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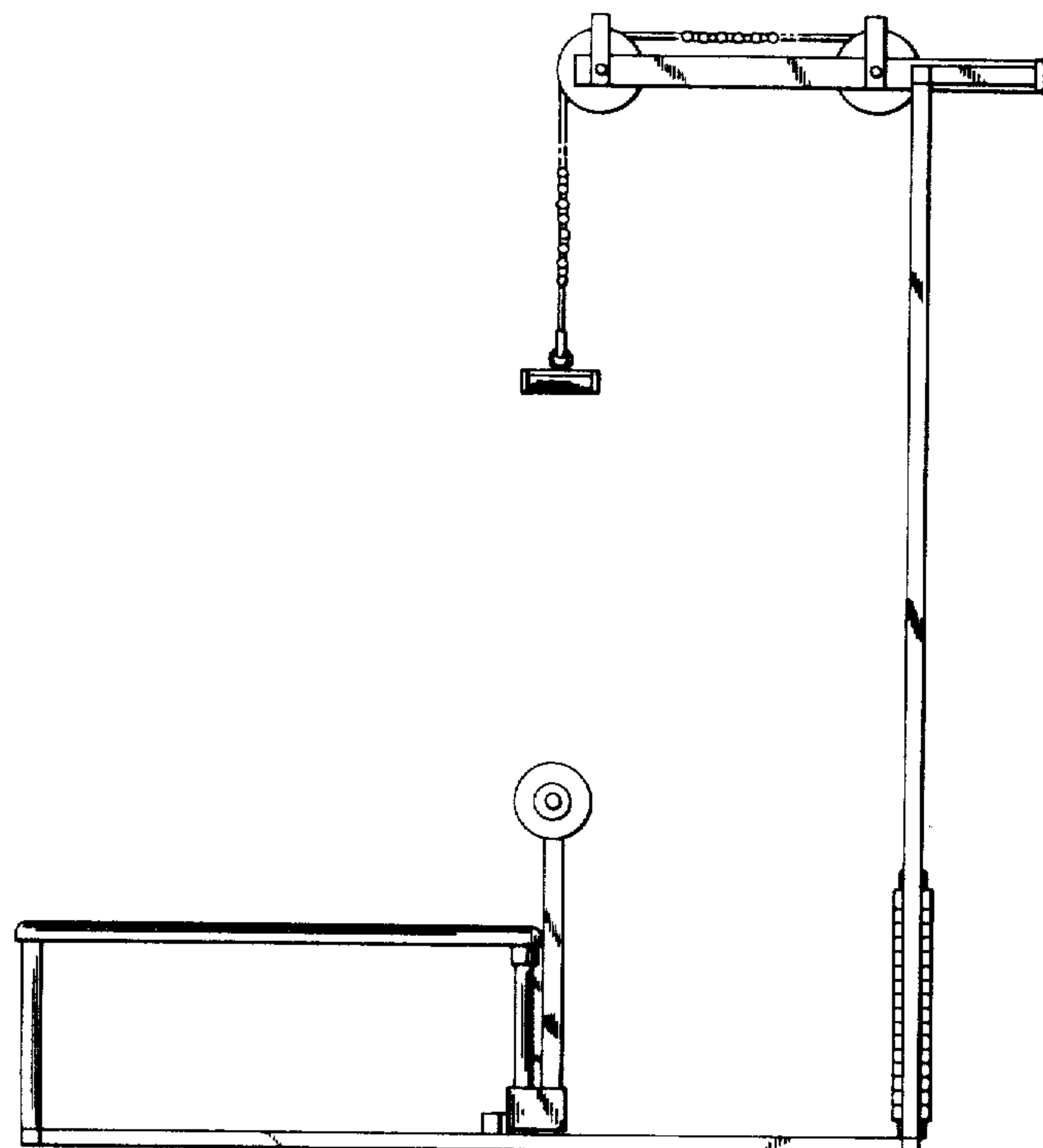
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[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a physical exerciser showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



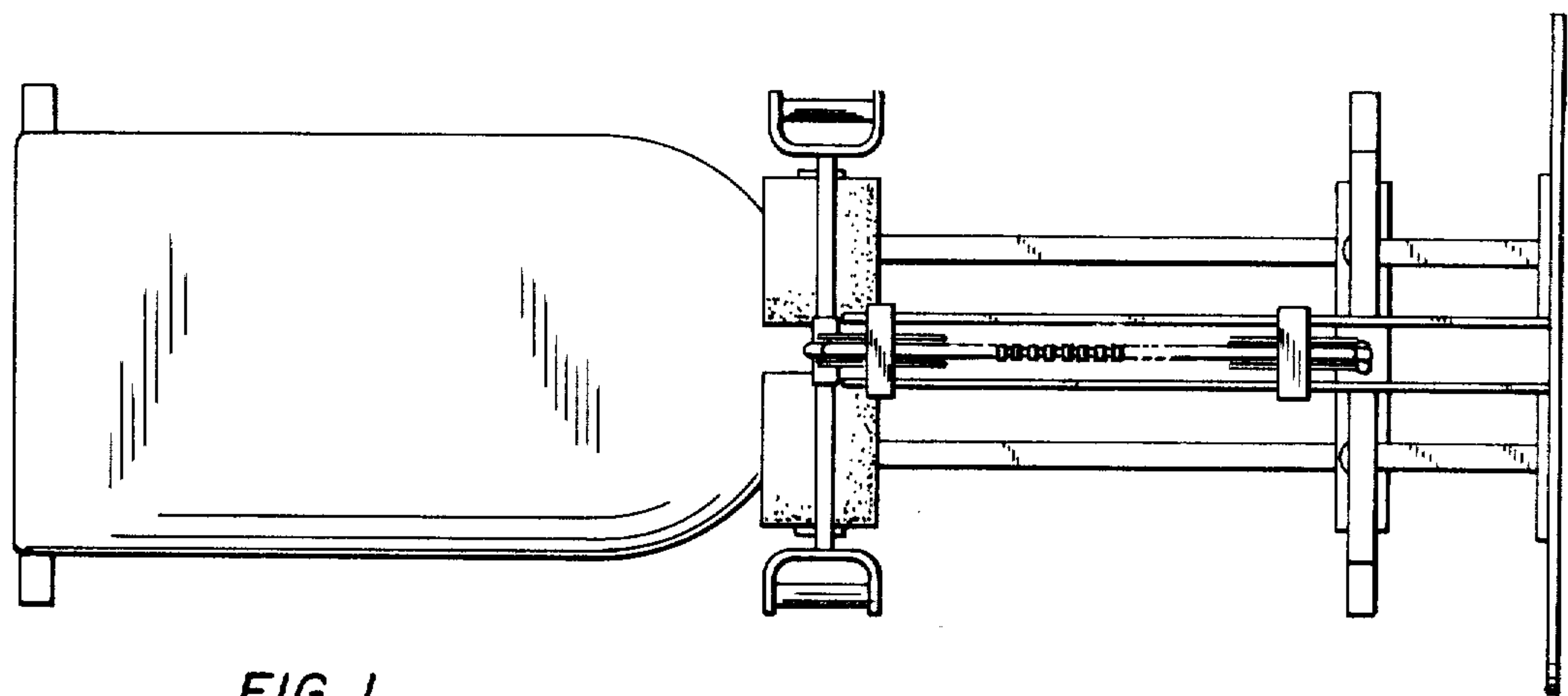

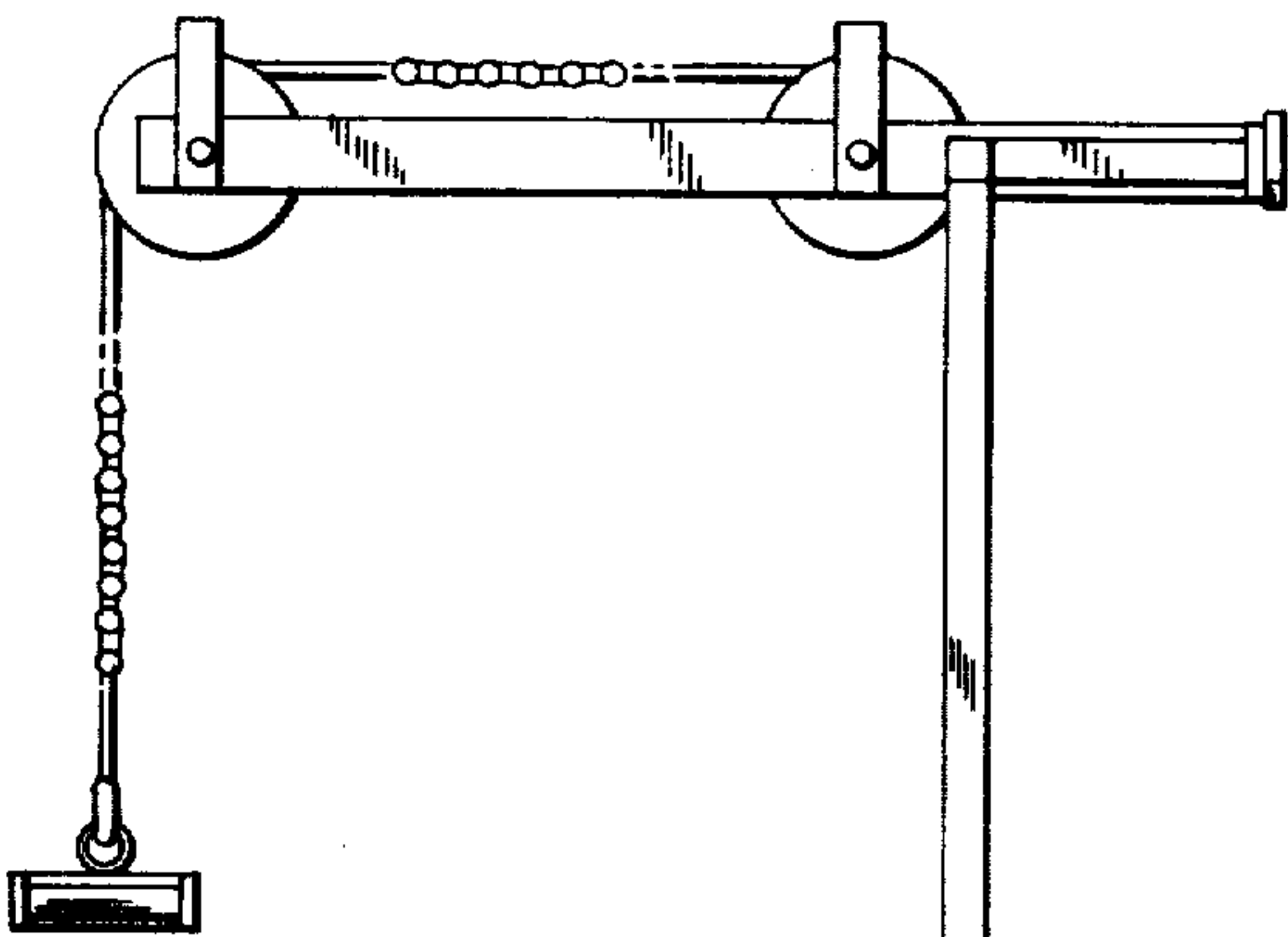

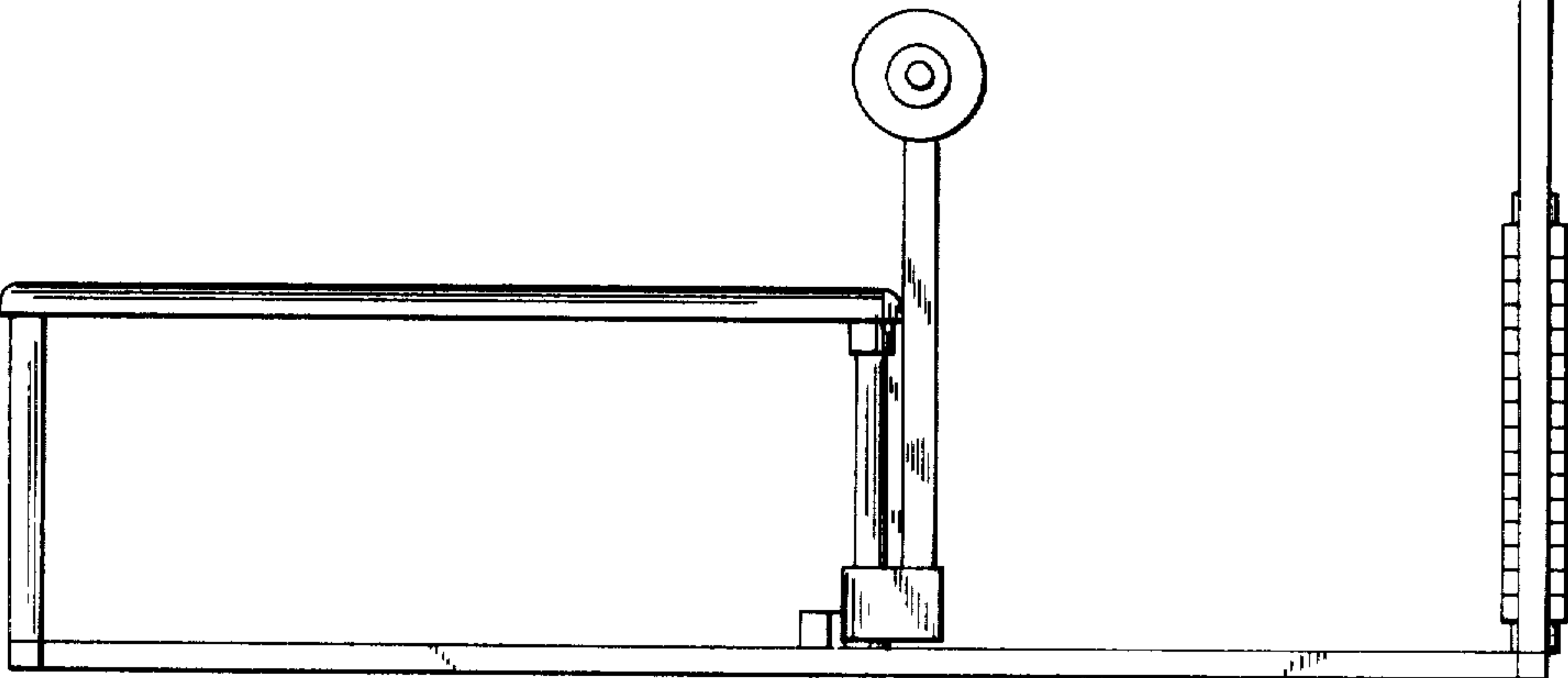

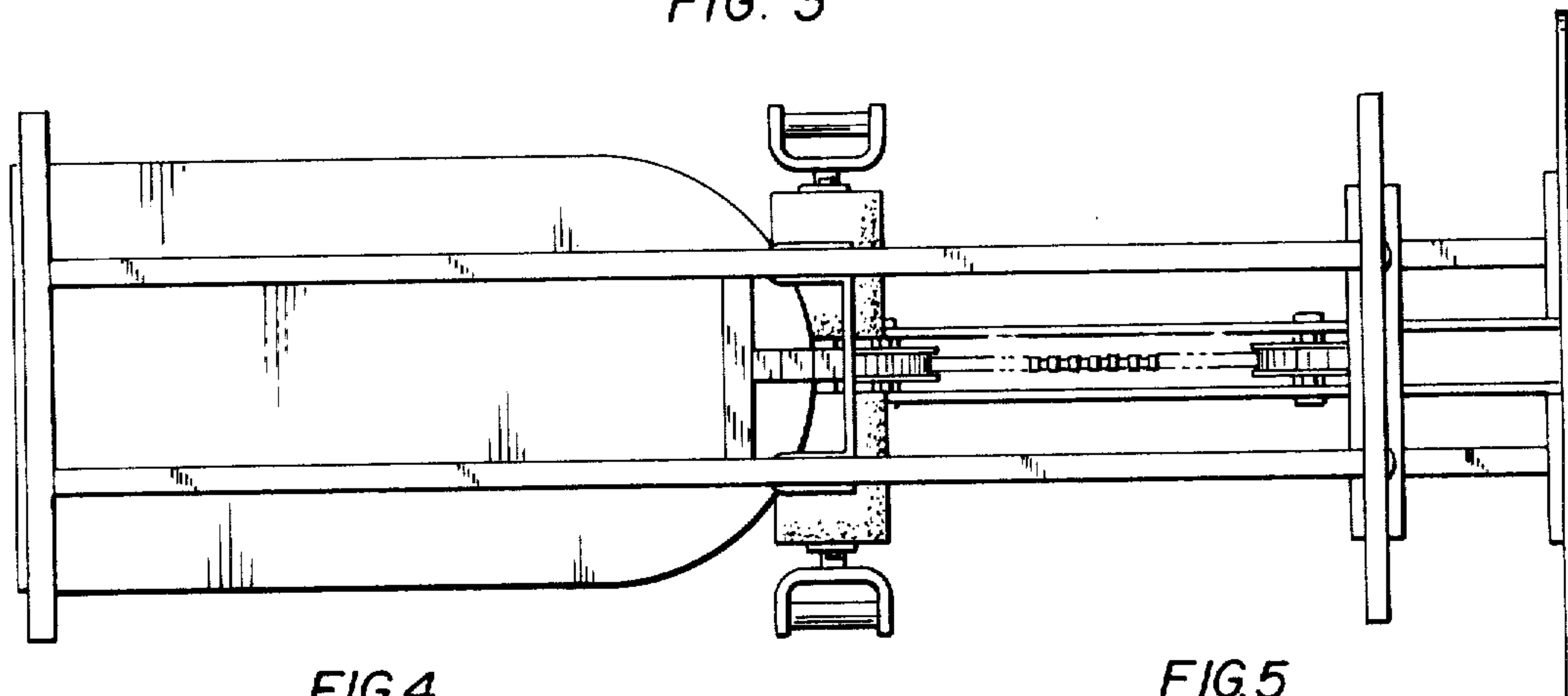

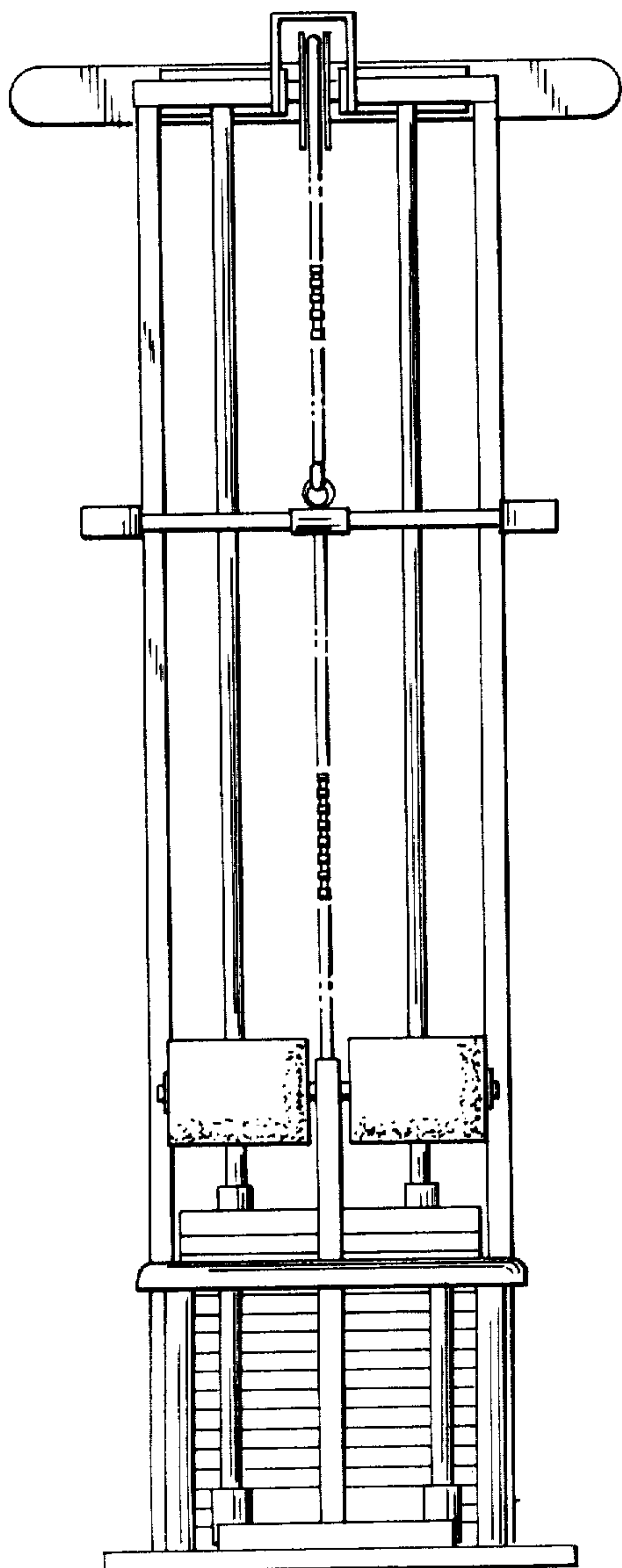
