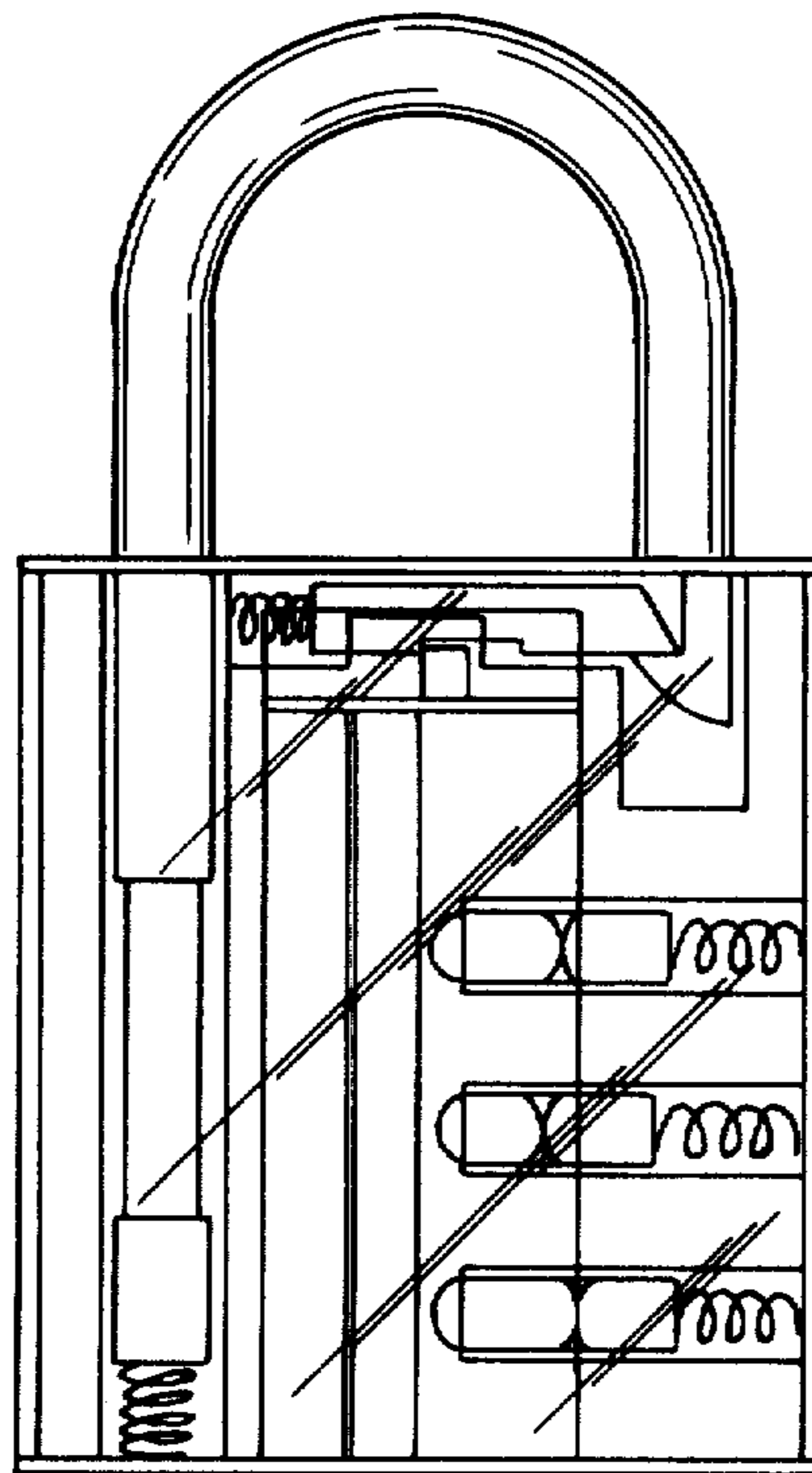

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy padlock, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy padlock showing my new design,
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



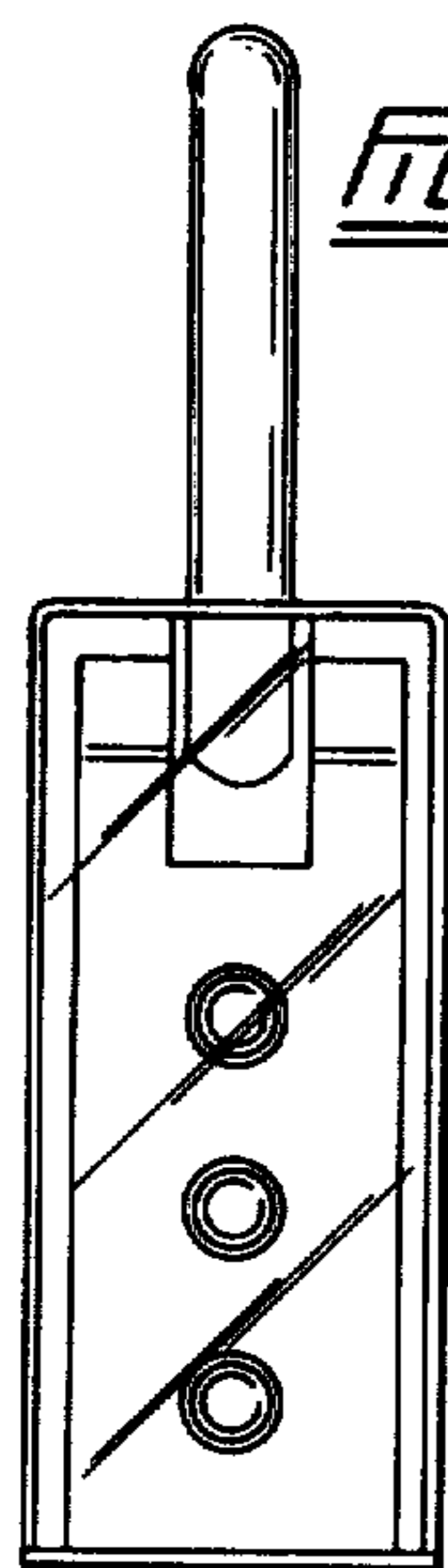

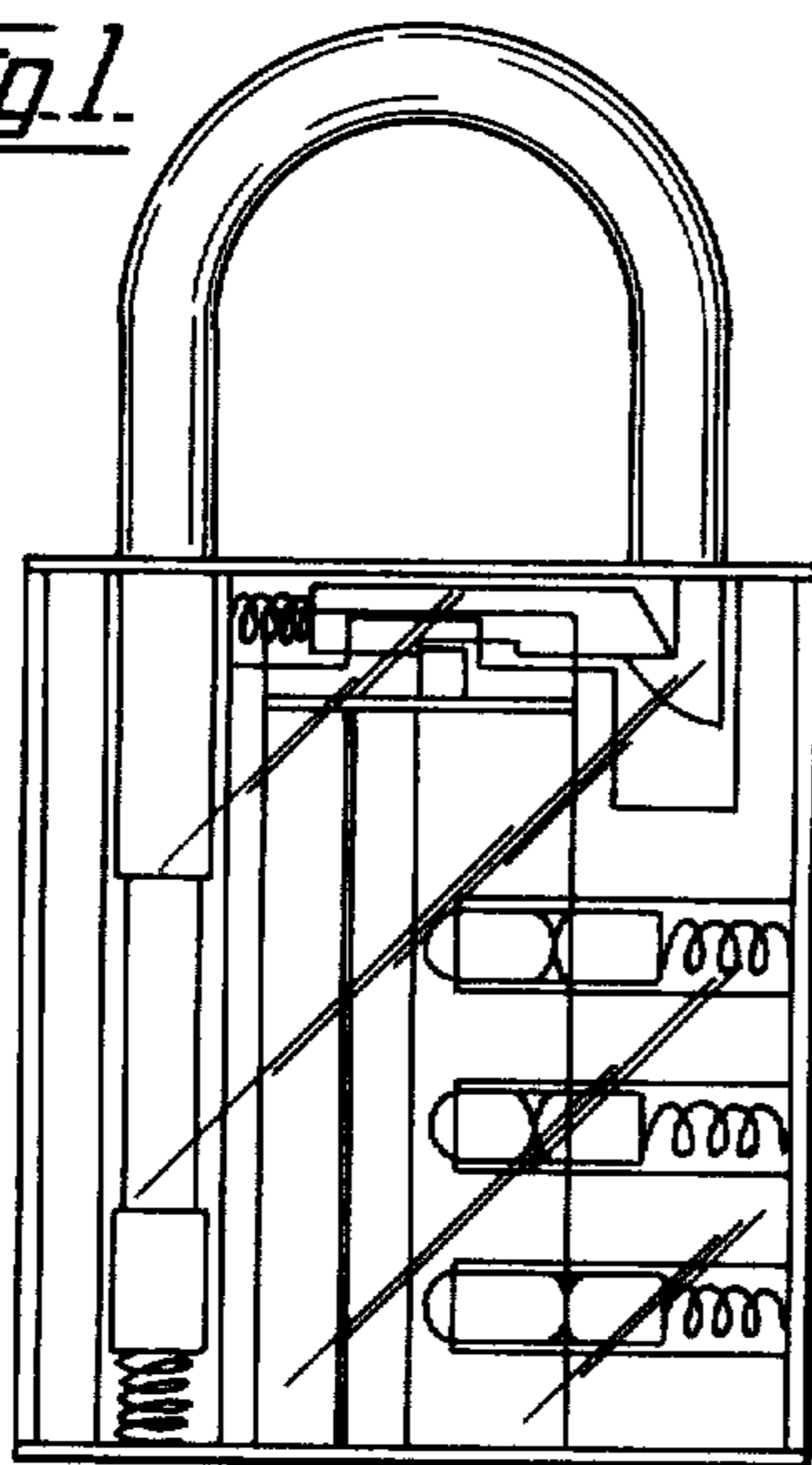

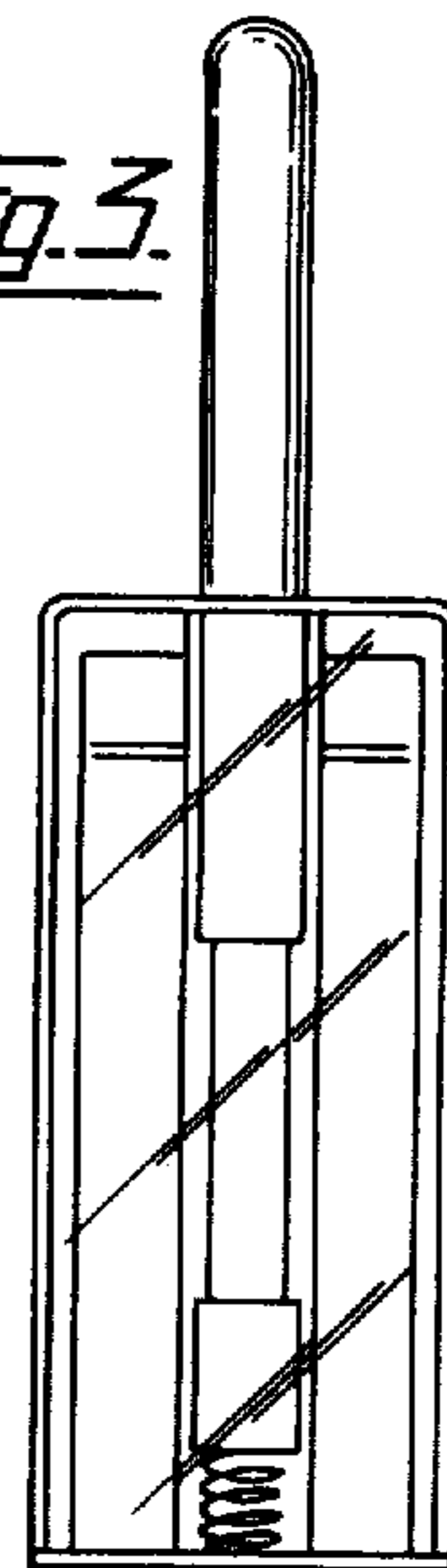

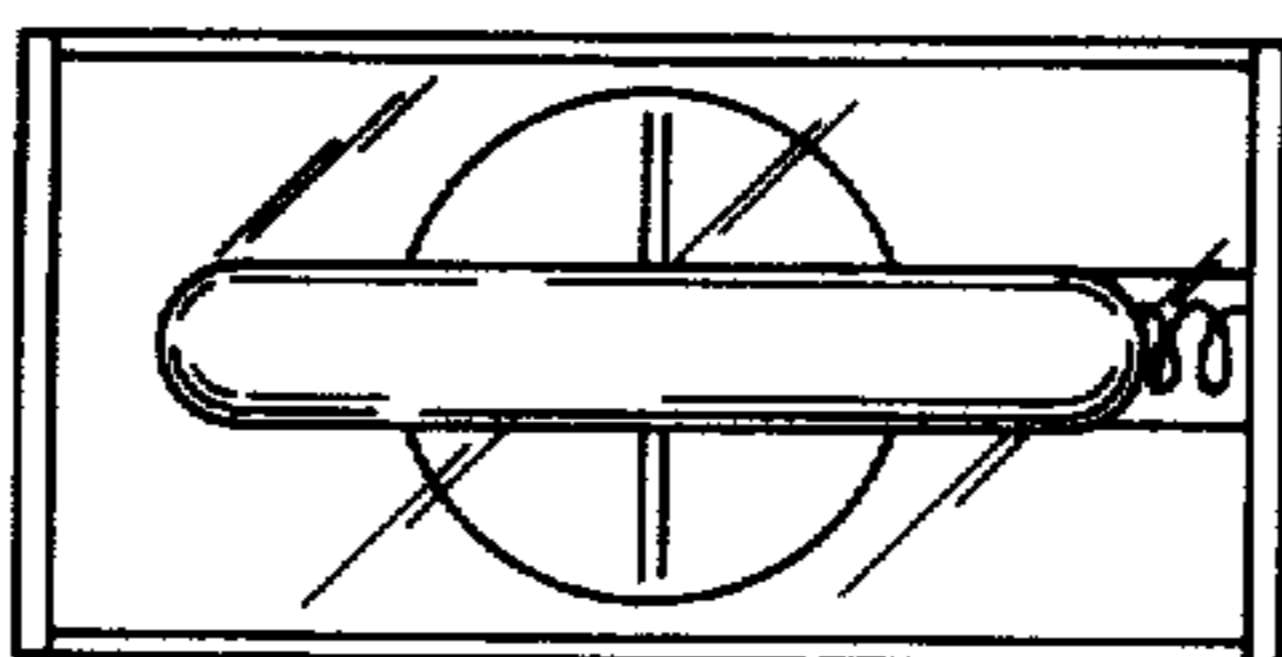

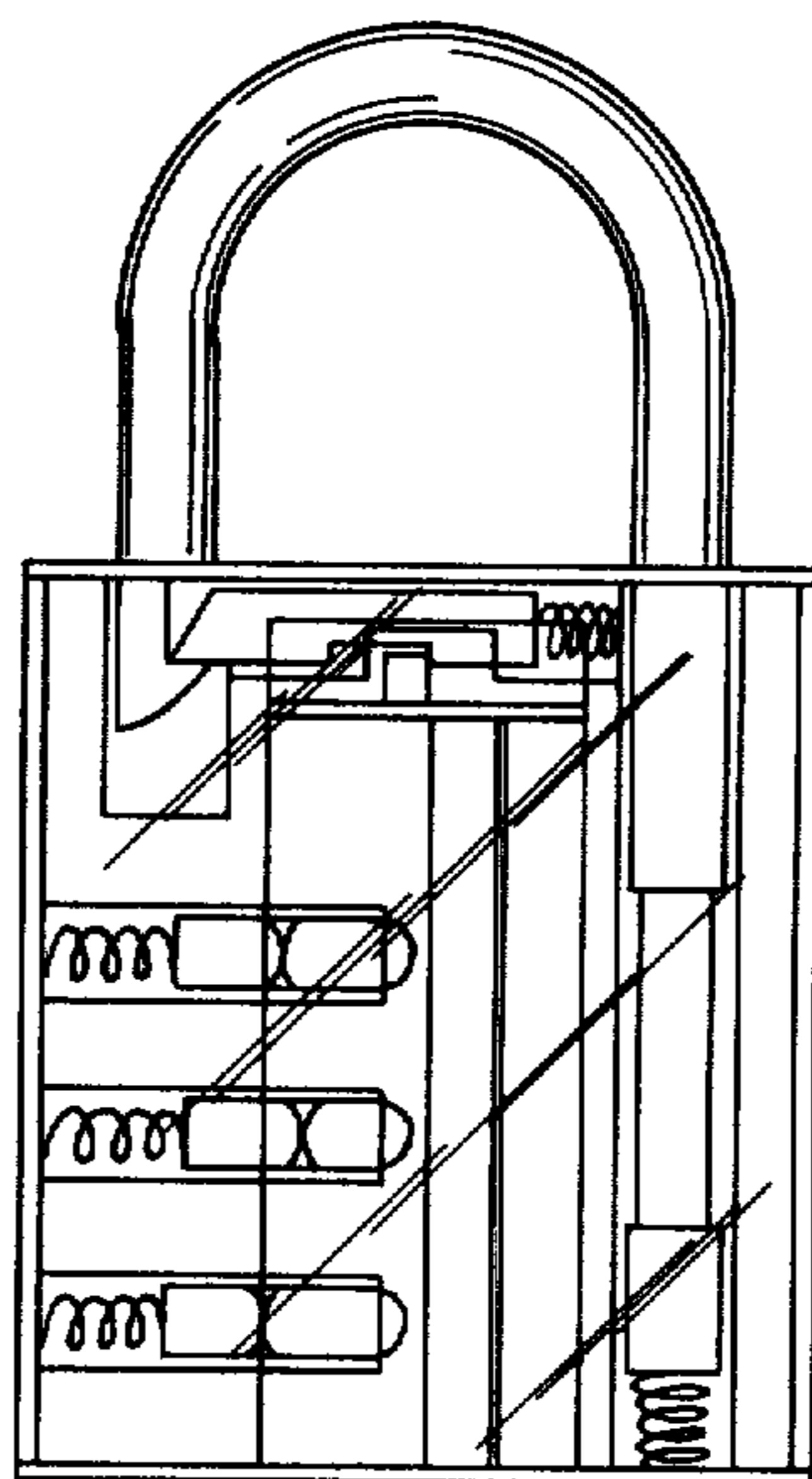
