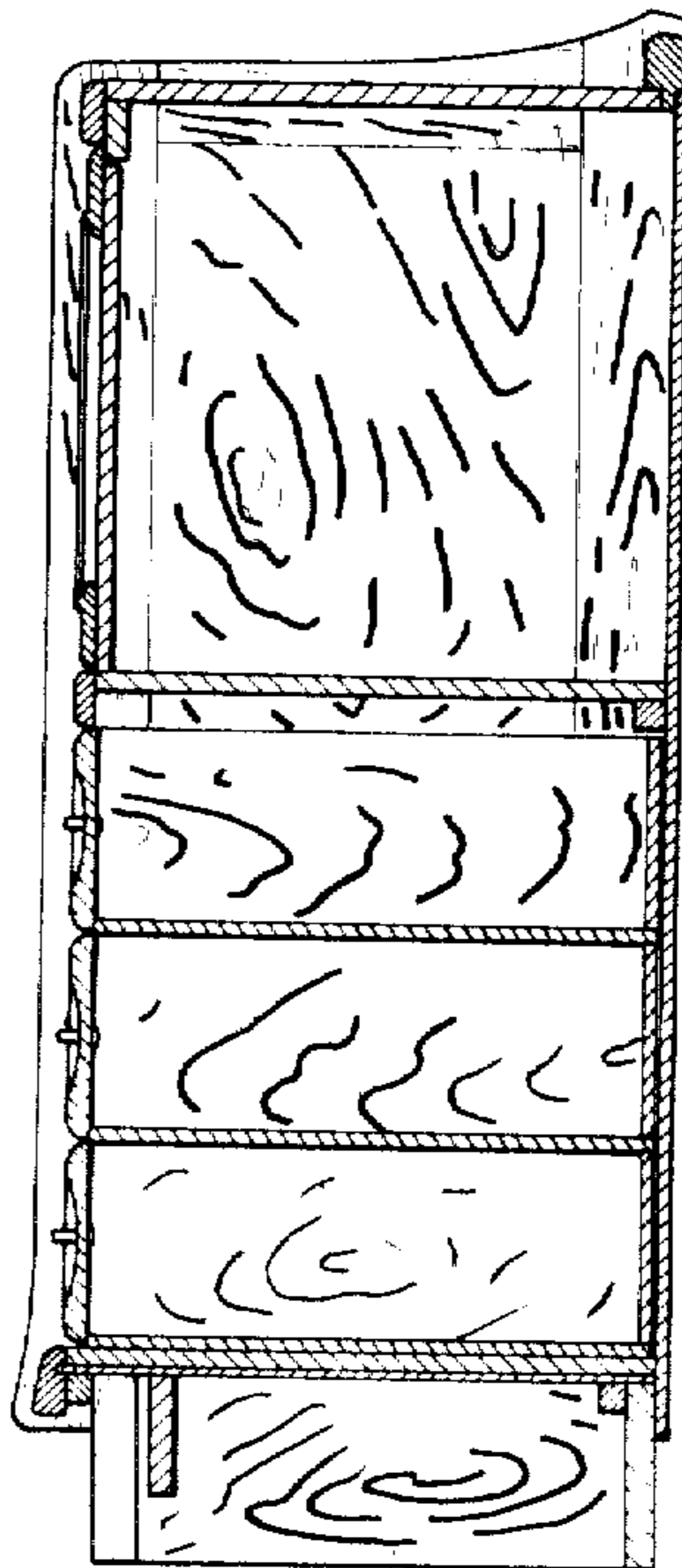
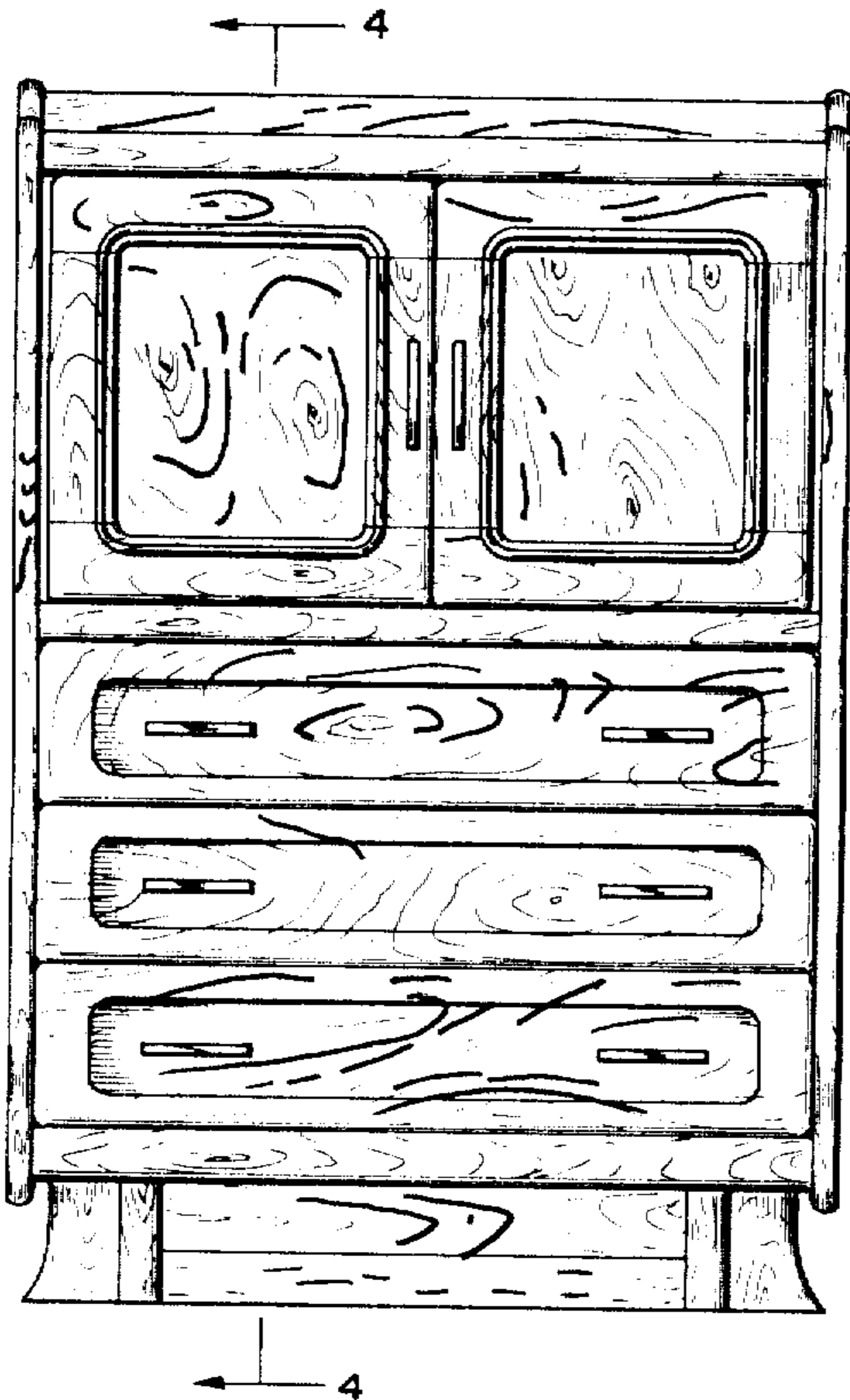

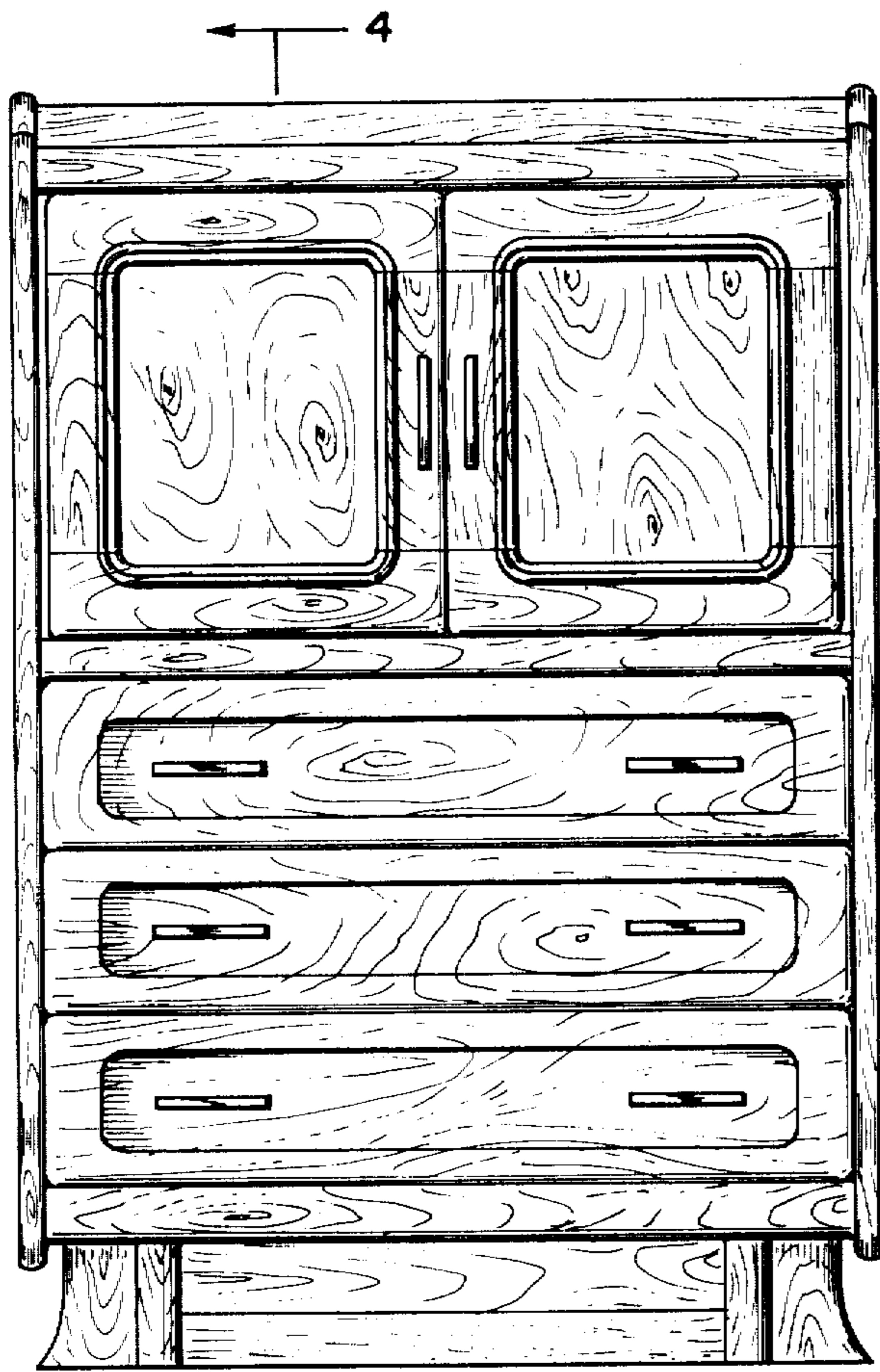
The ornamental design for a door chest, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door chest showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 1.

The rear elevational view of the door chest is conventionally flat and unornamented.

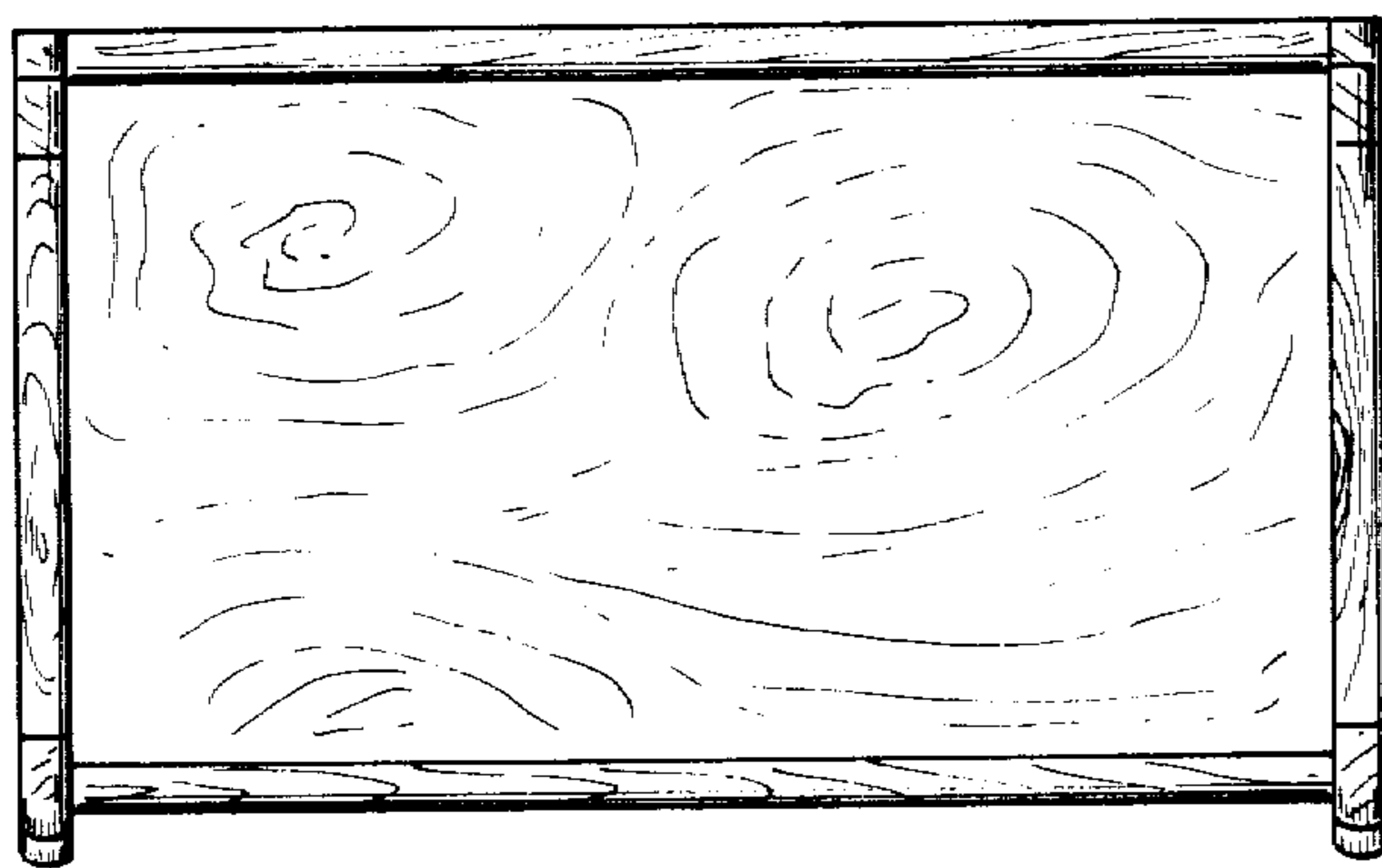

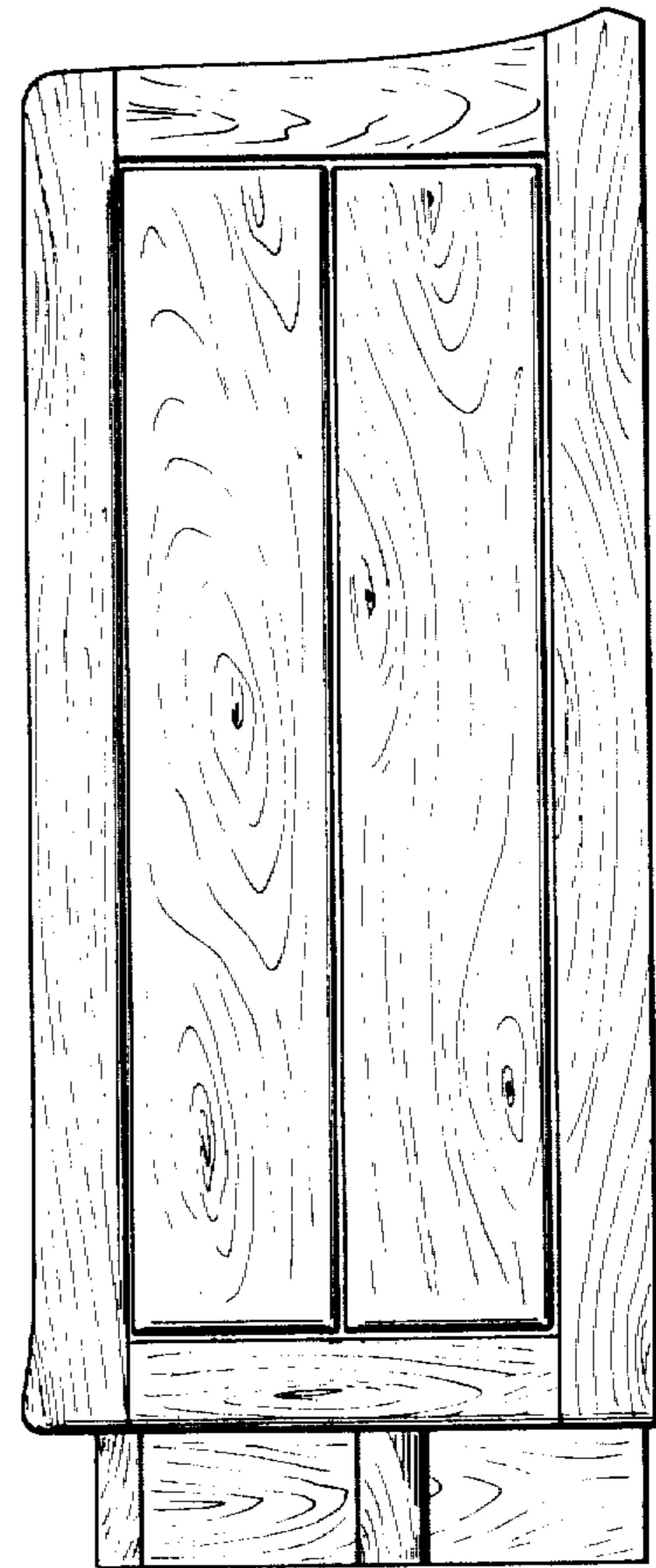

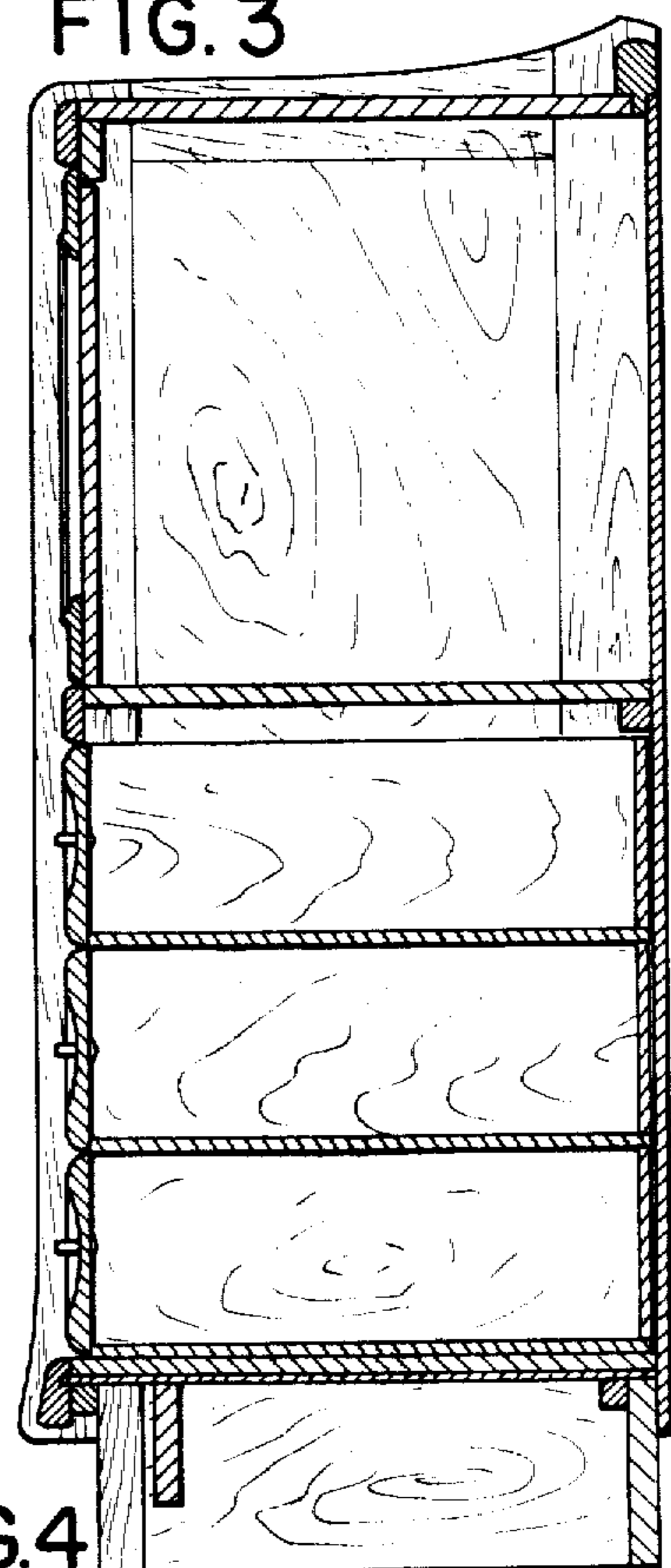
