FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy wheelbarrow showing my new design.

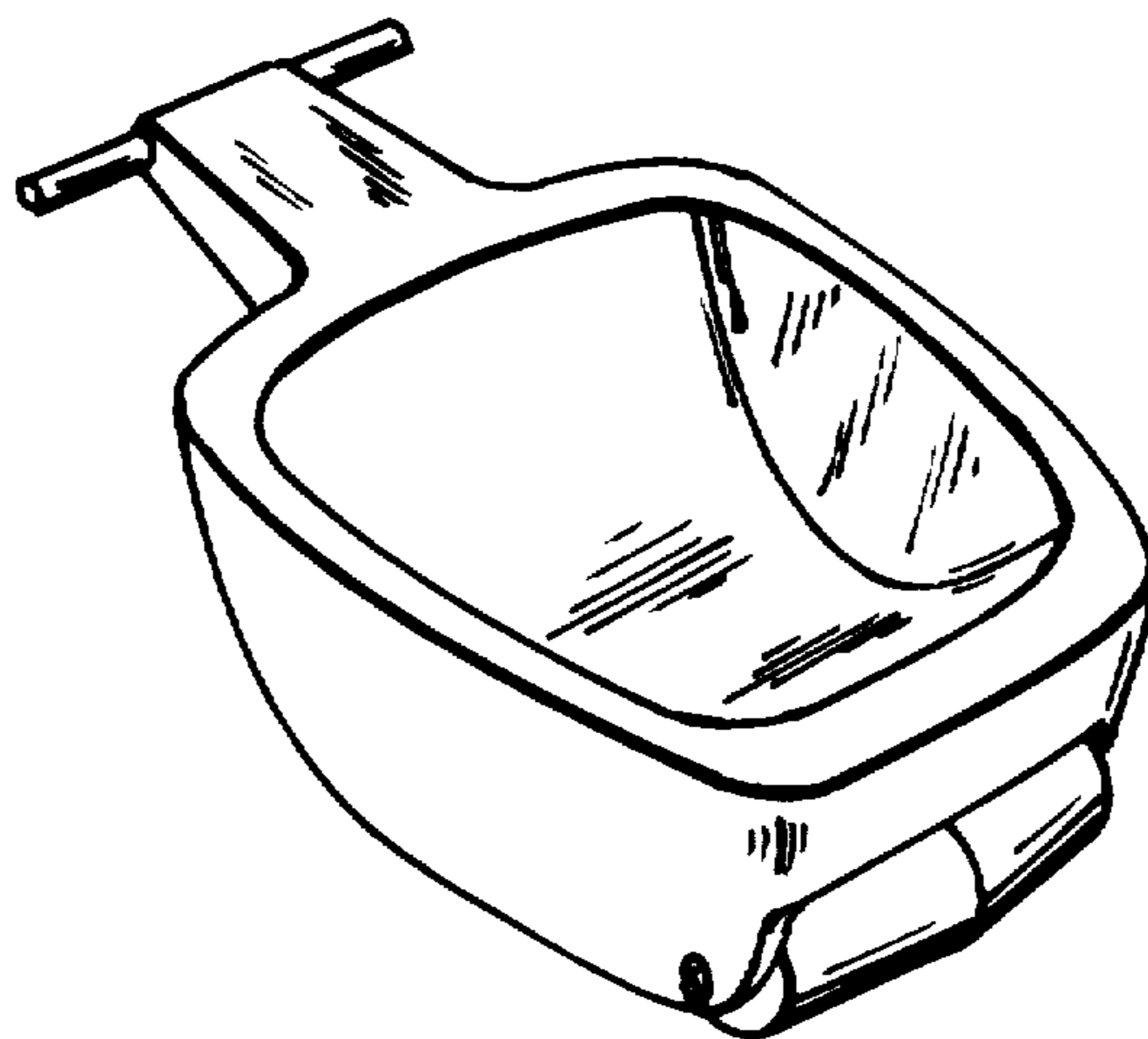
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other side being a mirror image.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



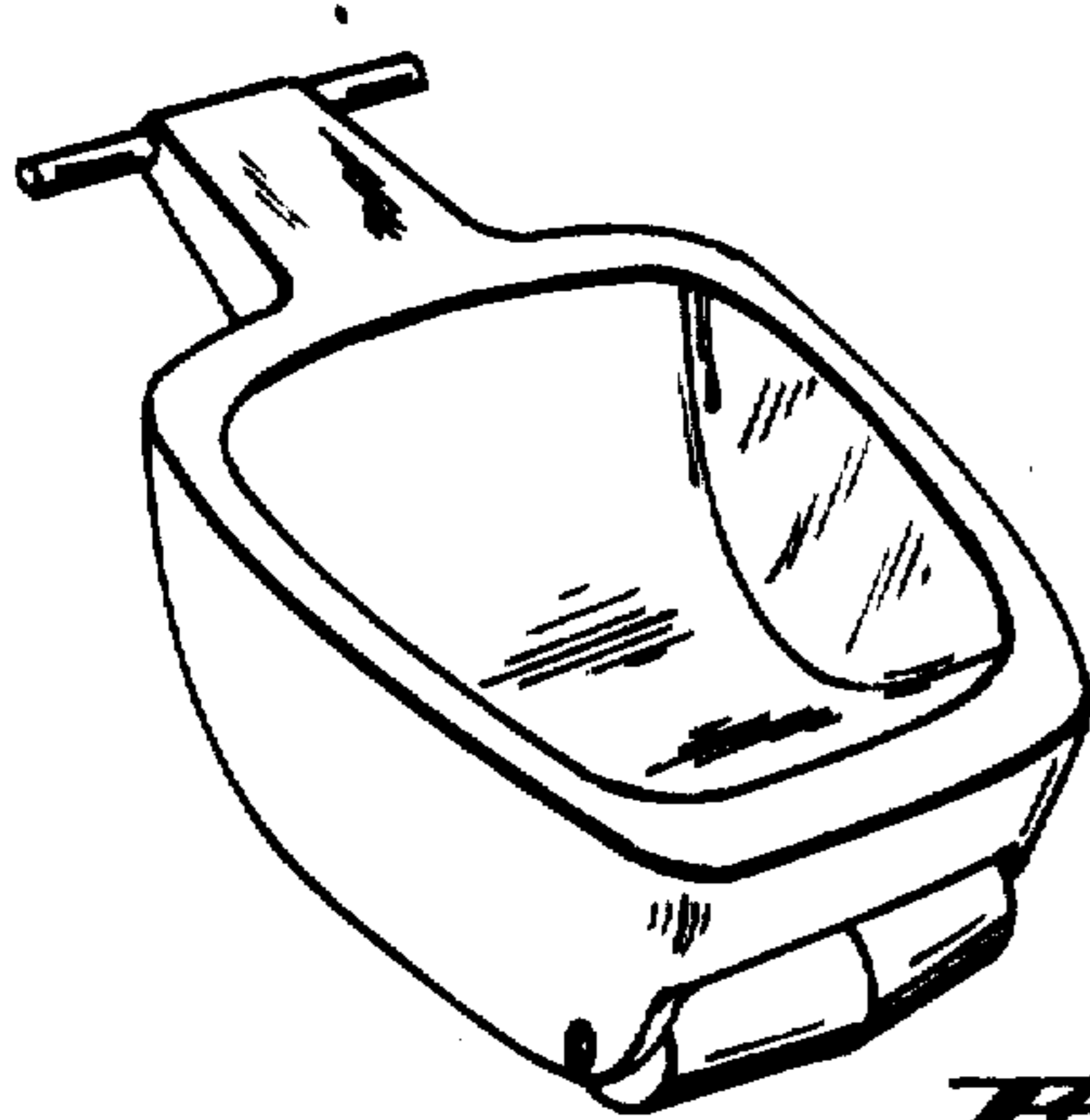

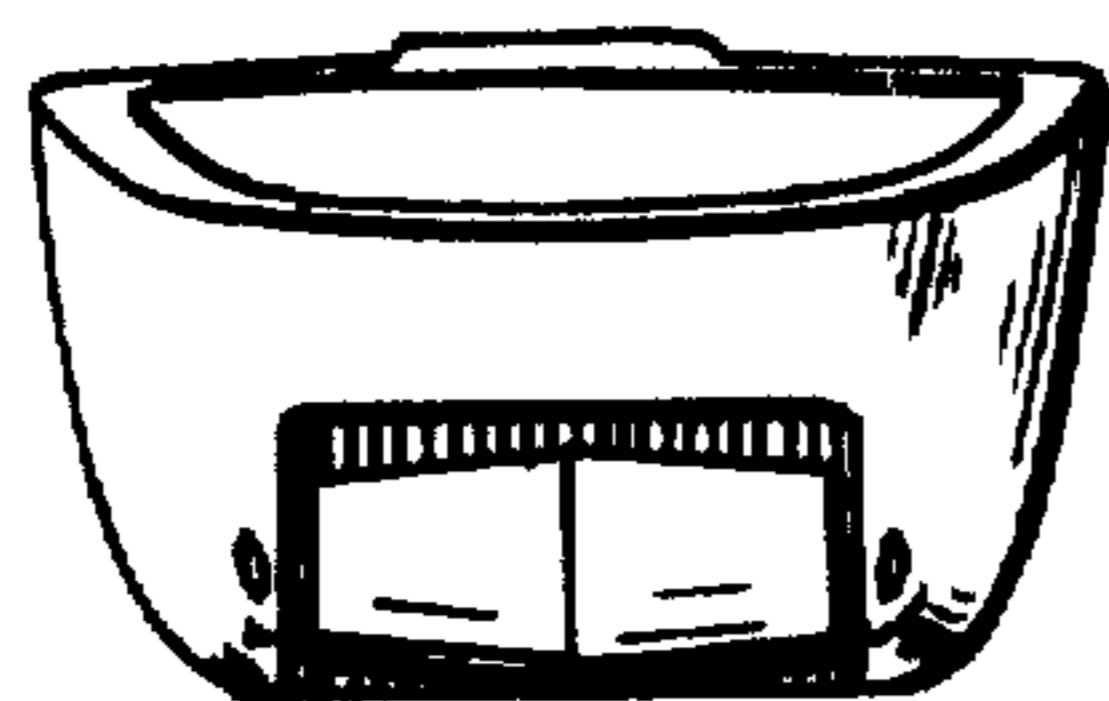

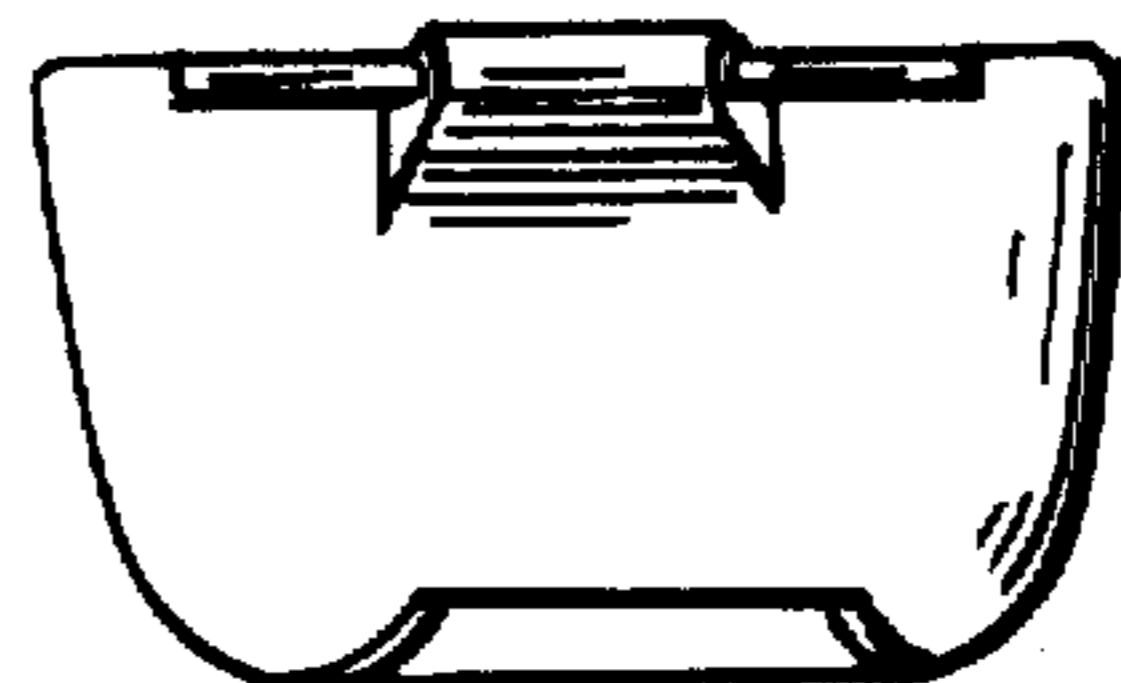

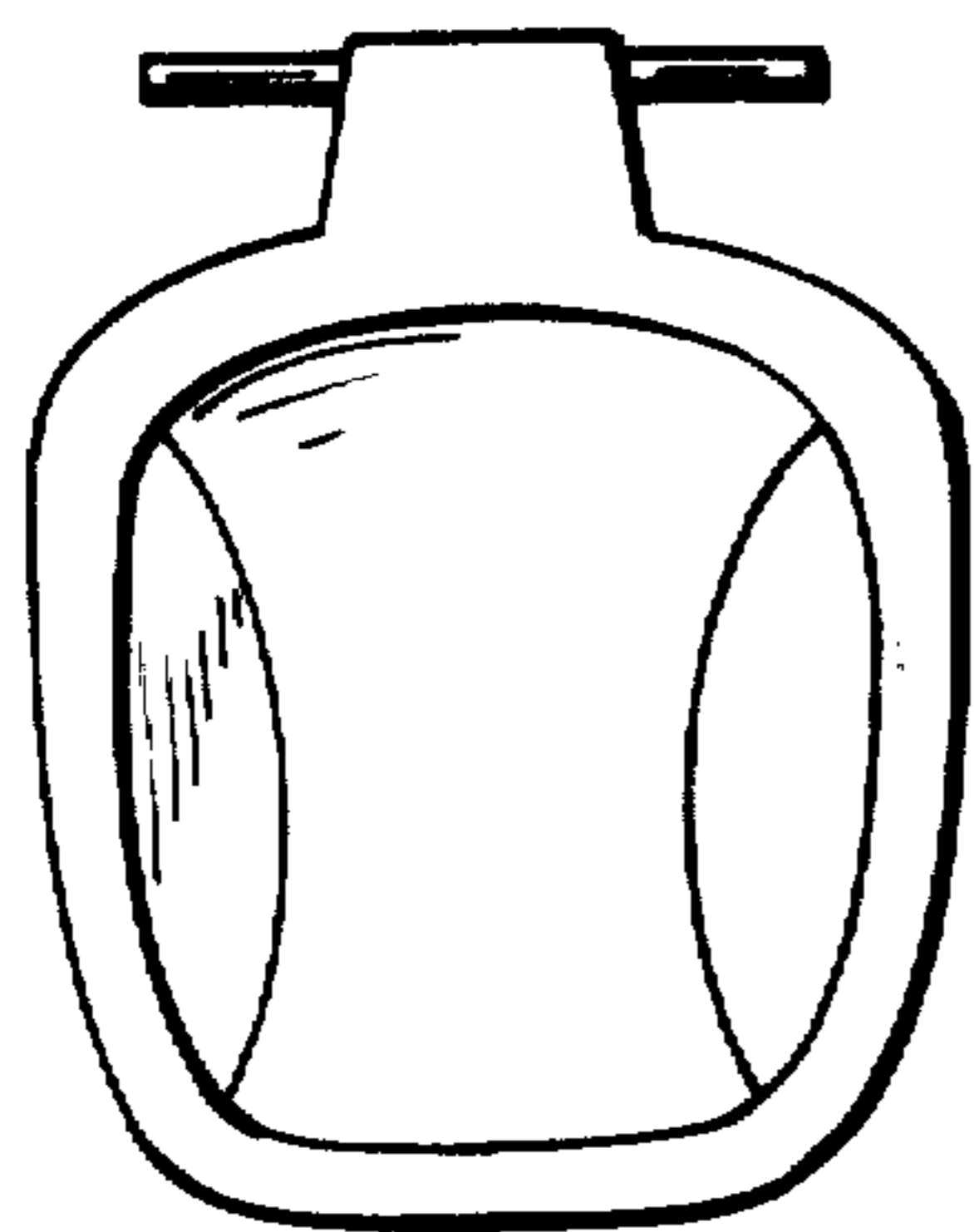

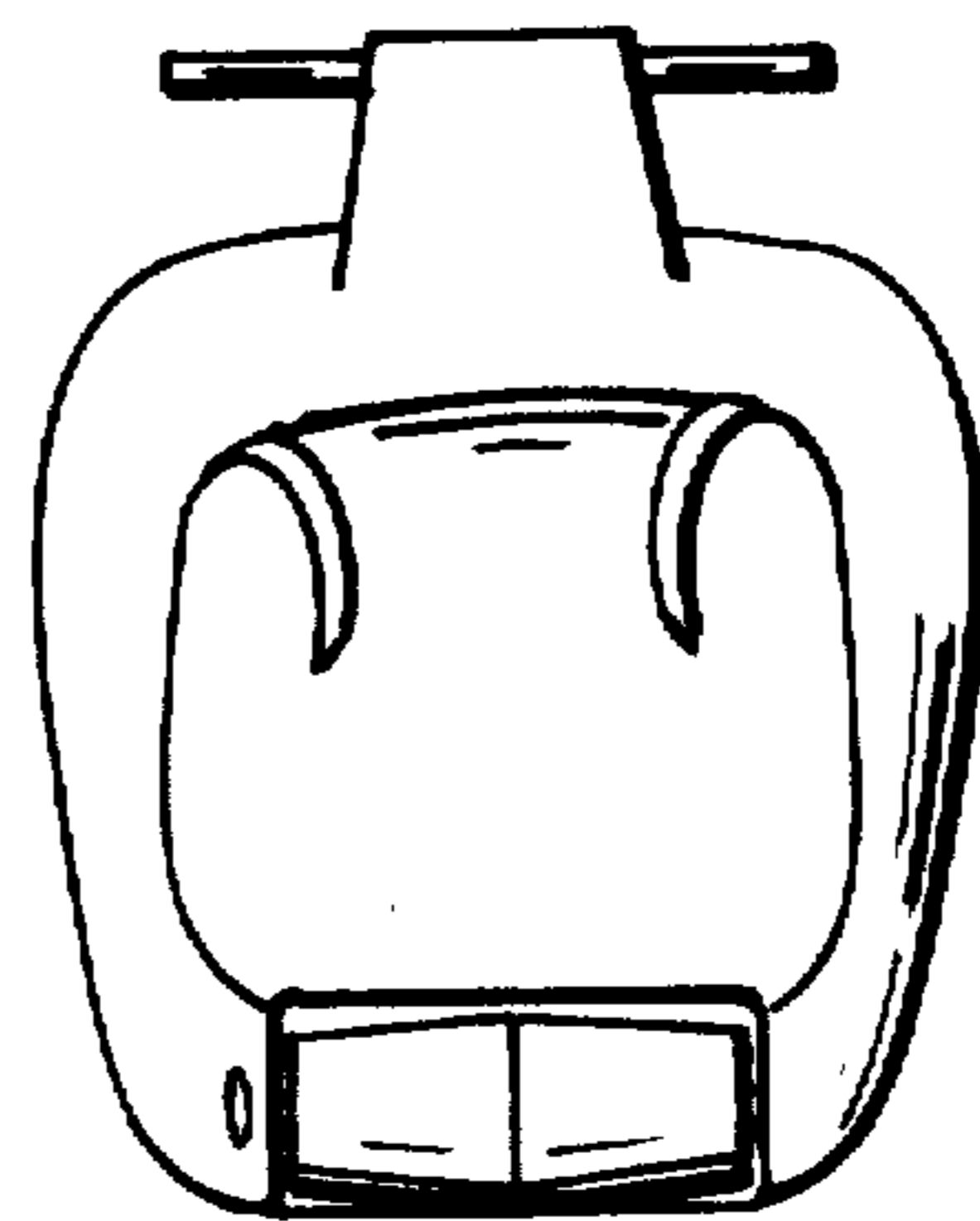
