FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof in the open position.

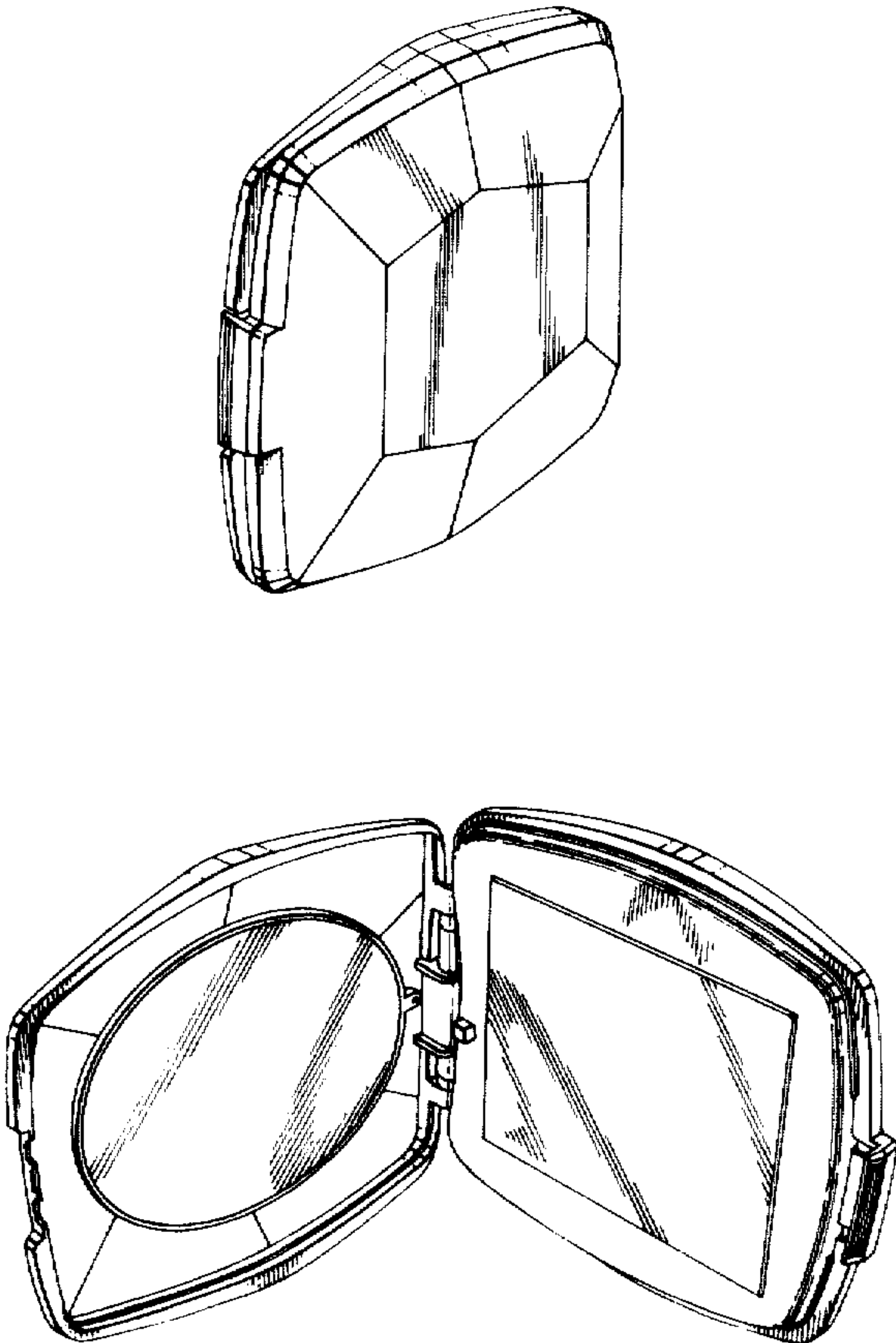

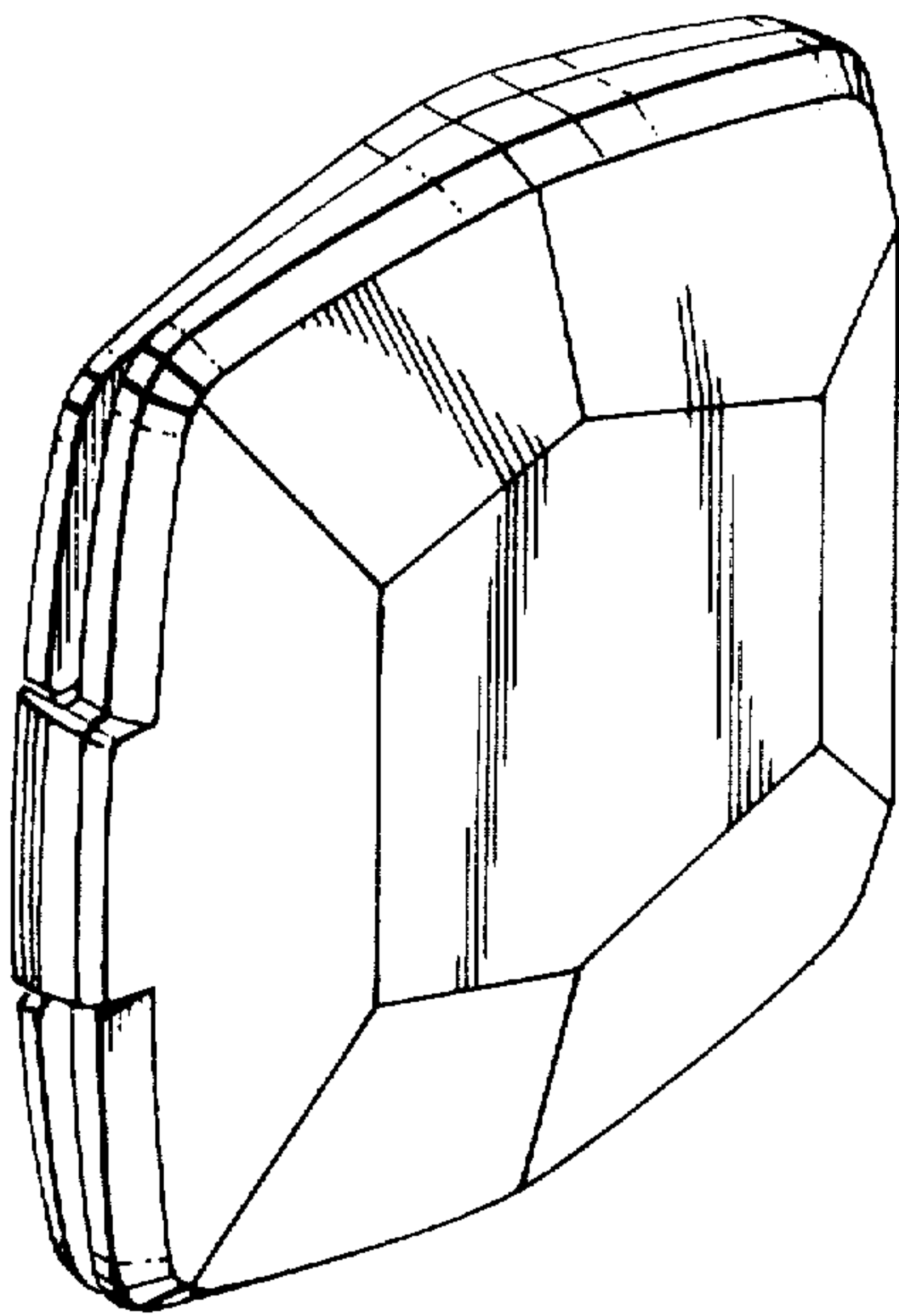

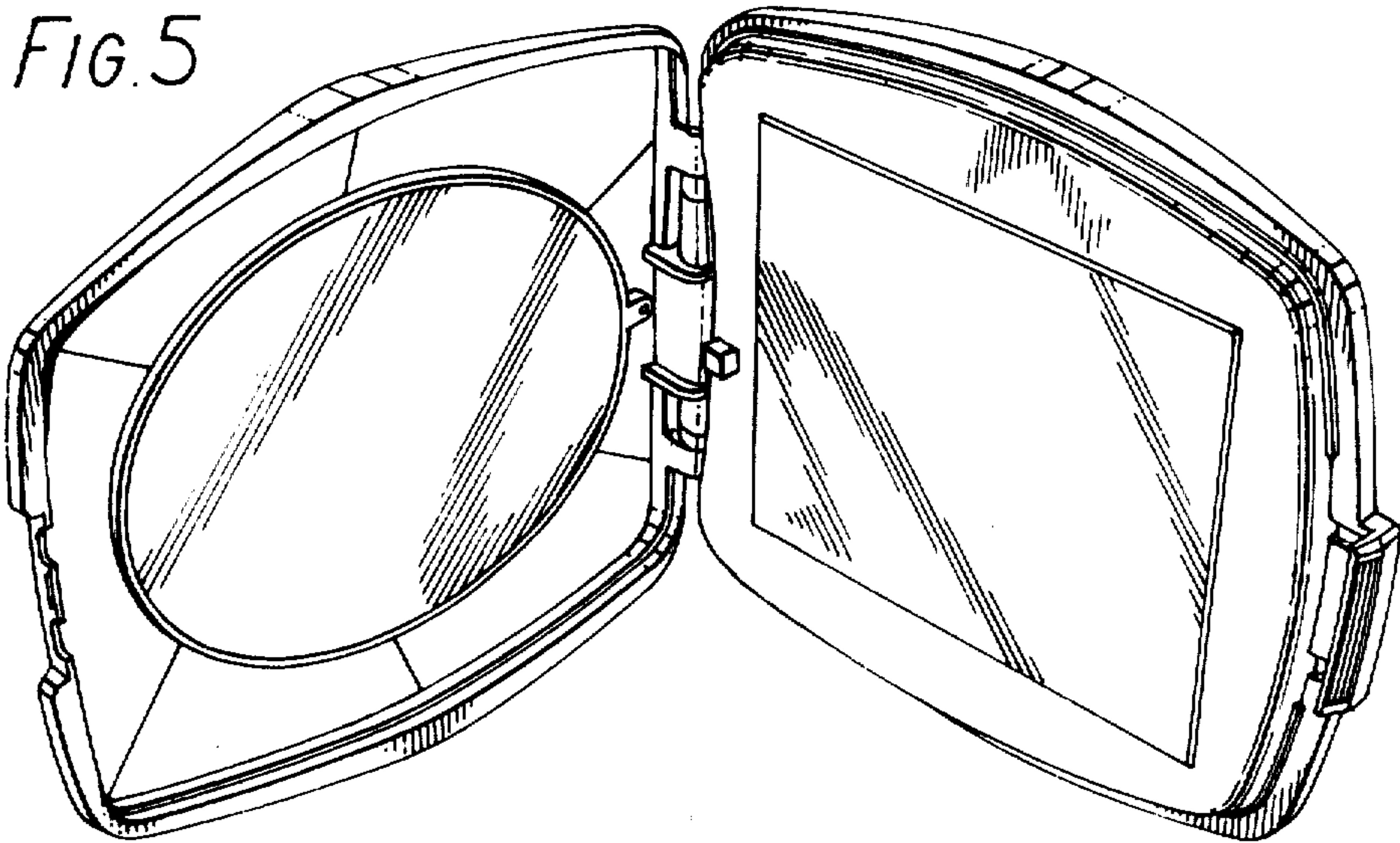

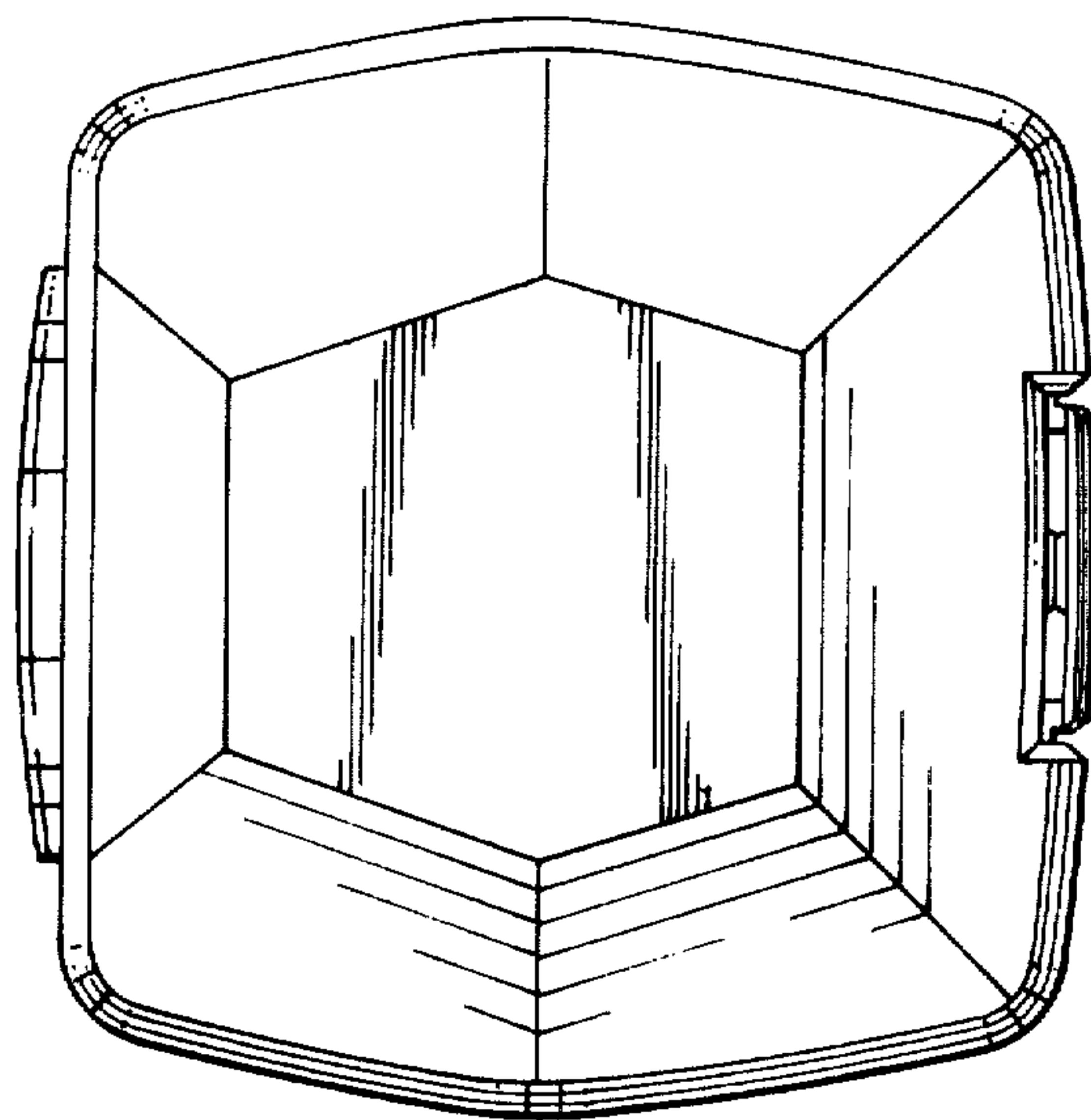
