The ornamental design for a can or the like, as shown and described.

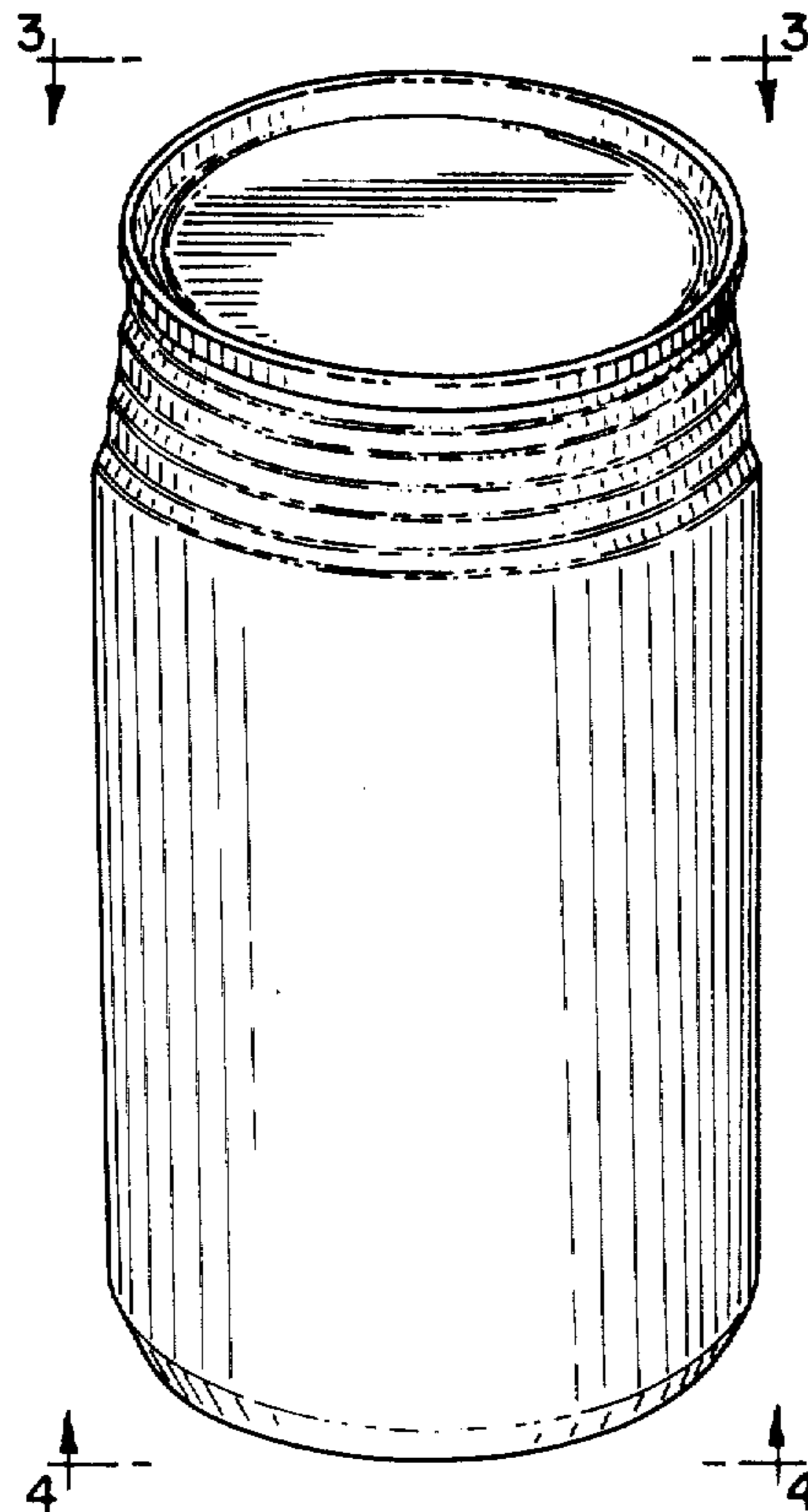
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom view plan thereof.



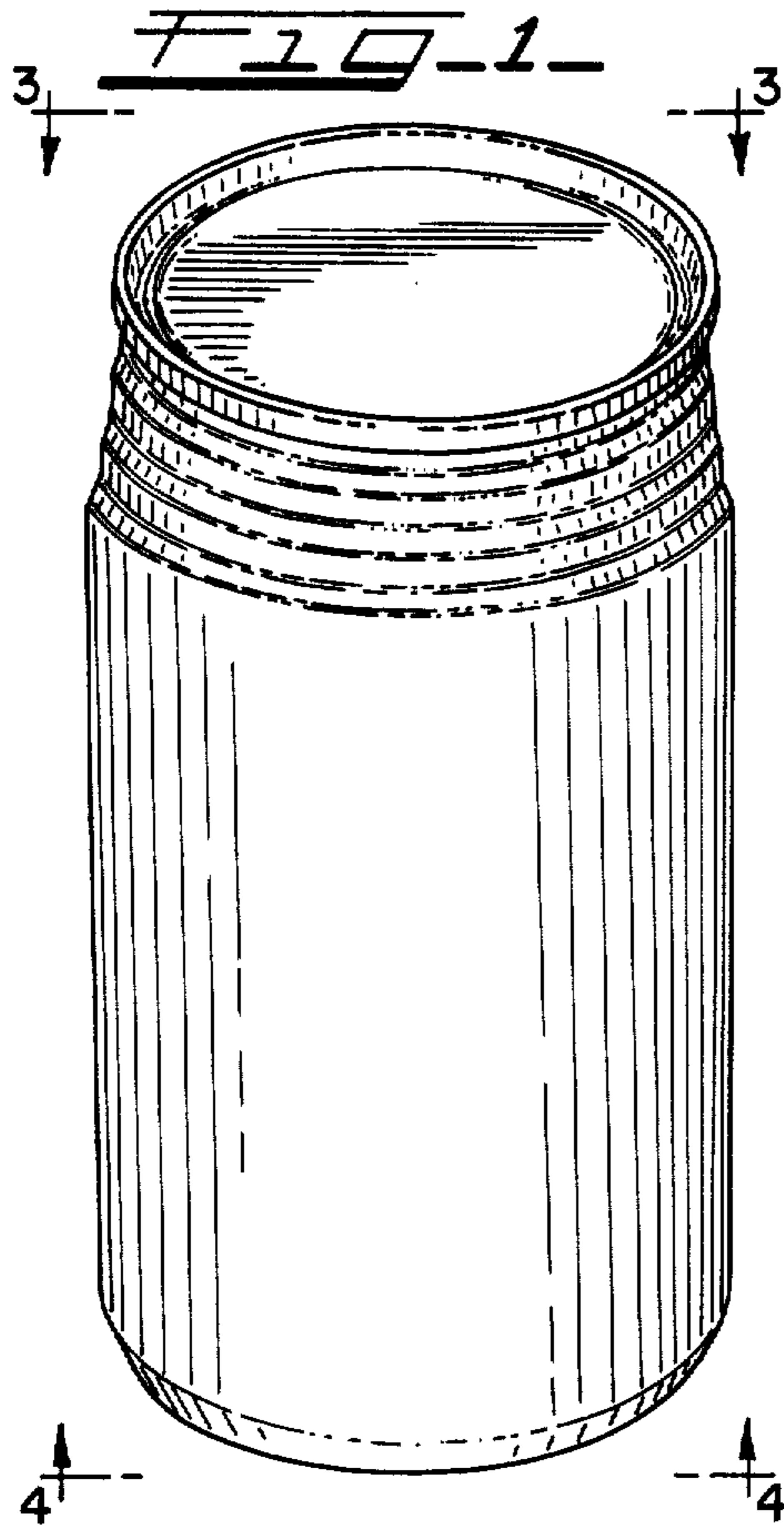

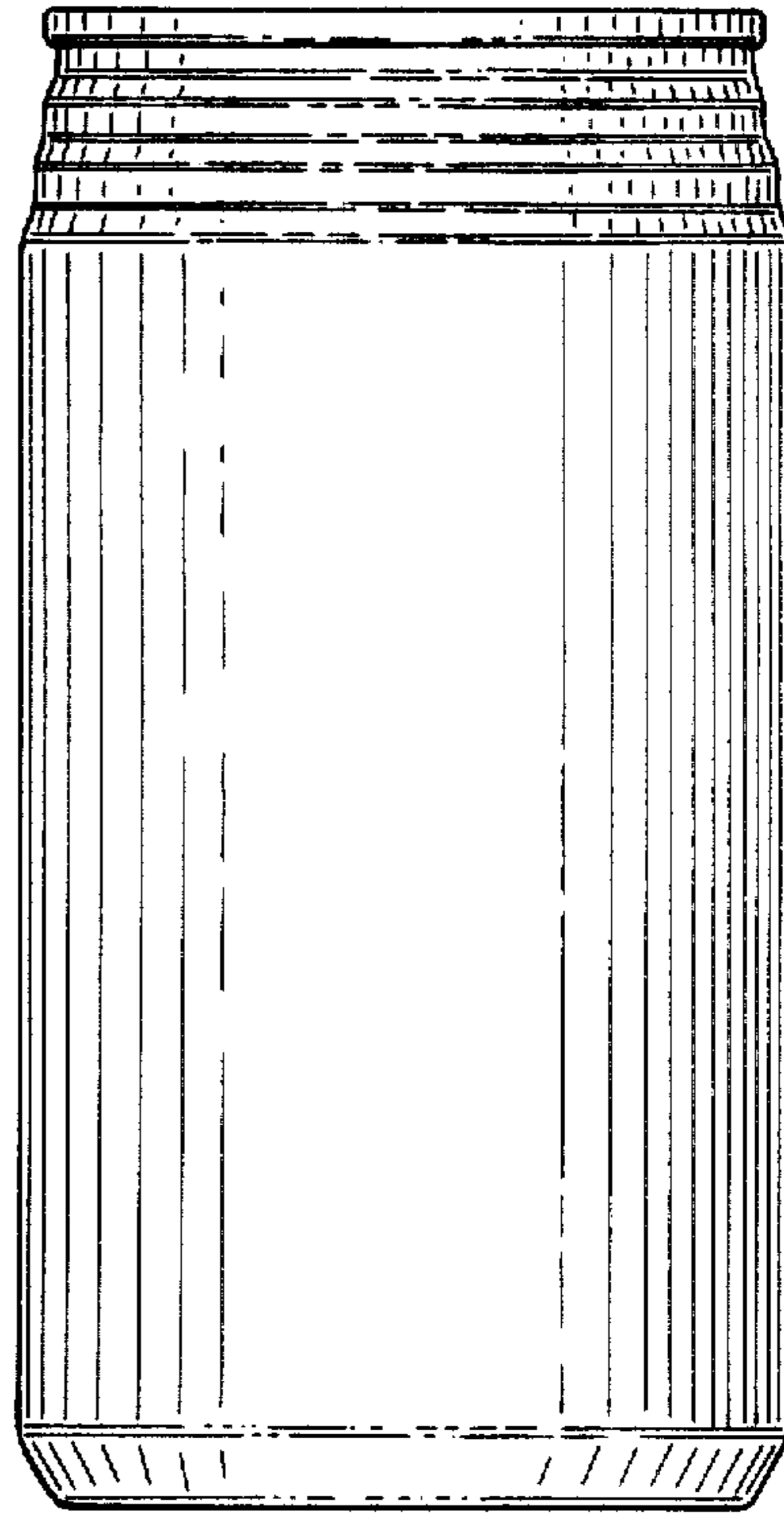

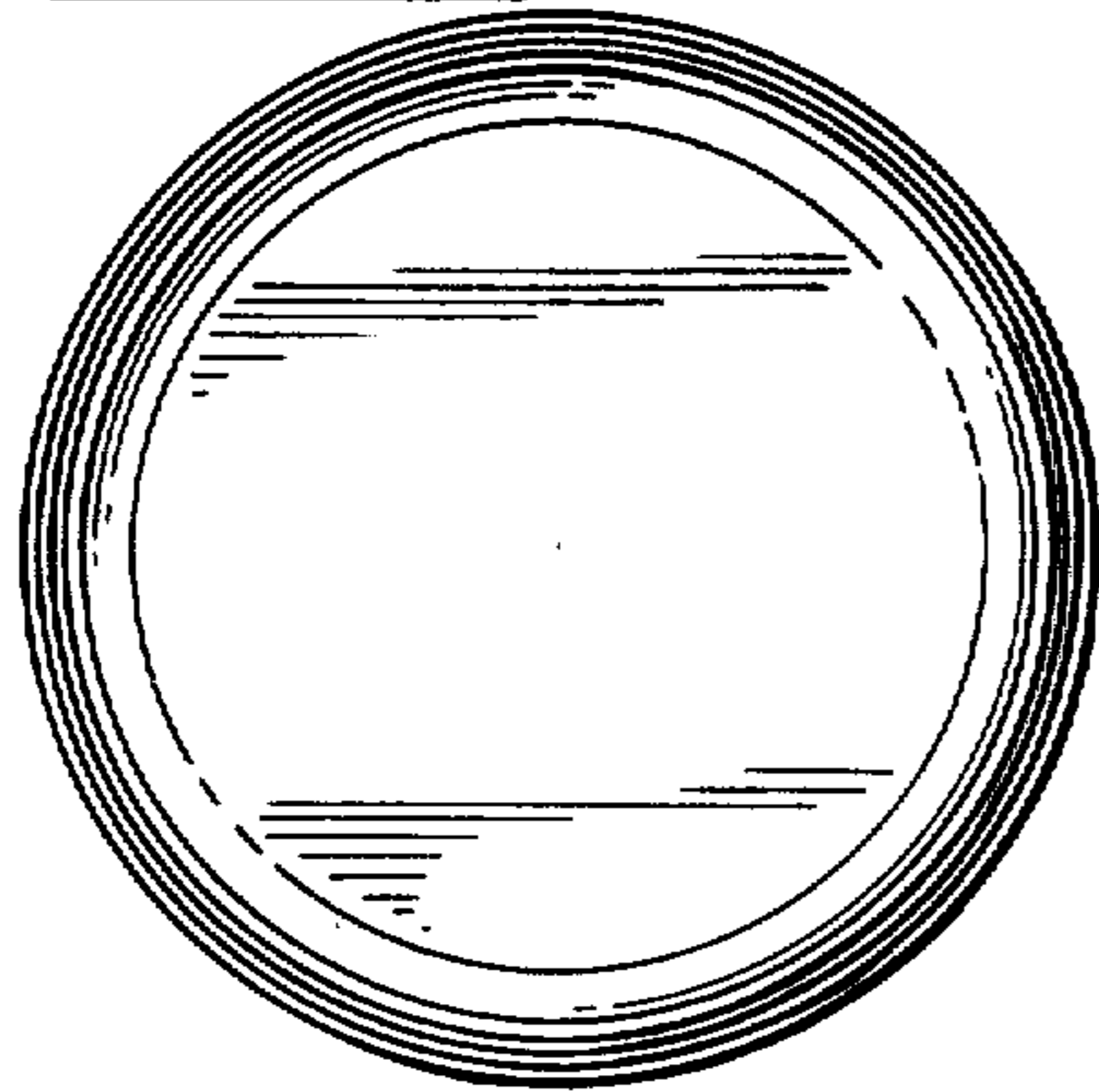
