FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-section taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 1.

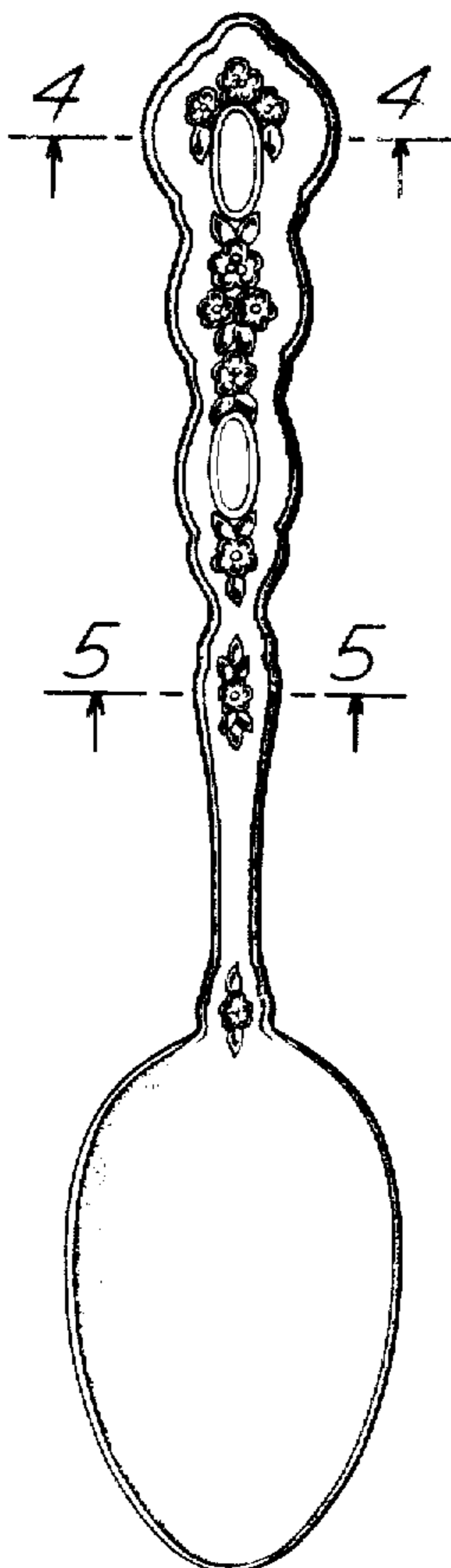

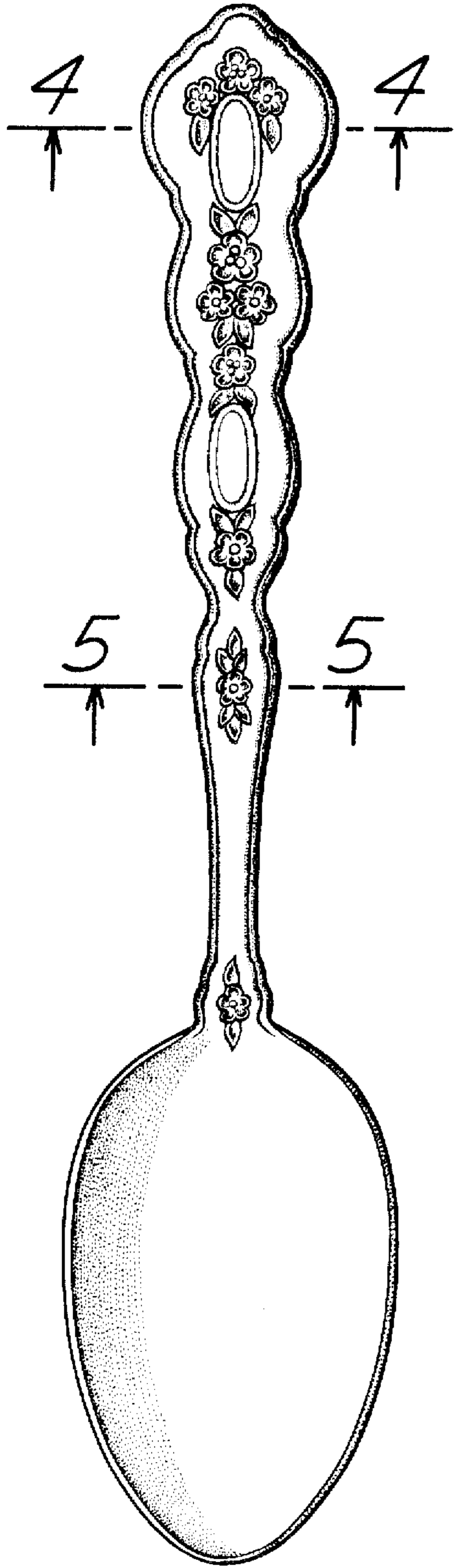

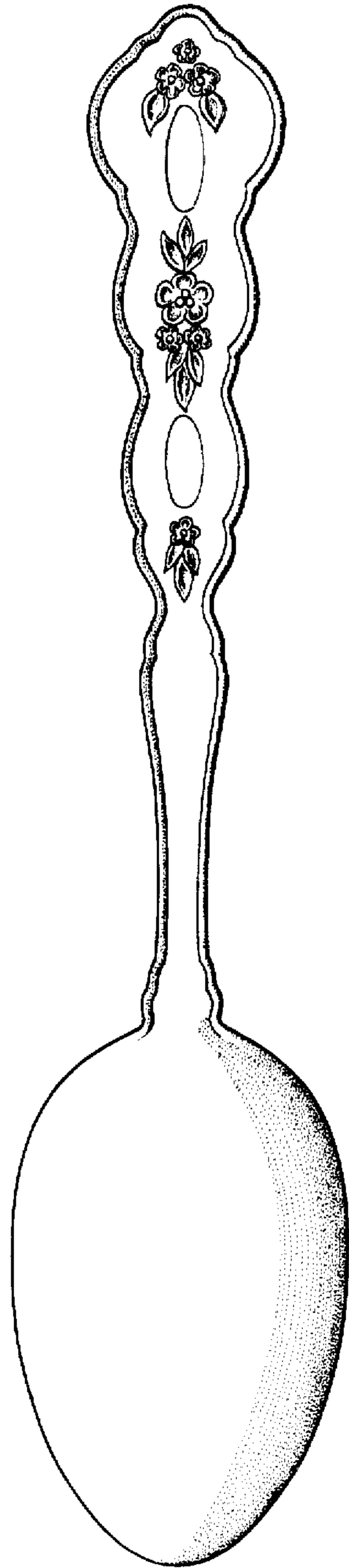

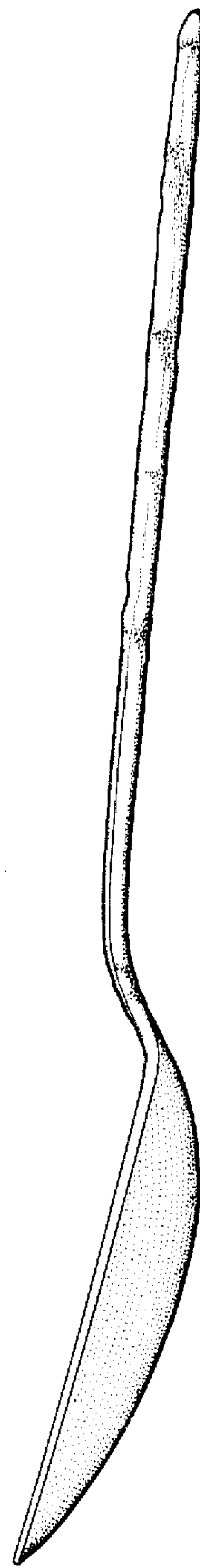
