**DESCRIPTION**

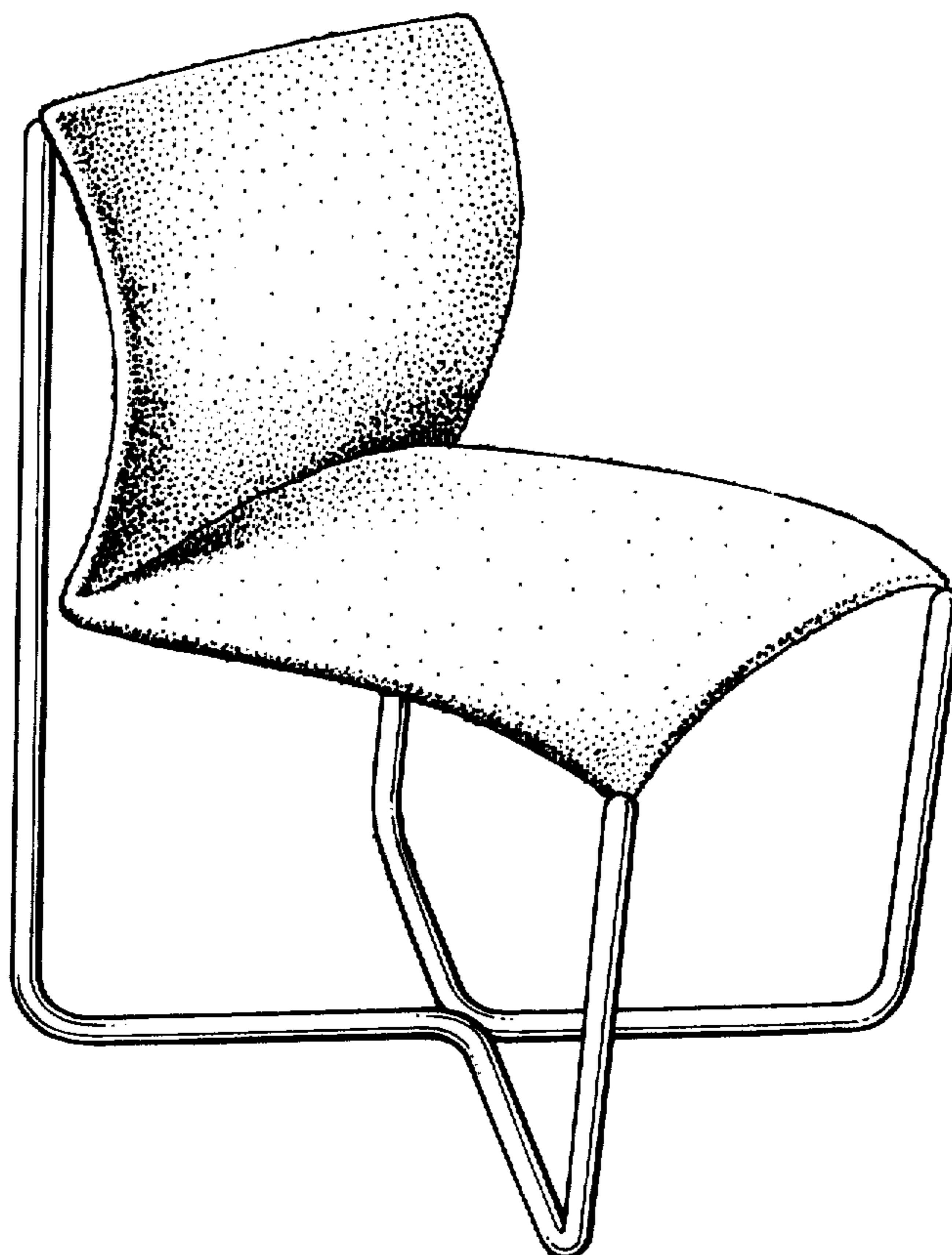
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair showing my new

down from above.



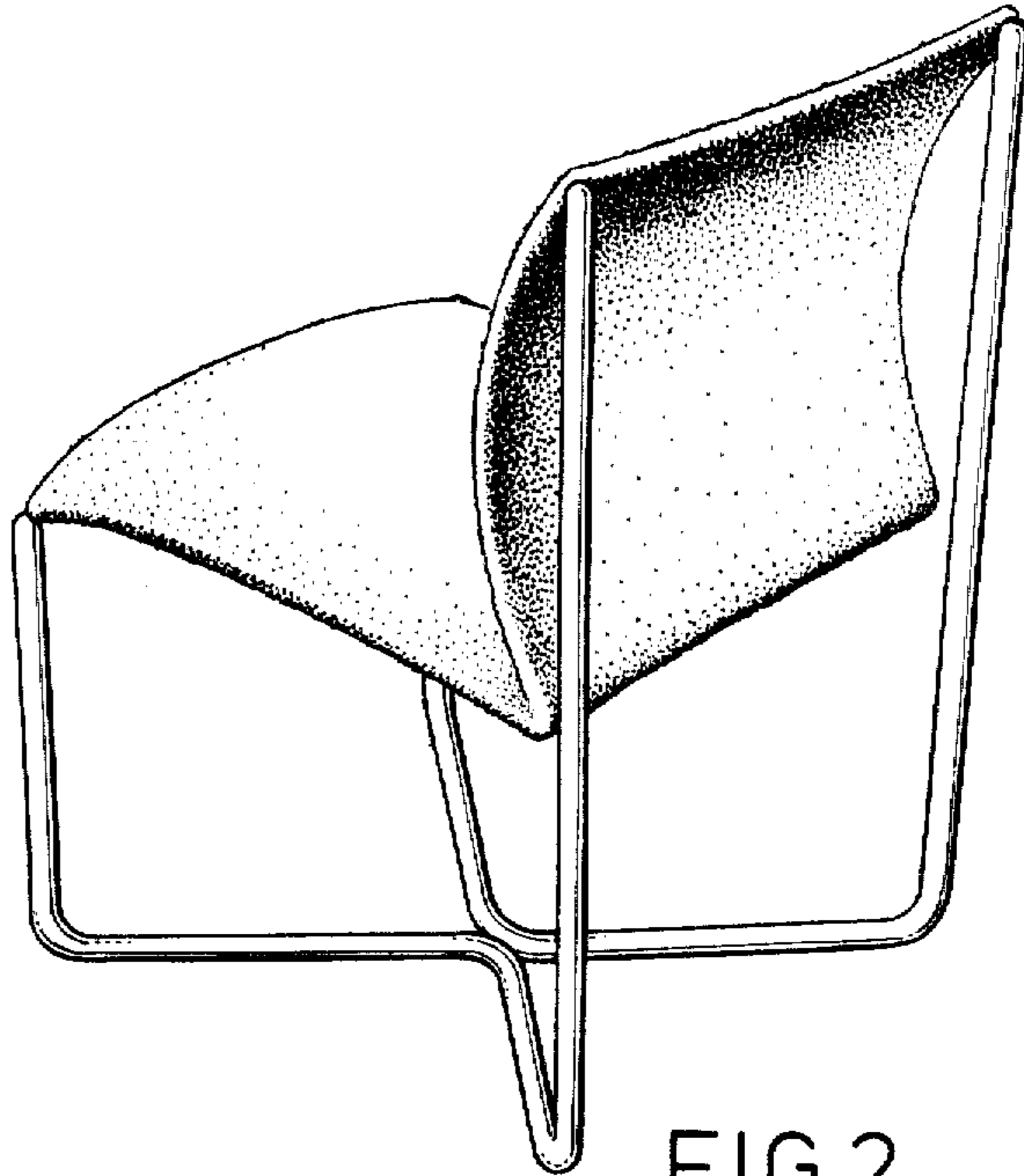

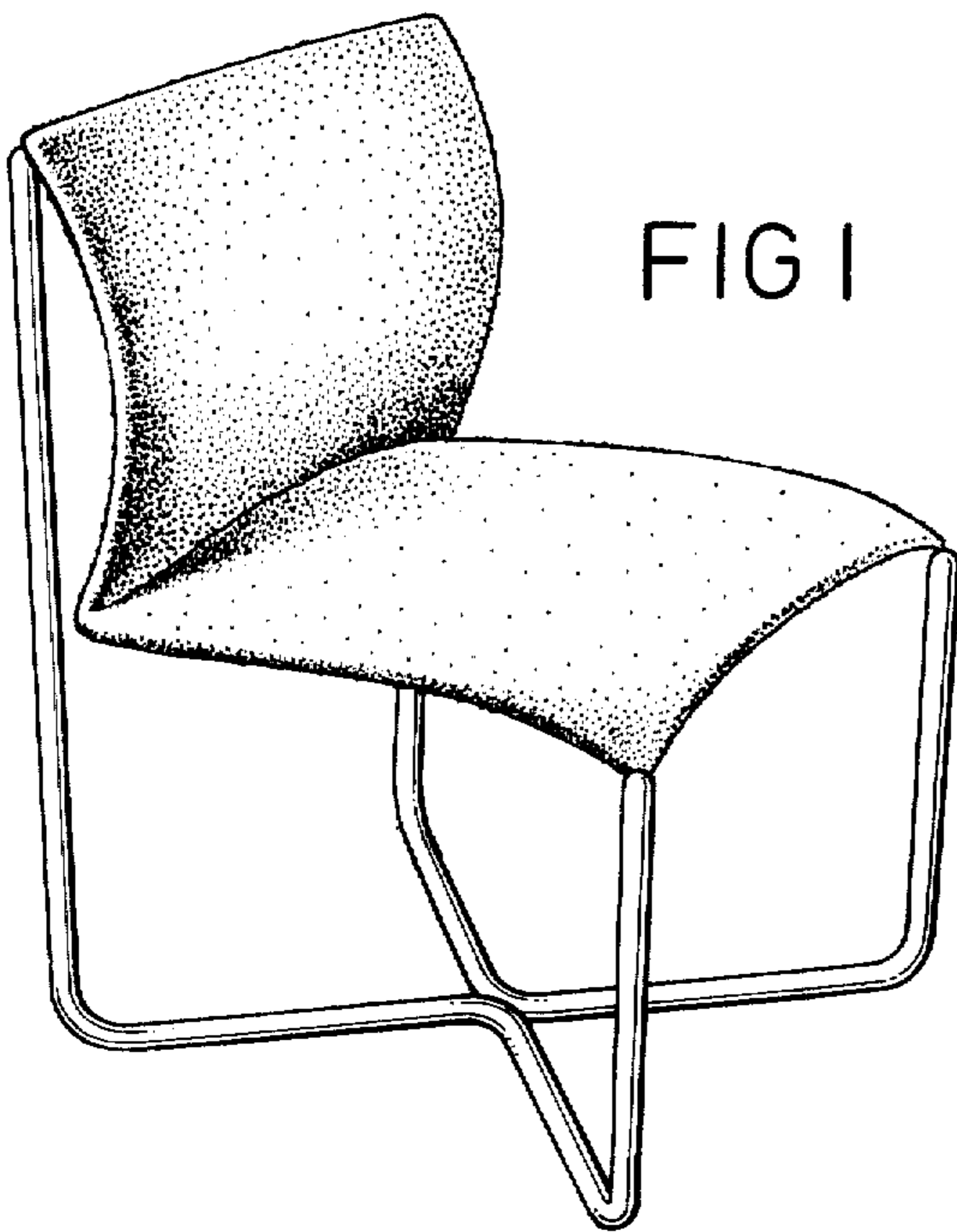

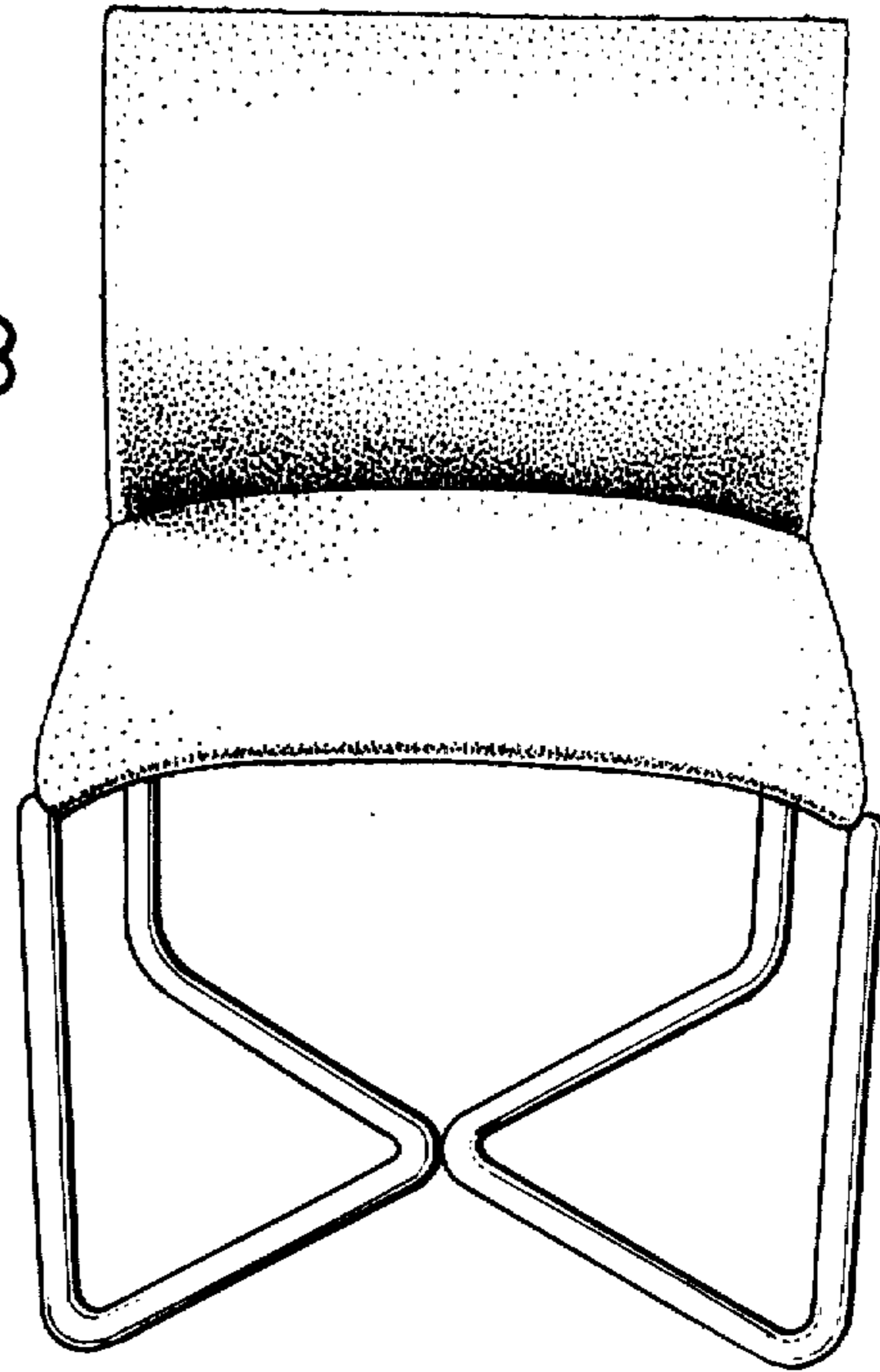

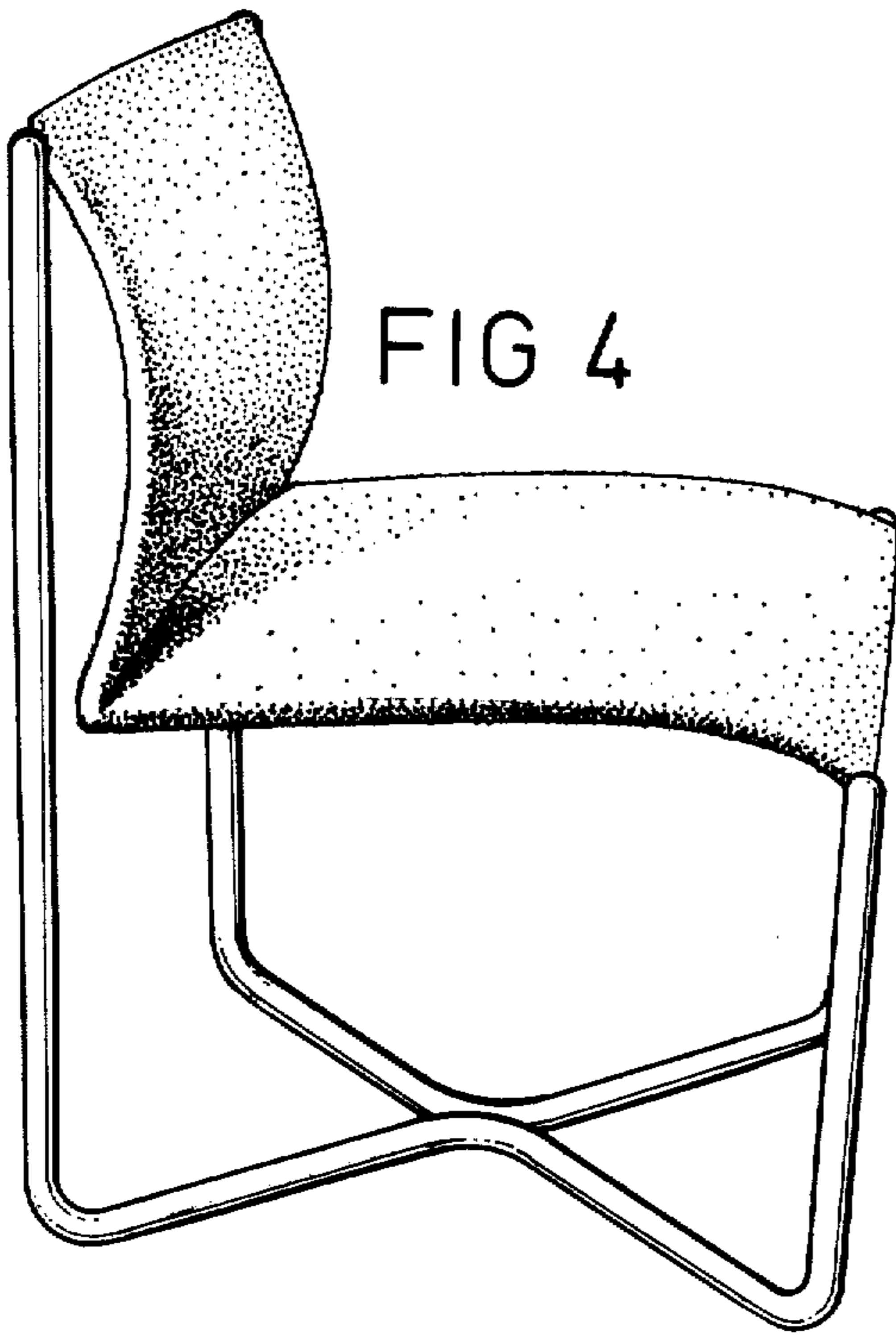
