FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a boat clock showing our new design;

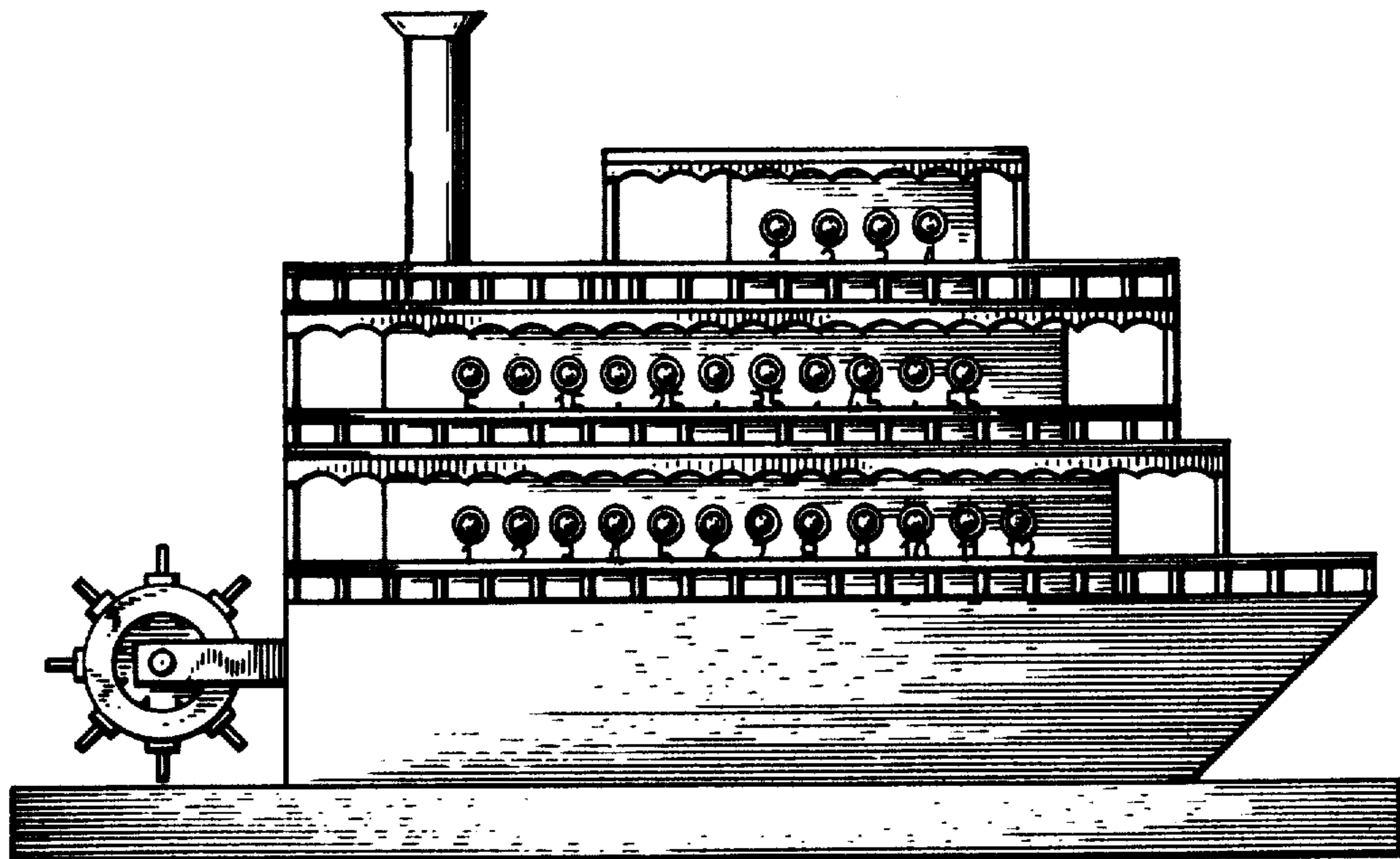
FIG. 2 is a right end elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.



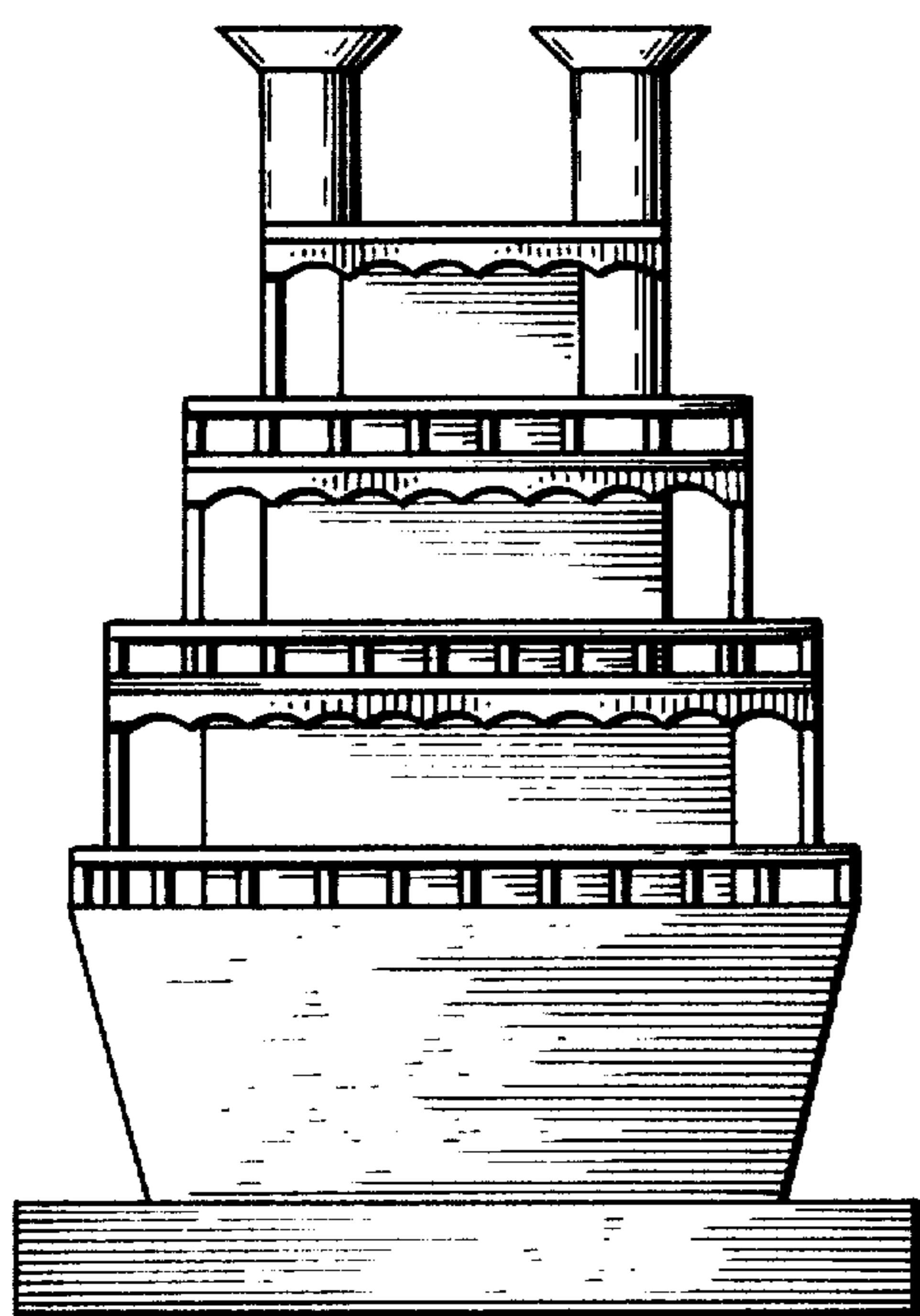
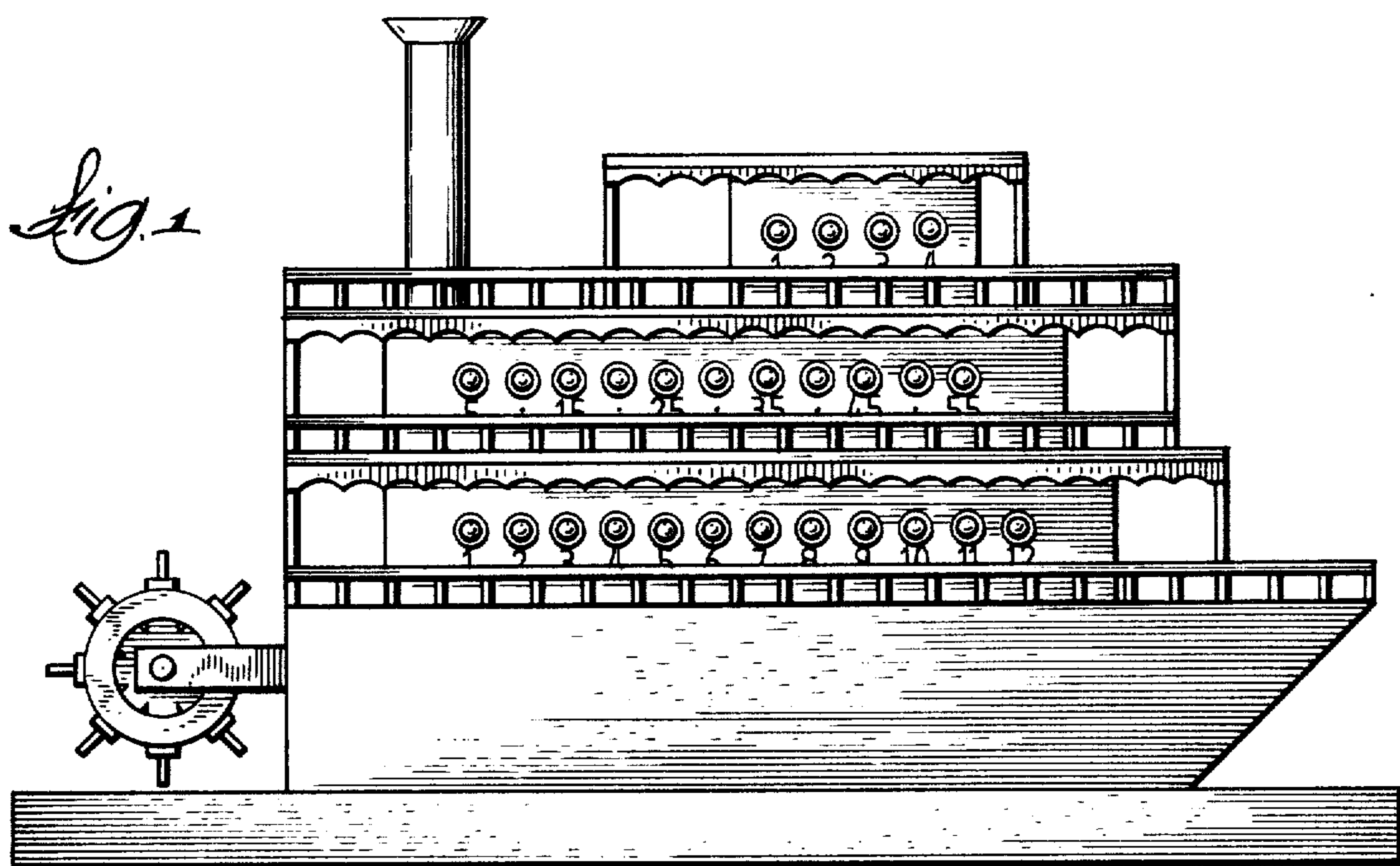

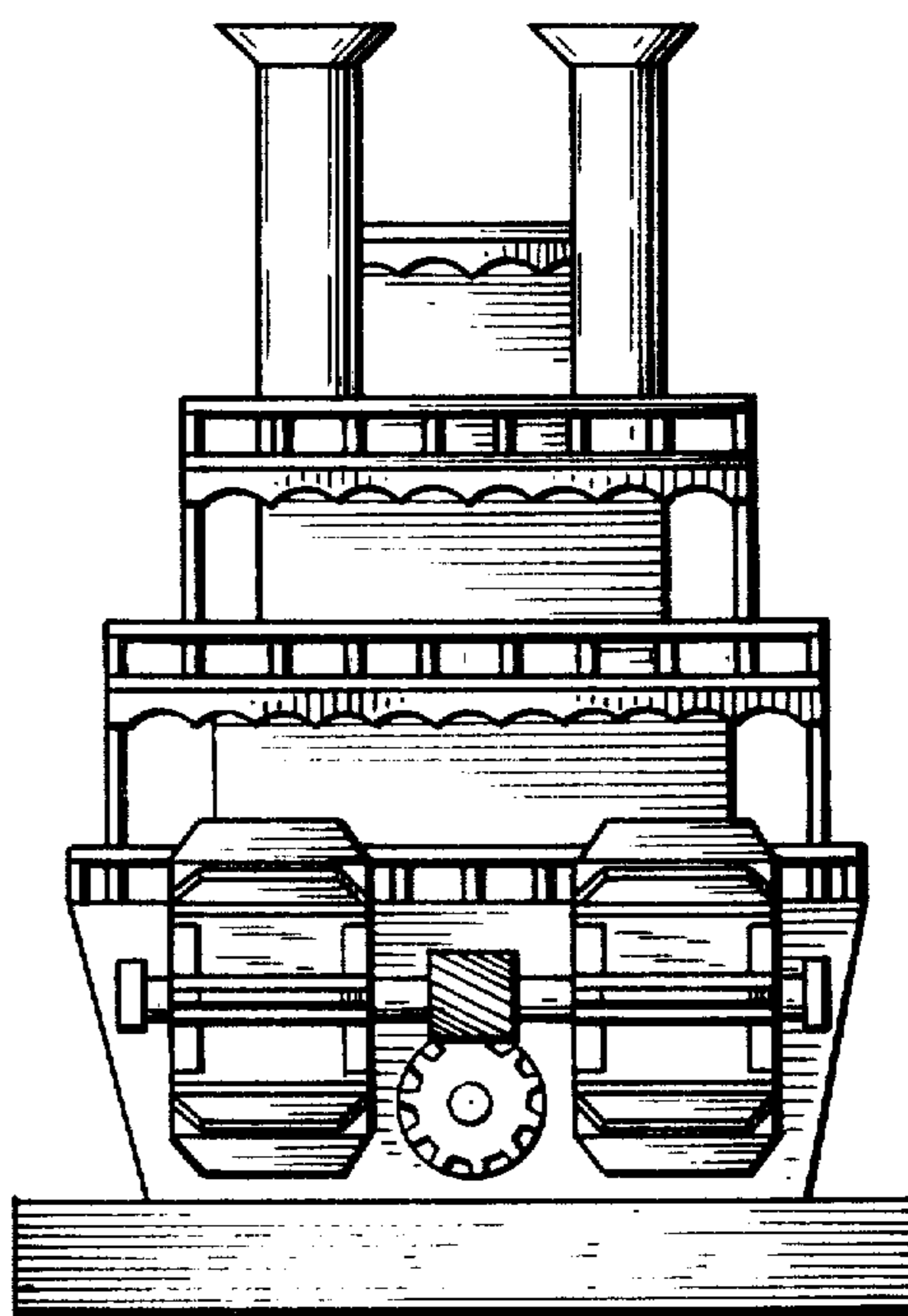
