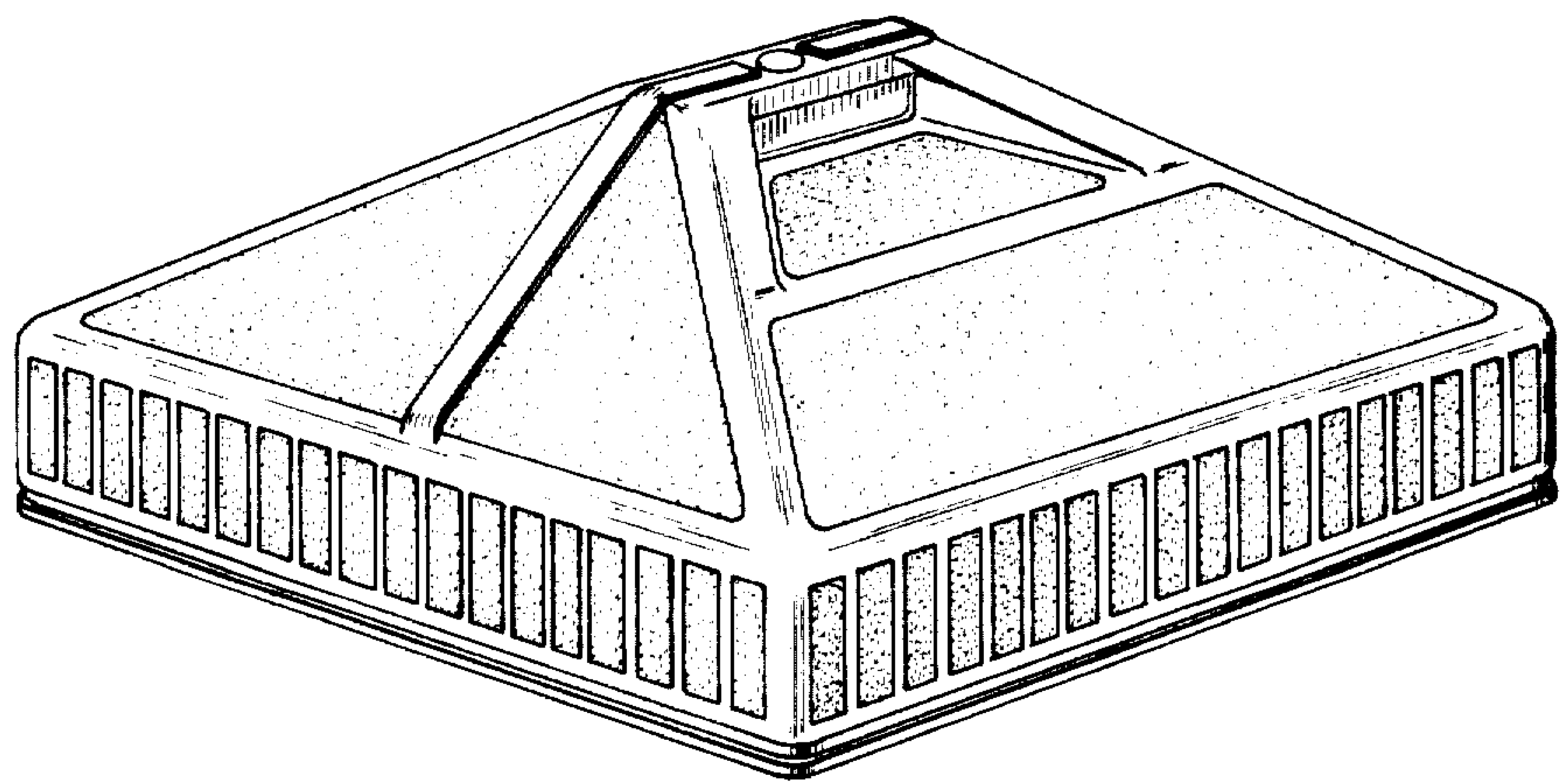
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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a trash can cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a trash can cover showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a reduced scale front elevational view thereof; the rear elevational view being substantially similar thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right end elevational view thereof; the left end elevational view being substantially similar thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a partial sectional view taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 2.



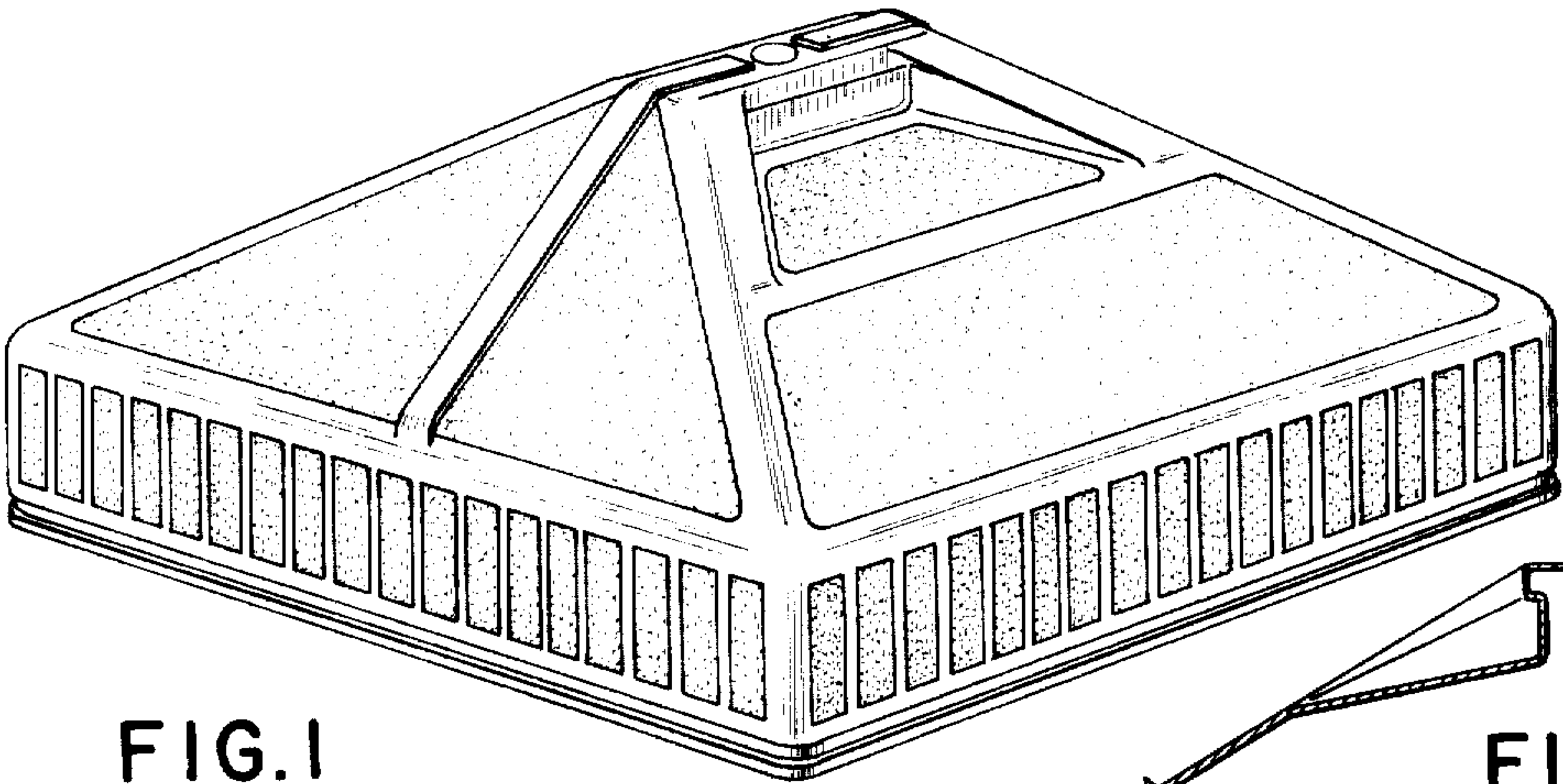

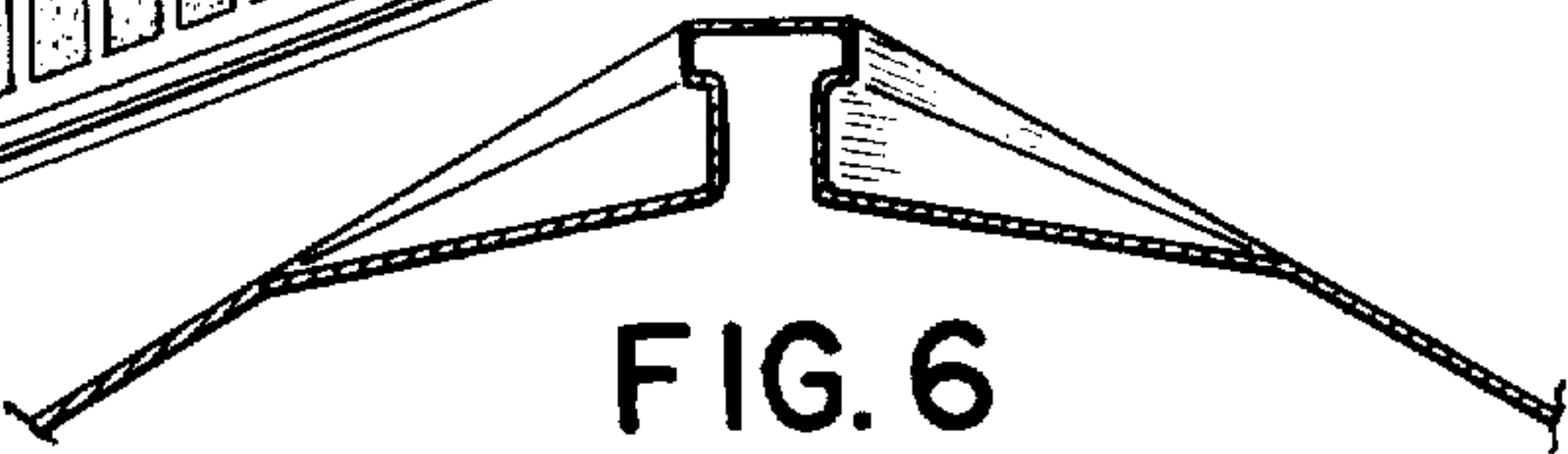

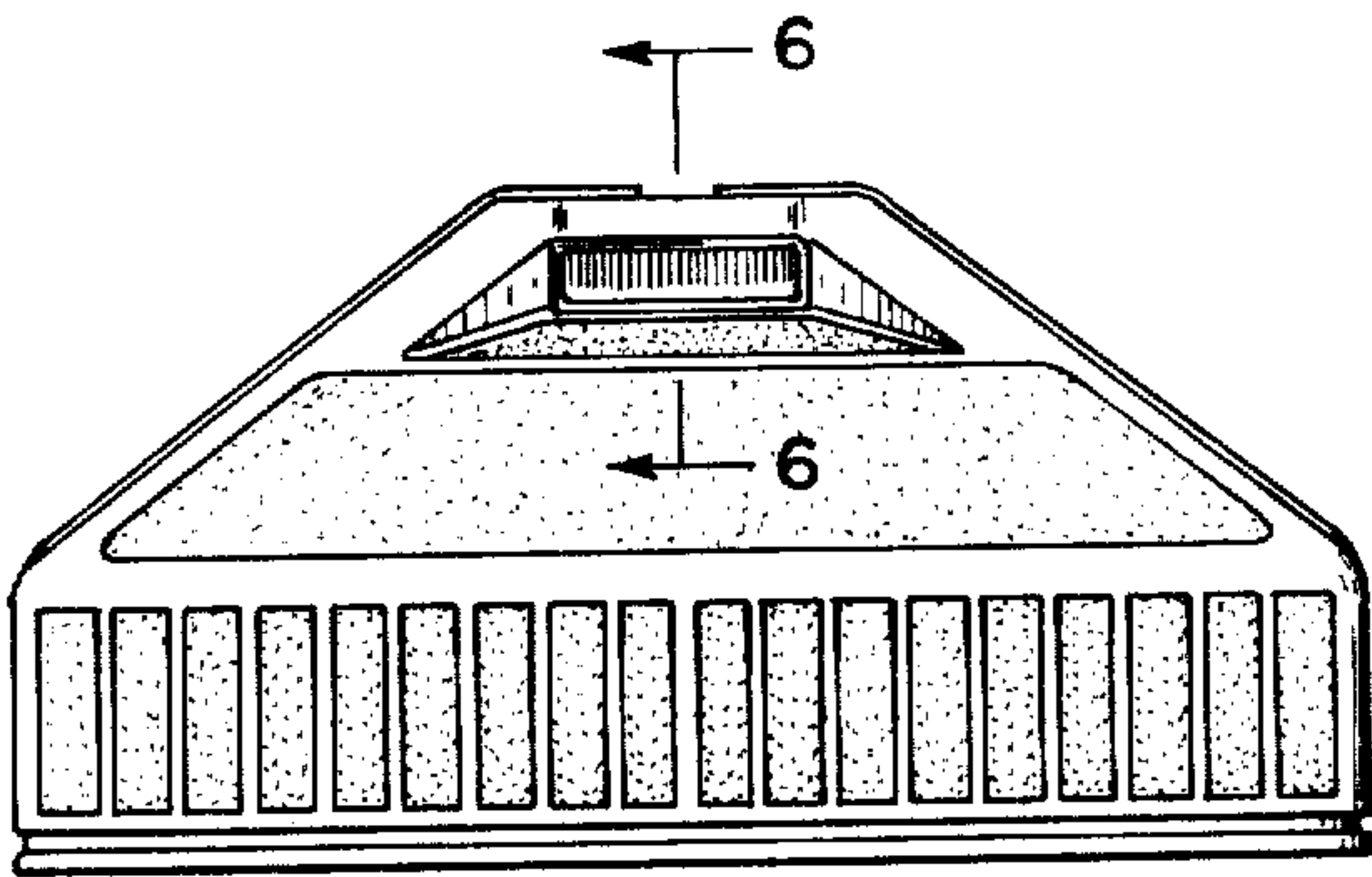

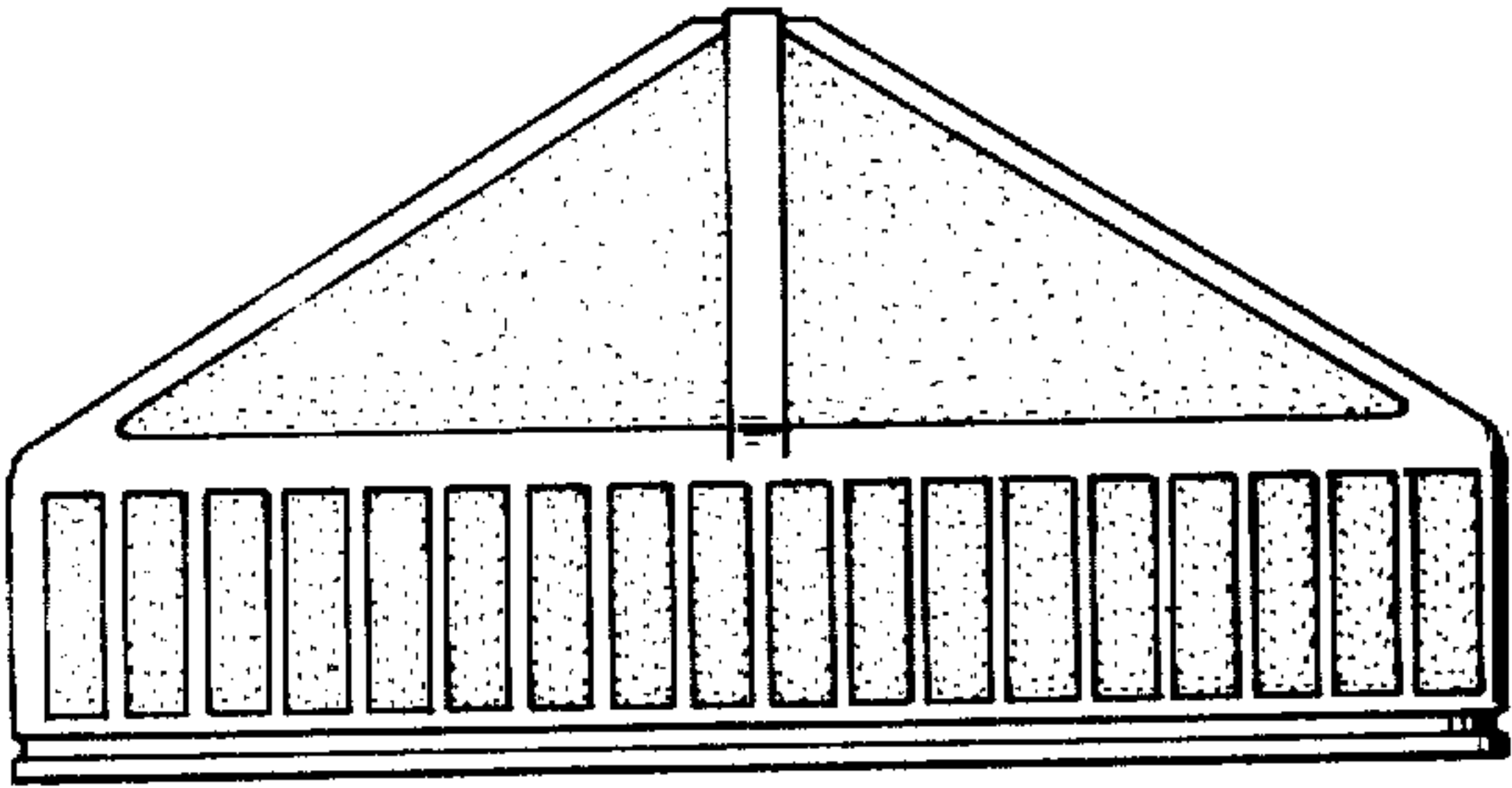

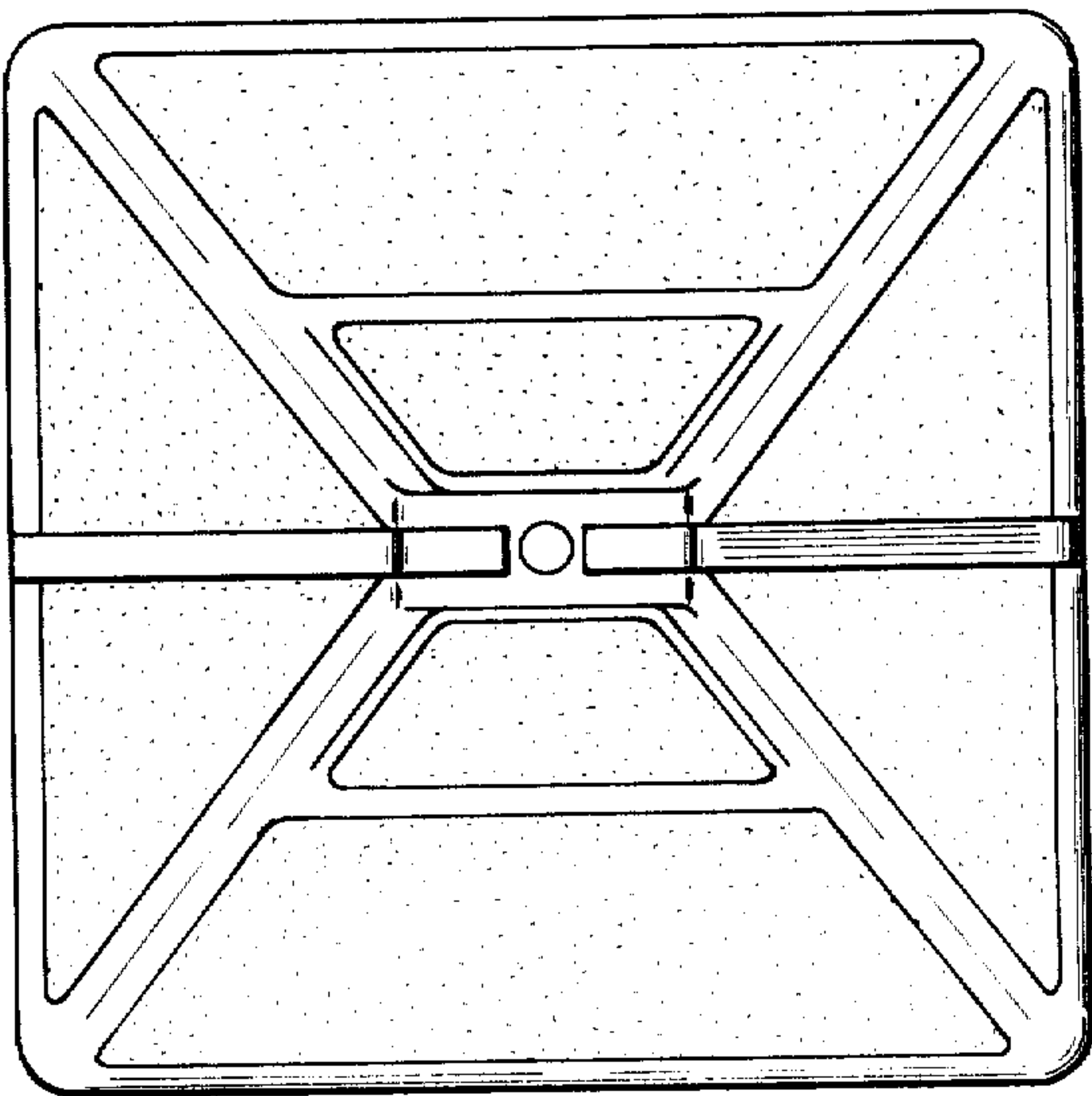

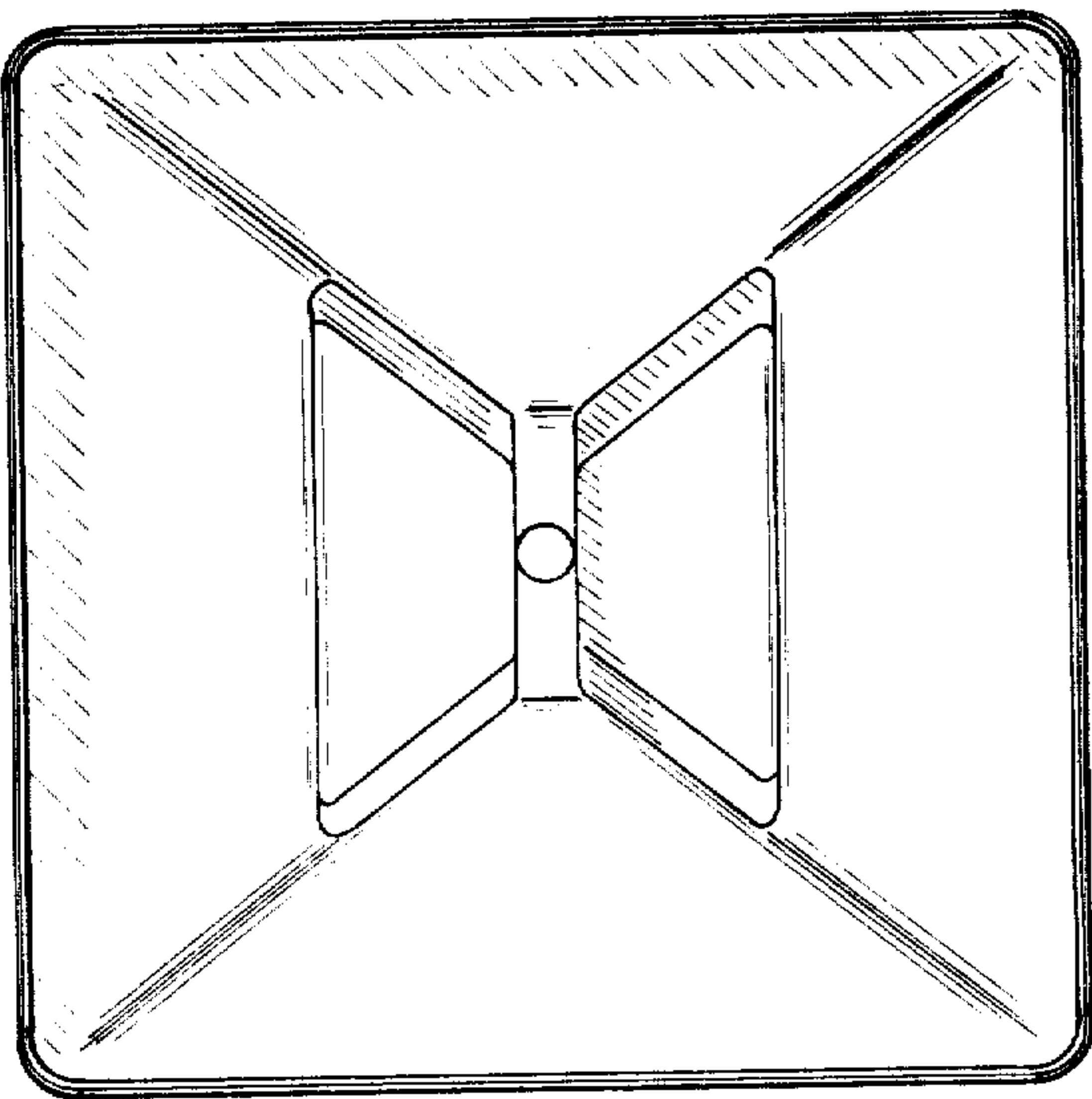
