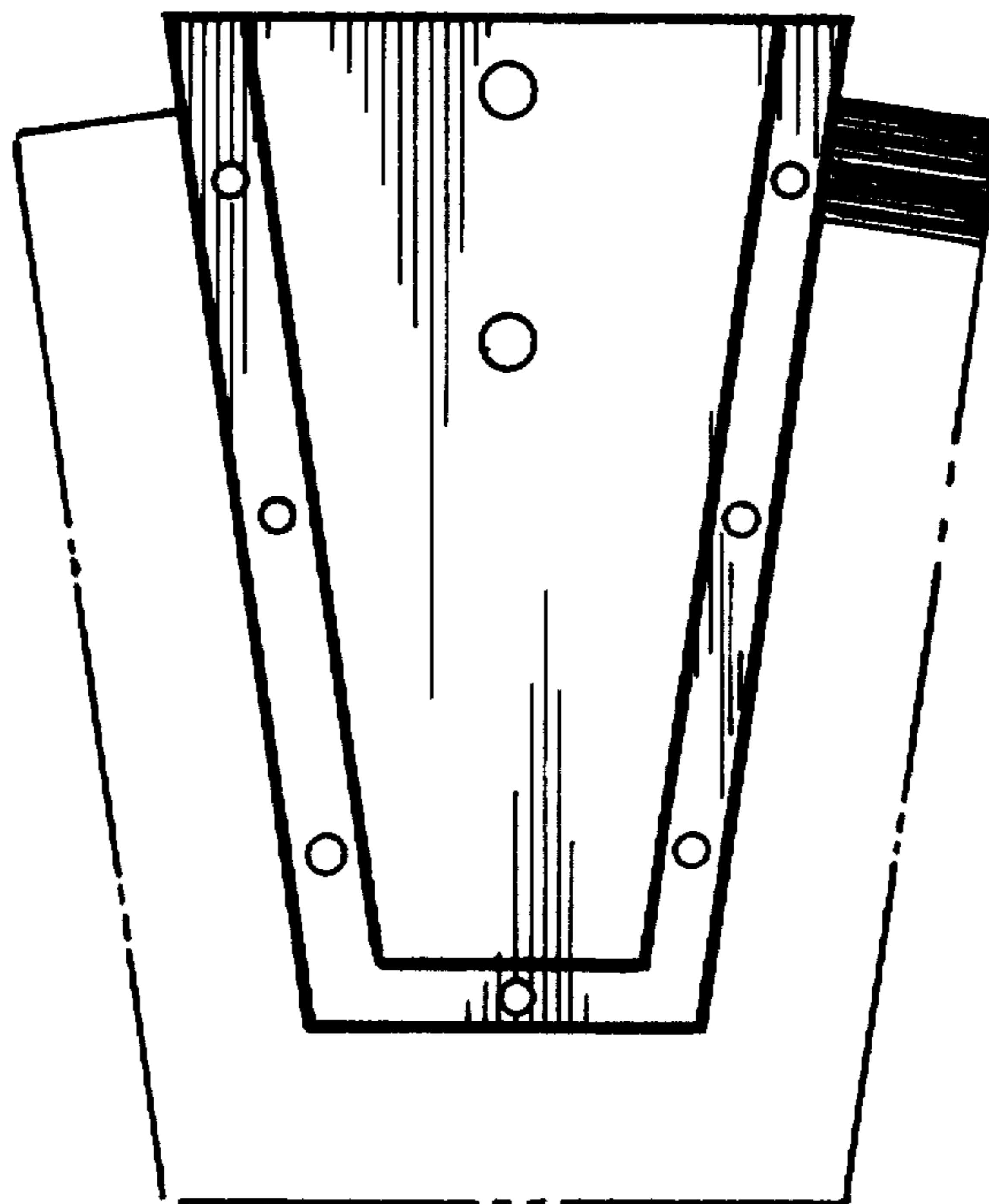
FIG. 1 is a front view of an eavetrough brush showing my new design.

The bristles in FIG. 1 are understood to repeat uniformly and continuously throughout the entire indicated area.



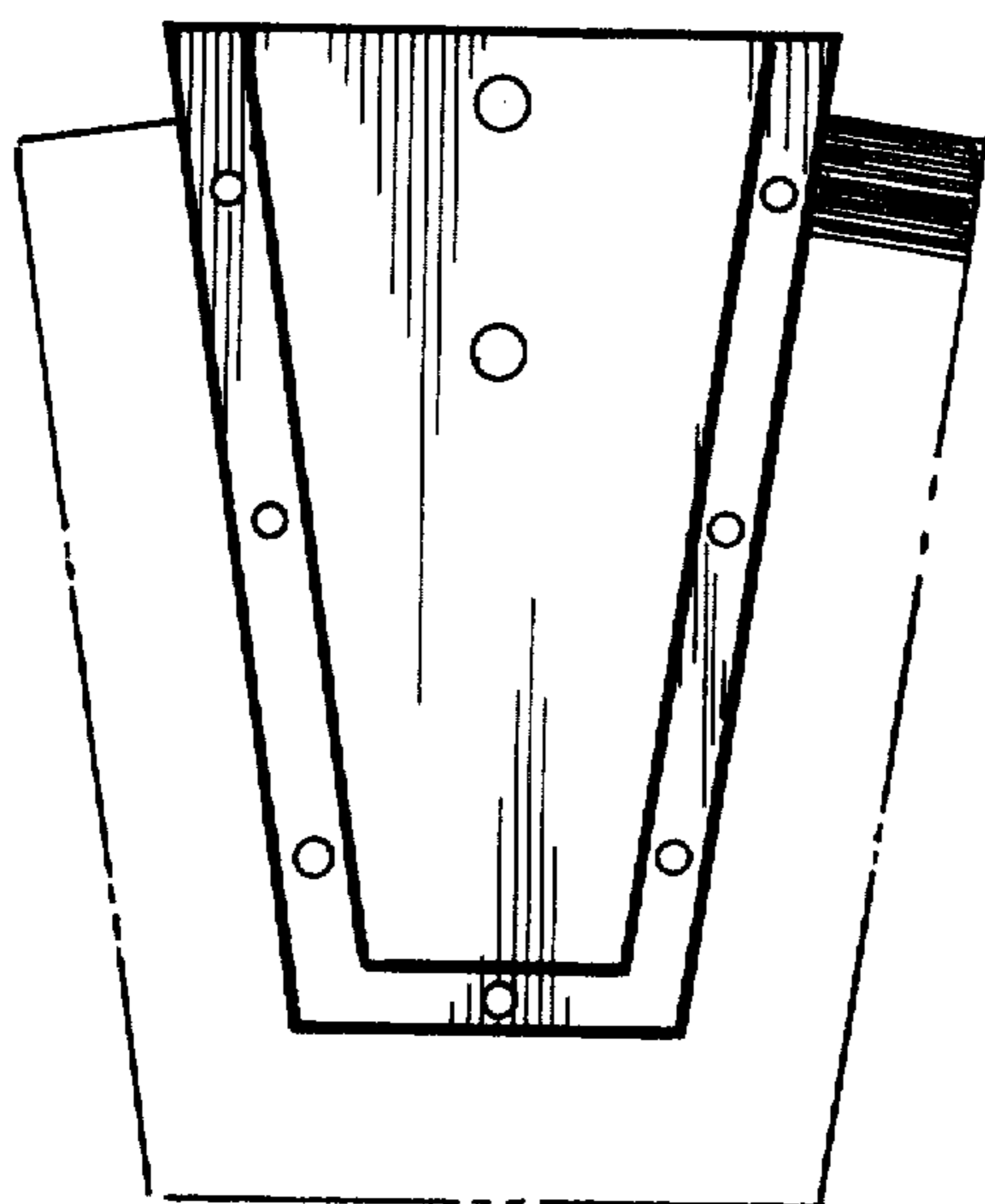
