[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a folding chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front and left side of a folding chair showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevation thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevation thereof; and FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof. The diagonal hatching represents a continuous piece of fabric.

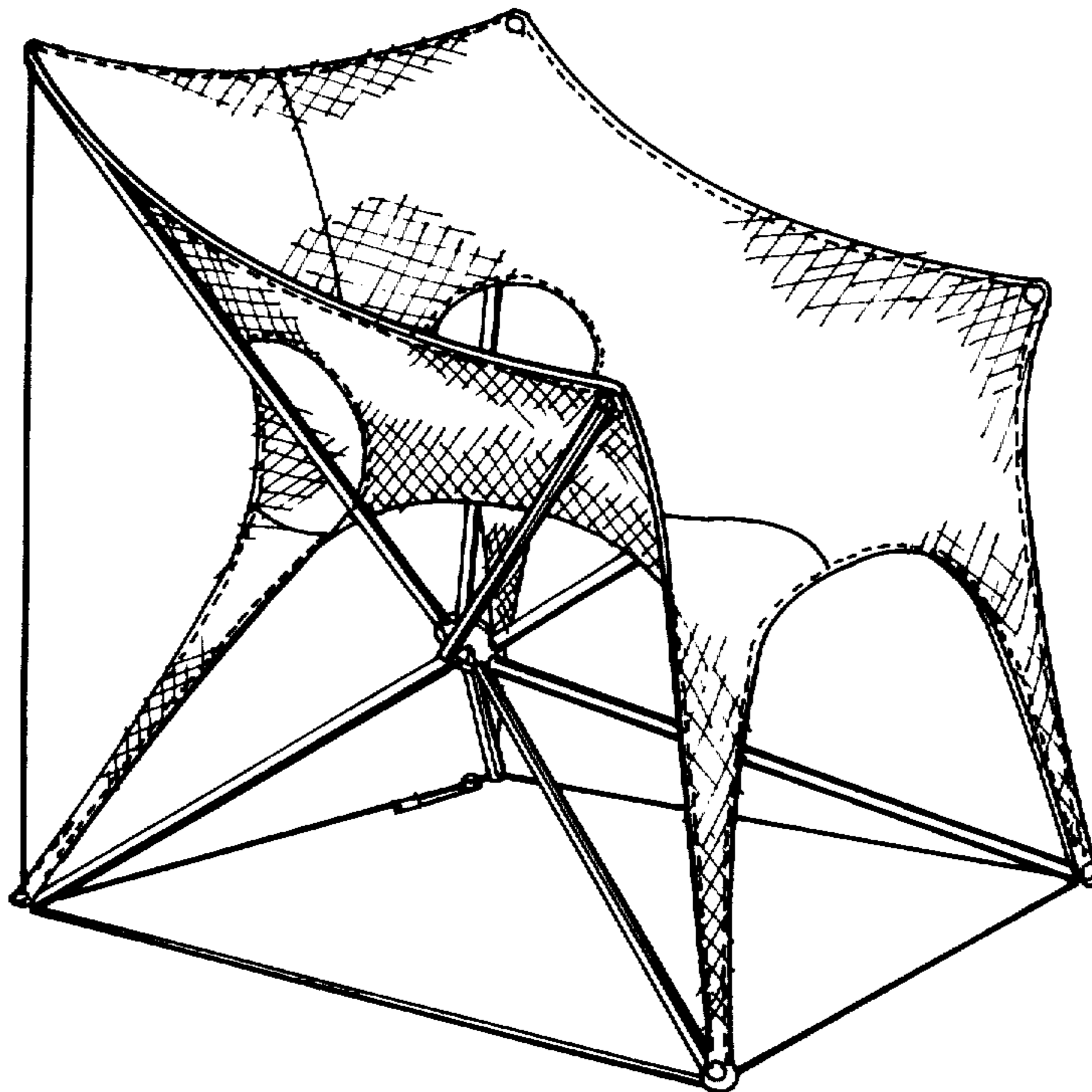

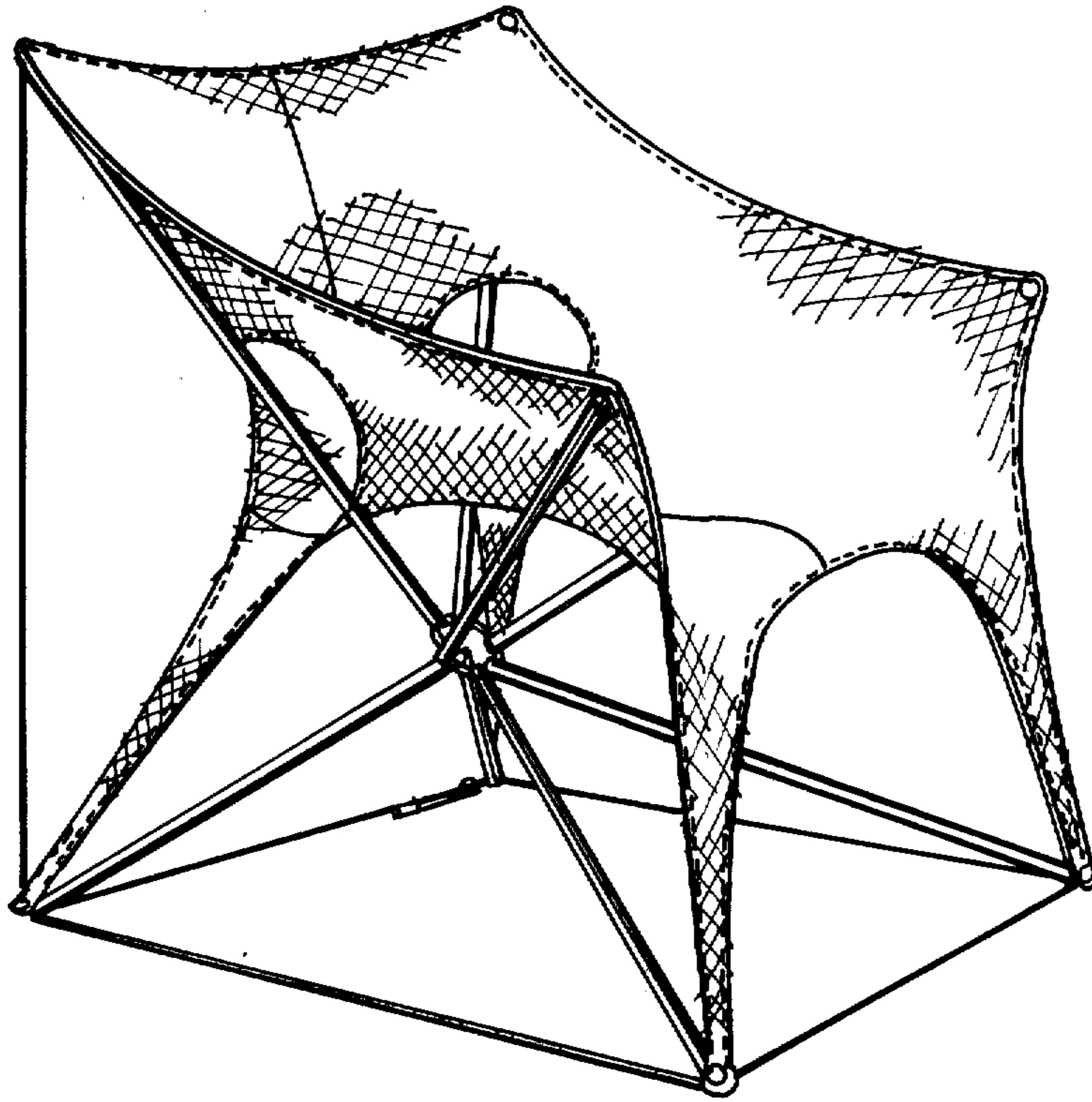

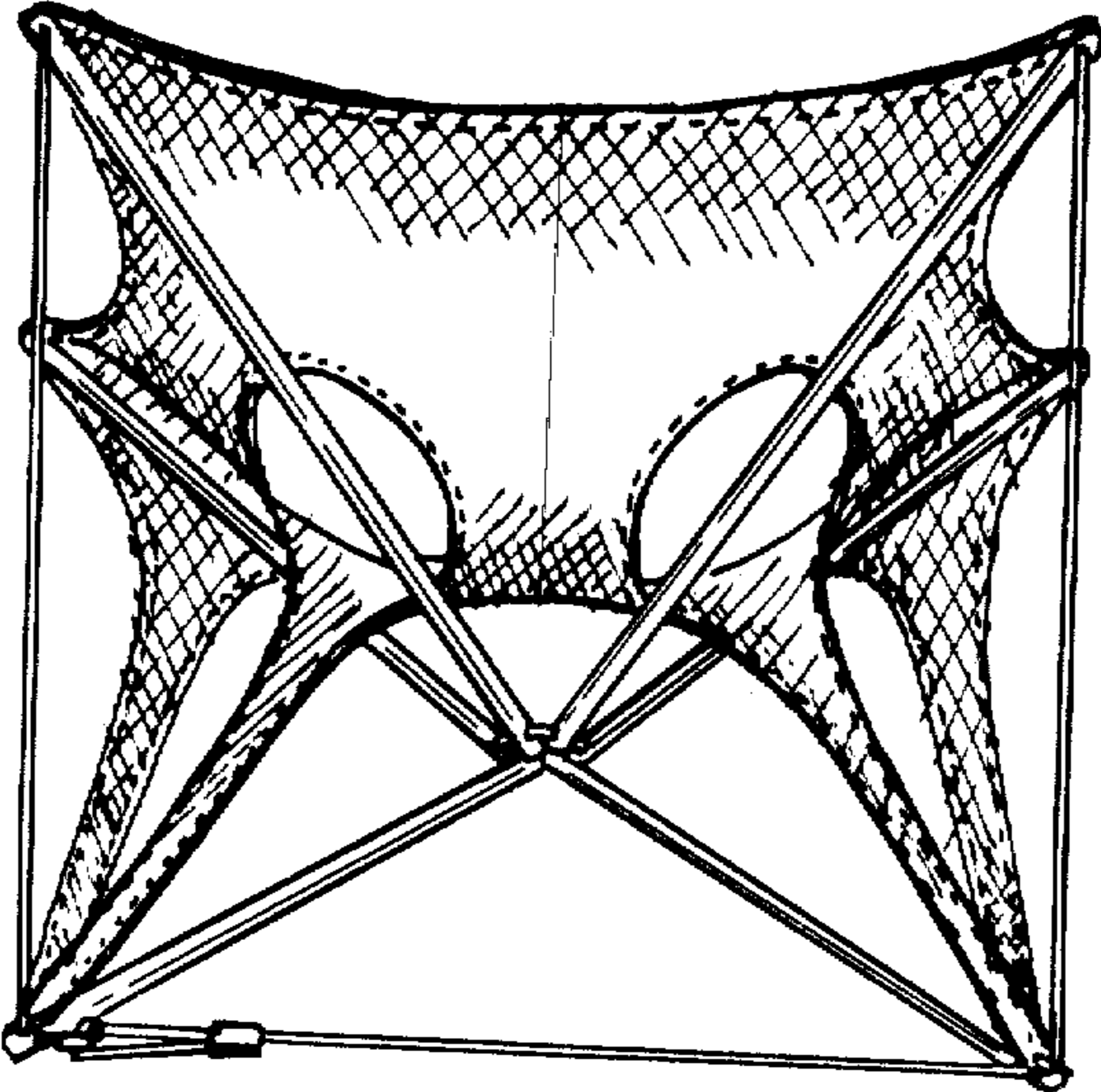

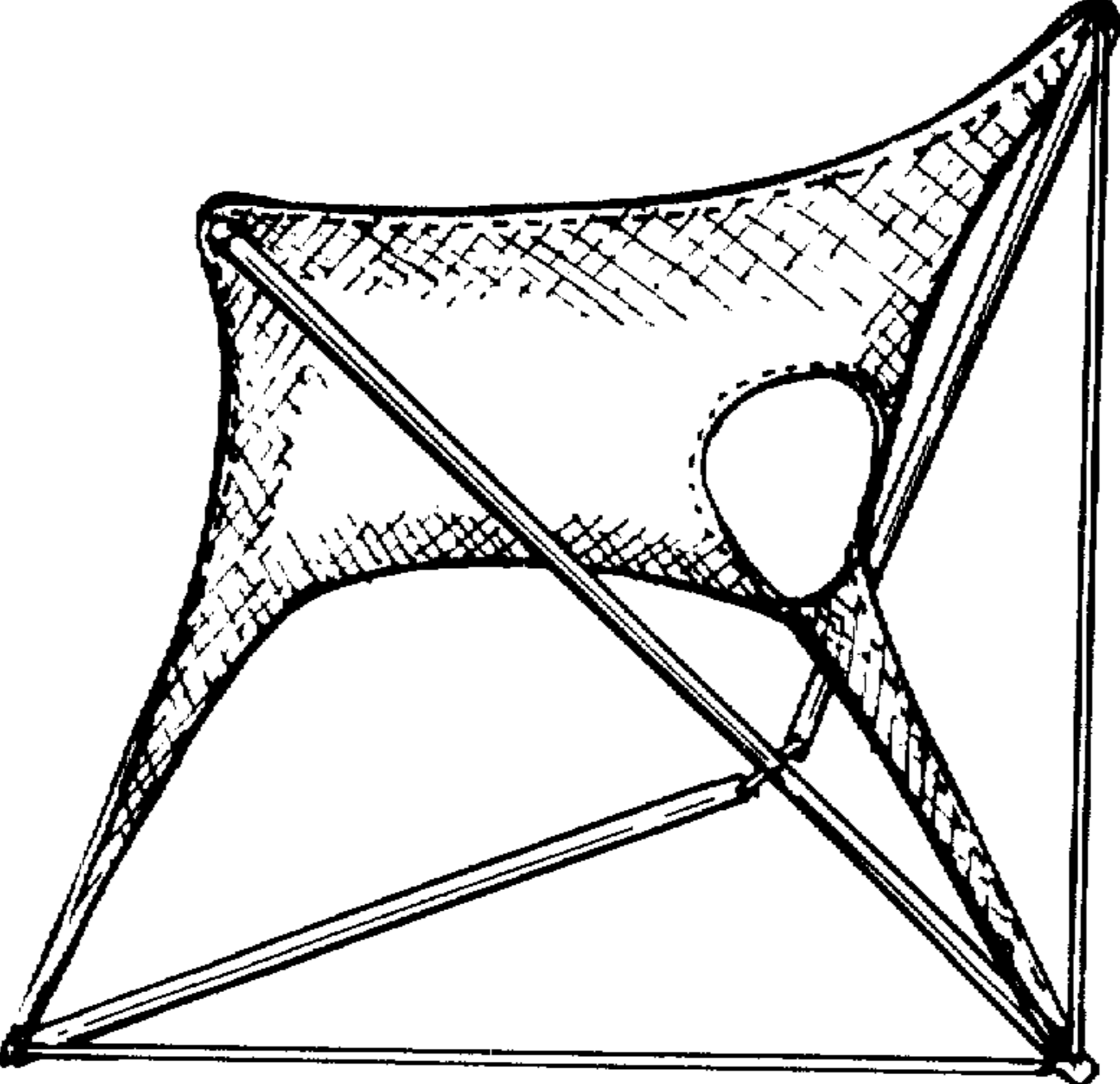
