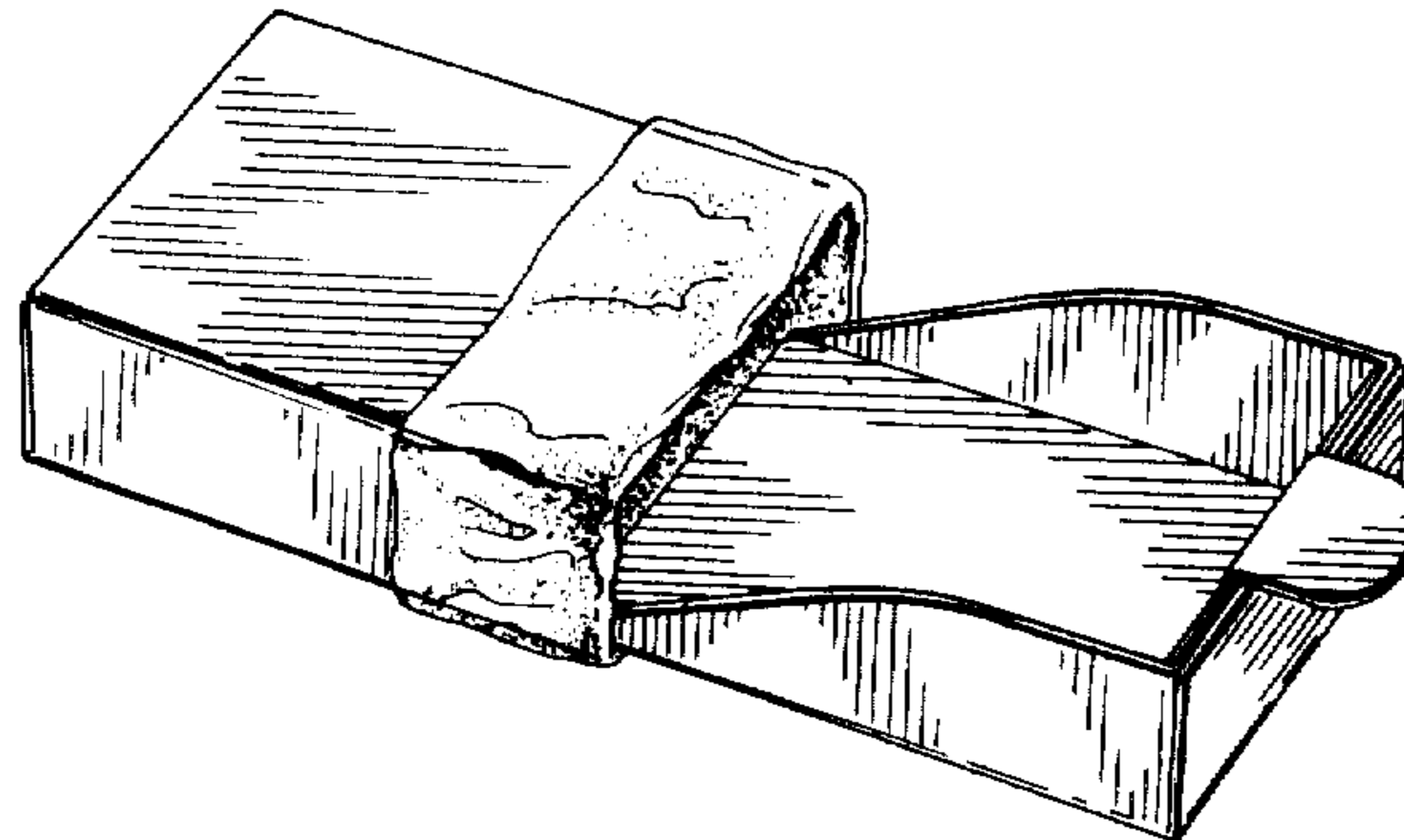

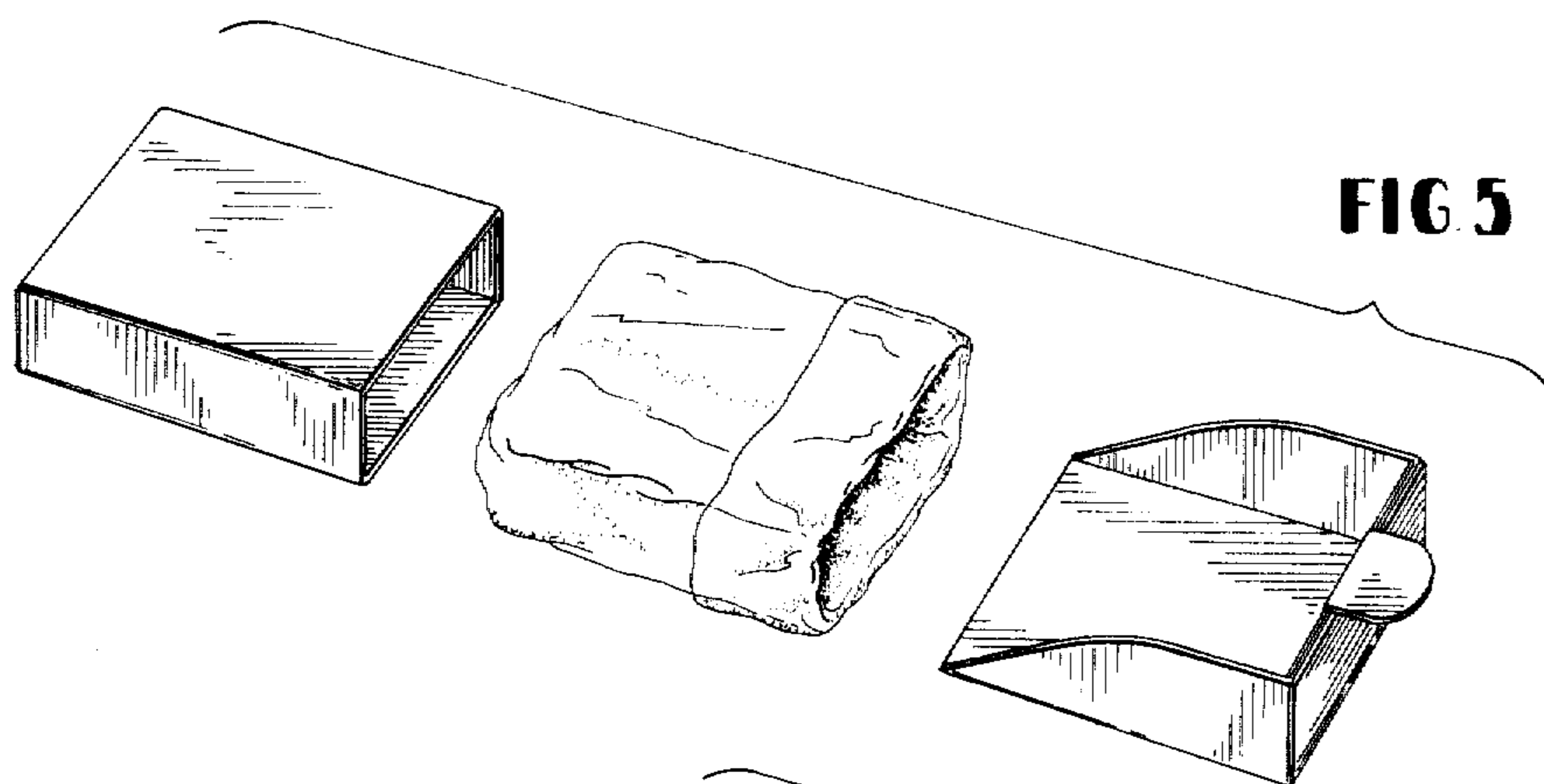
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined scoop and container for animal waste, as shown.

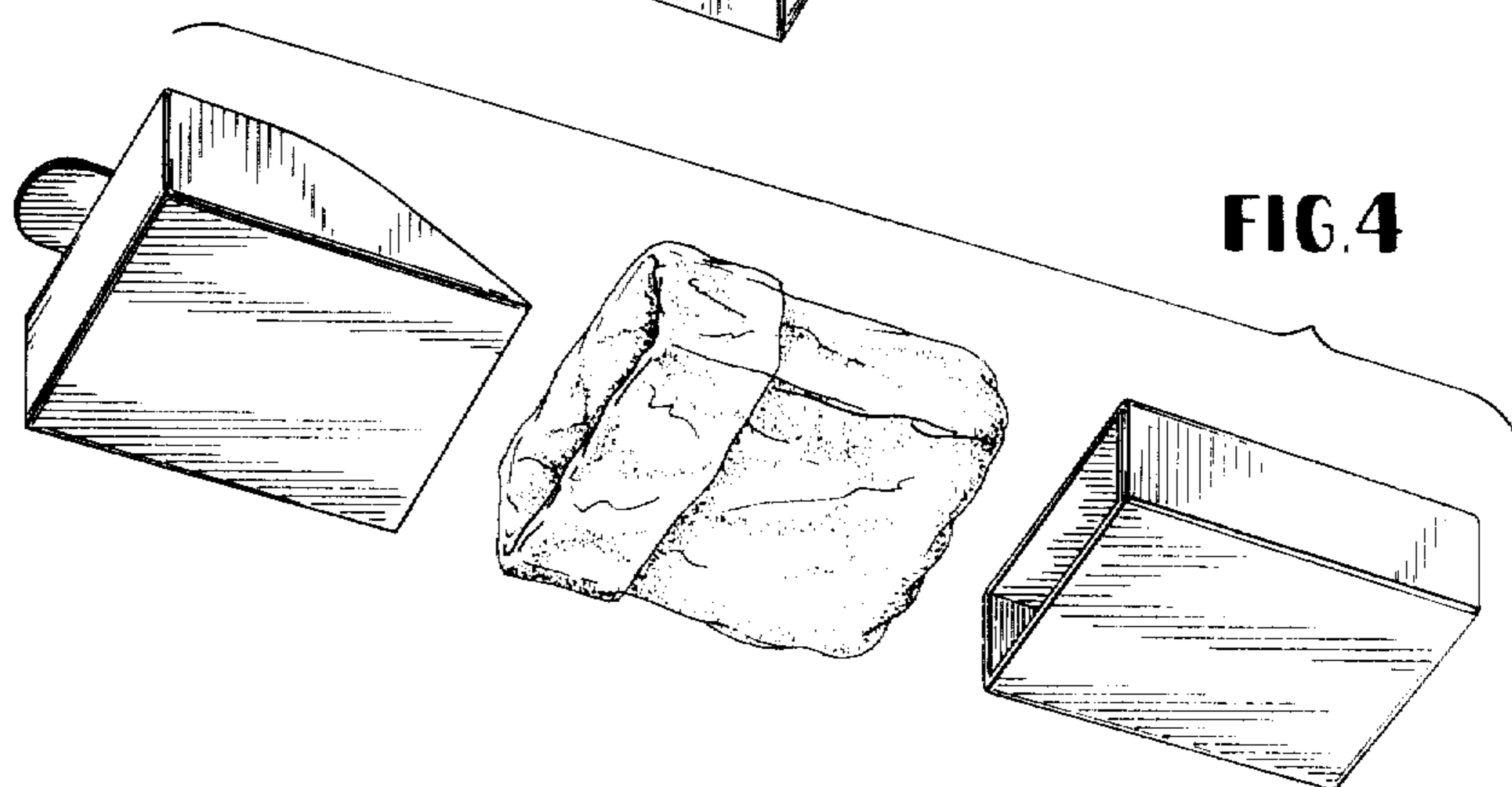
**DESCRIPTION**

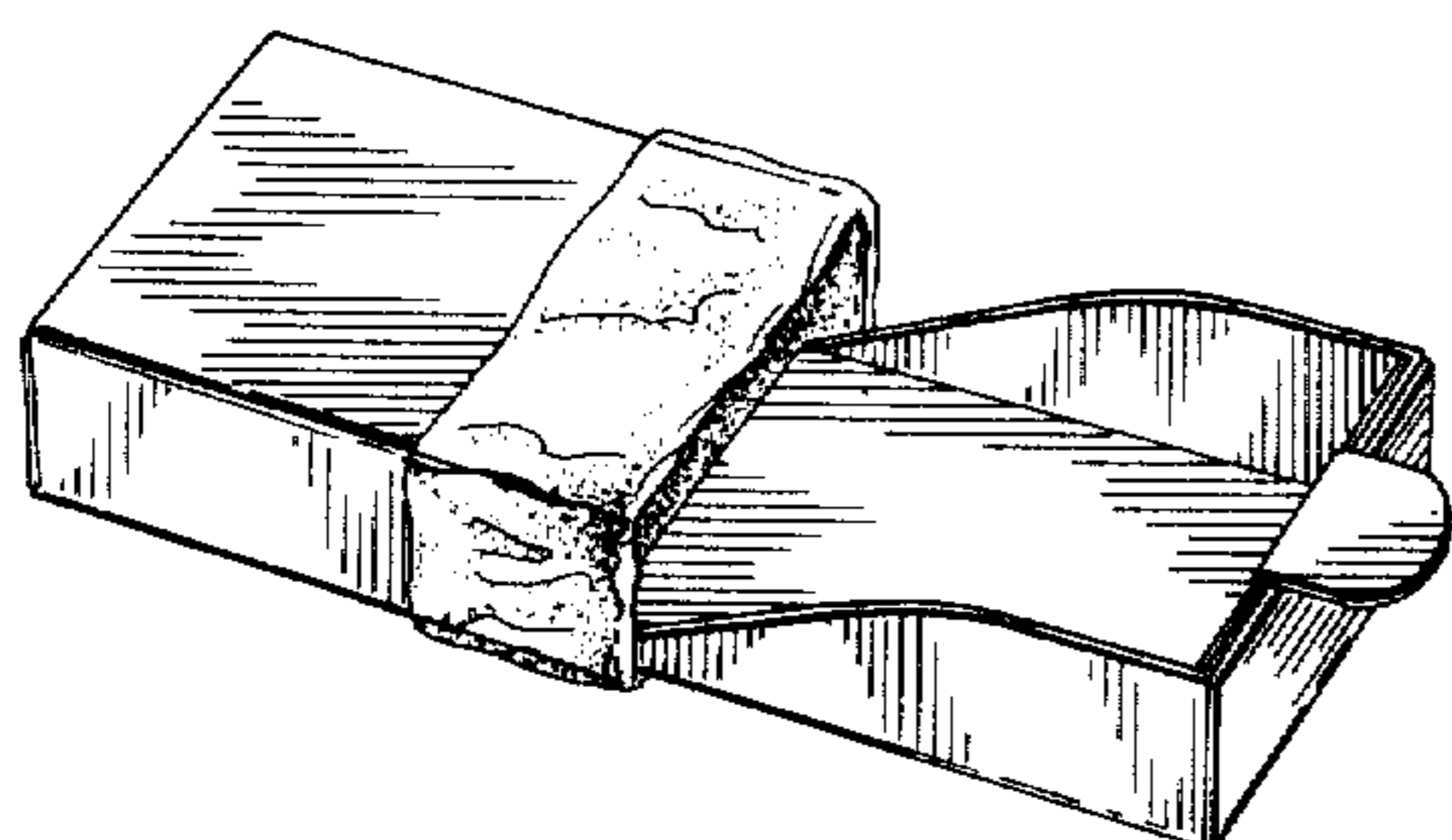

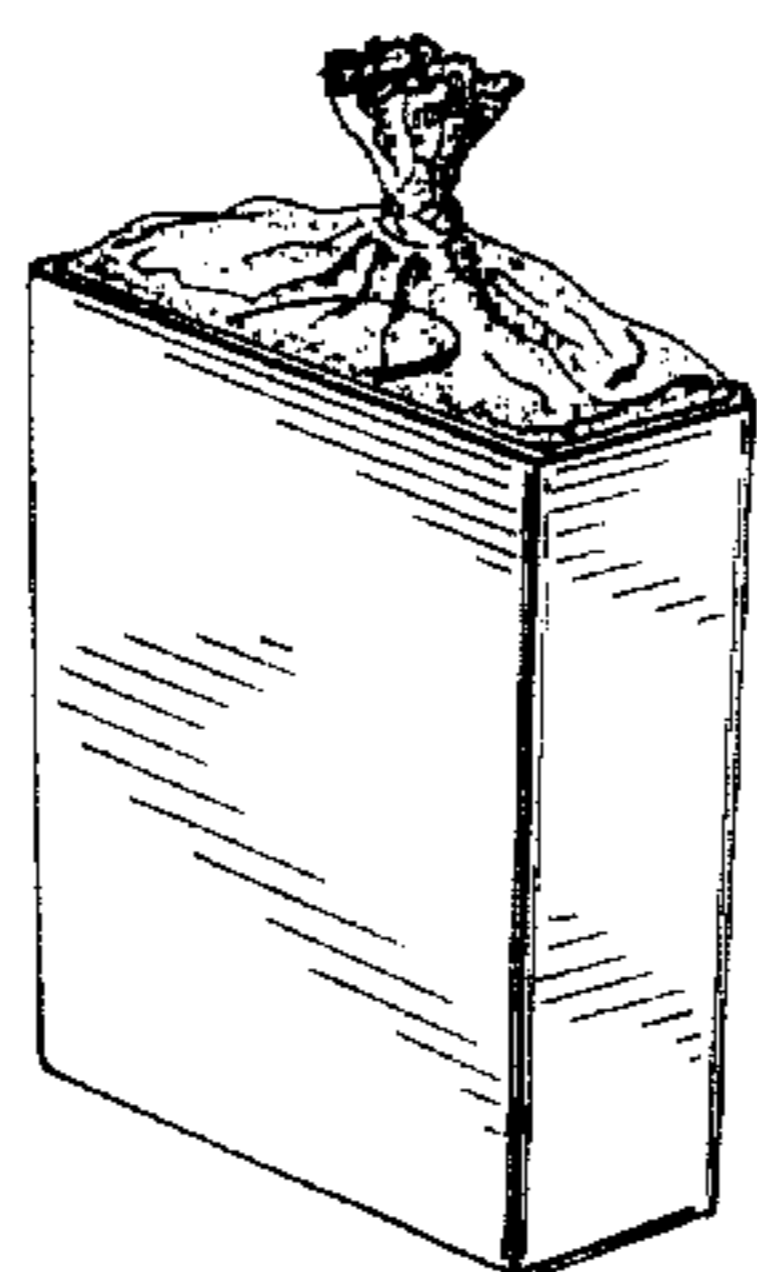
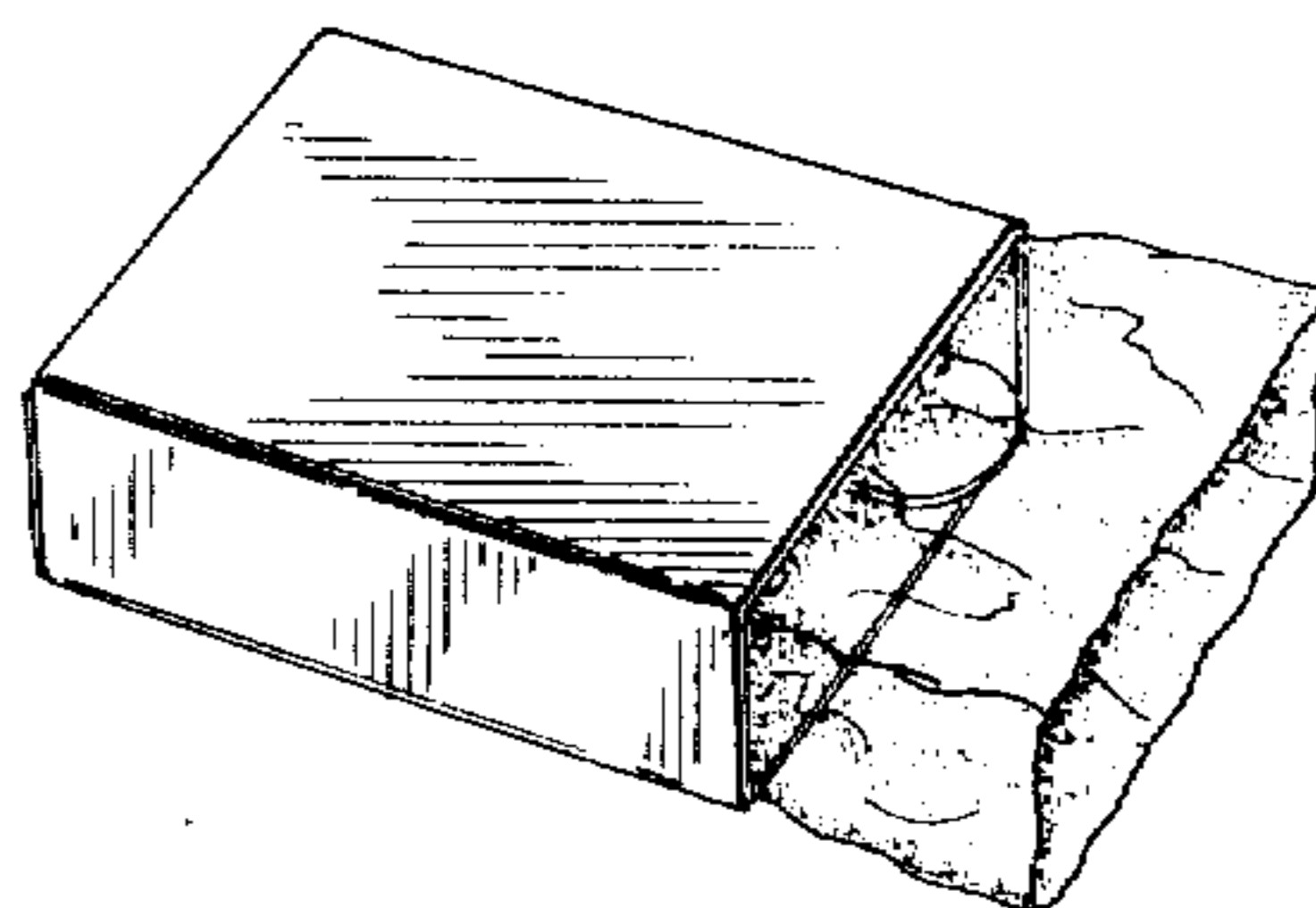
