The ornamental design for an electronic basketball game housing, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an electronic basketball game housing embodying my design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view of said electronic basketball game housing;
 FIG. 3 is a side view of said electronic basketball game housing, opposite side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 4 is a rear view of said electronic basketball game housing; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of a electronic basketball game housing embodying my design.

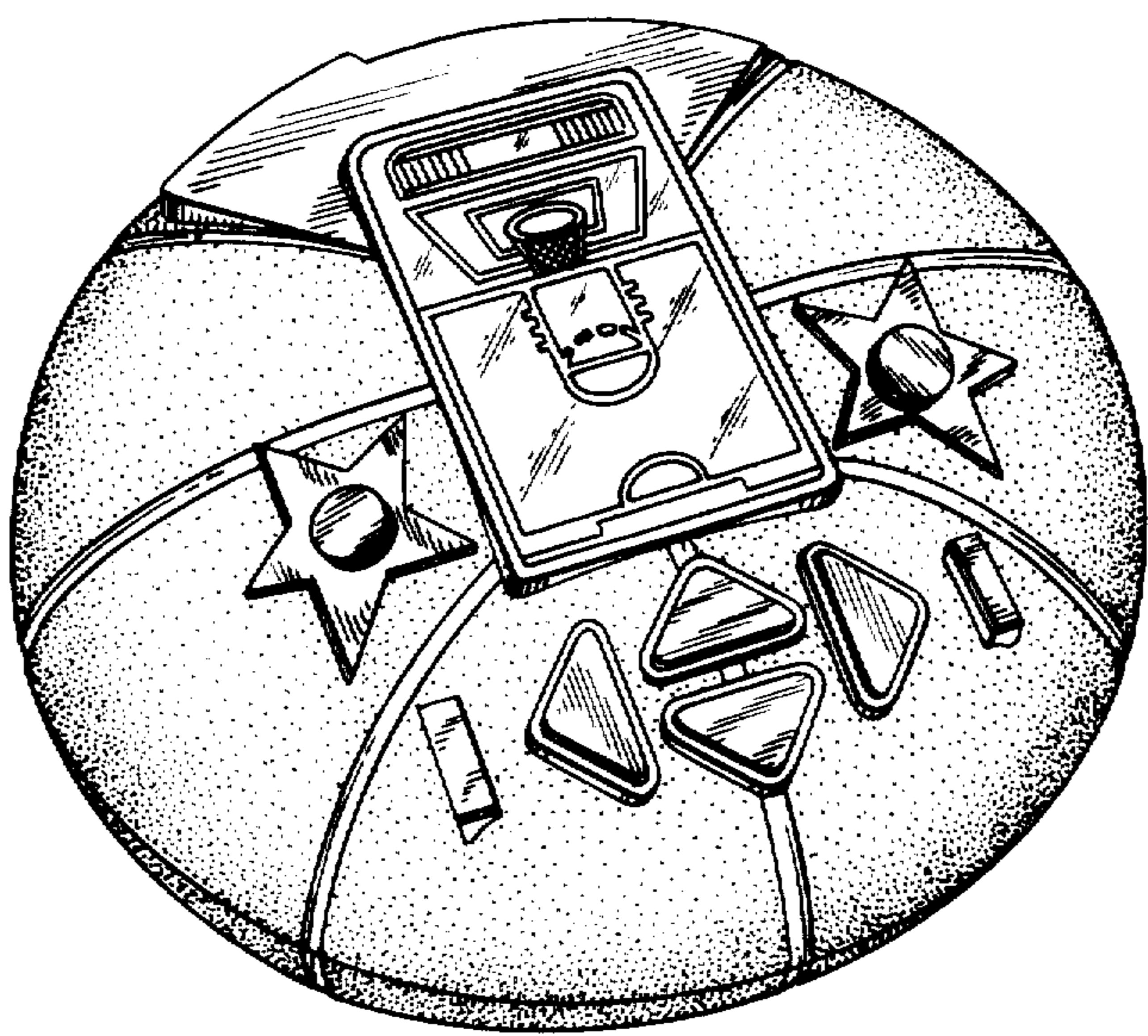

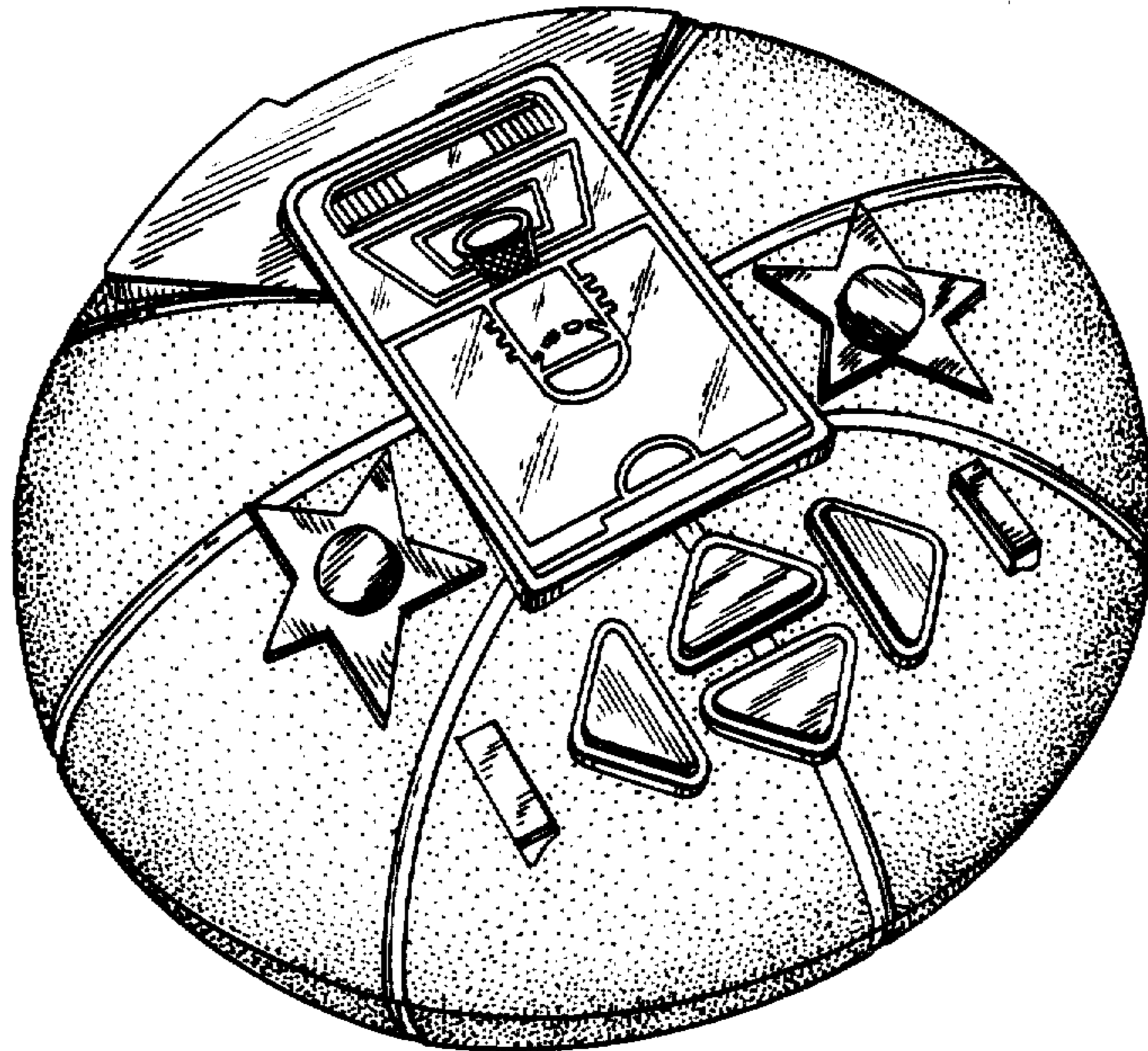

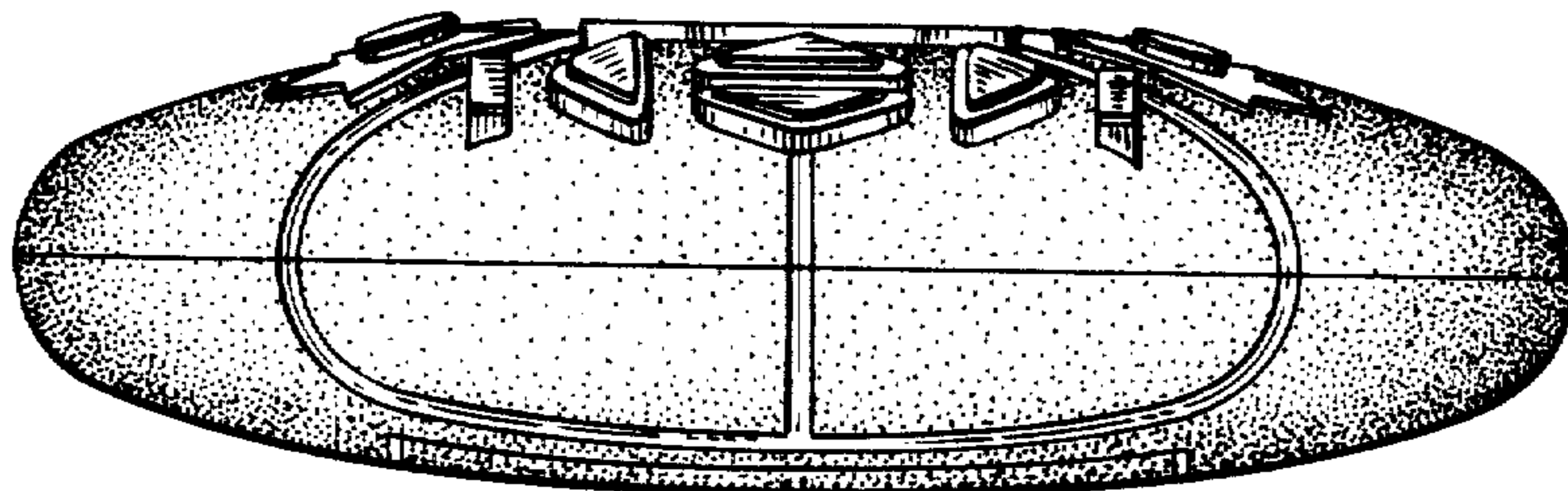

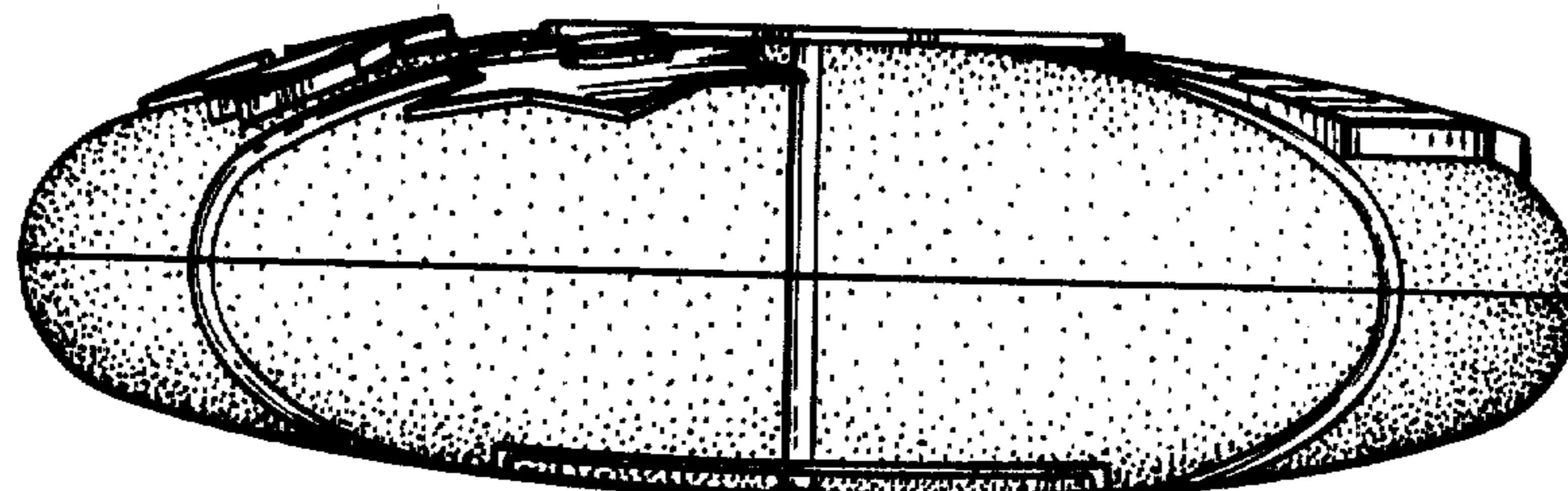

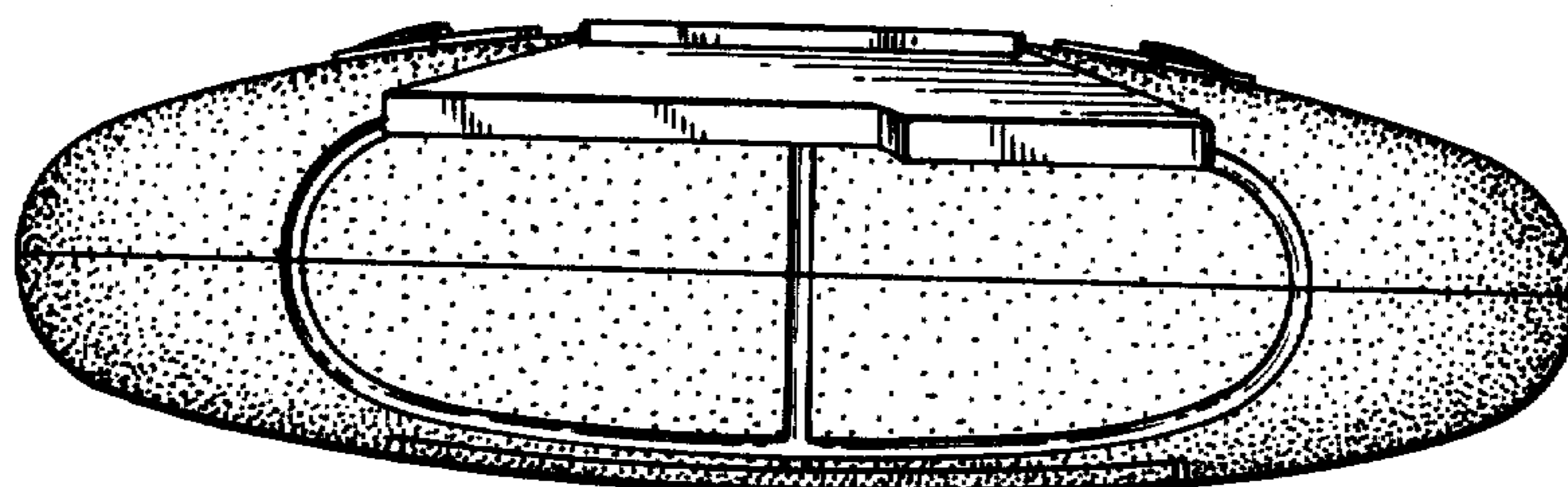
