DESCRIPTION

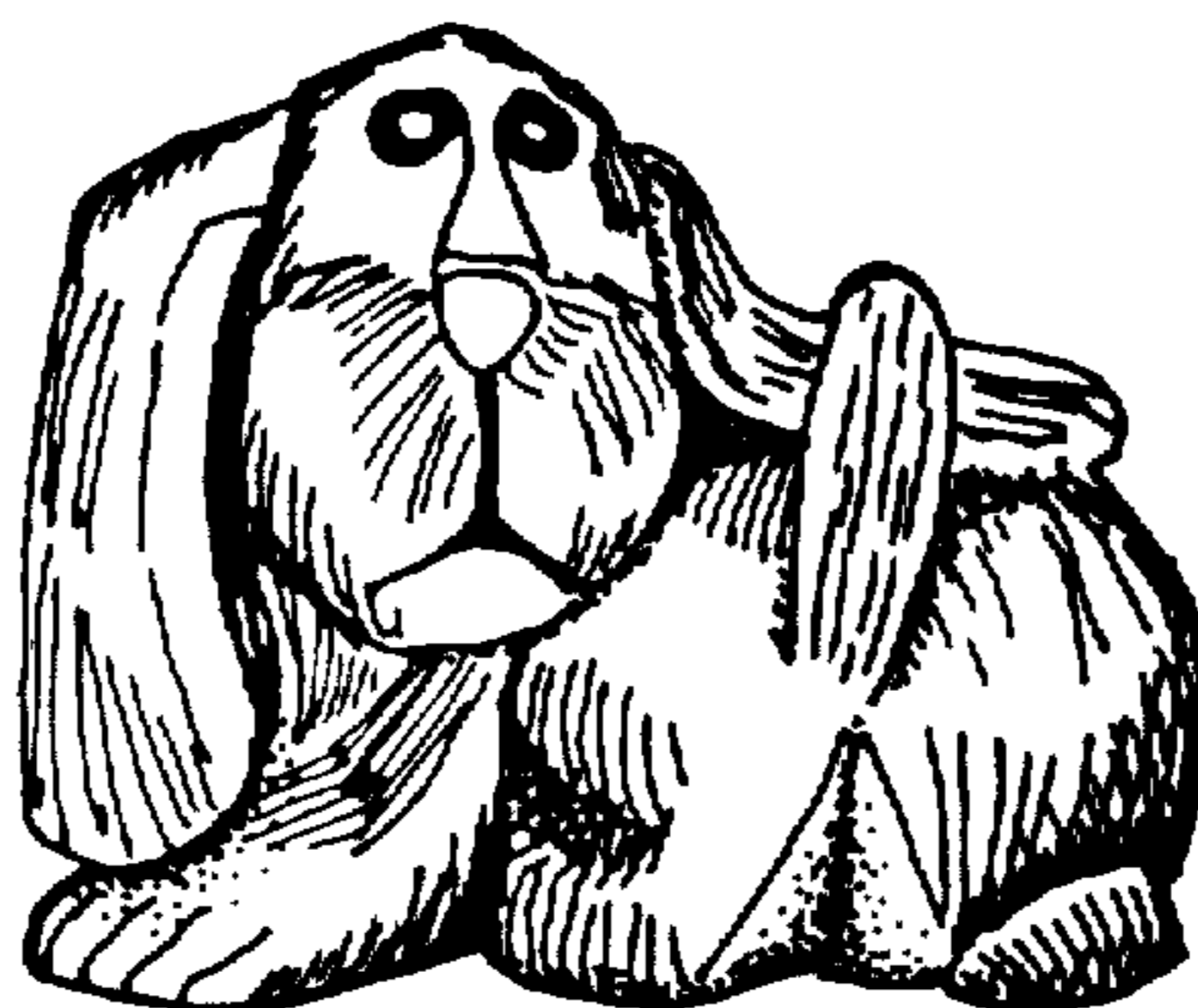
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the figurine showing

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.



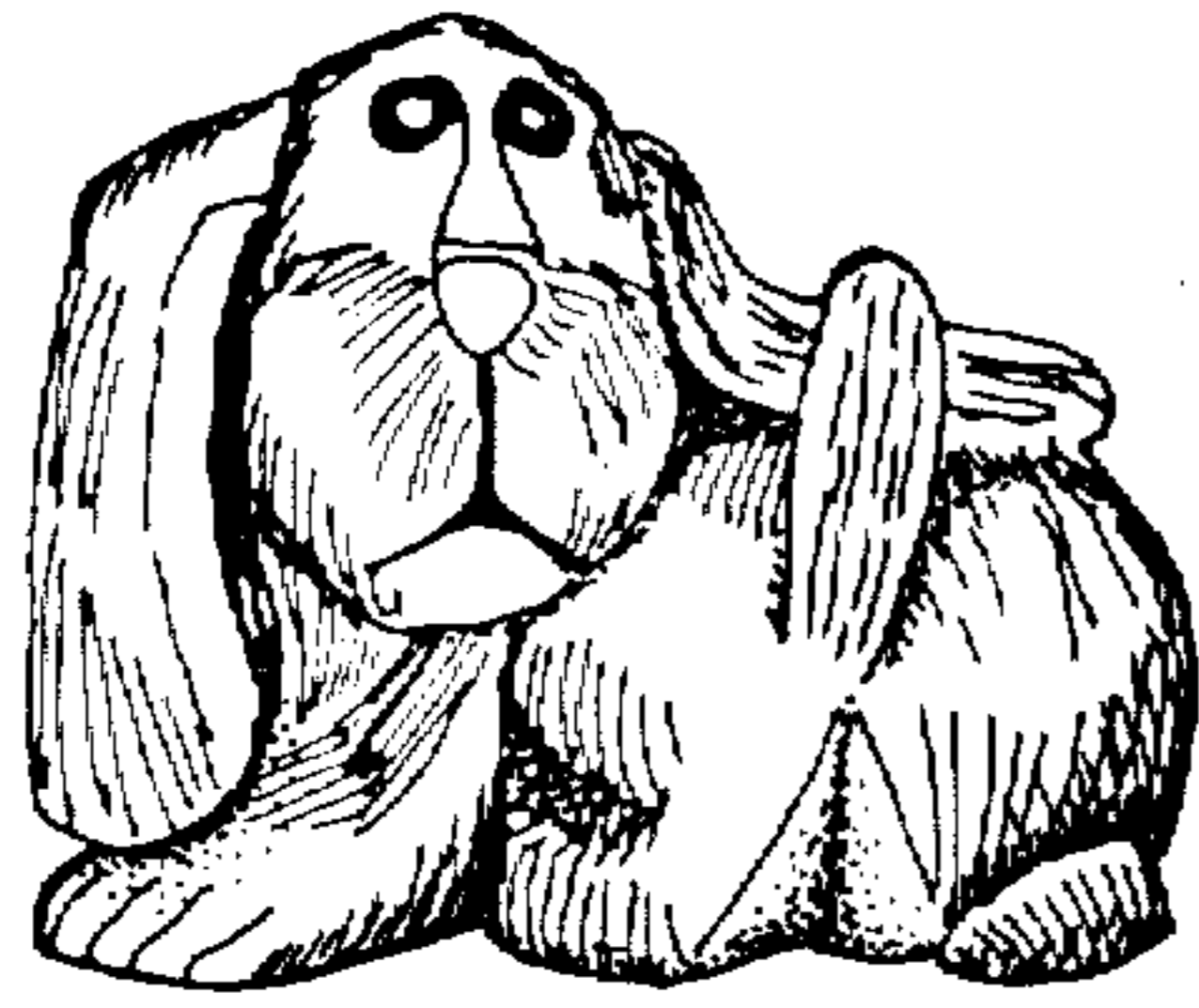

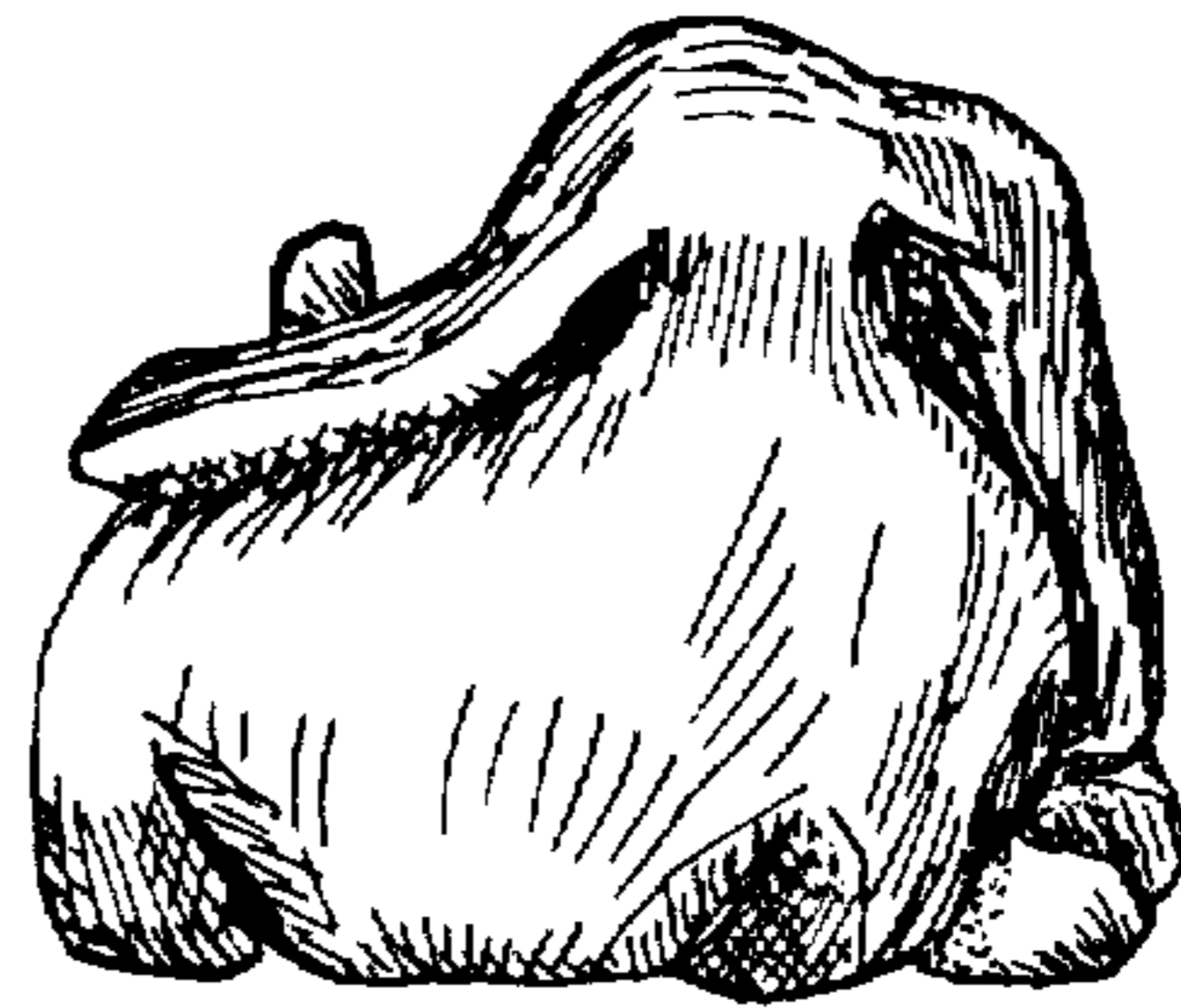

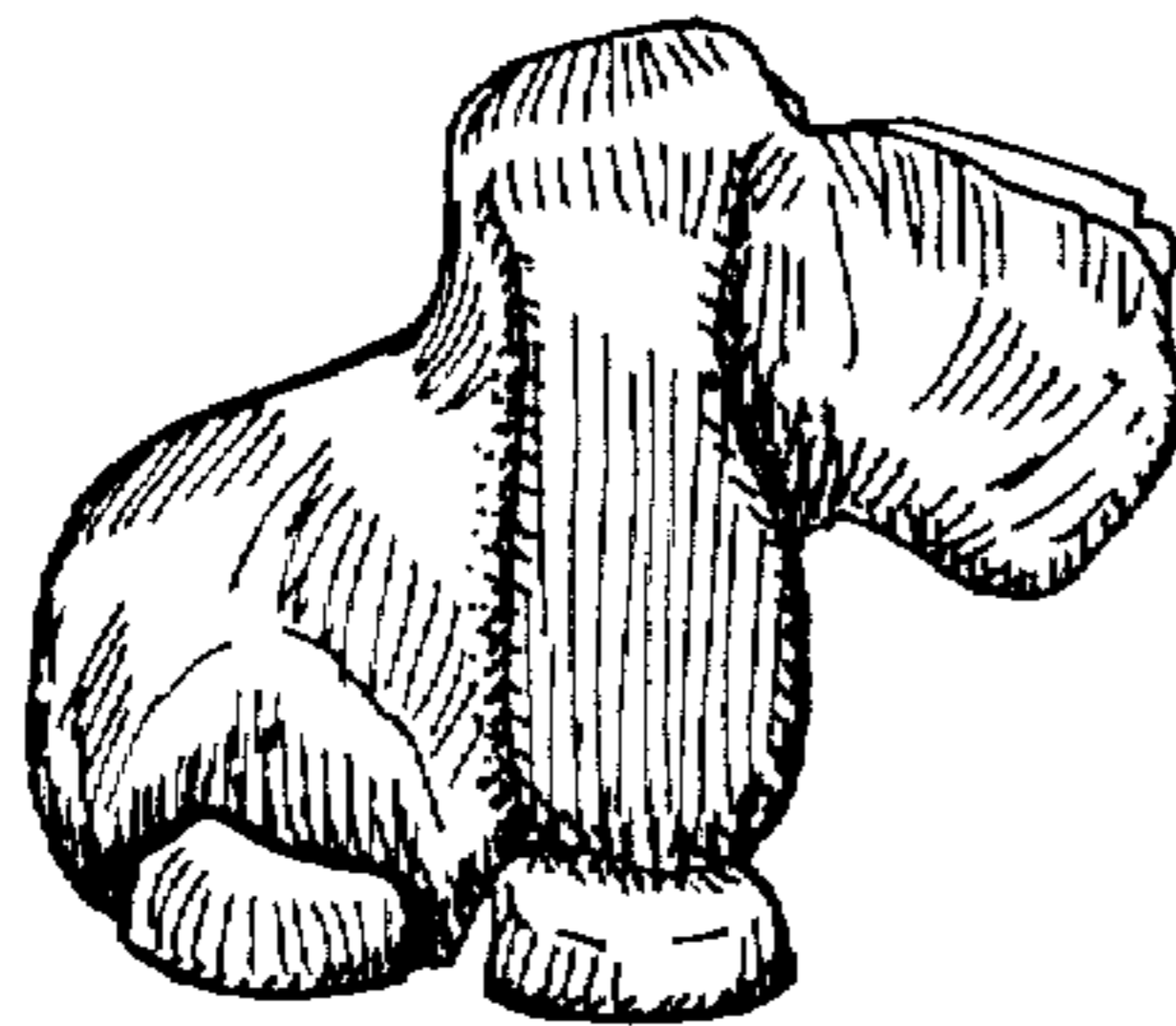

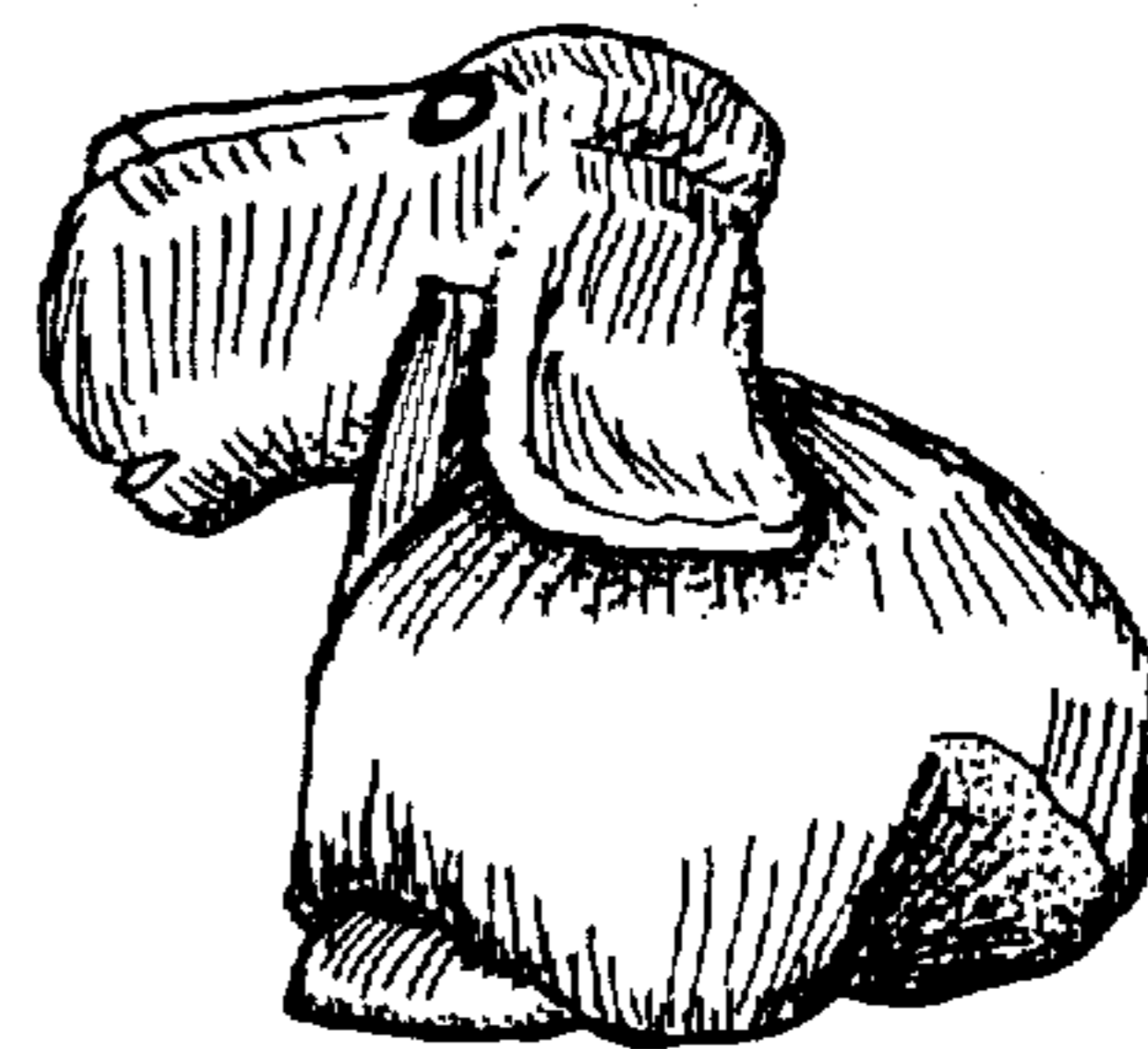

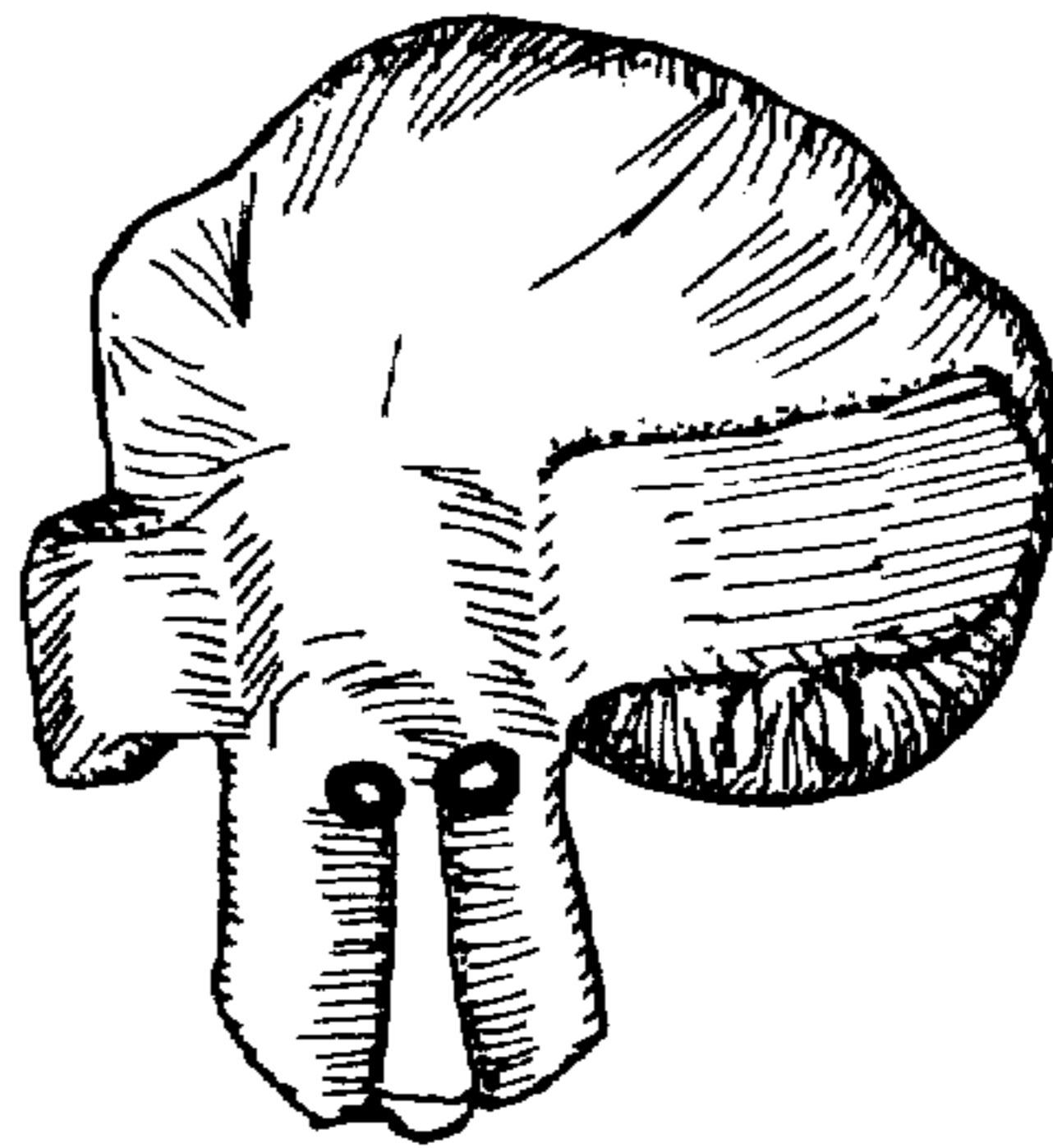
