The shoe shown in the figures is for use on the right foot, the shoe for use on the left foot being identical but a mirror image thereof.

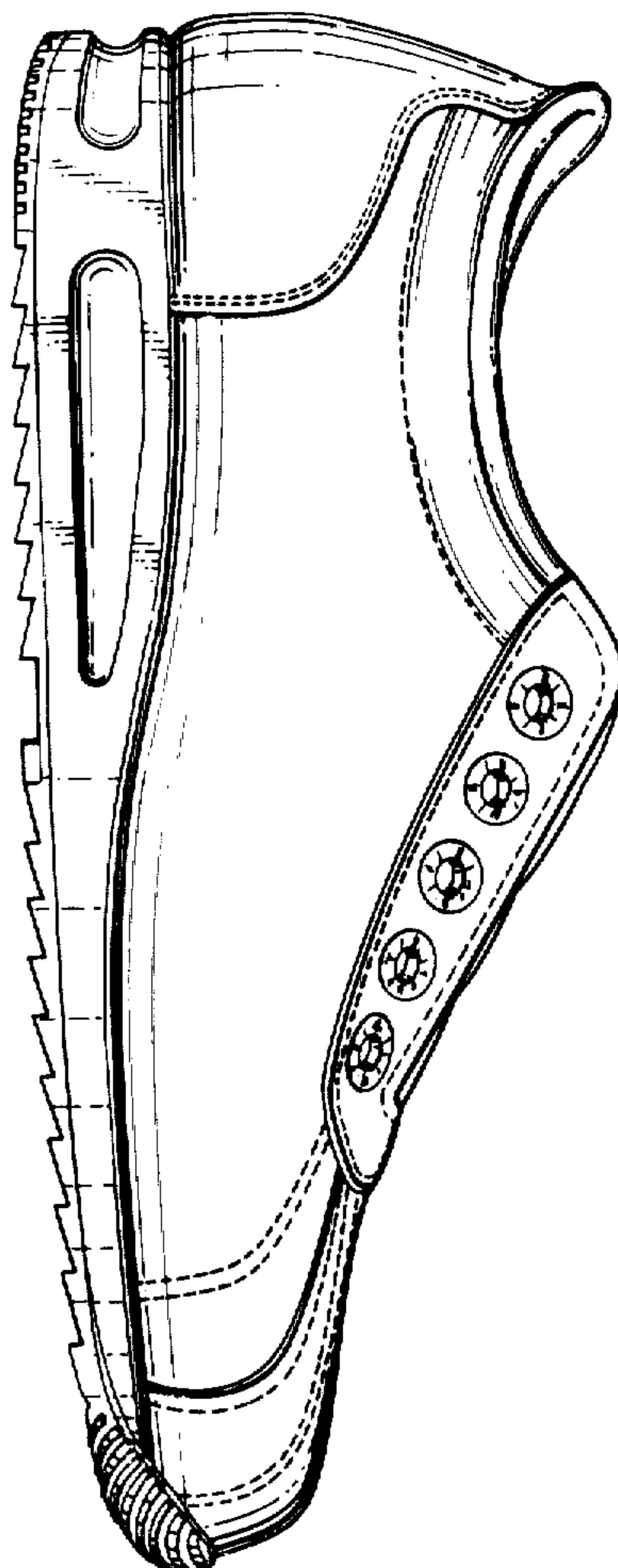

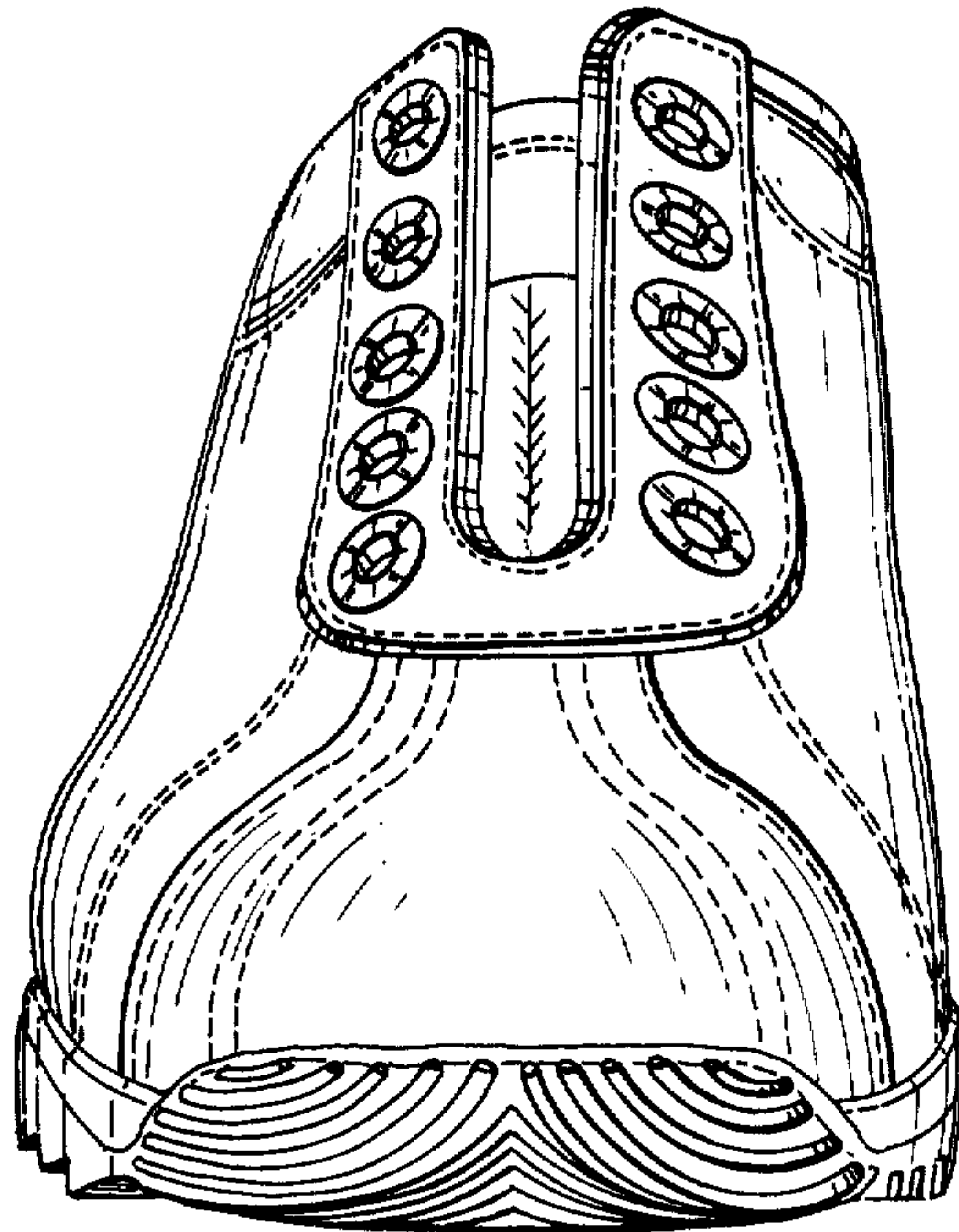

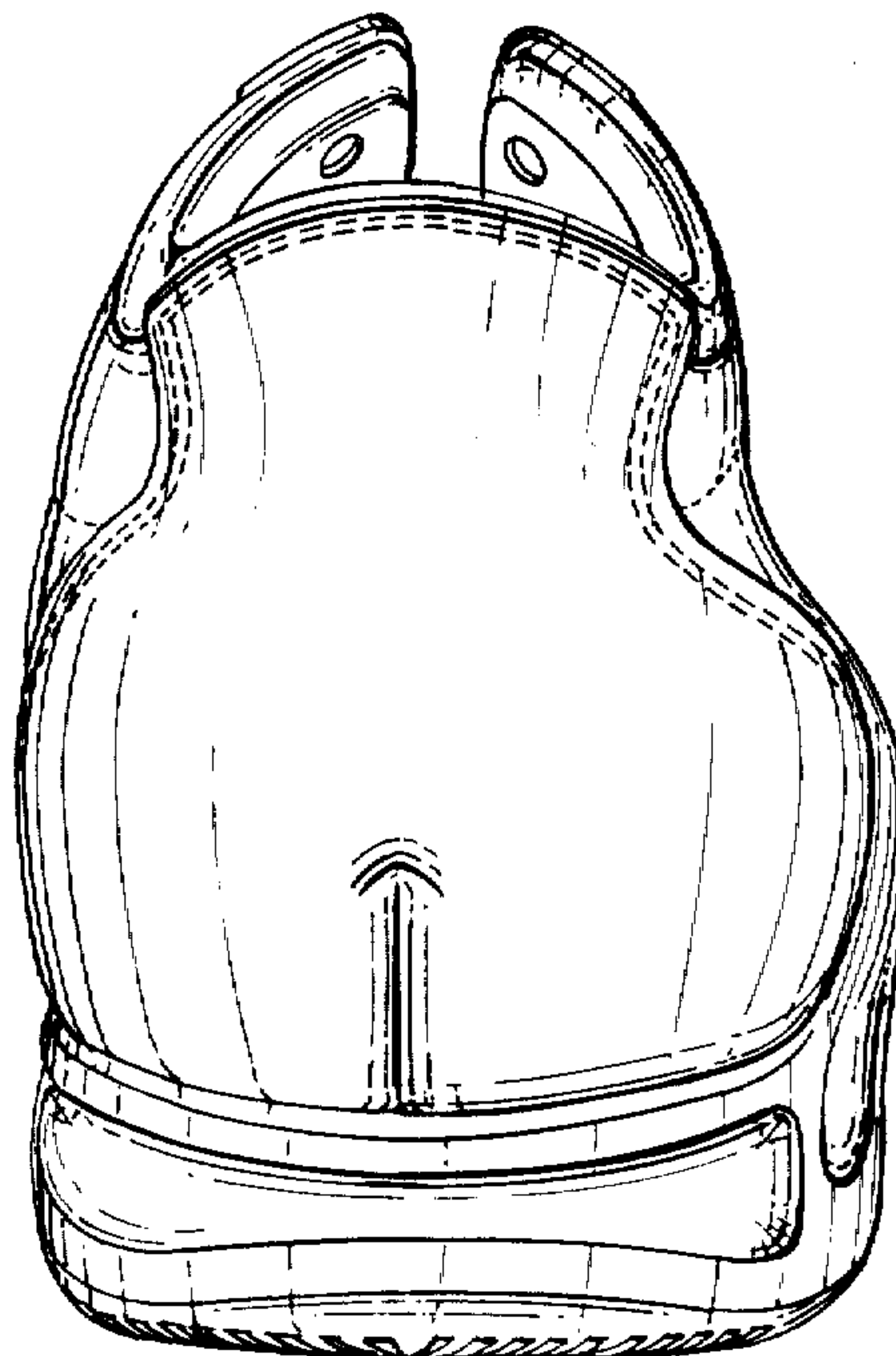

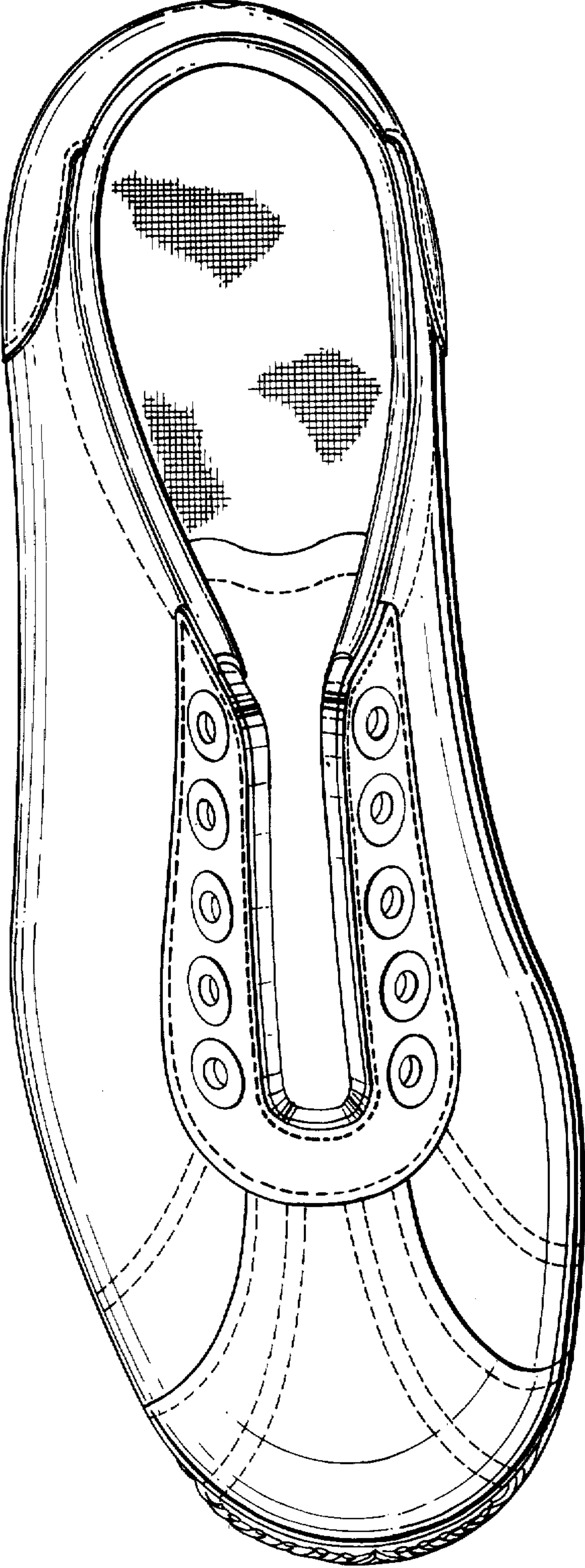
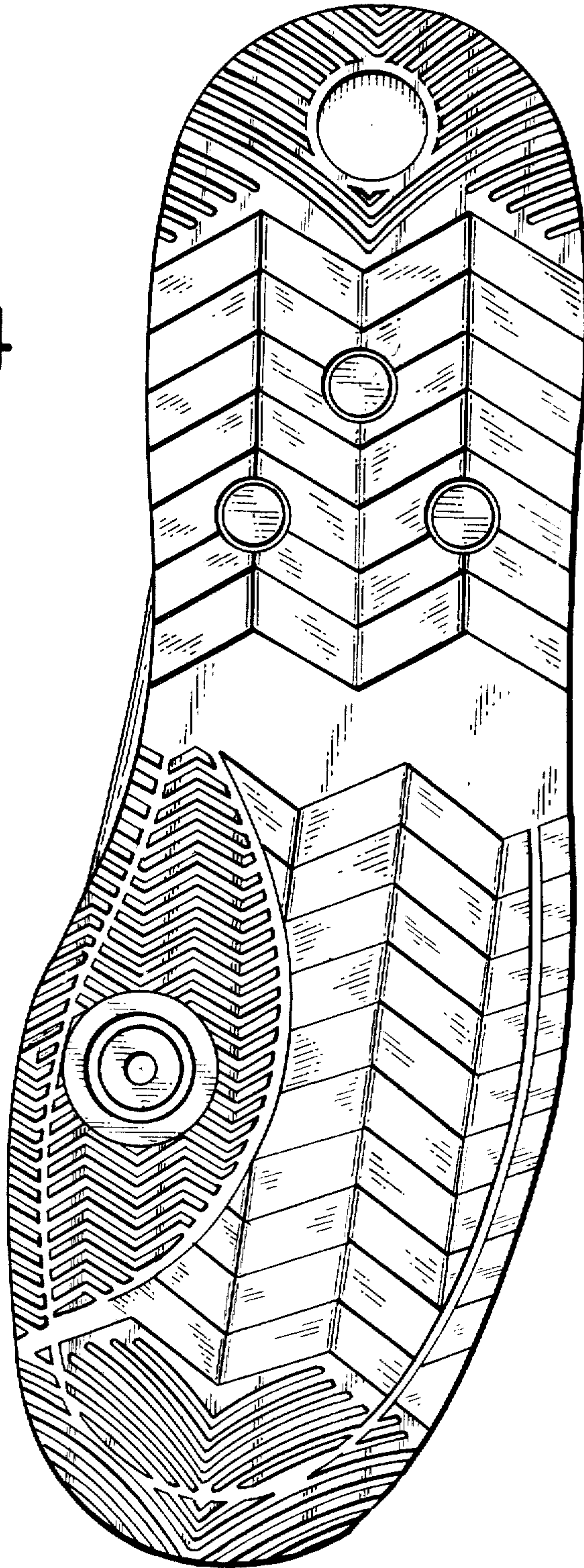

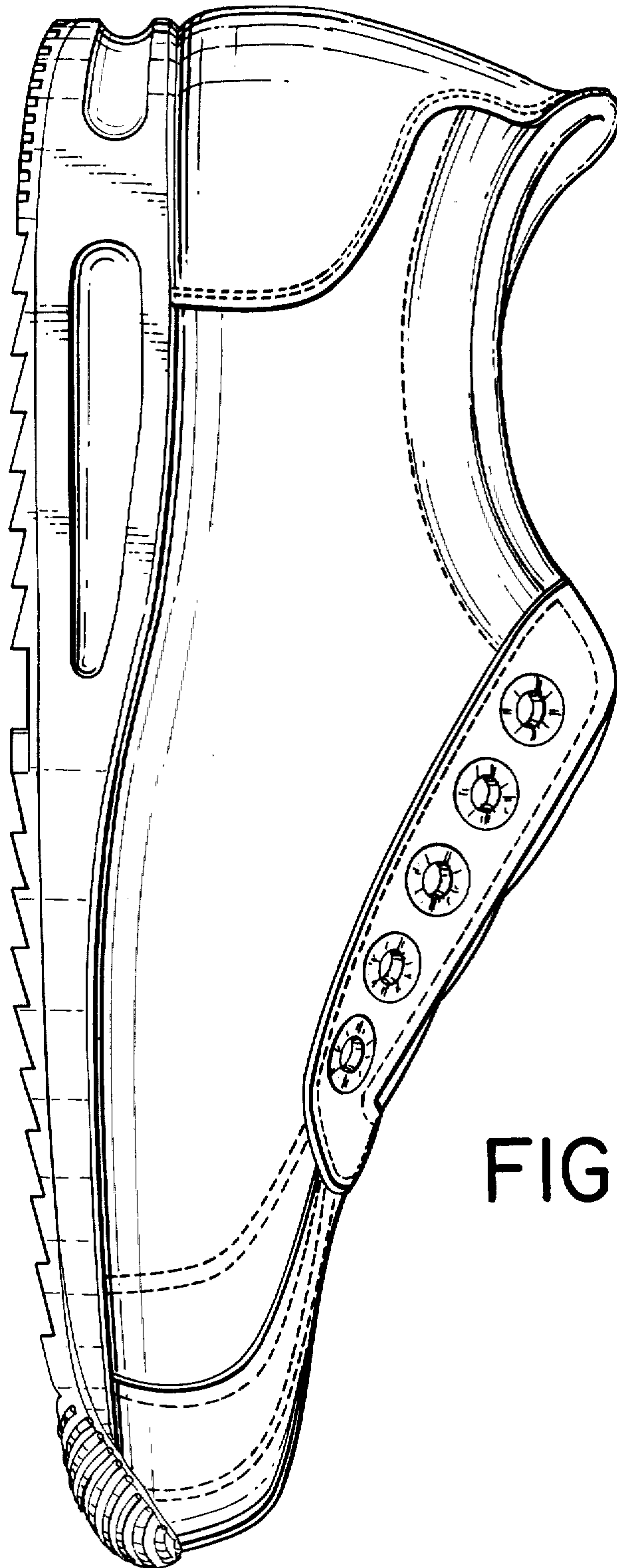

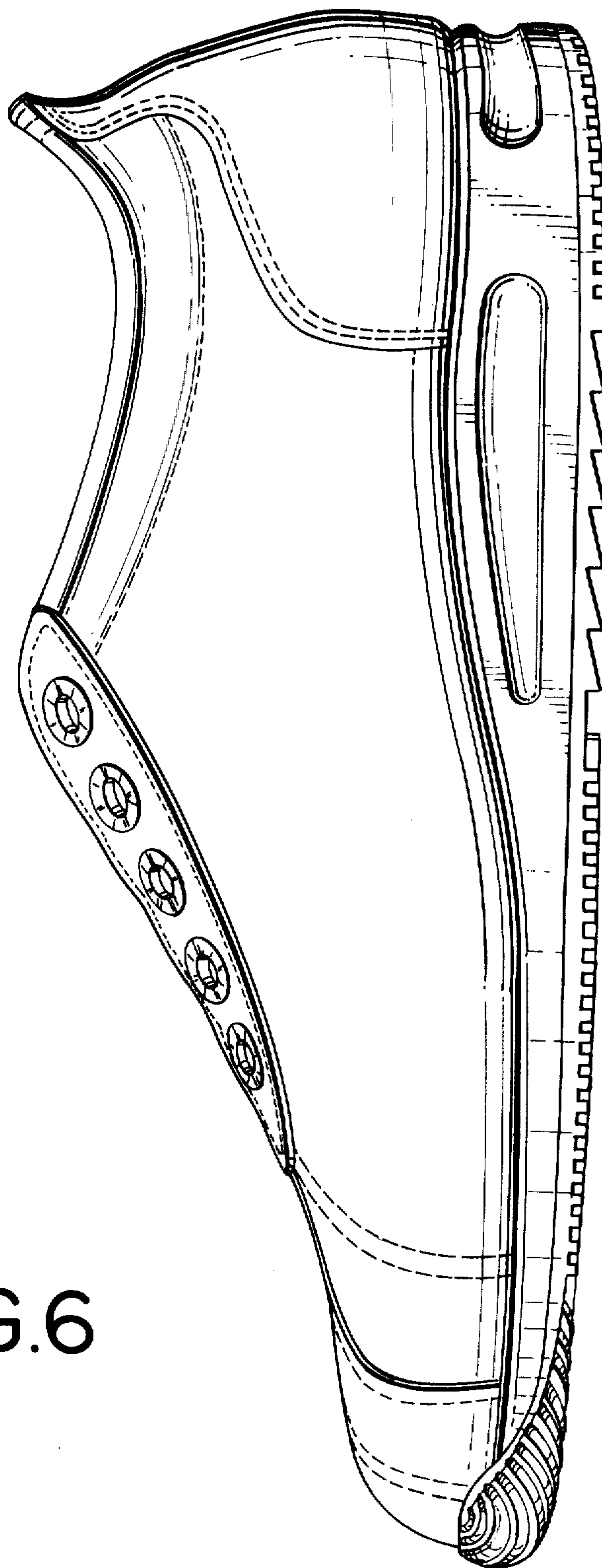
