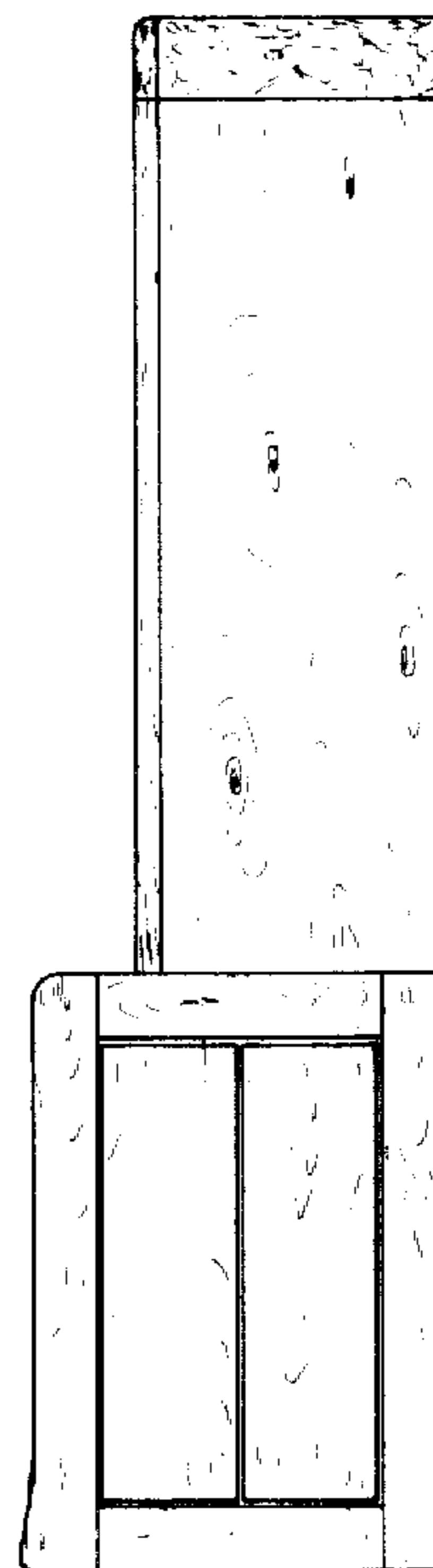
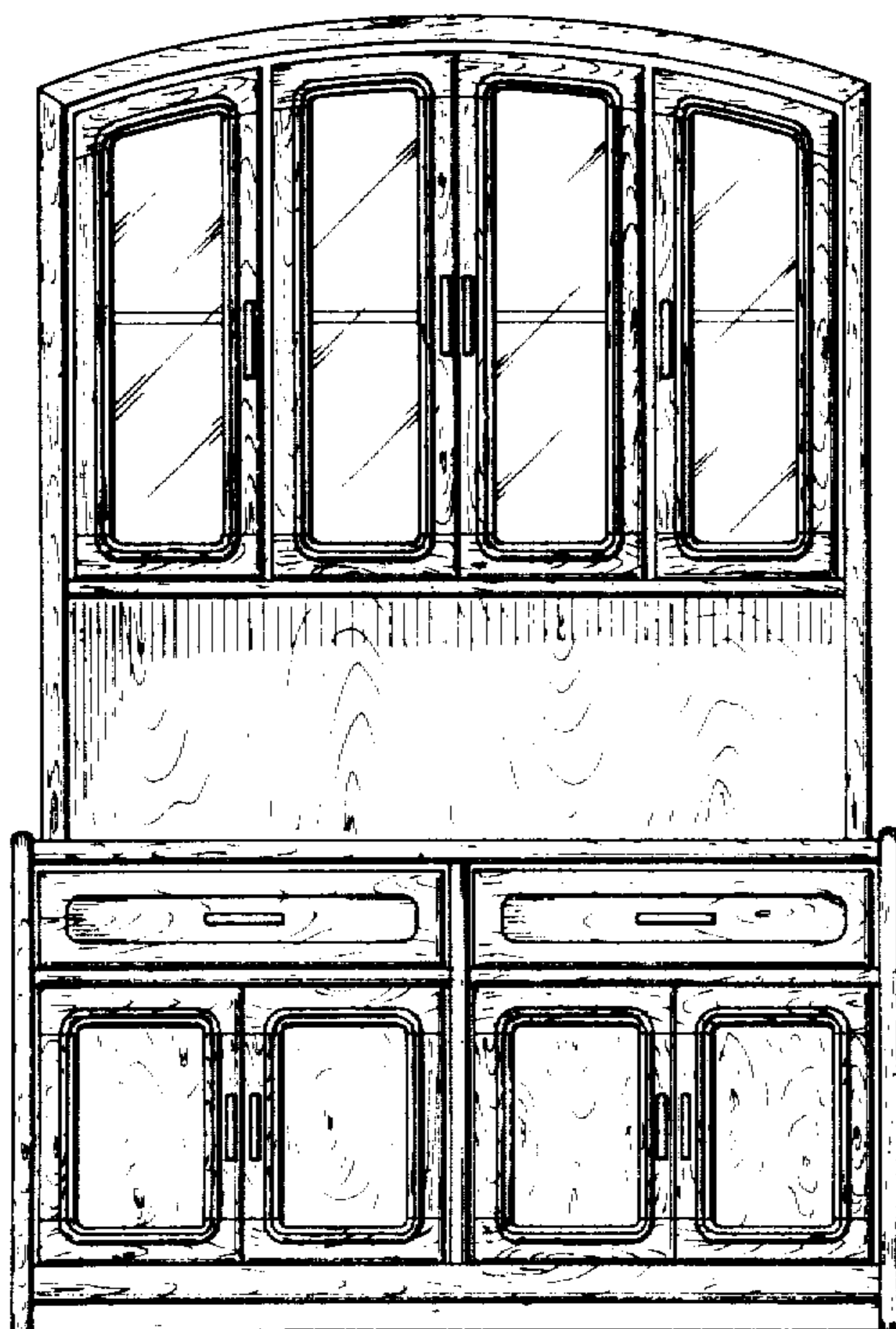
The ornamental design for a china, as shown and de-

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a china showing my  
new design; and

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left  
side being a mirror image thereof.

The top surfaces of the china are plain and unorna-  
mented while the rear of the china is conventionally flat  
and unornamented.



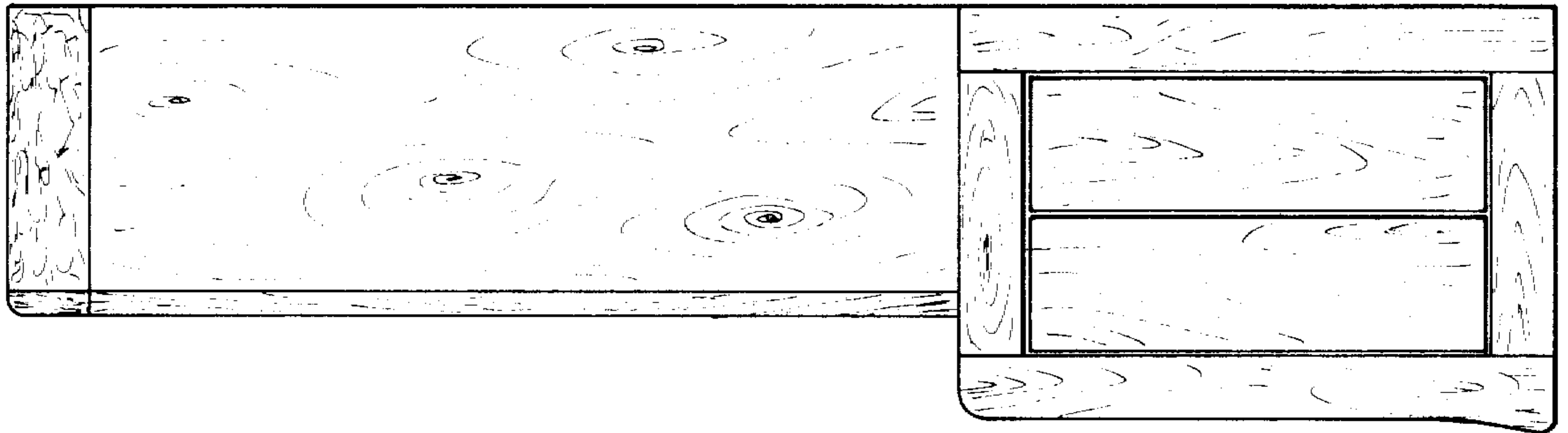

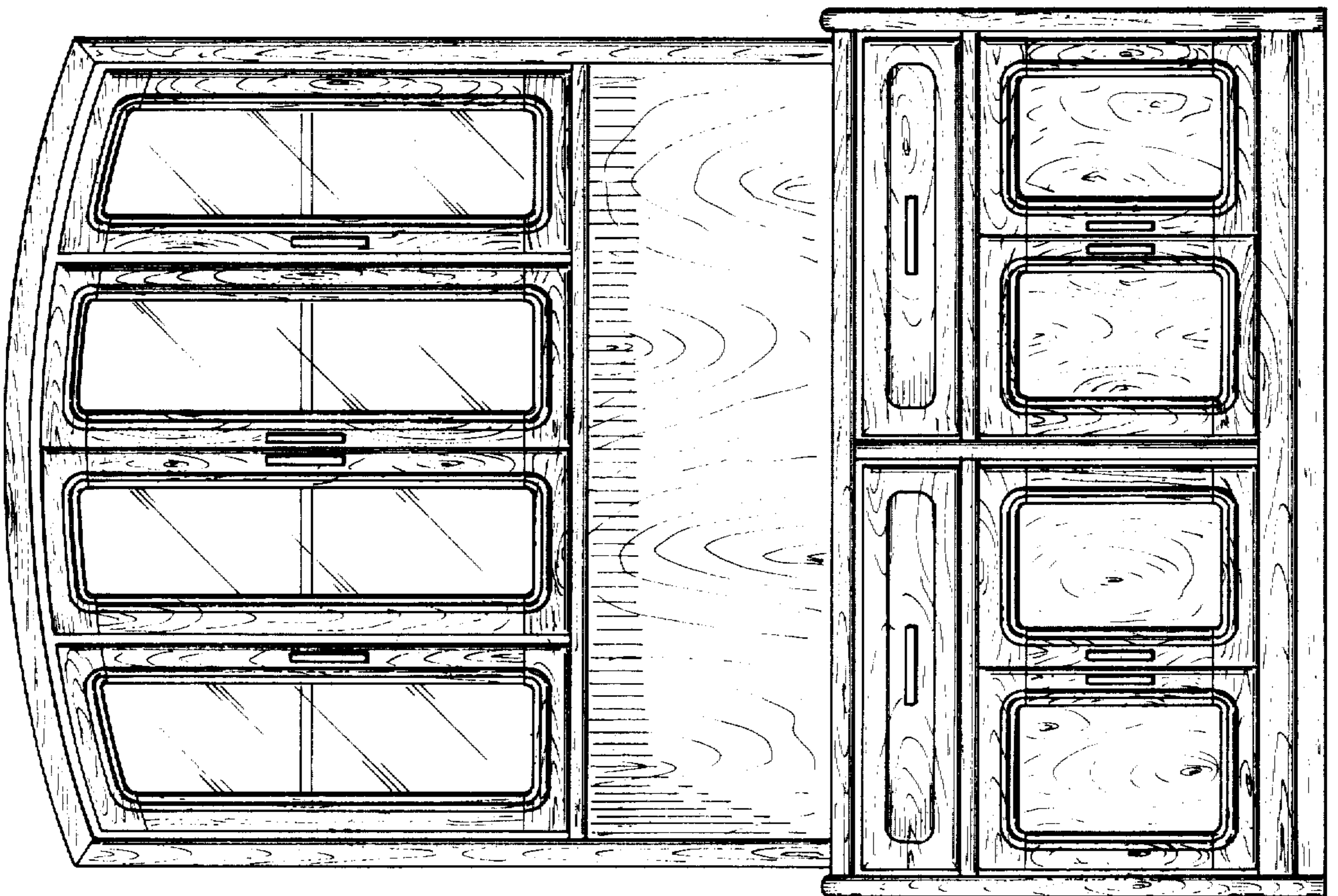
