The ornamental design for a midstream collection housing, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a midstream collection housing embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the housing of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the housing of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the housing of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the housing of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the housing of FIG. 1.
