CLAIM

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and seribed.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing they design in the form of a sofa;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the seat shown in the form of a loveseat;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of the seat shown in the form of an armchair; and

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the seat.

The side of the seat not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 4 while the rear of the seat is conventional in appearance.
