[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined toy bear and cage charm, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined toy bear and cage charm, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view as viewed from the right in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view as viewed from the left in FIG. 1;

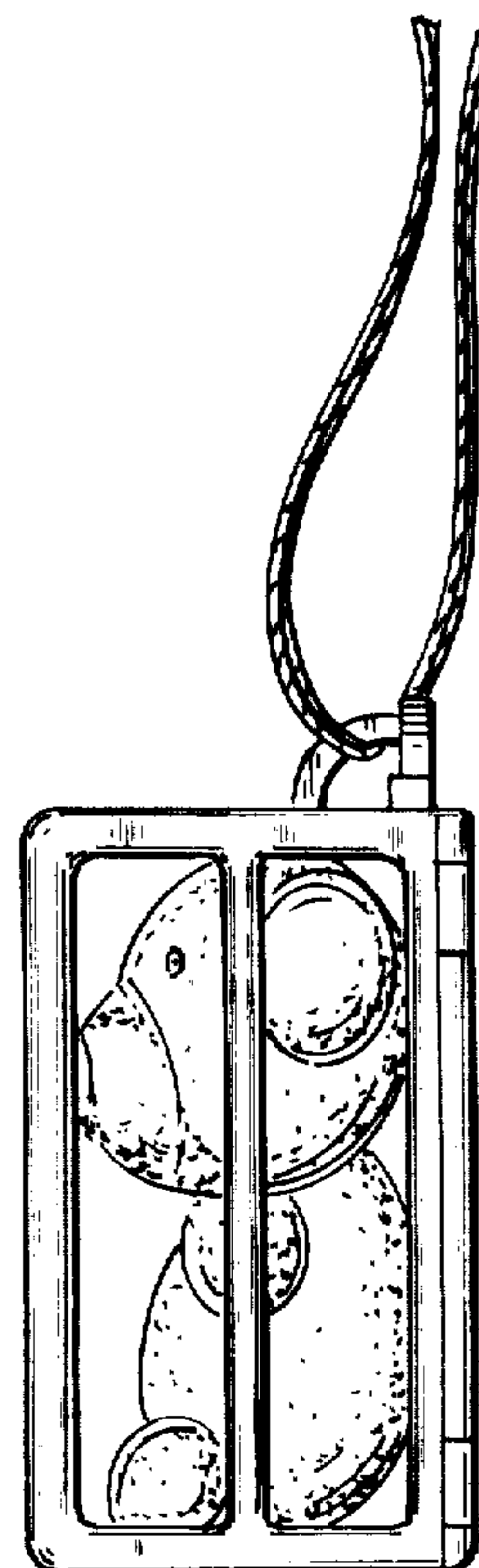
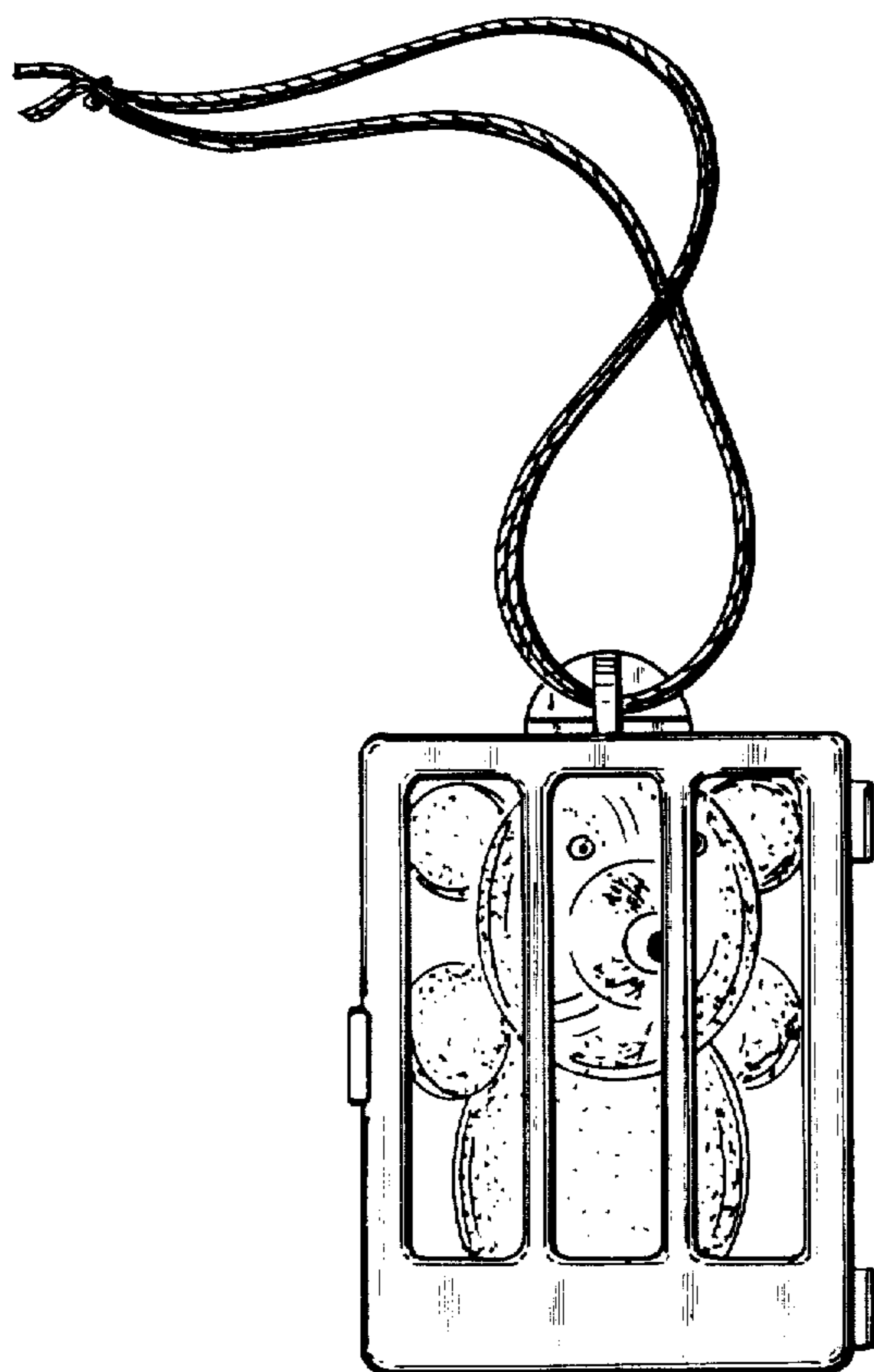
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

The cord is shown only partially in FIGS. 2-5 and 7 for ease of illustration.



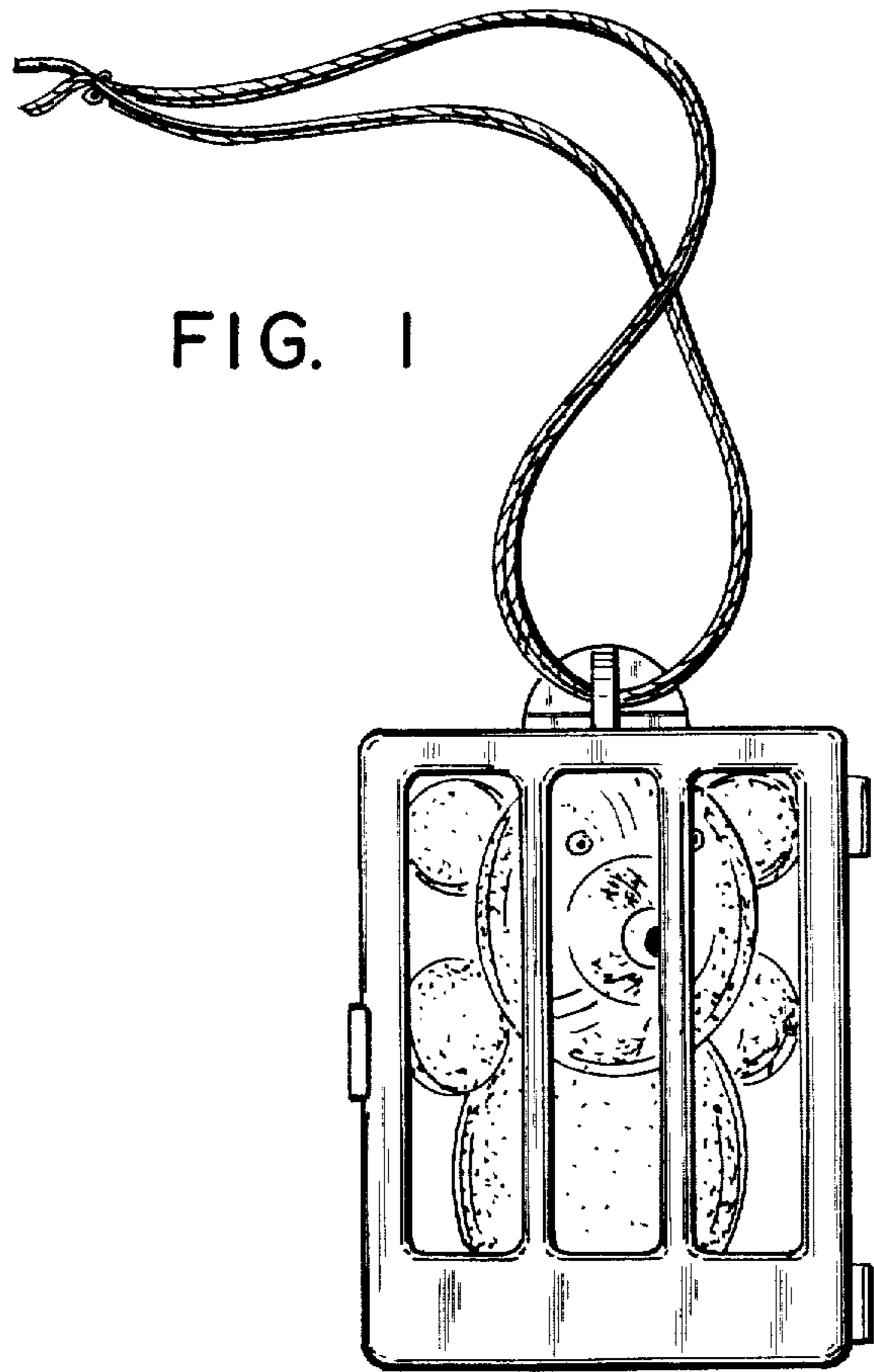

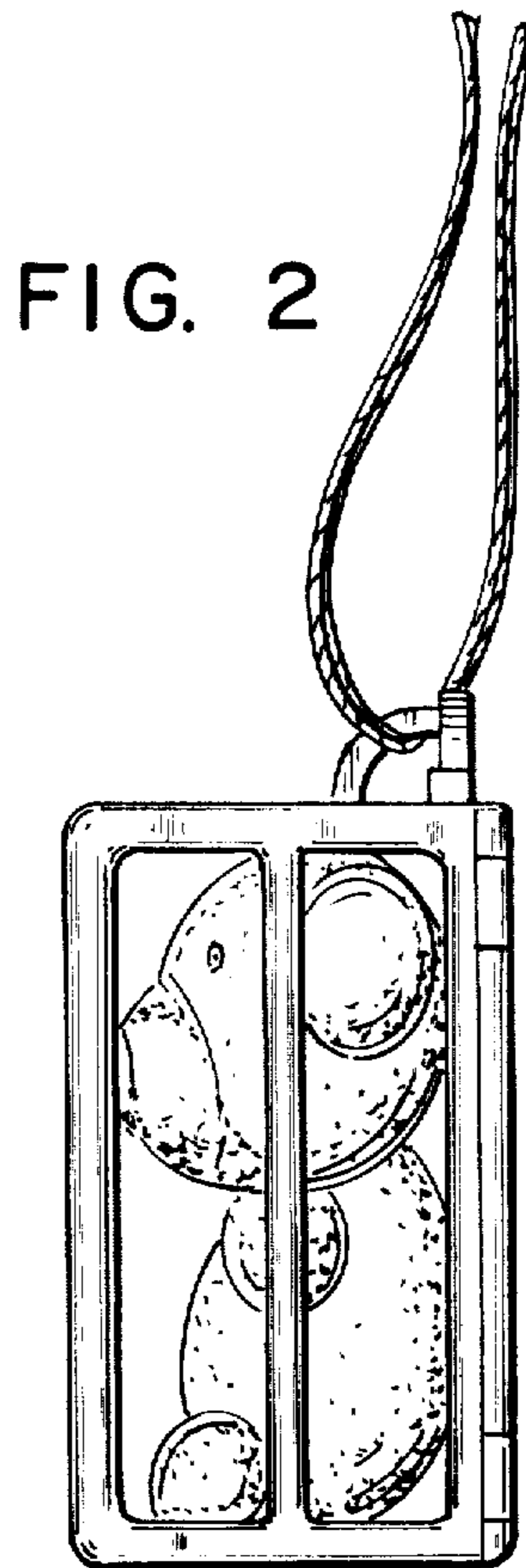

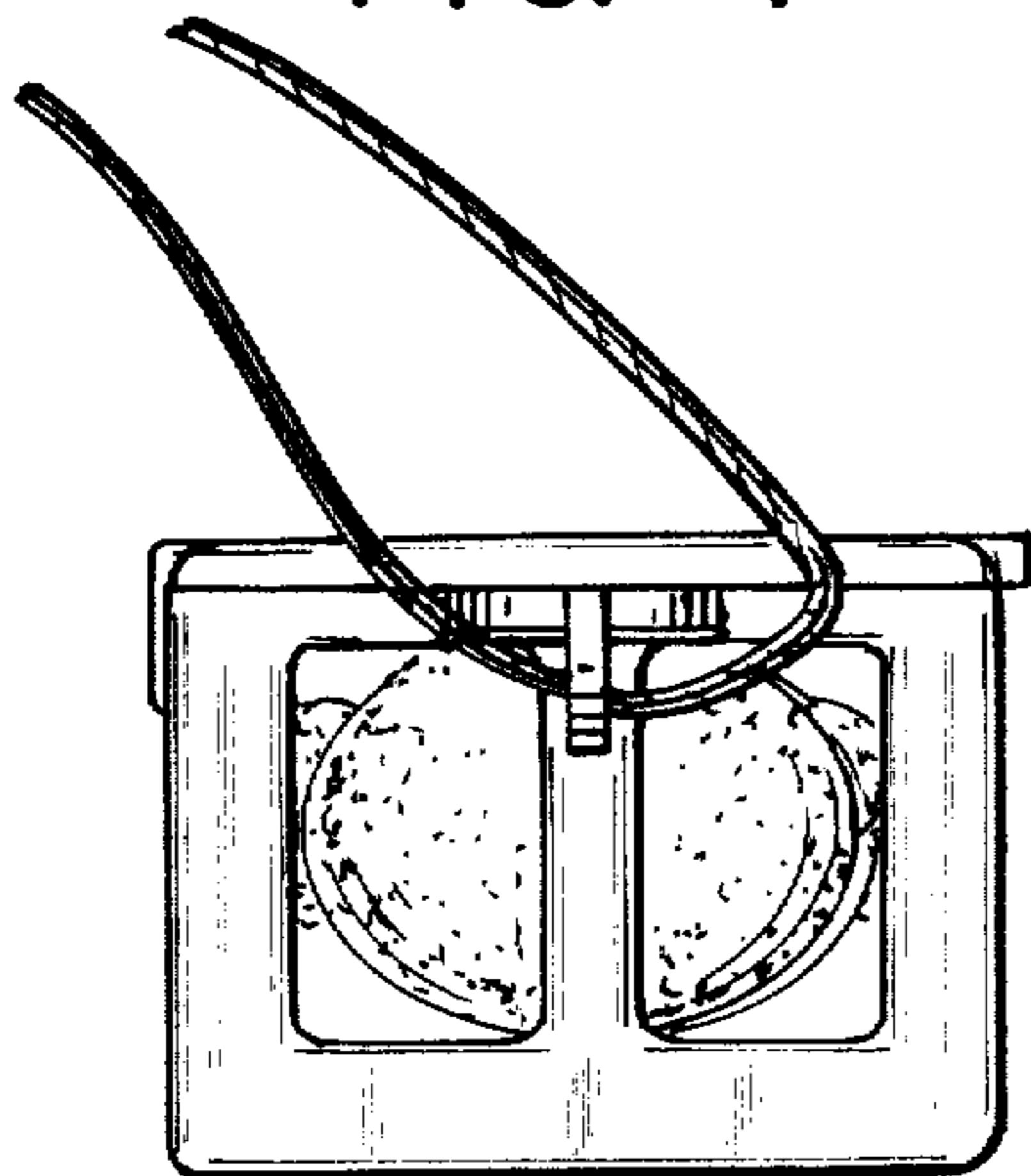

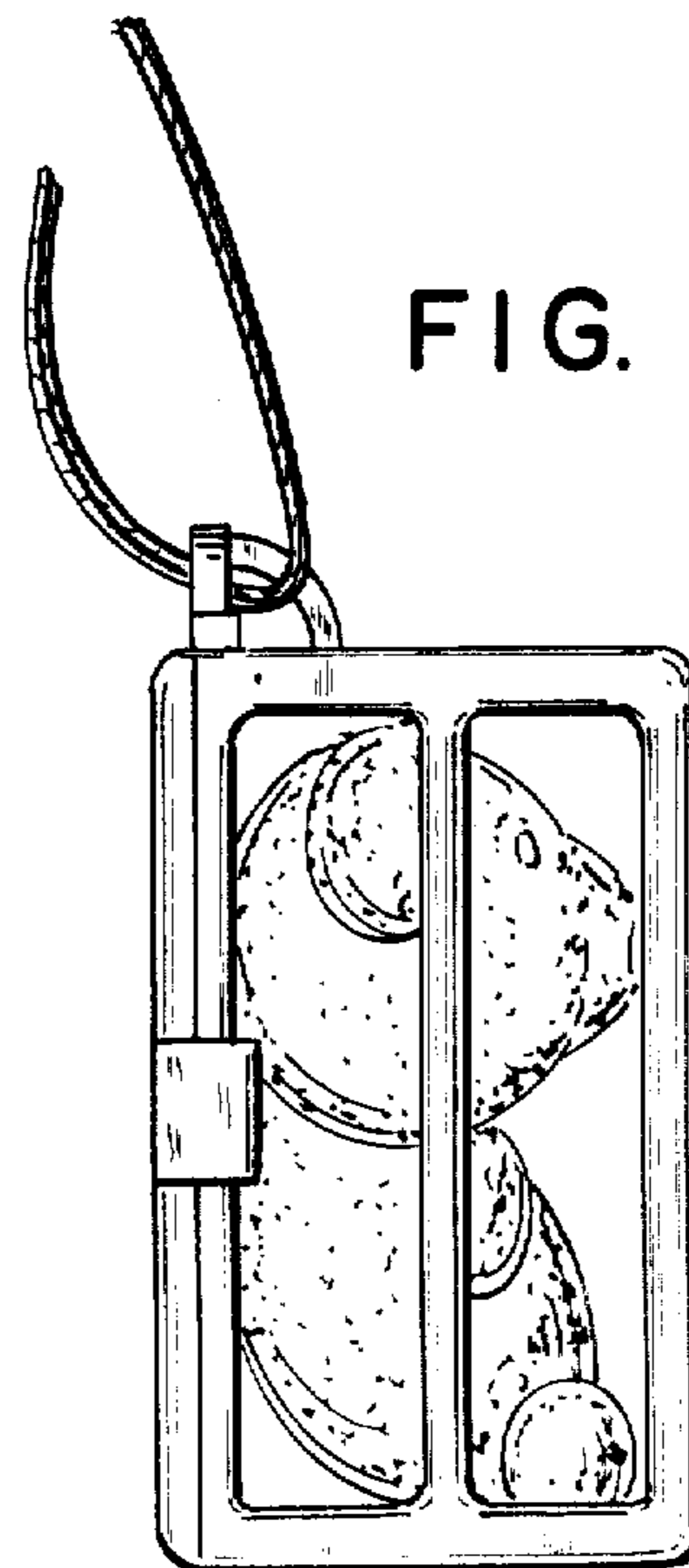

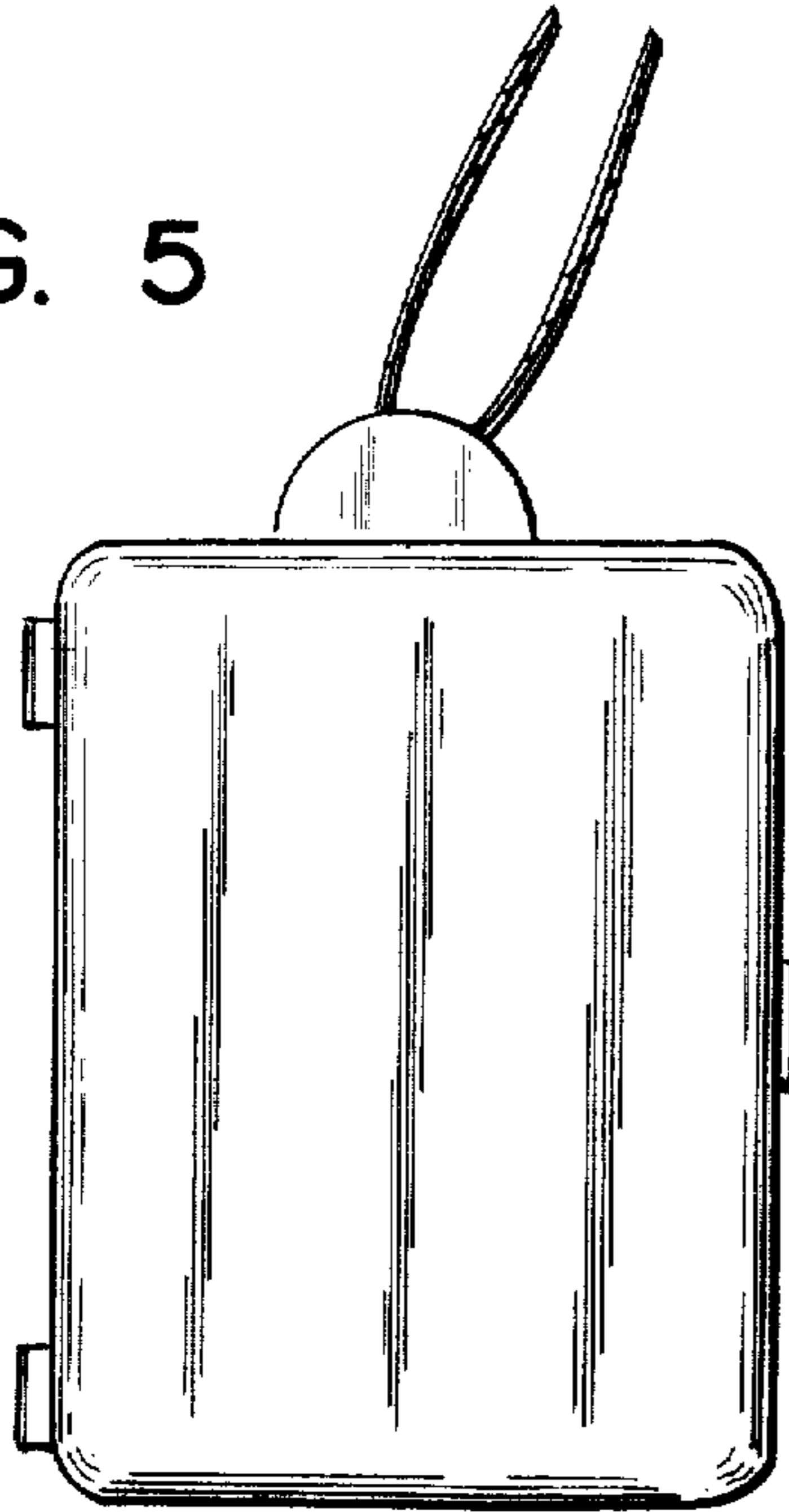

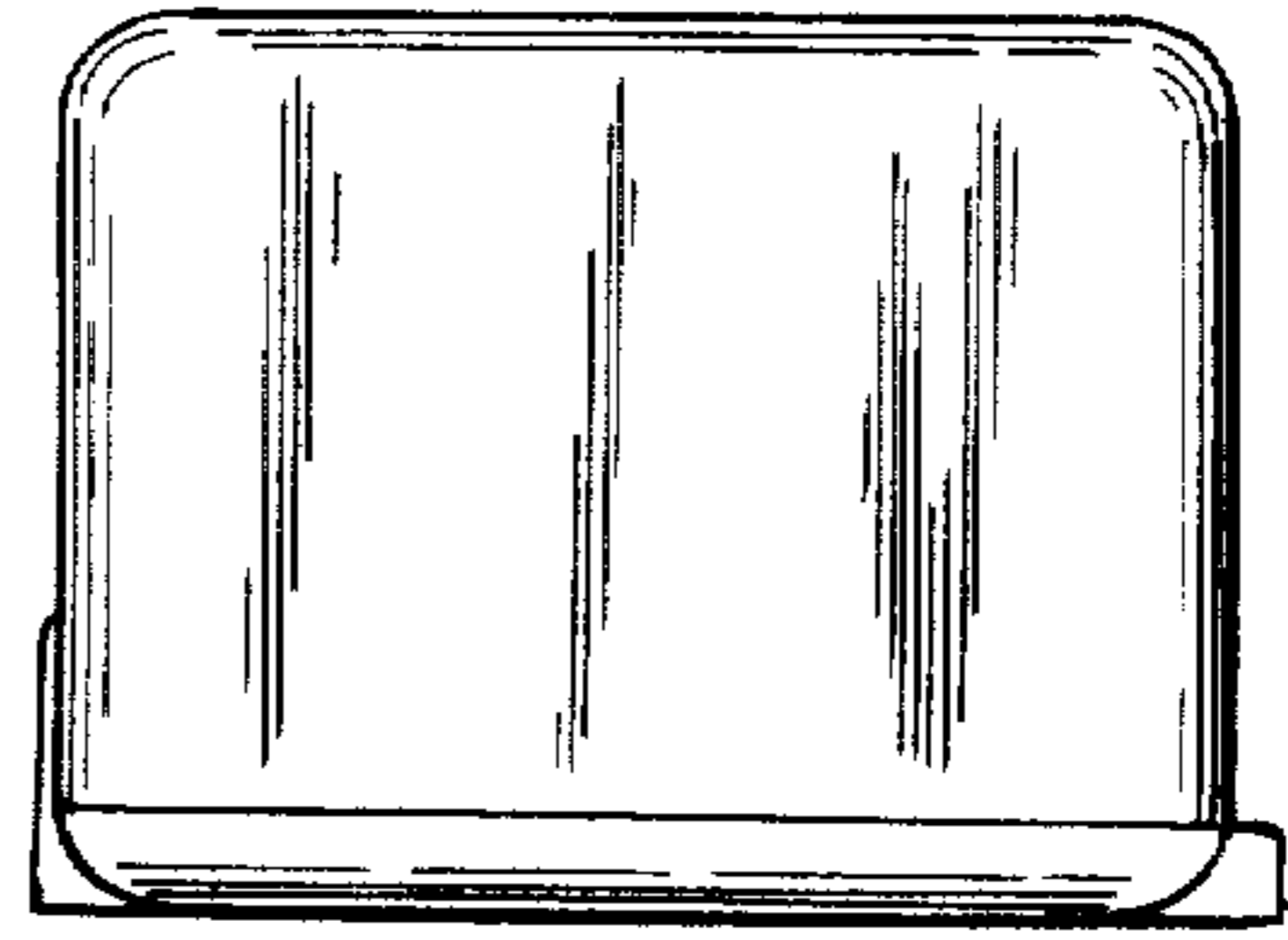
