DESCRIPTION

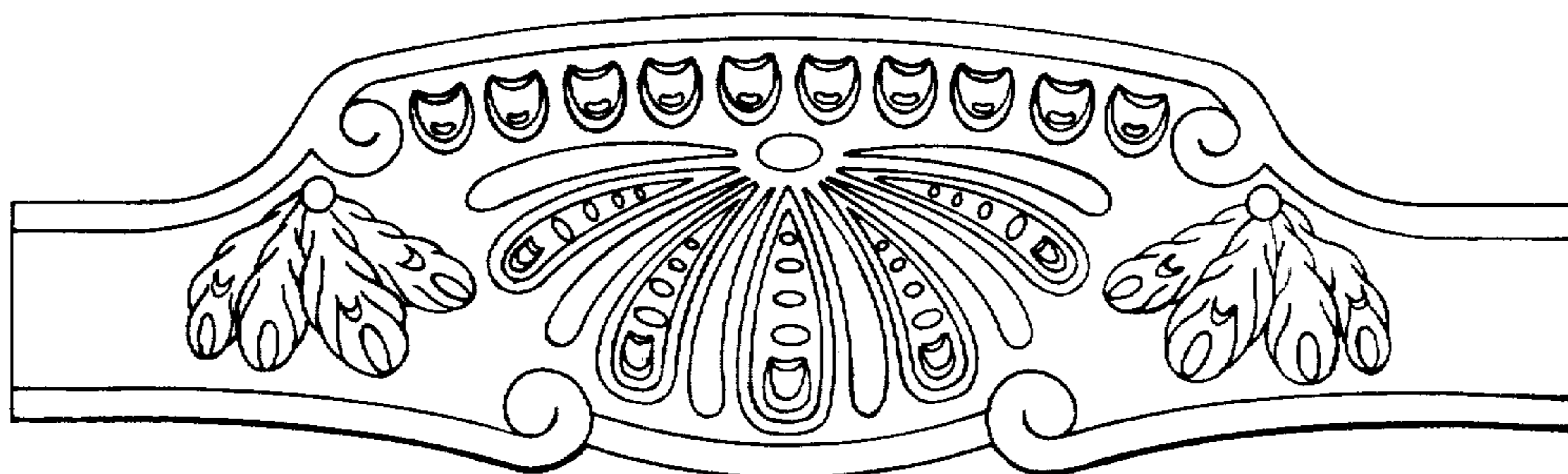
FIG. 1 is a front view of the panel for a chair back showing our new design.

The reverse side of the panel is plain and unornamented.



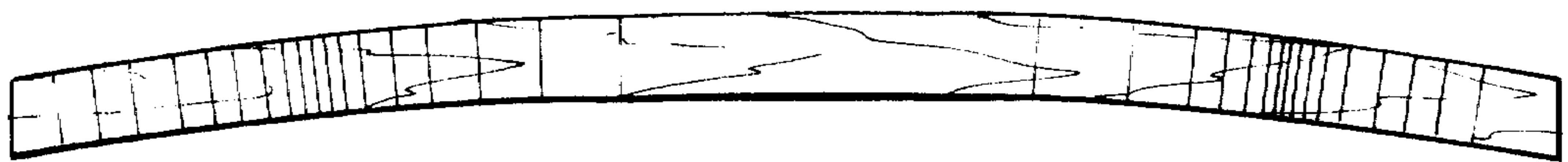

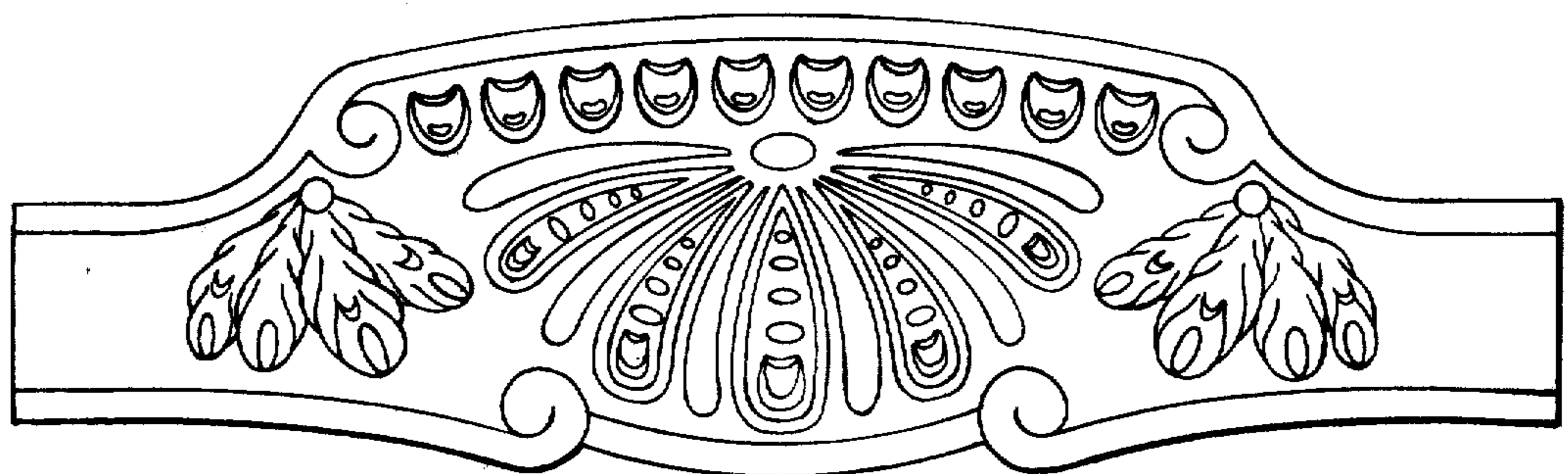

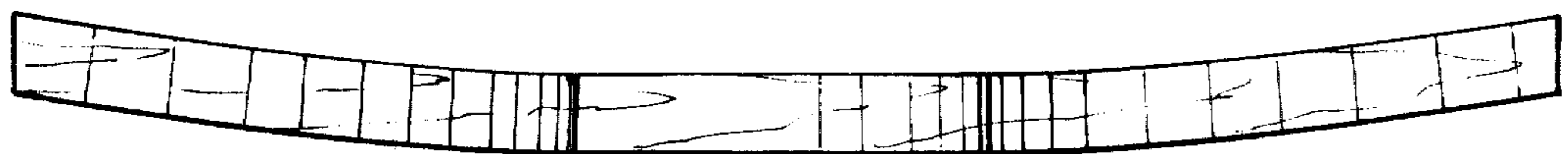

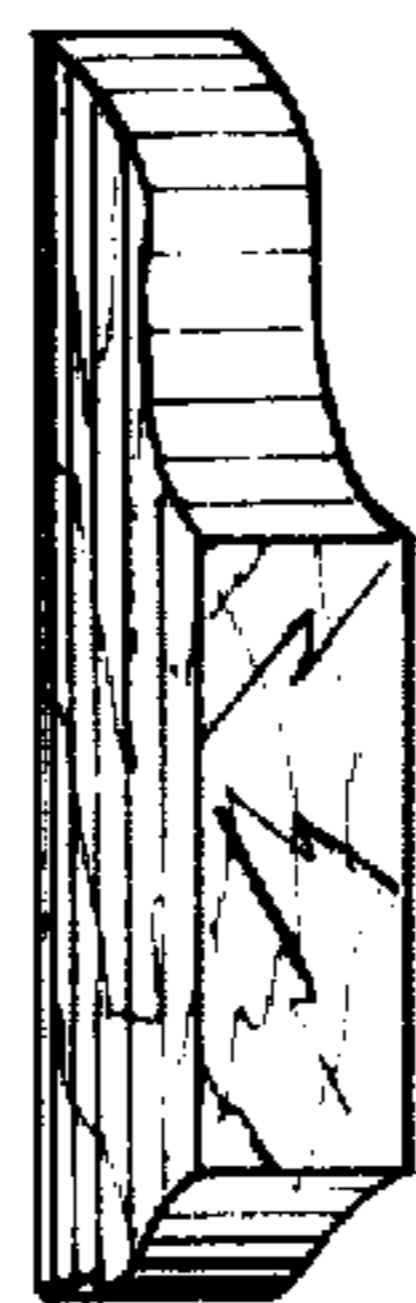
