[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lighted water game housing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lighted water game housing showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof. The side opposite that shown in FIG. 2 is essentially a mirror image thereof.

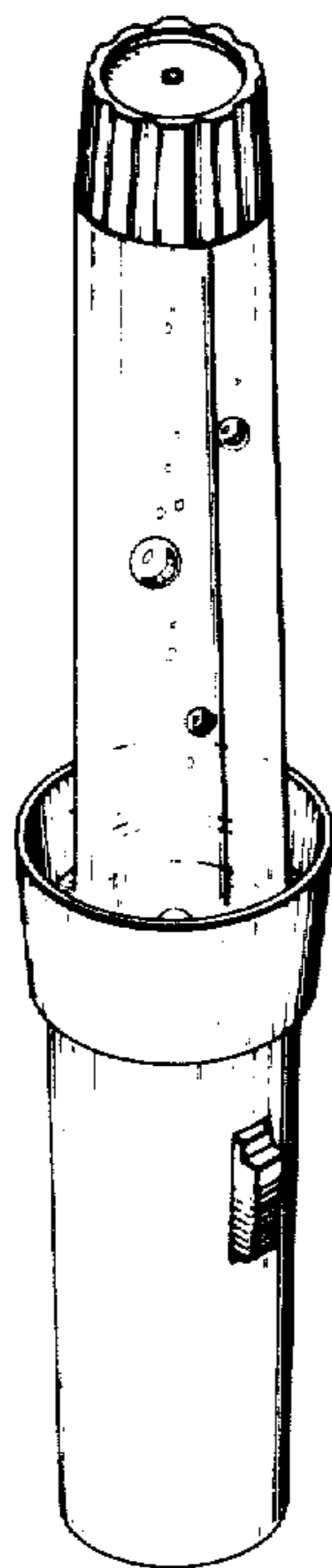

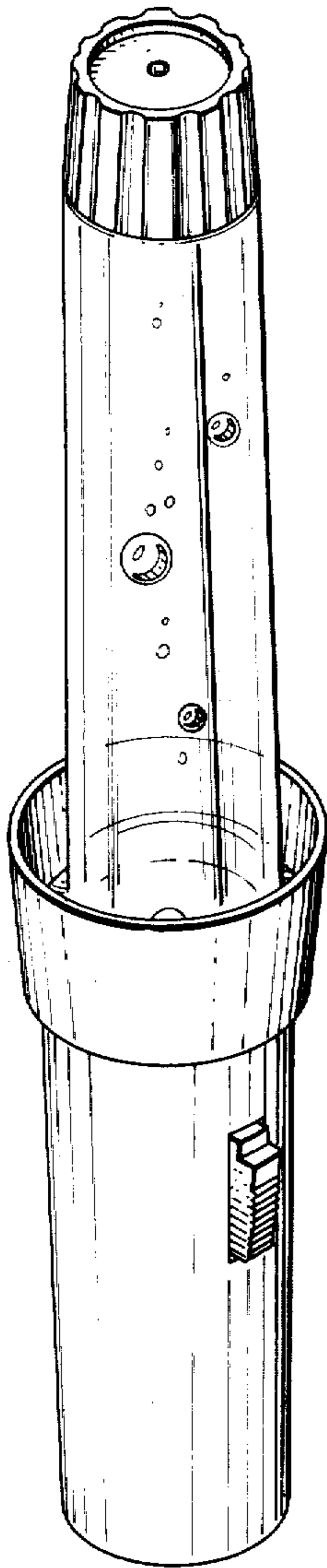

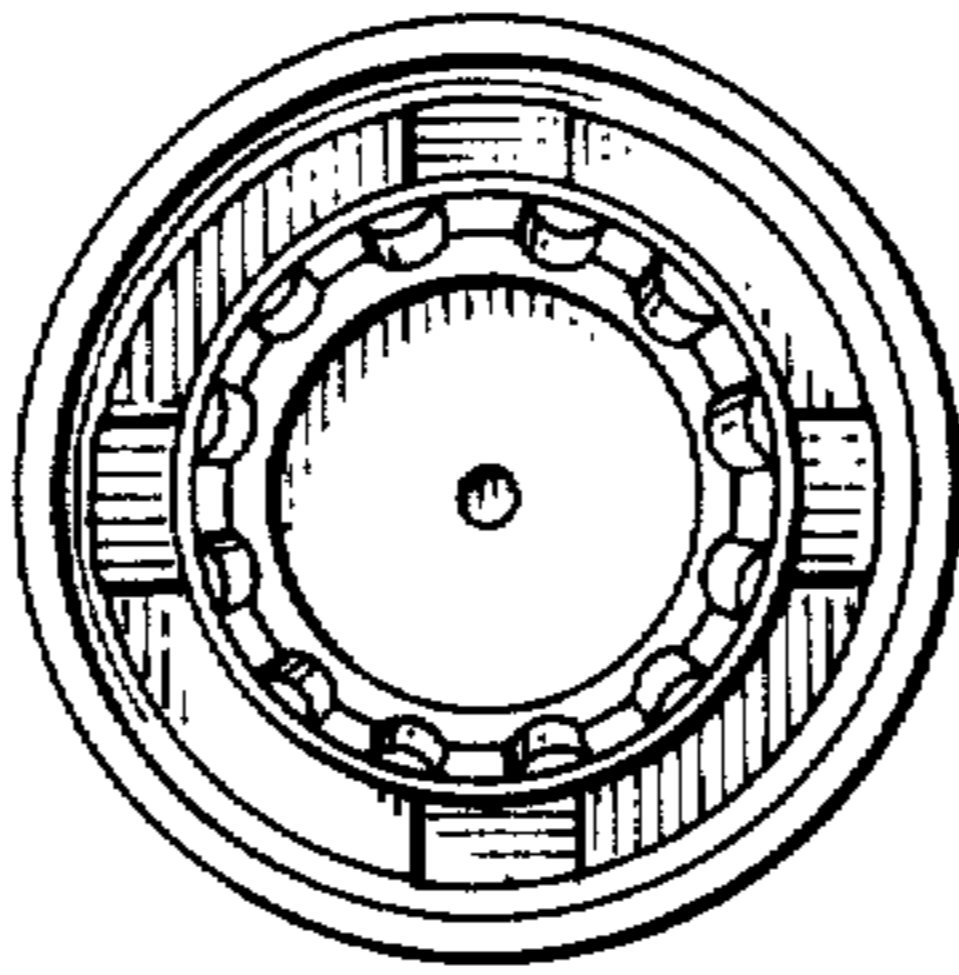

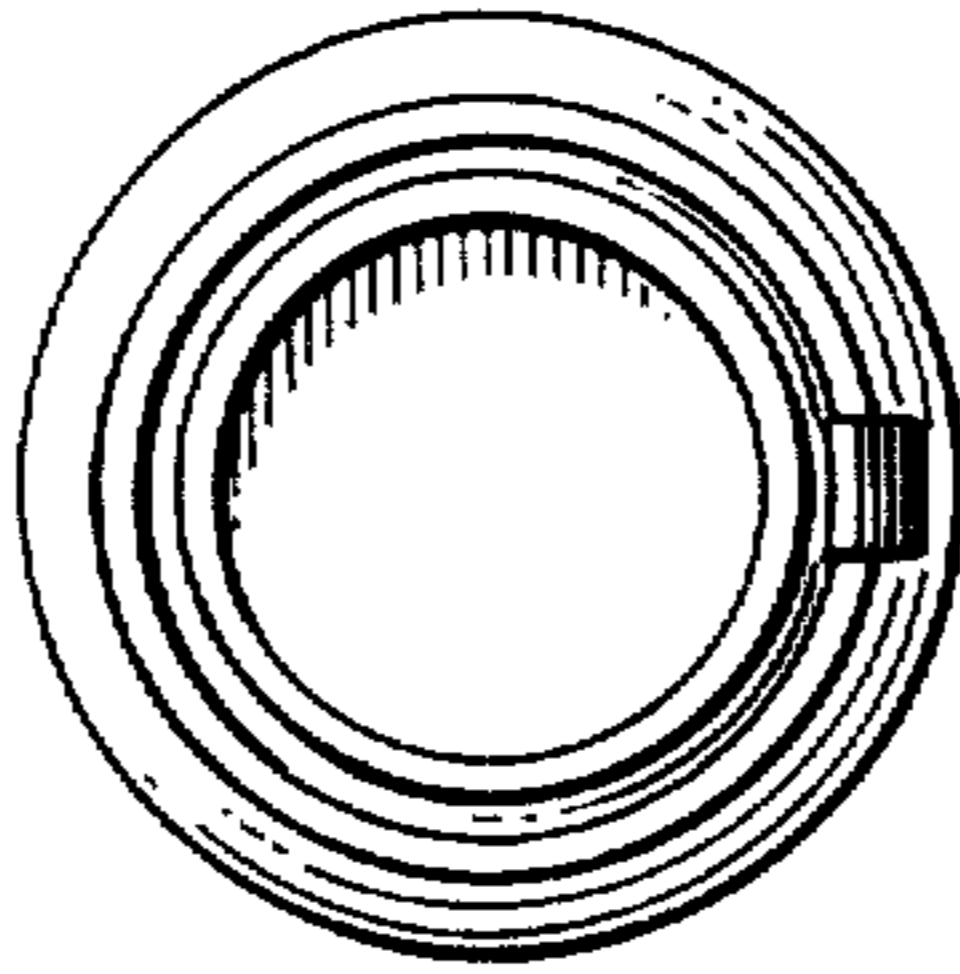
