DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side perspective view of the toy saber saw showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

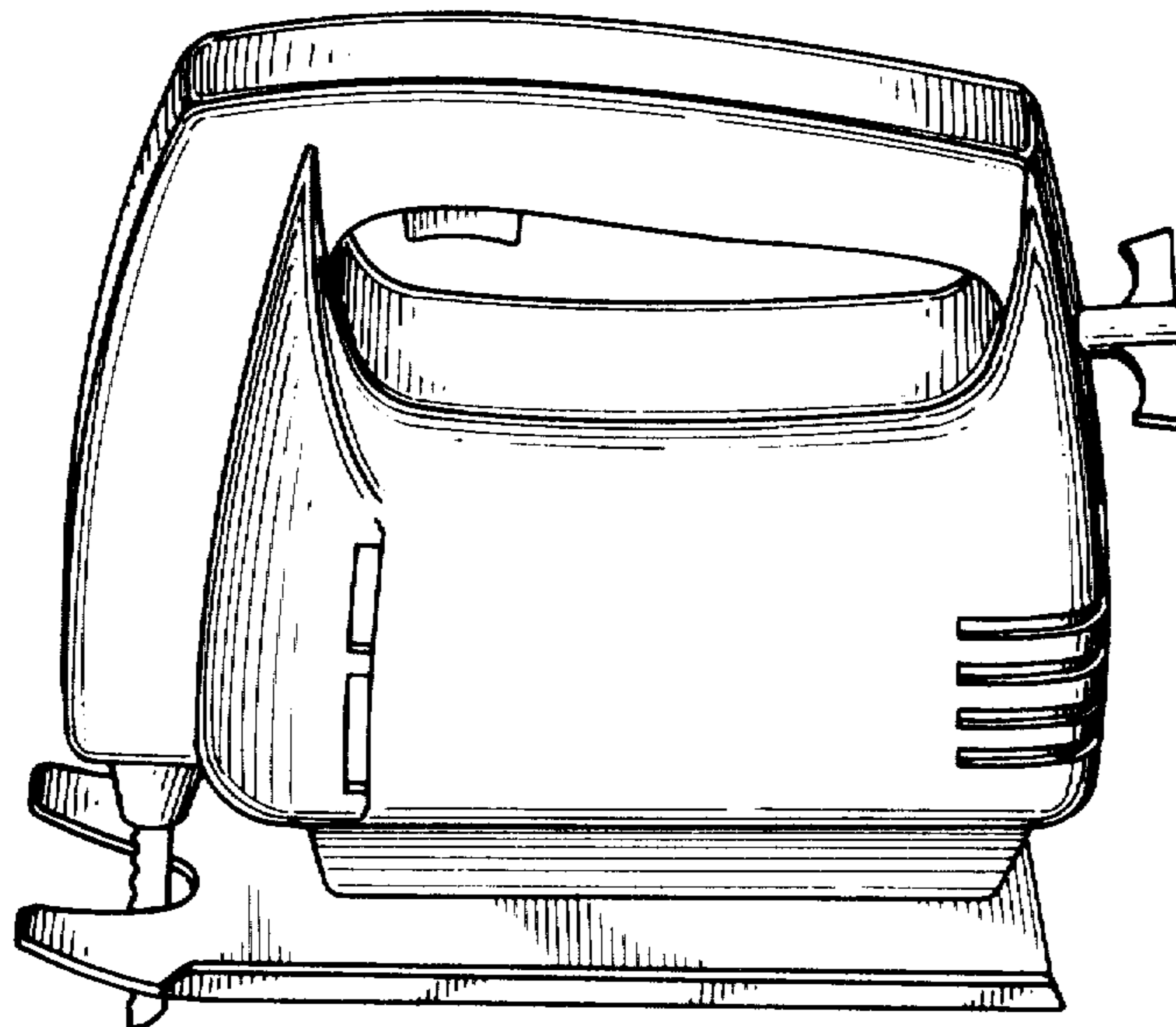

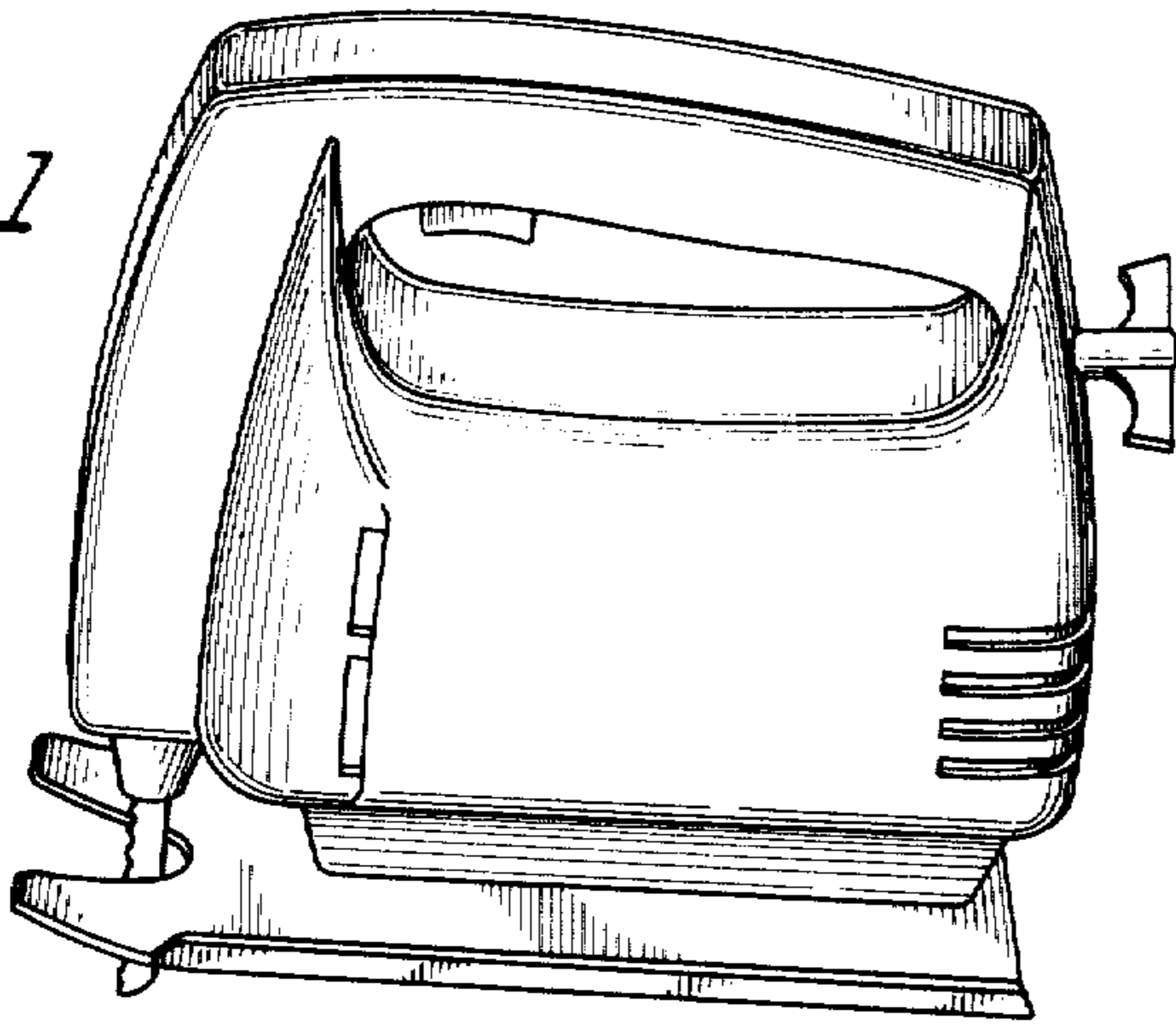

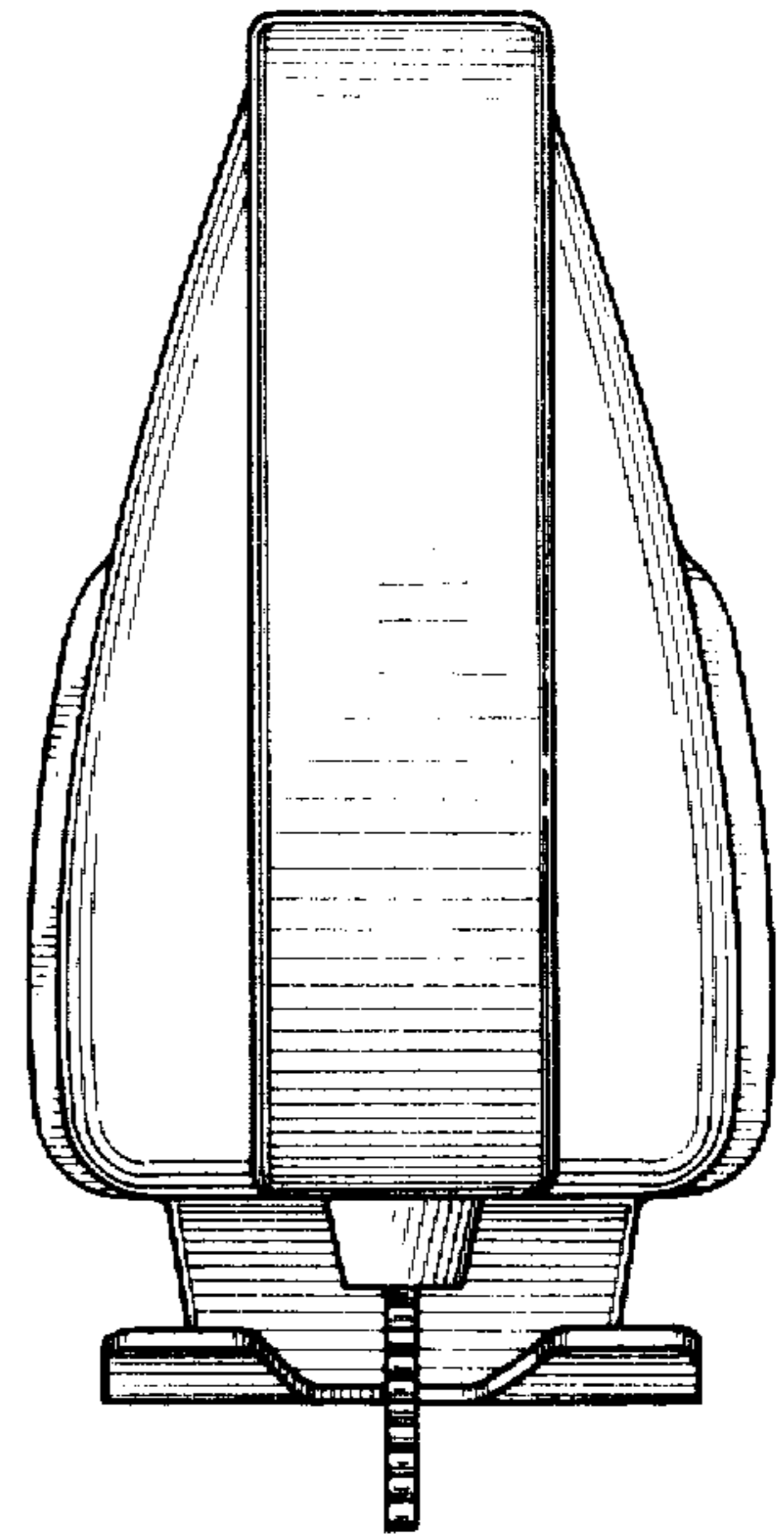

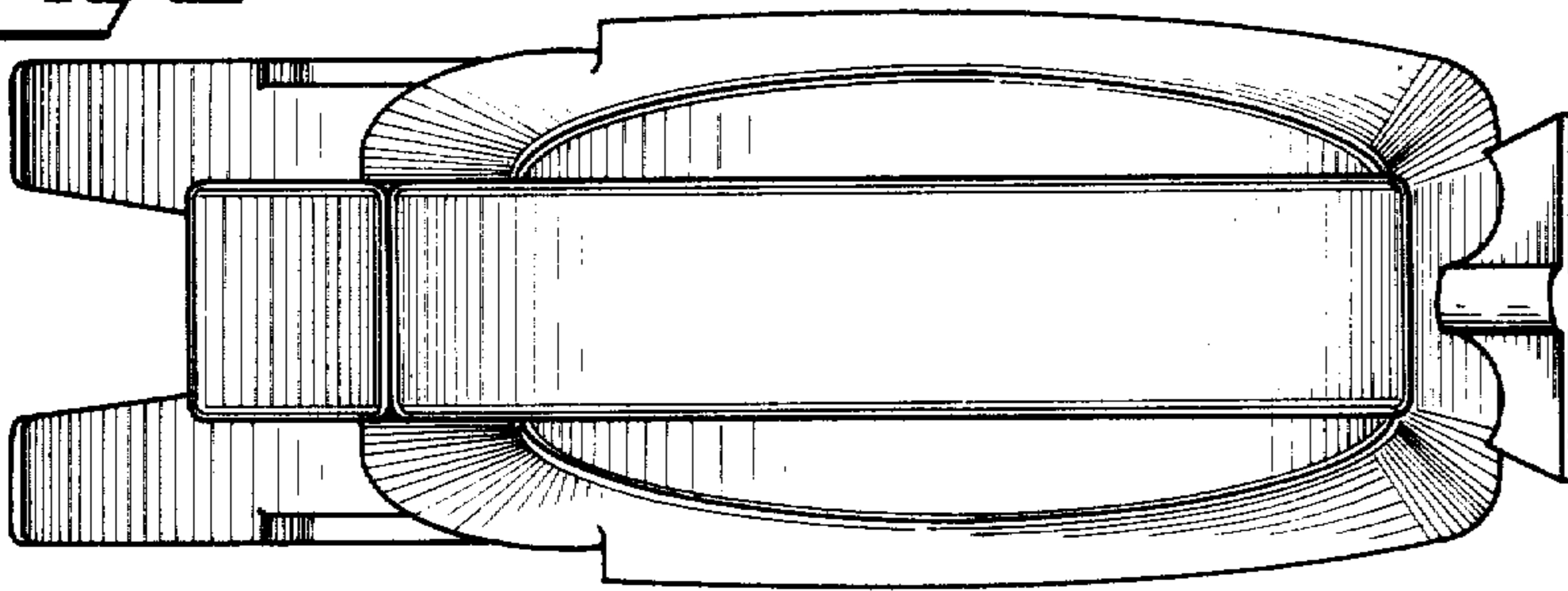

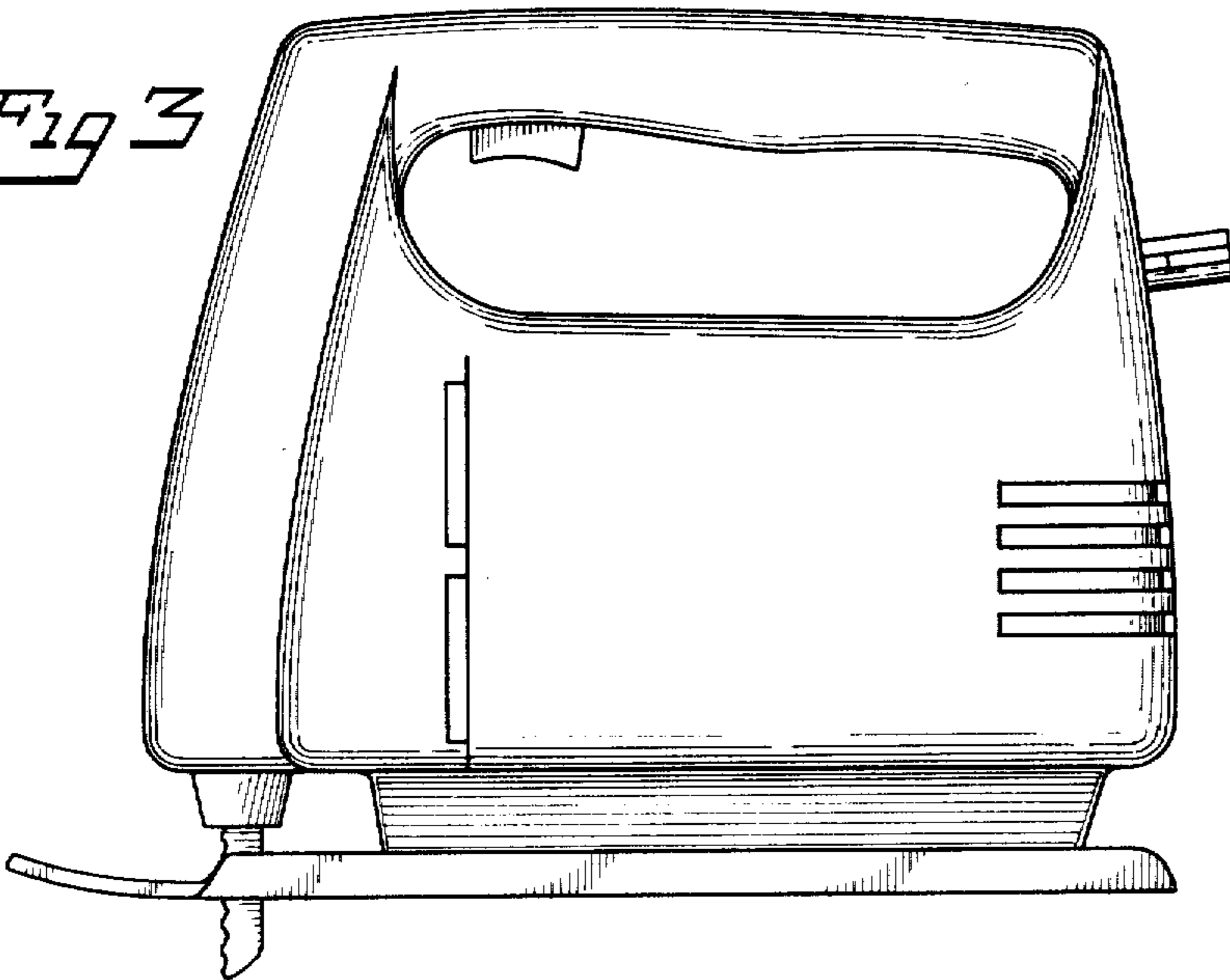

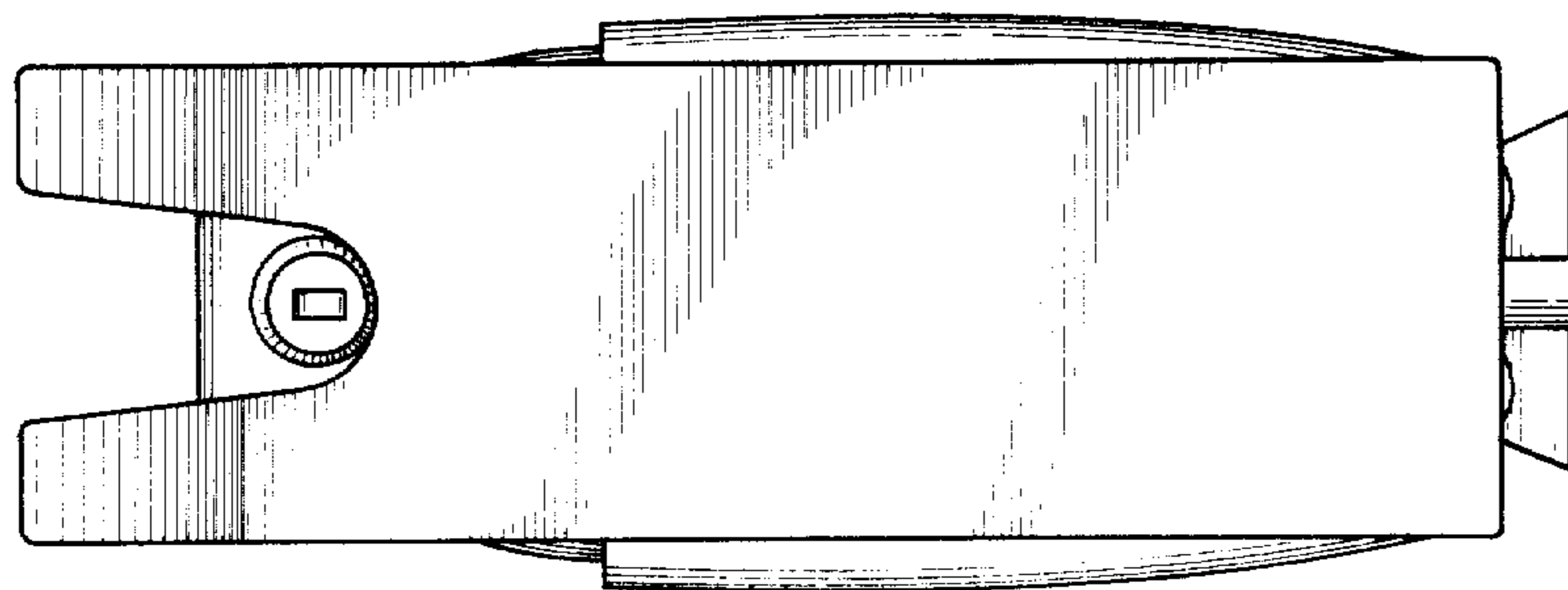
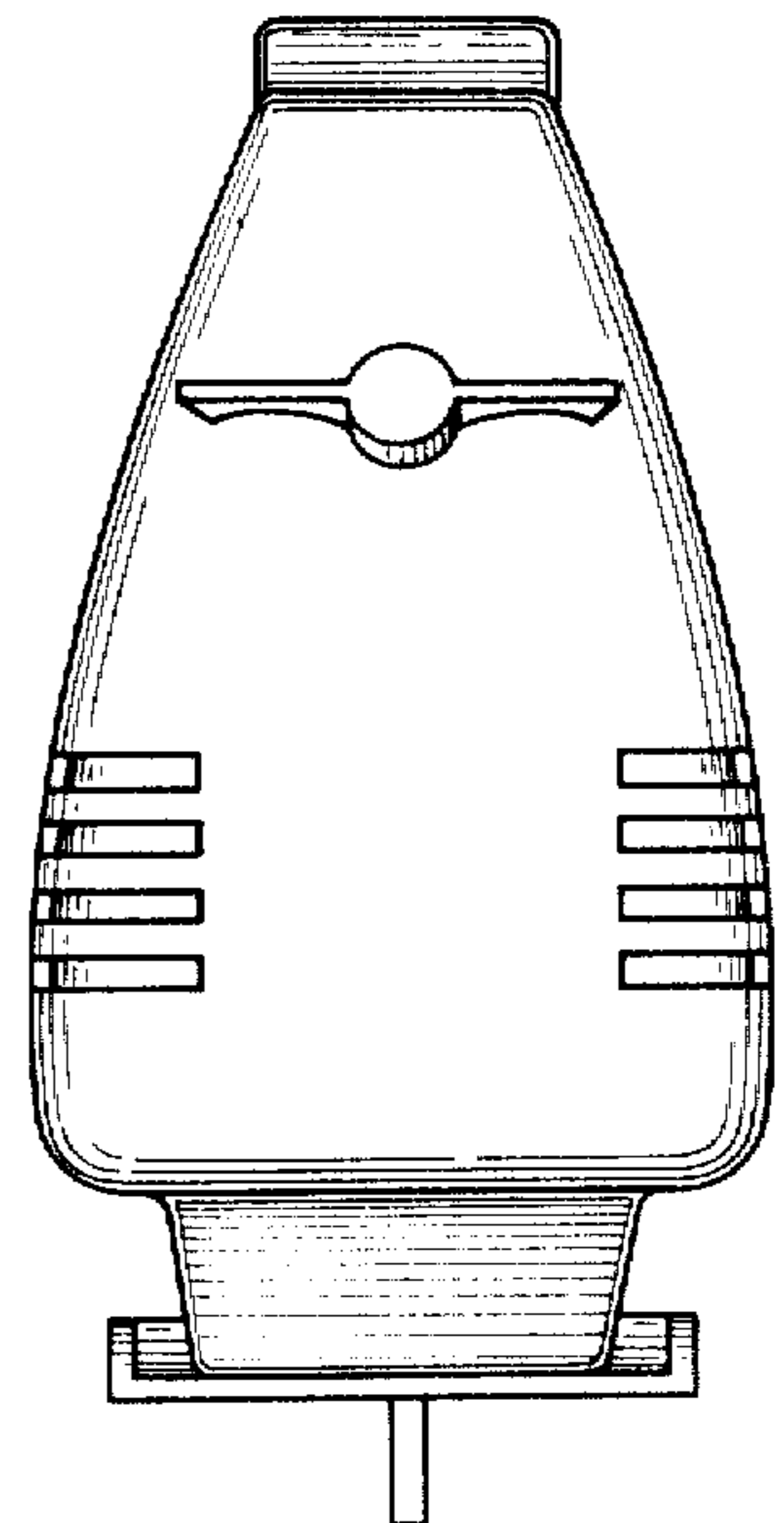
