DESCRIPTION

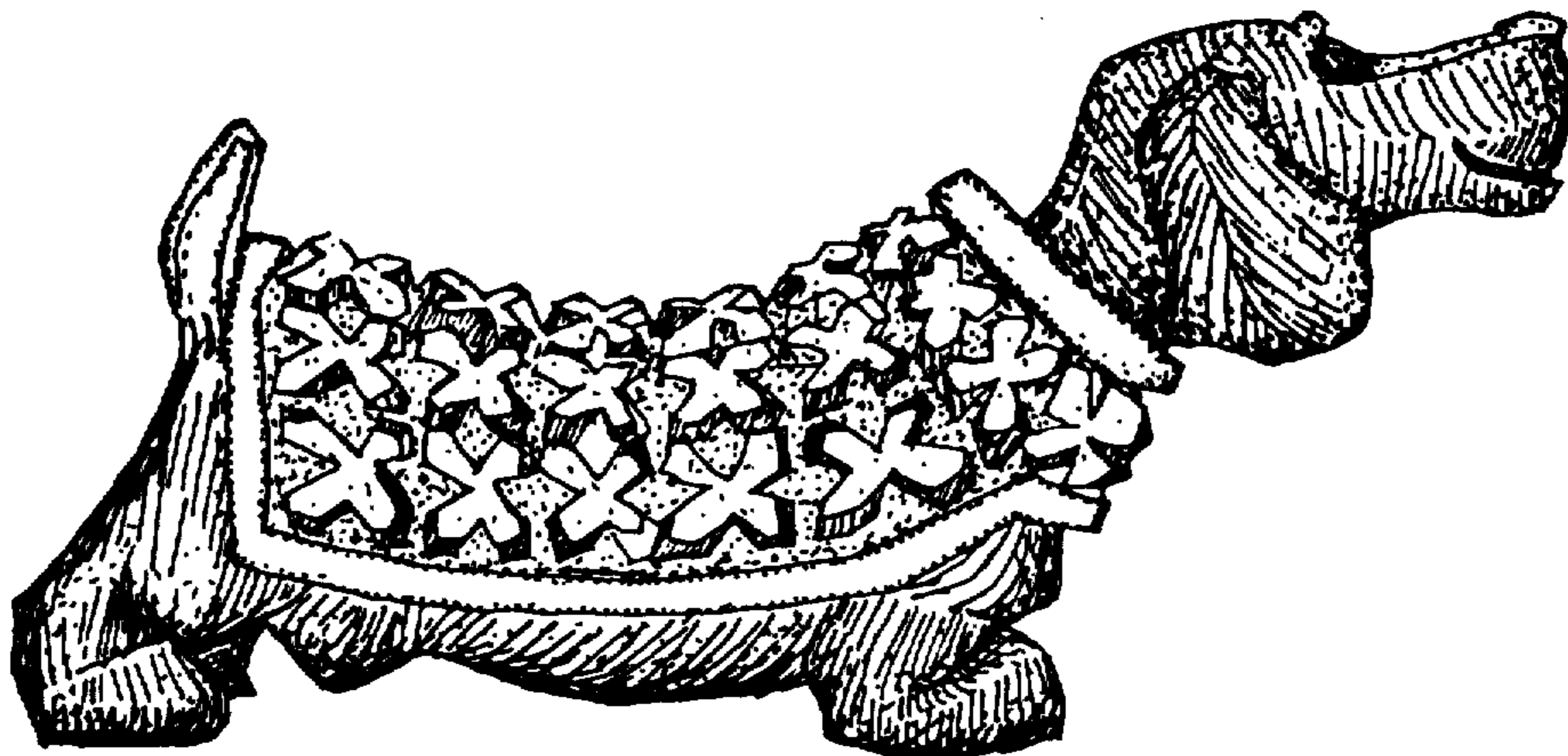
FIG. 1 is a front end perspective view of the figurine showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.



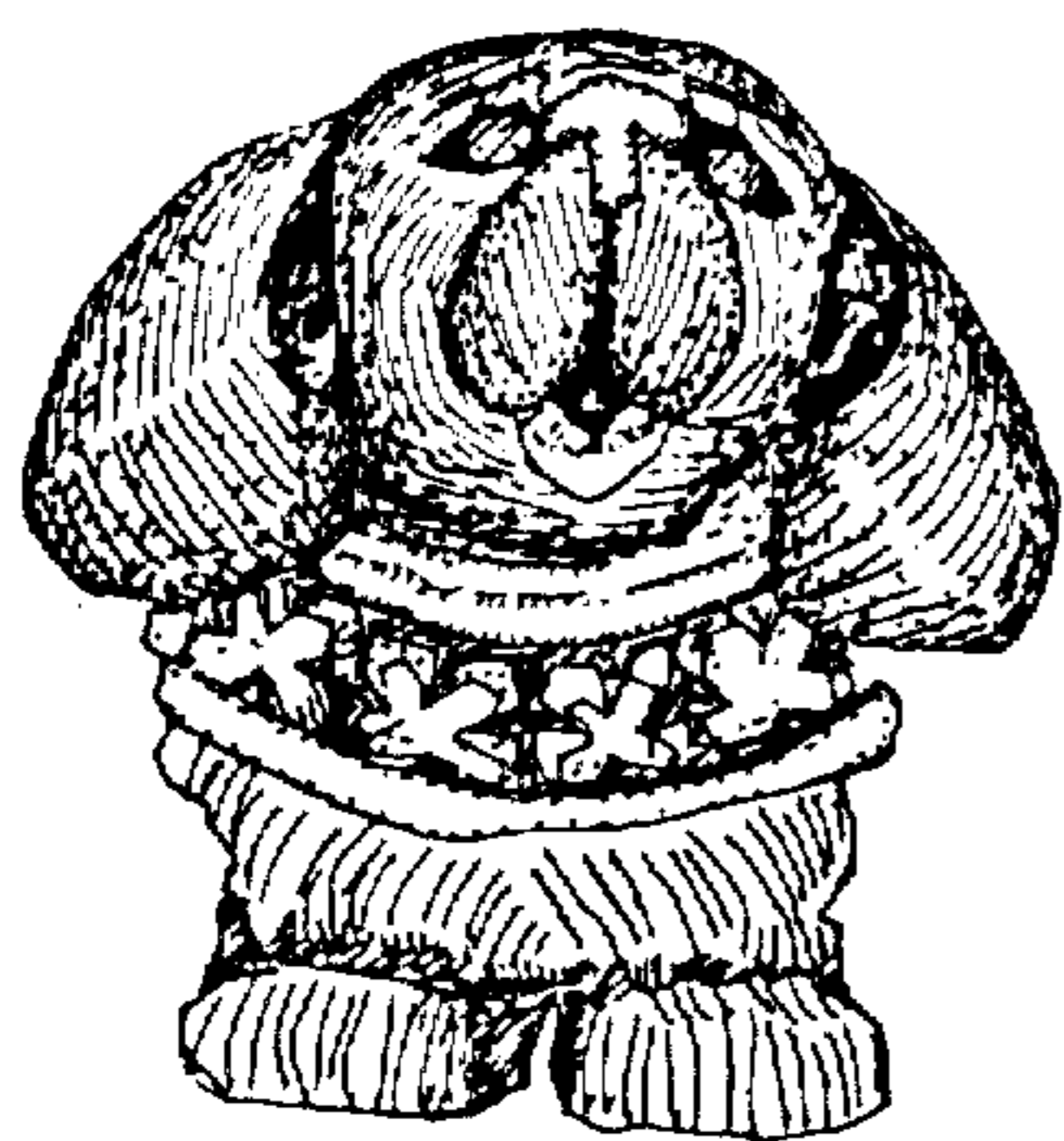

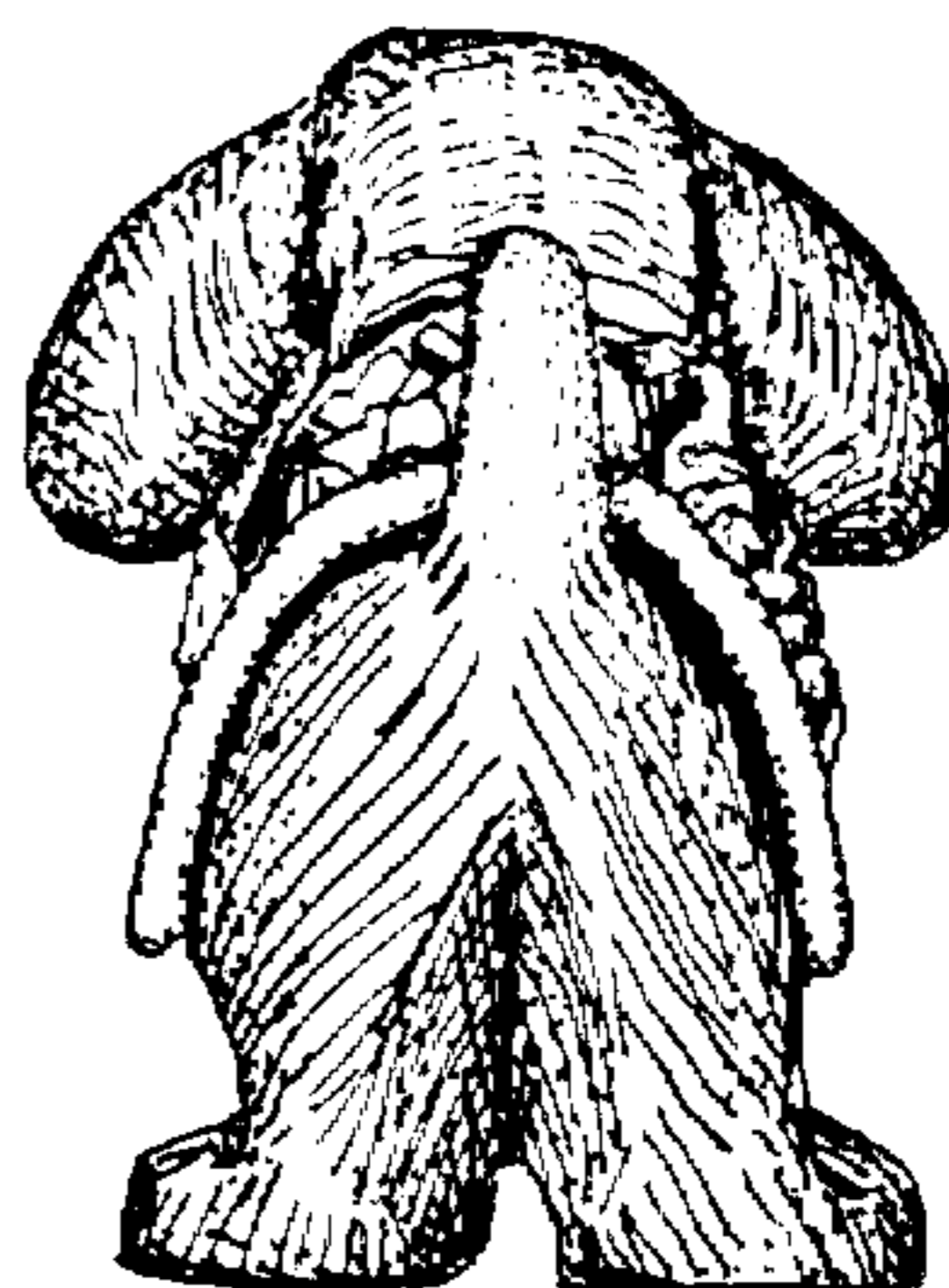

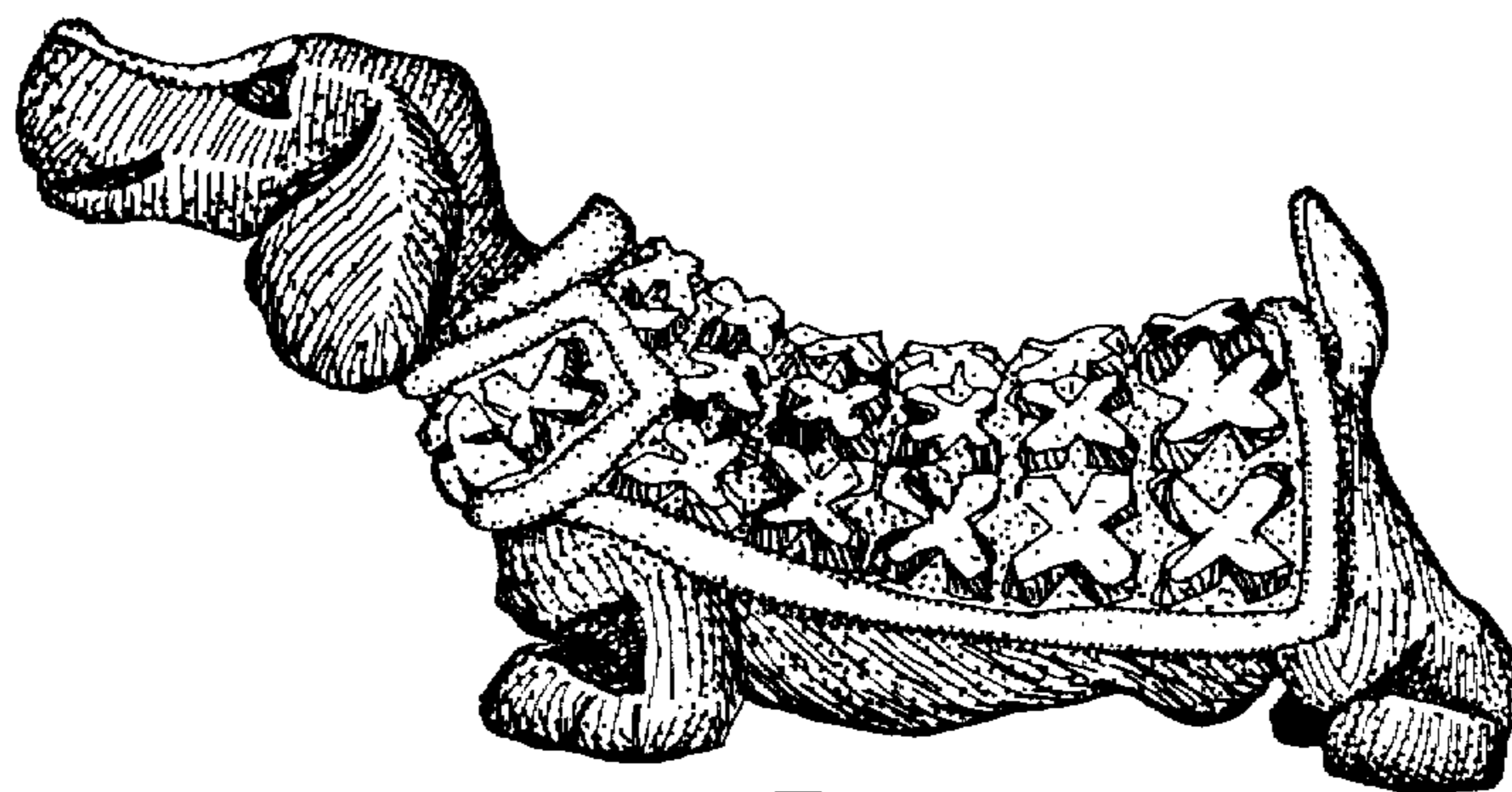

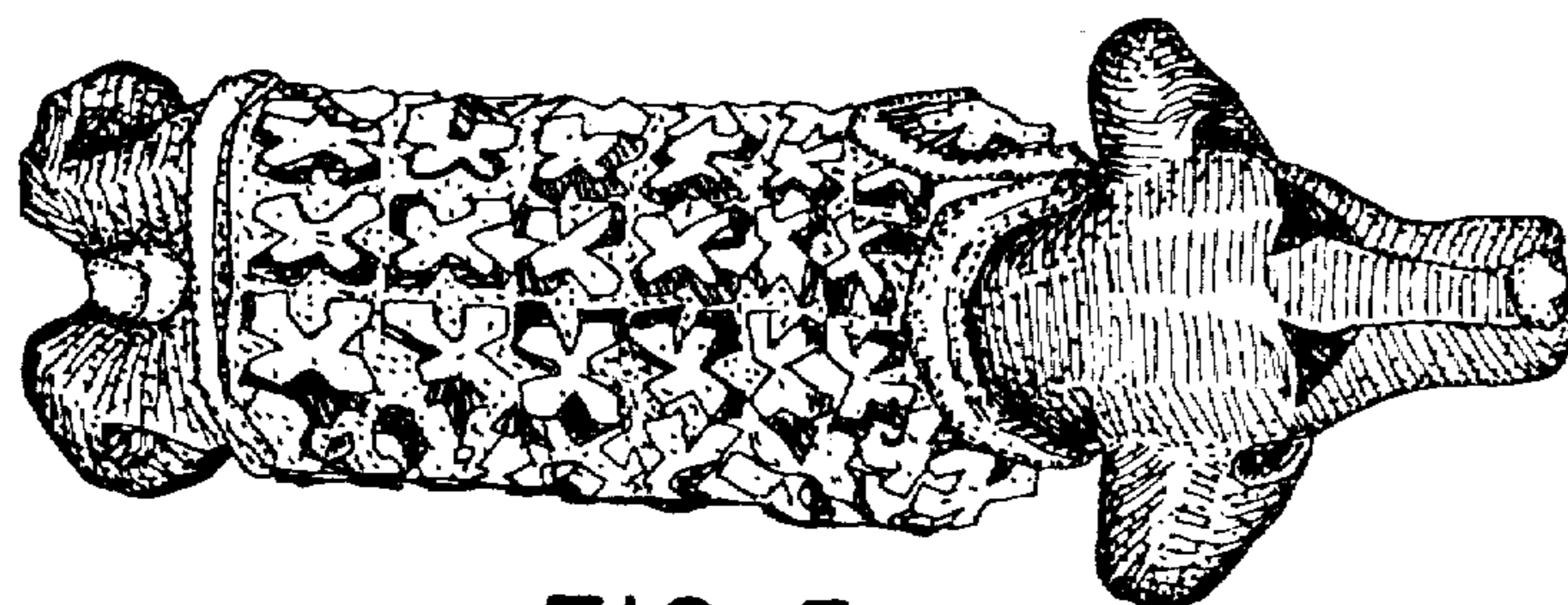
