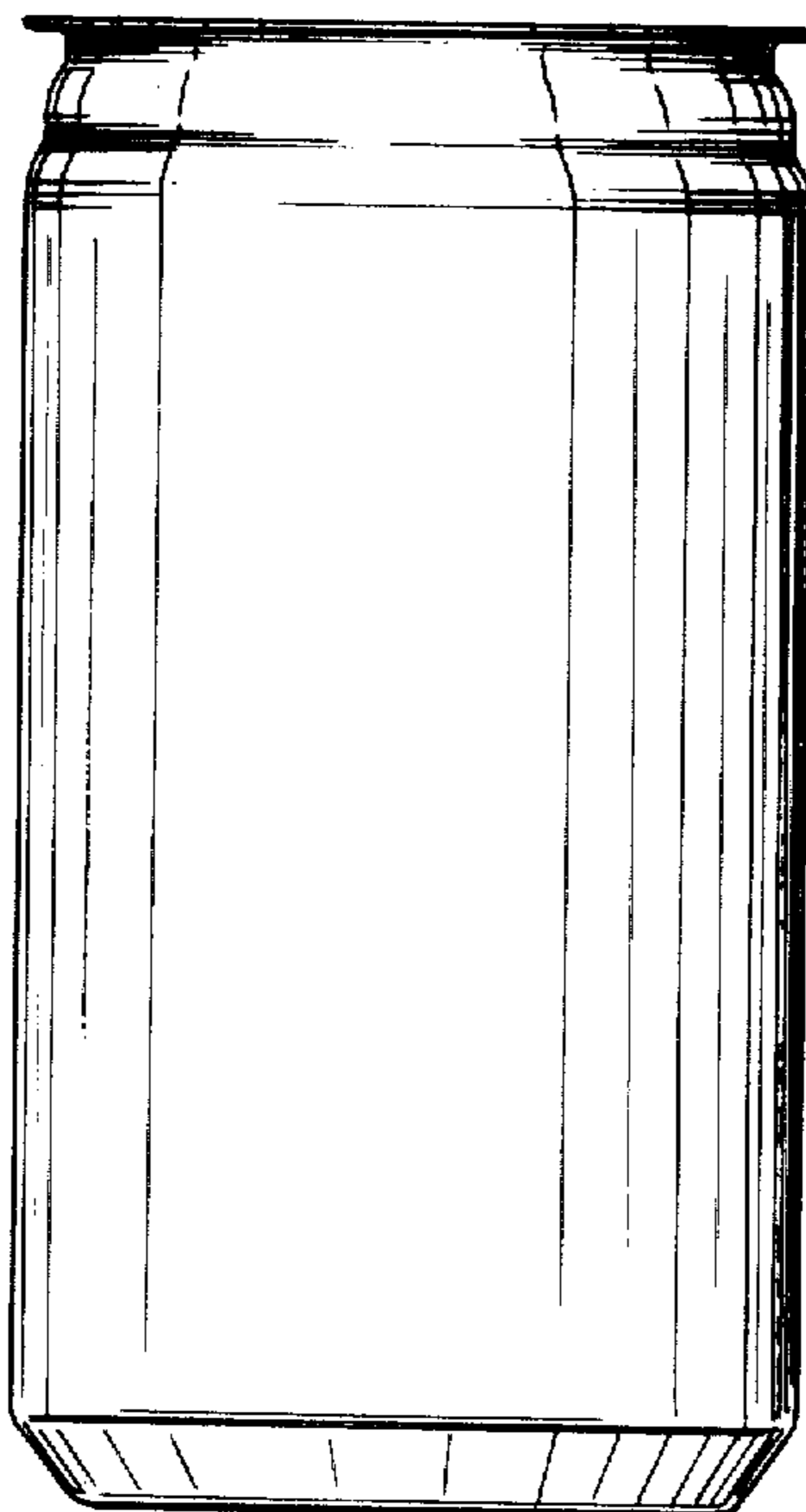
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

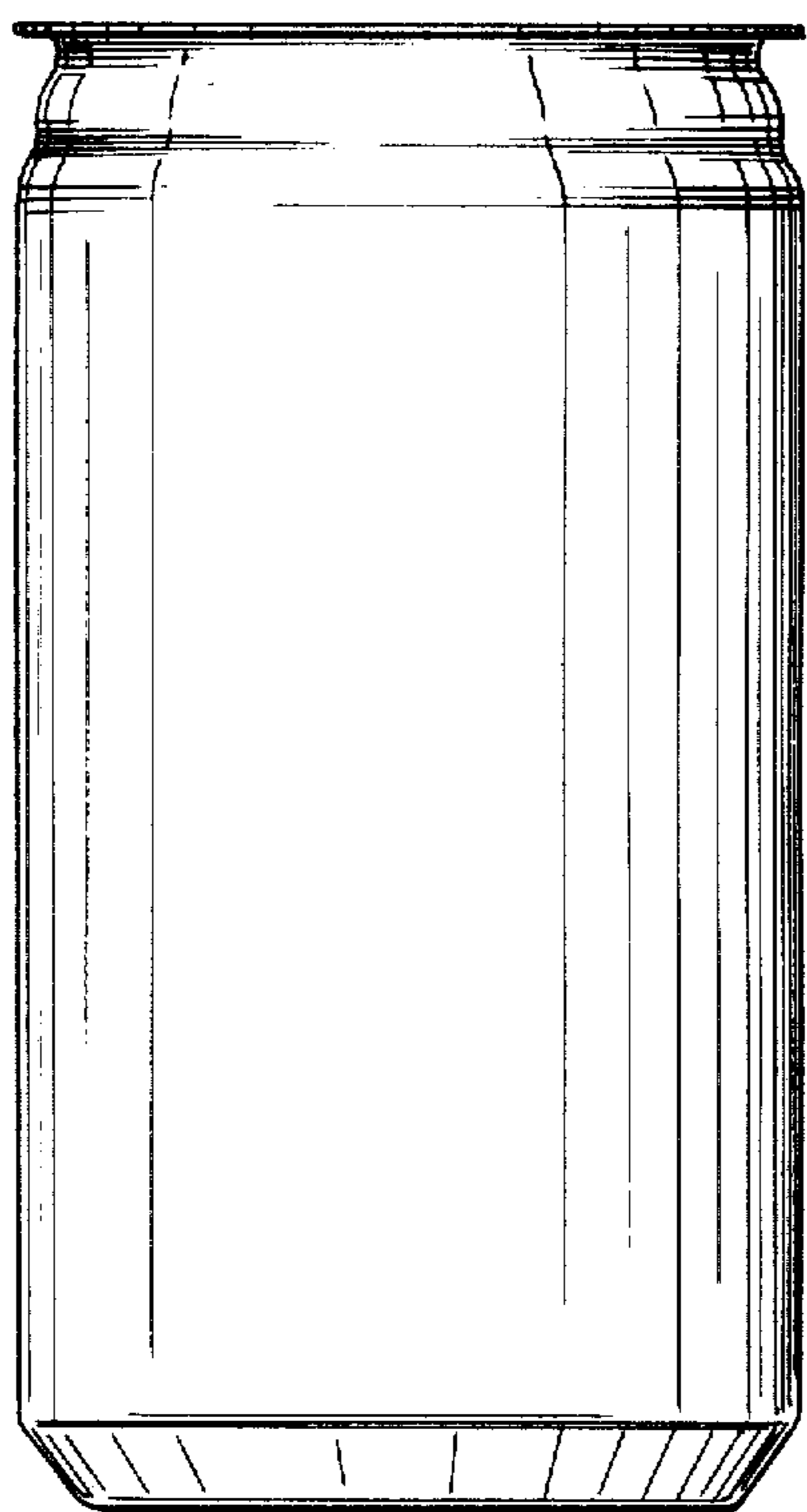

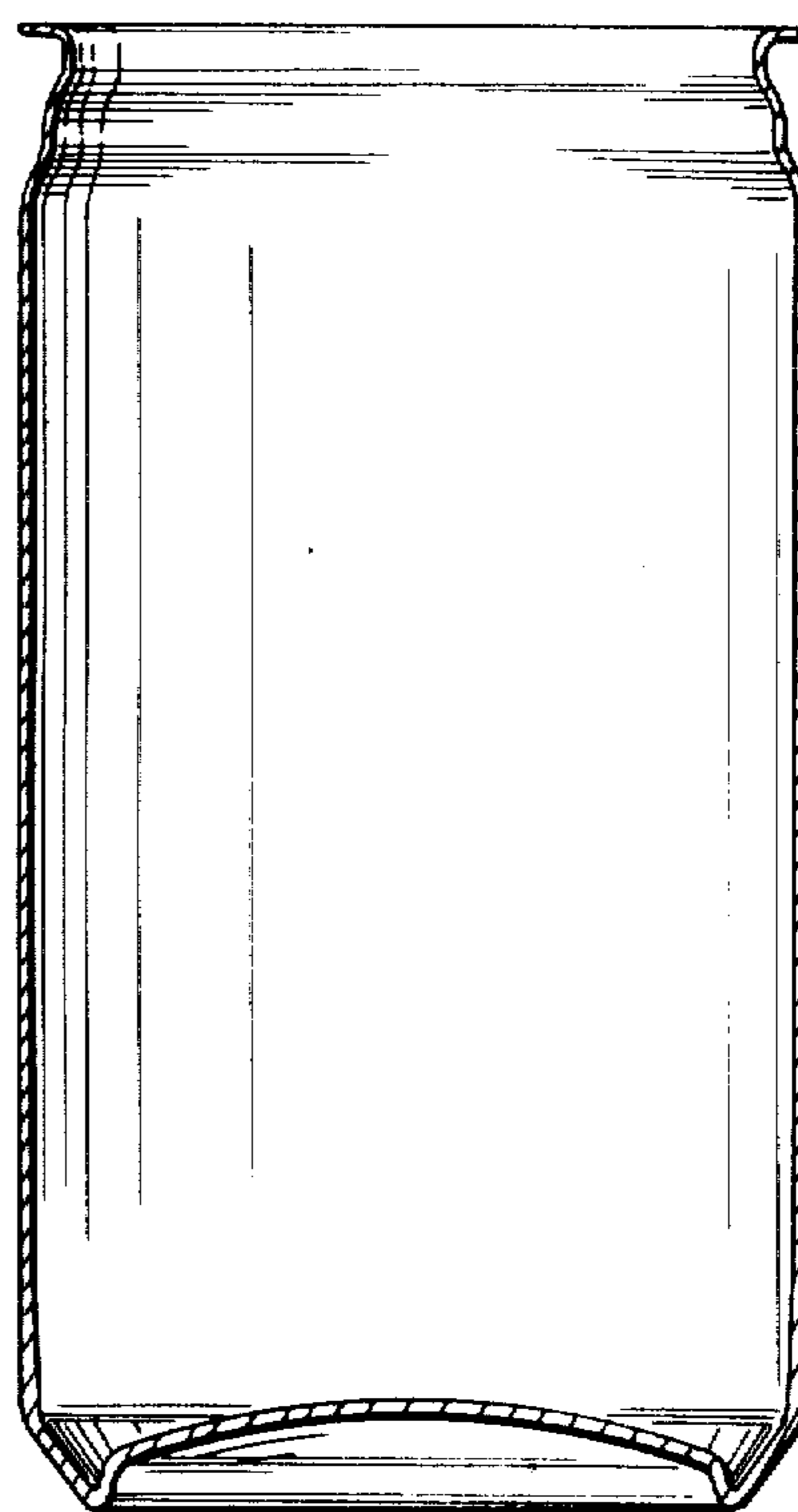

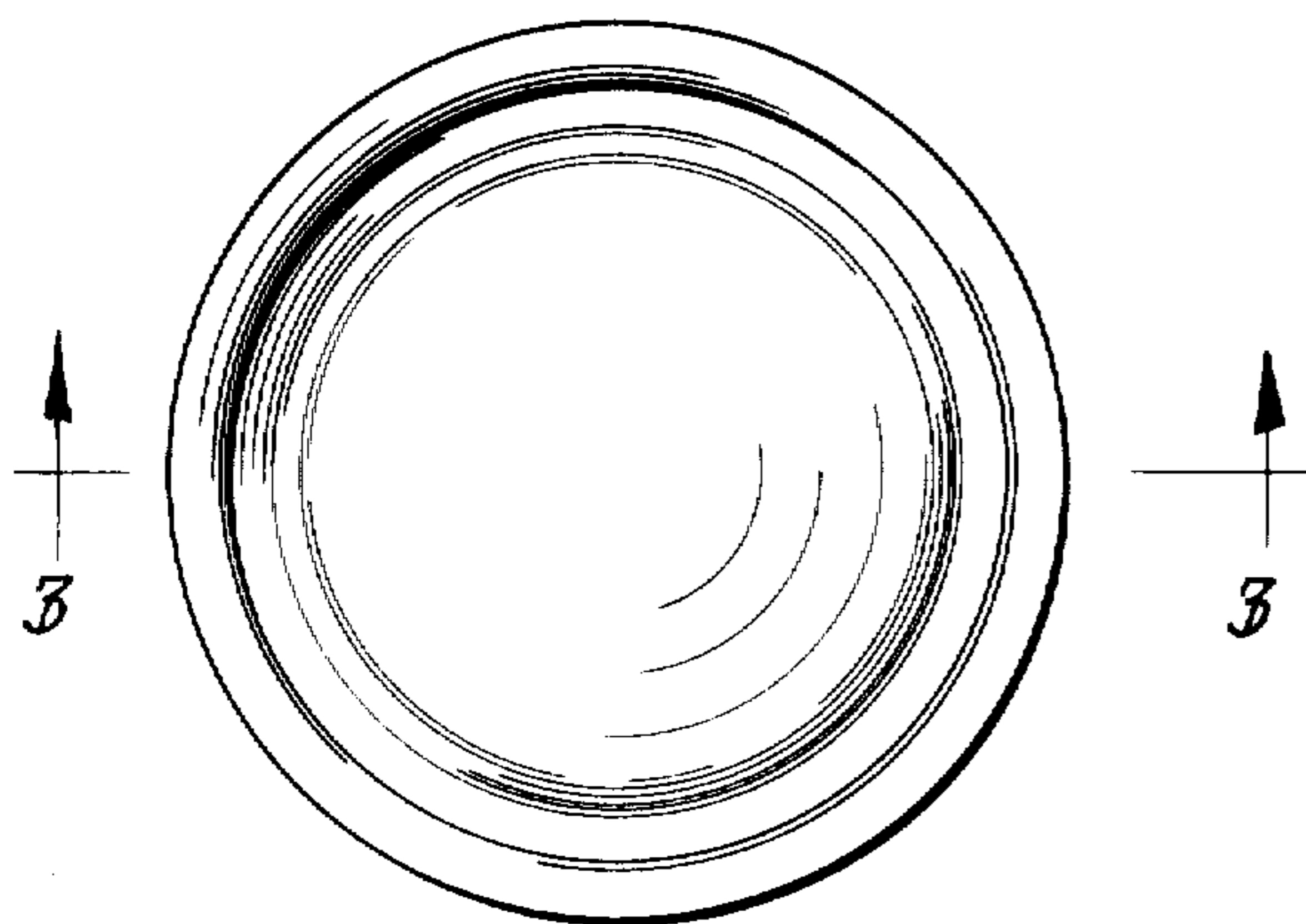

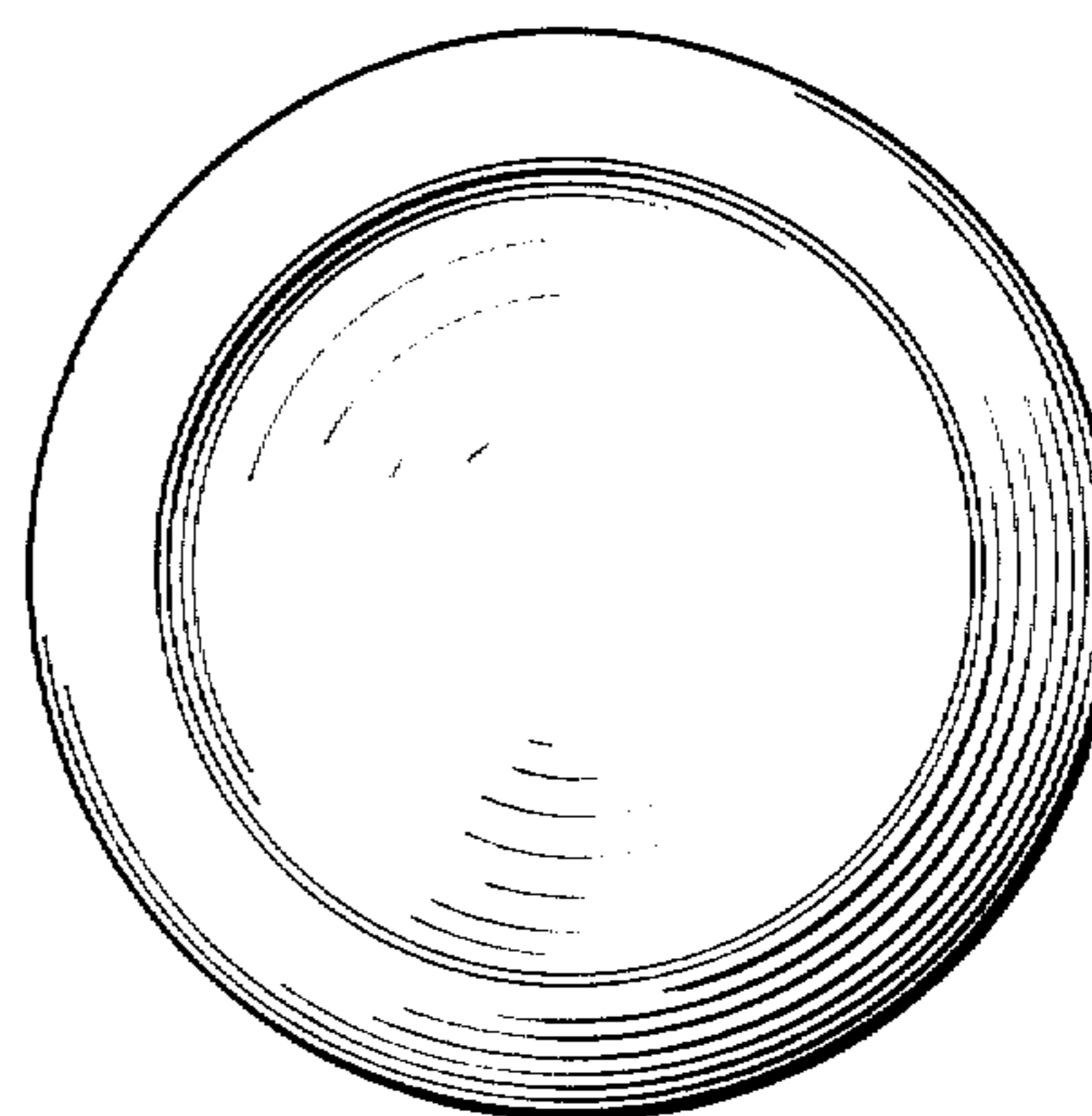
