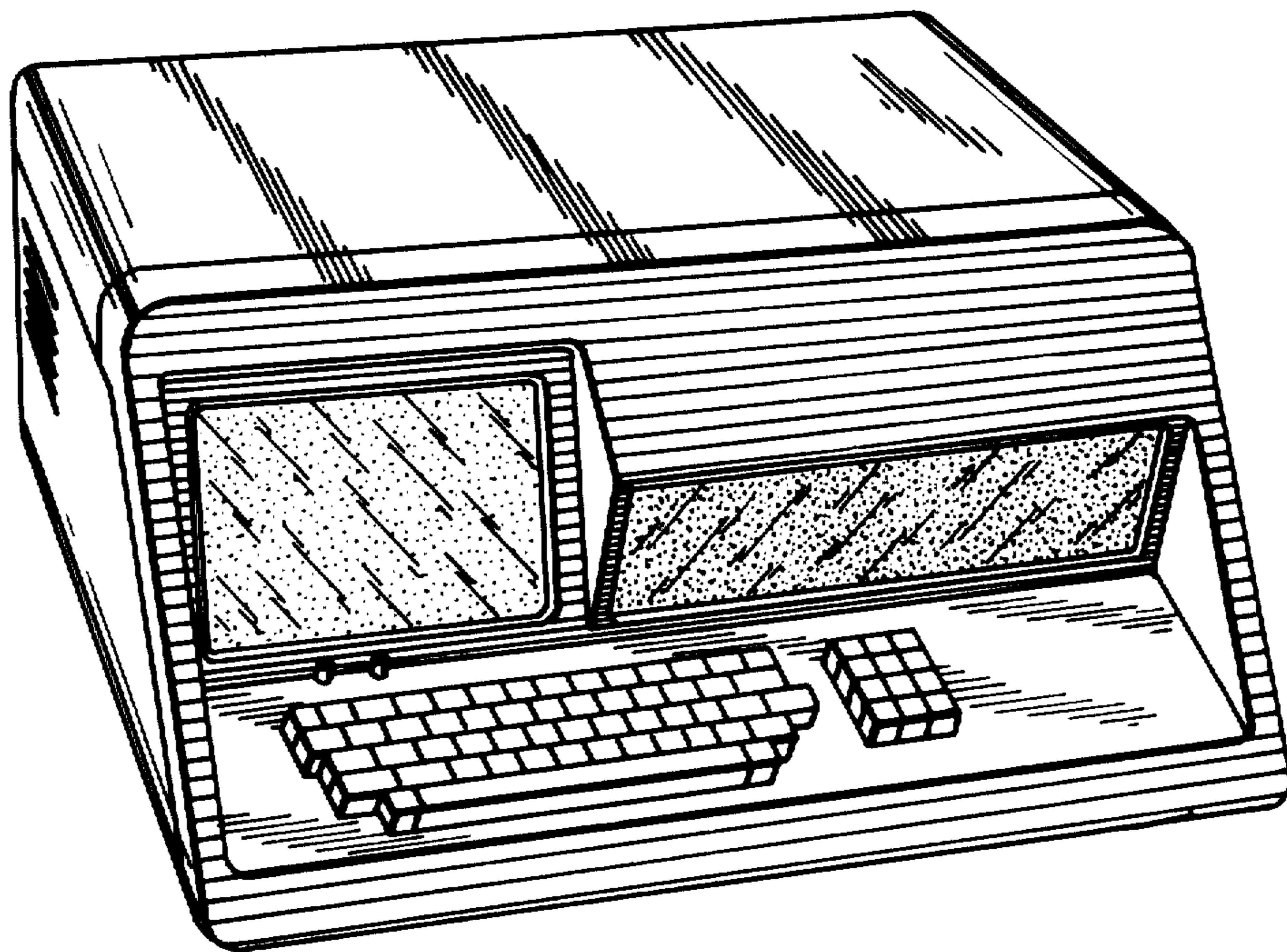

The ornamental design for a combined terminal and self-contained computer system, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front, left side and top of the combined terminal and self-contained computer system showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale, the right side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof on a slightly enlarged scale;
 FIG. 5 is a top view thereof on a reduced scale;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof on a reduced scale.



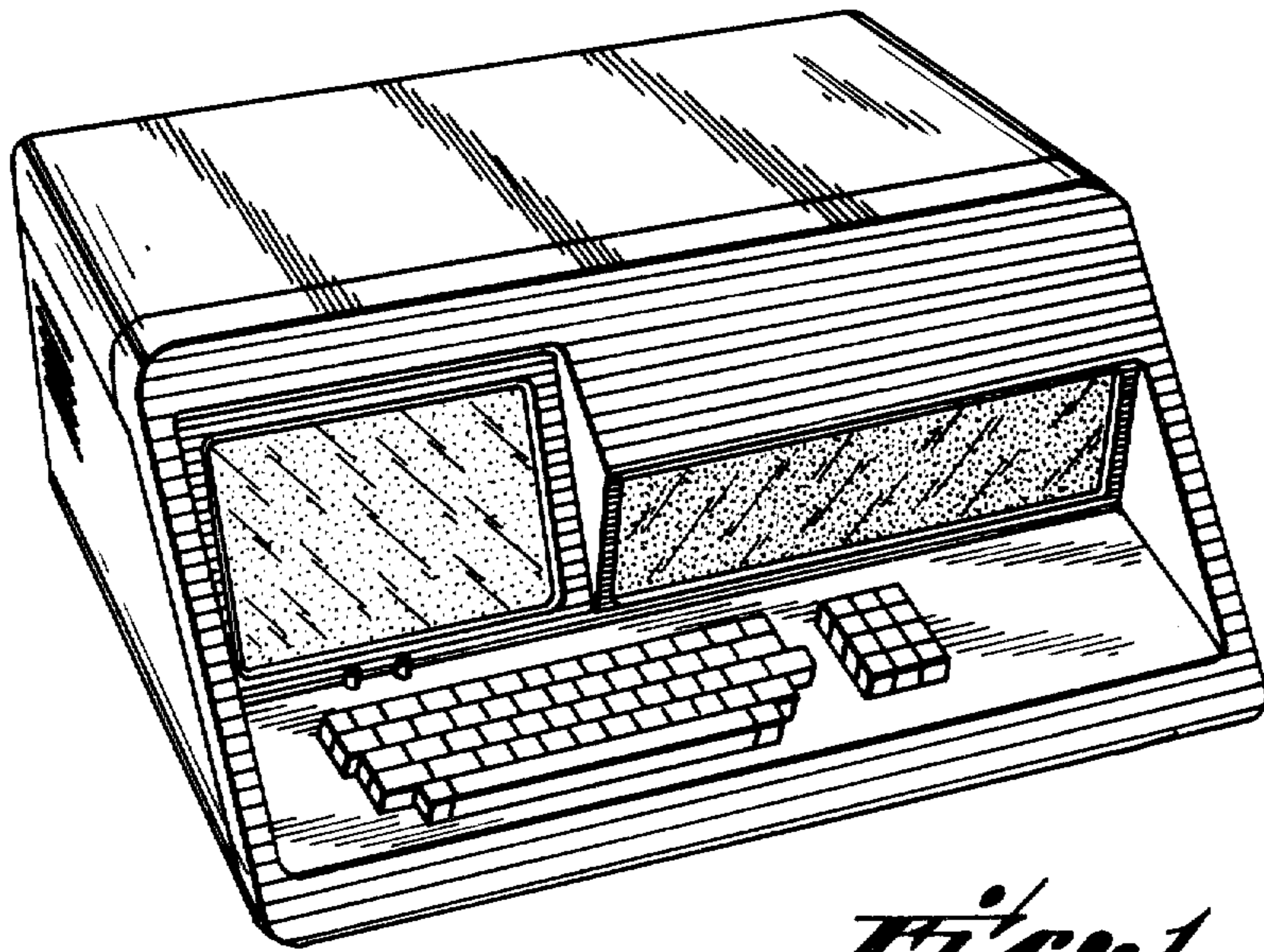

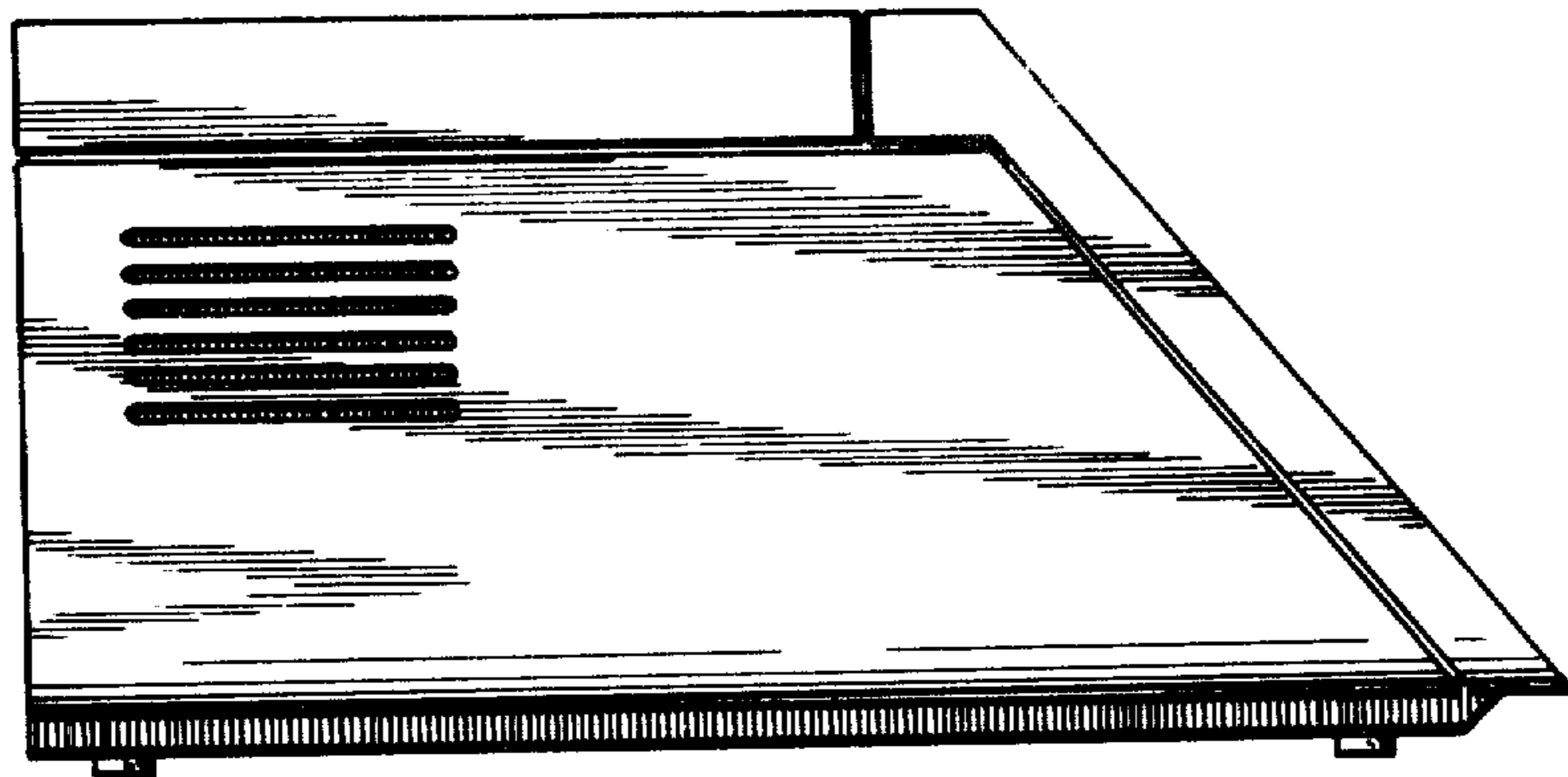

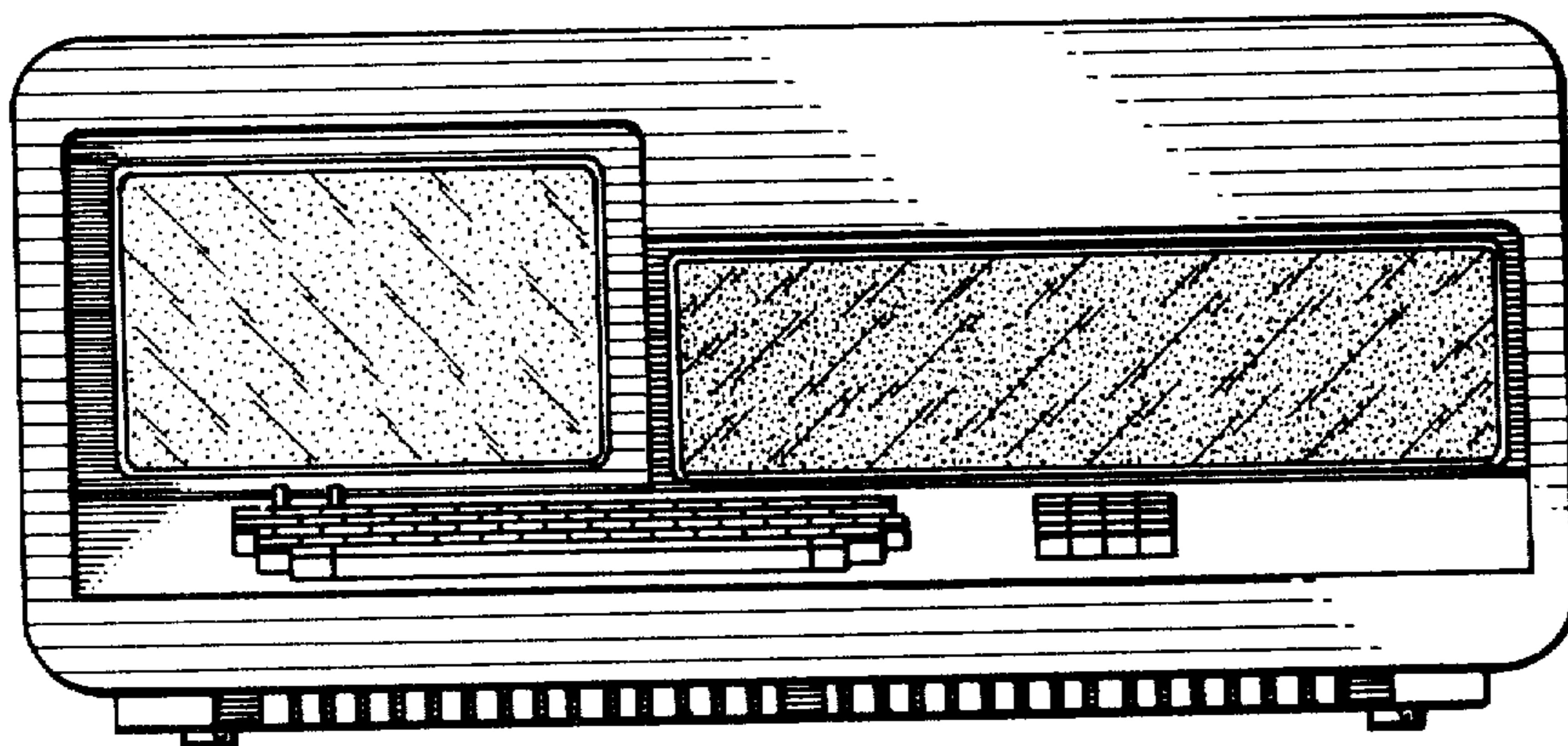

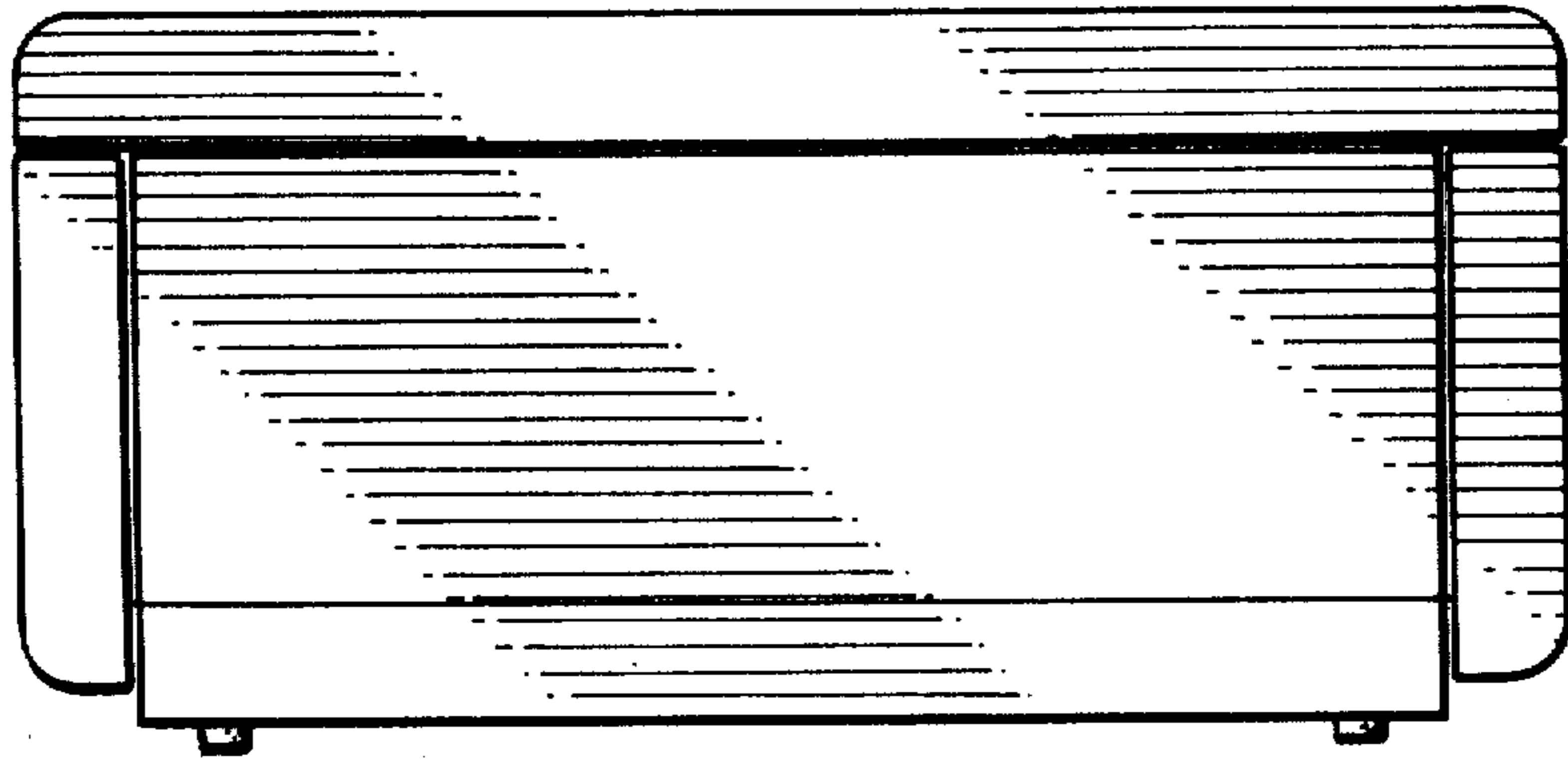

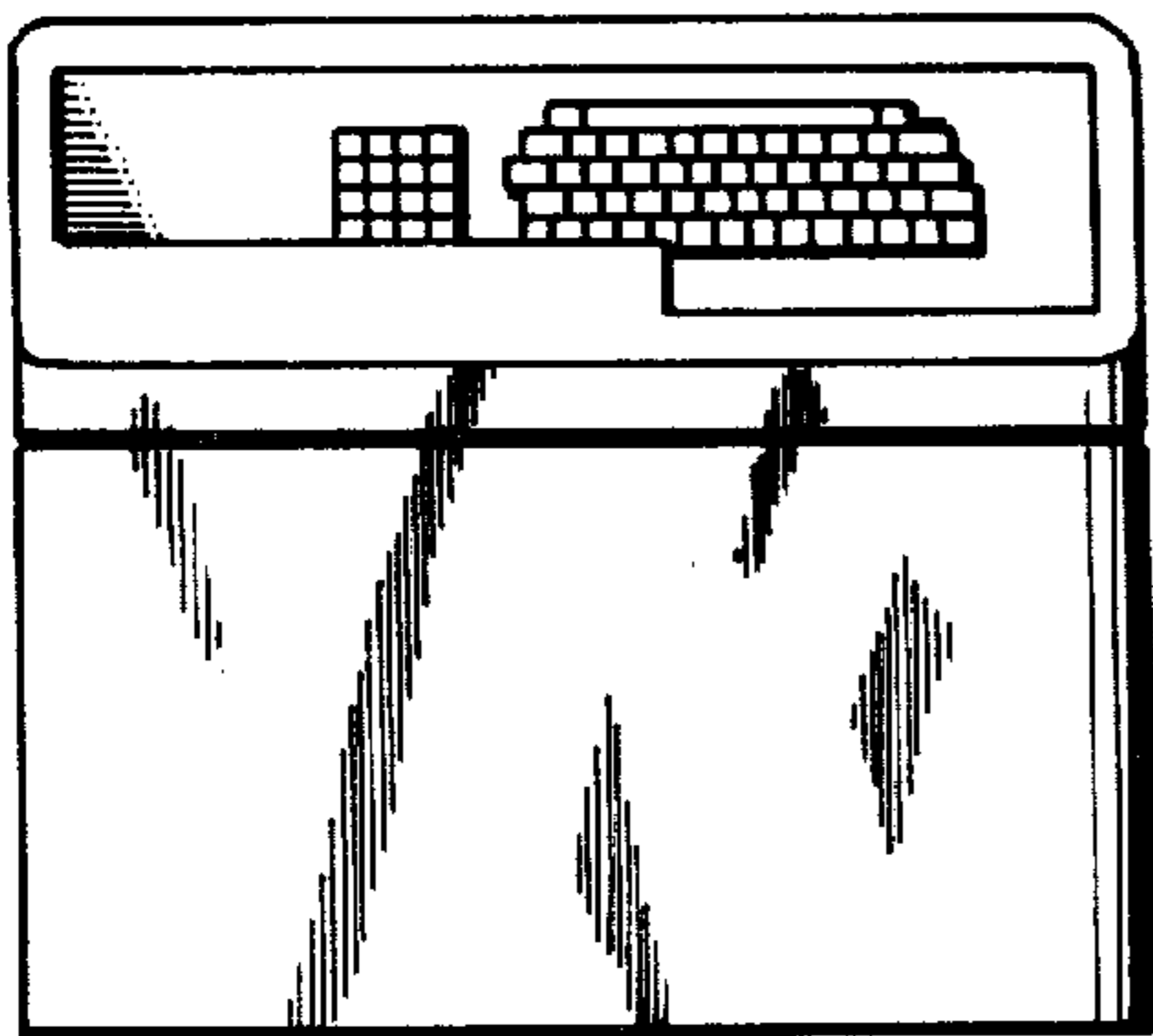

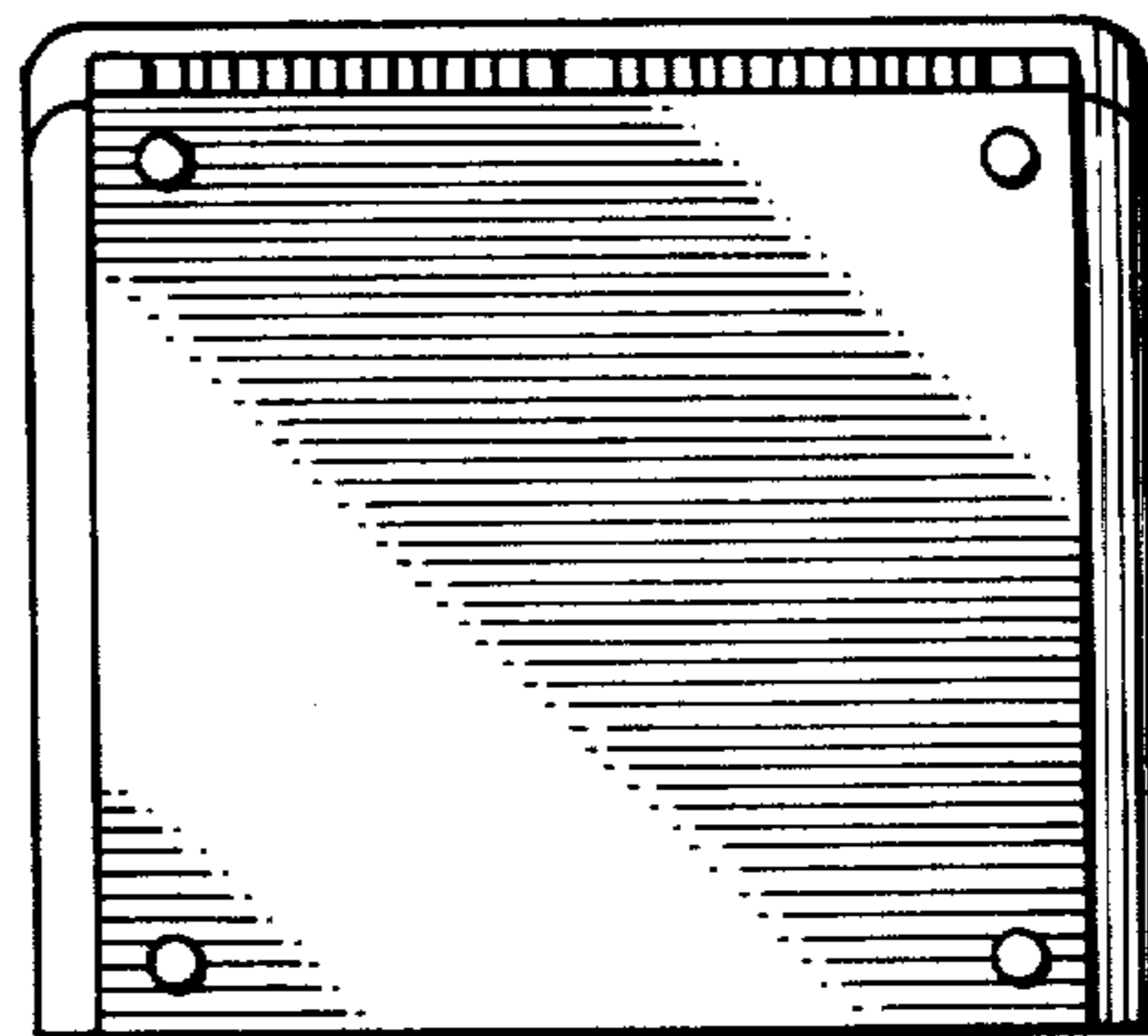
