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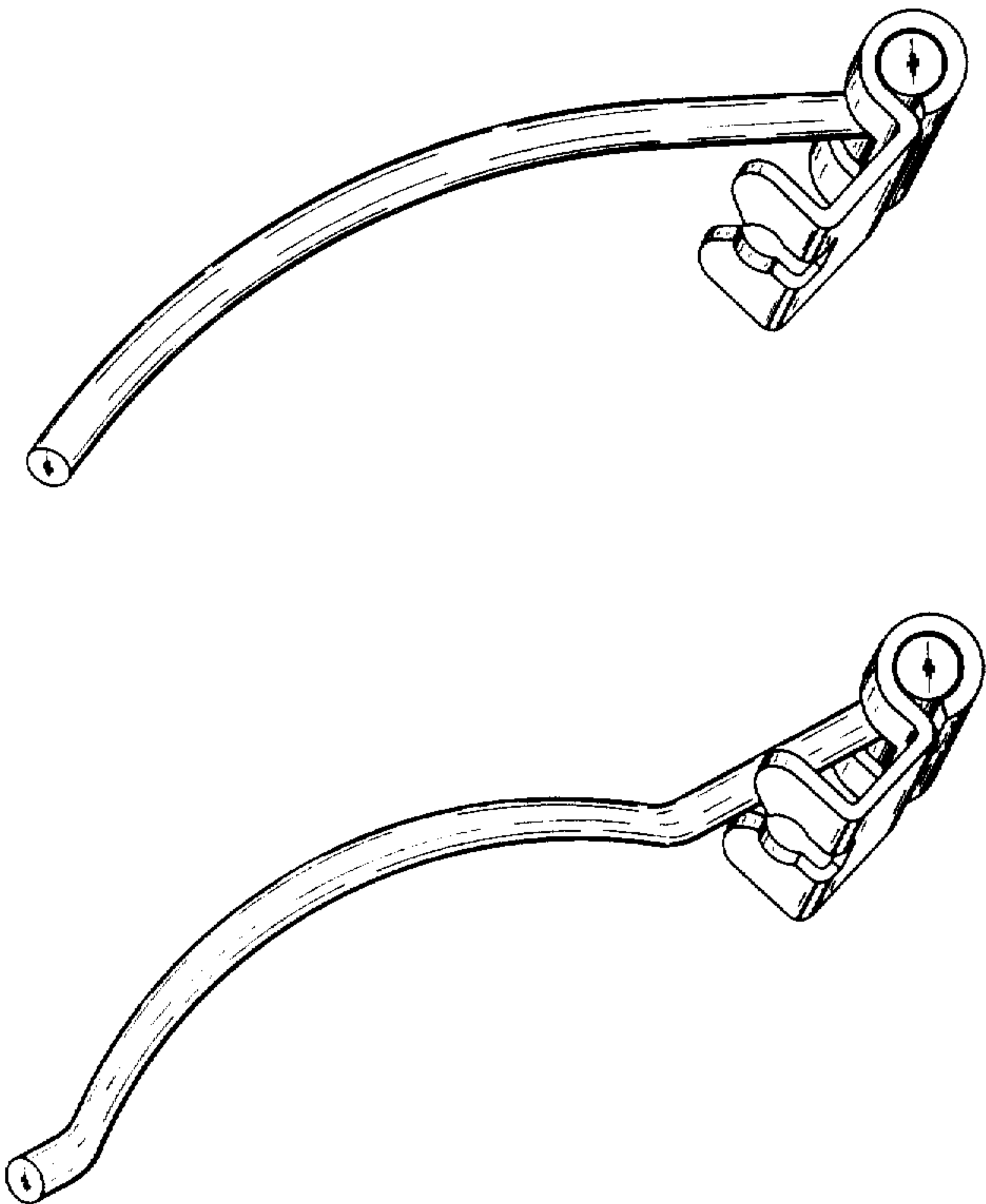
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a jewelry clip or the like showing a modified form of my new design.



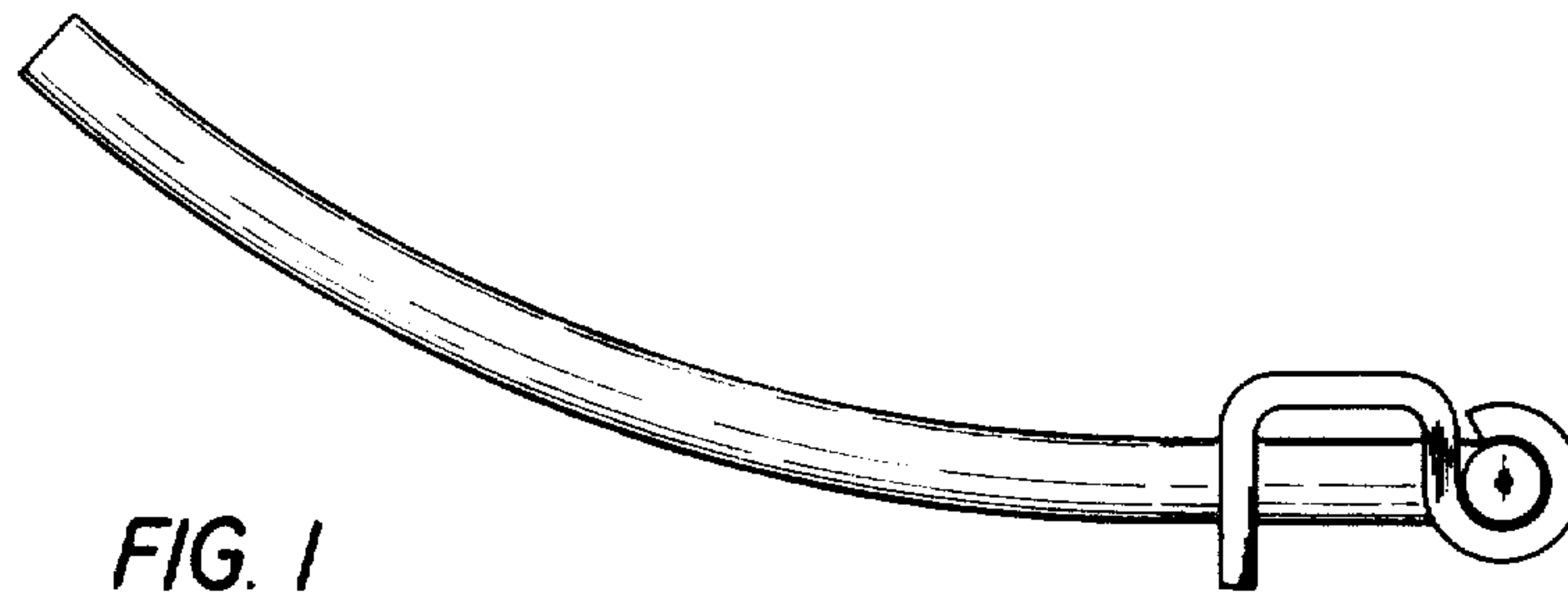

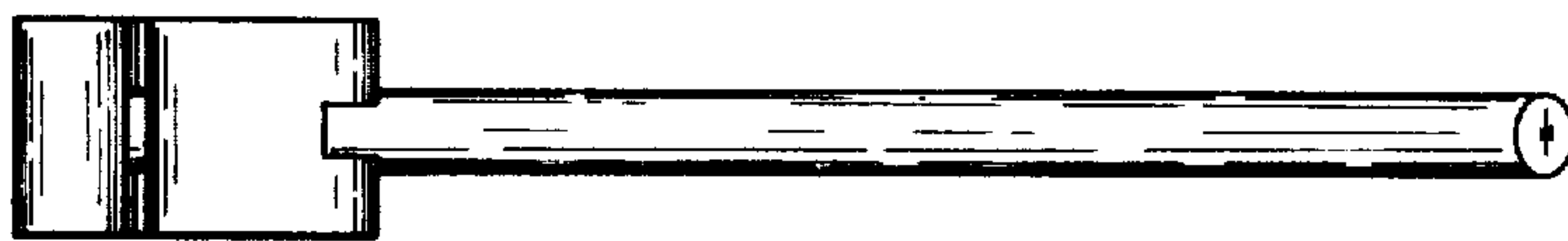

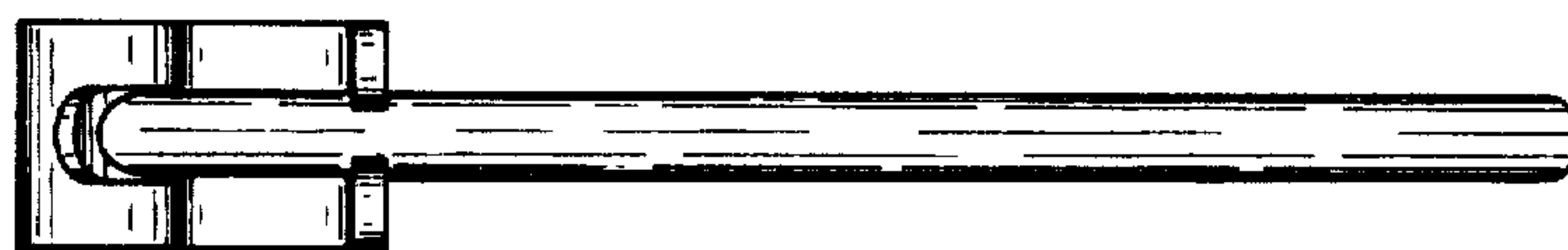

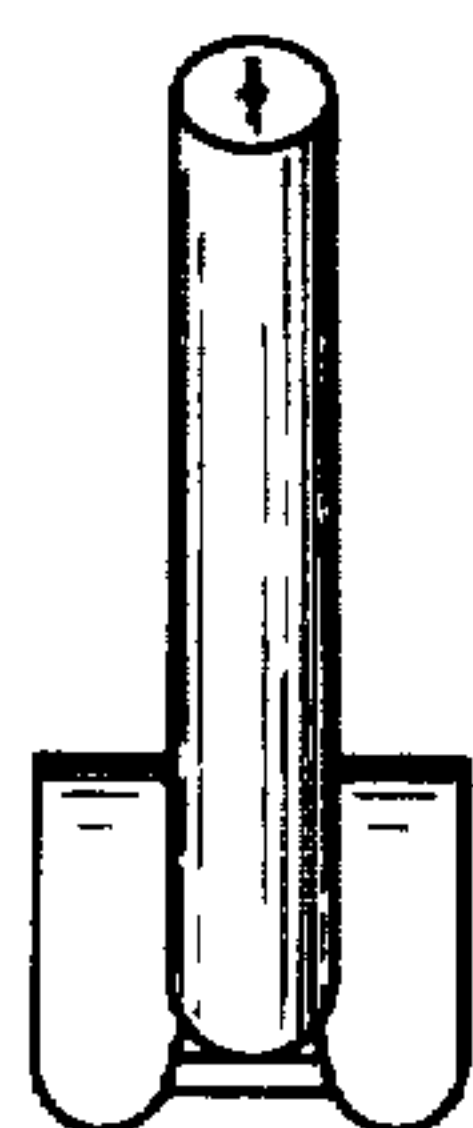

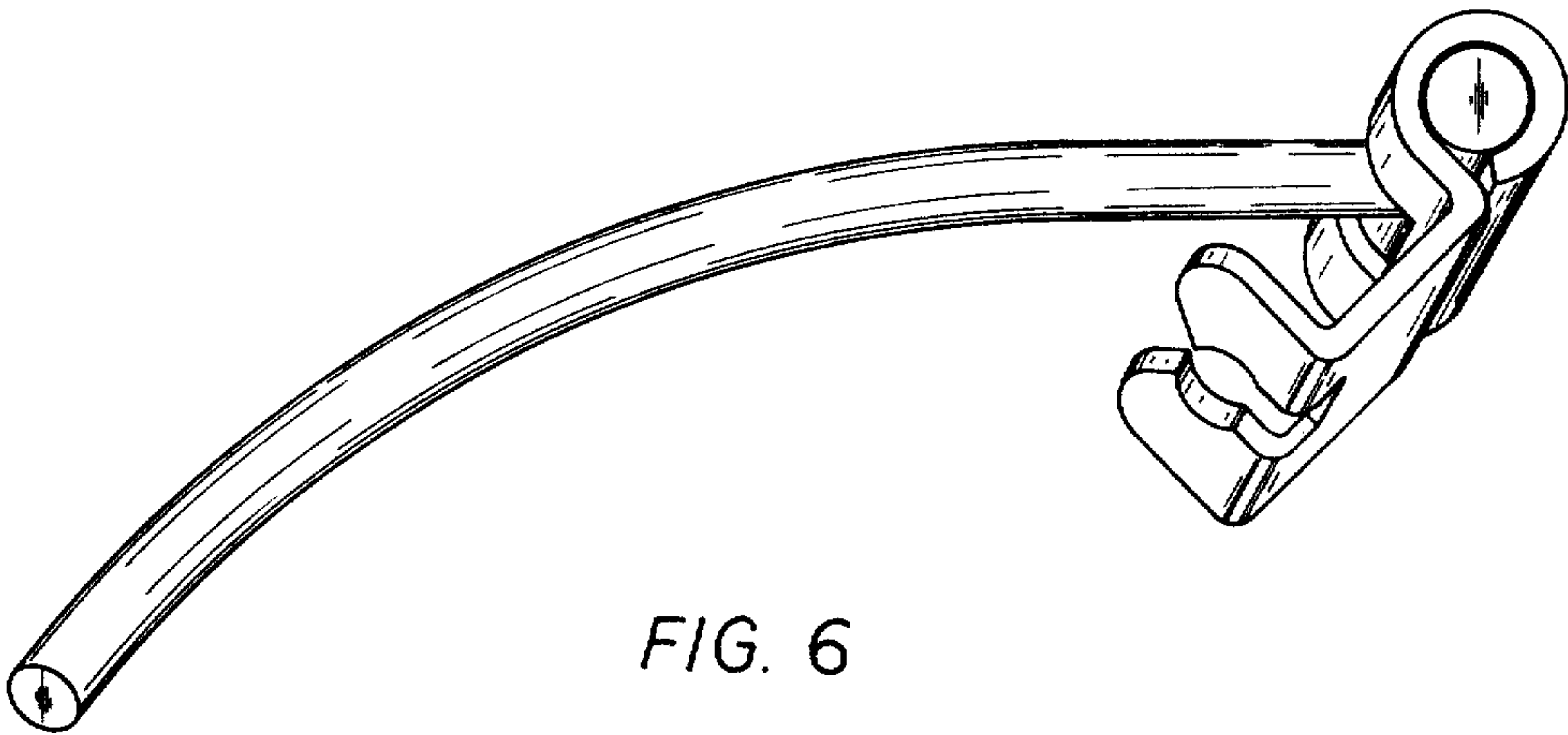

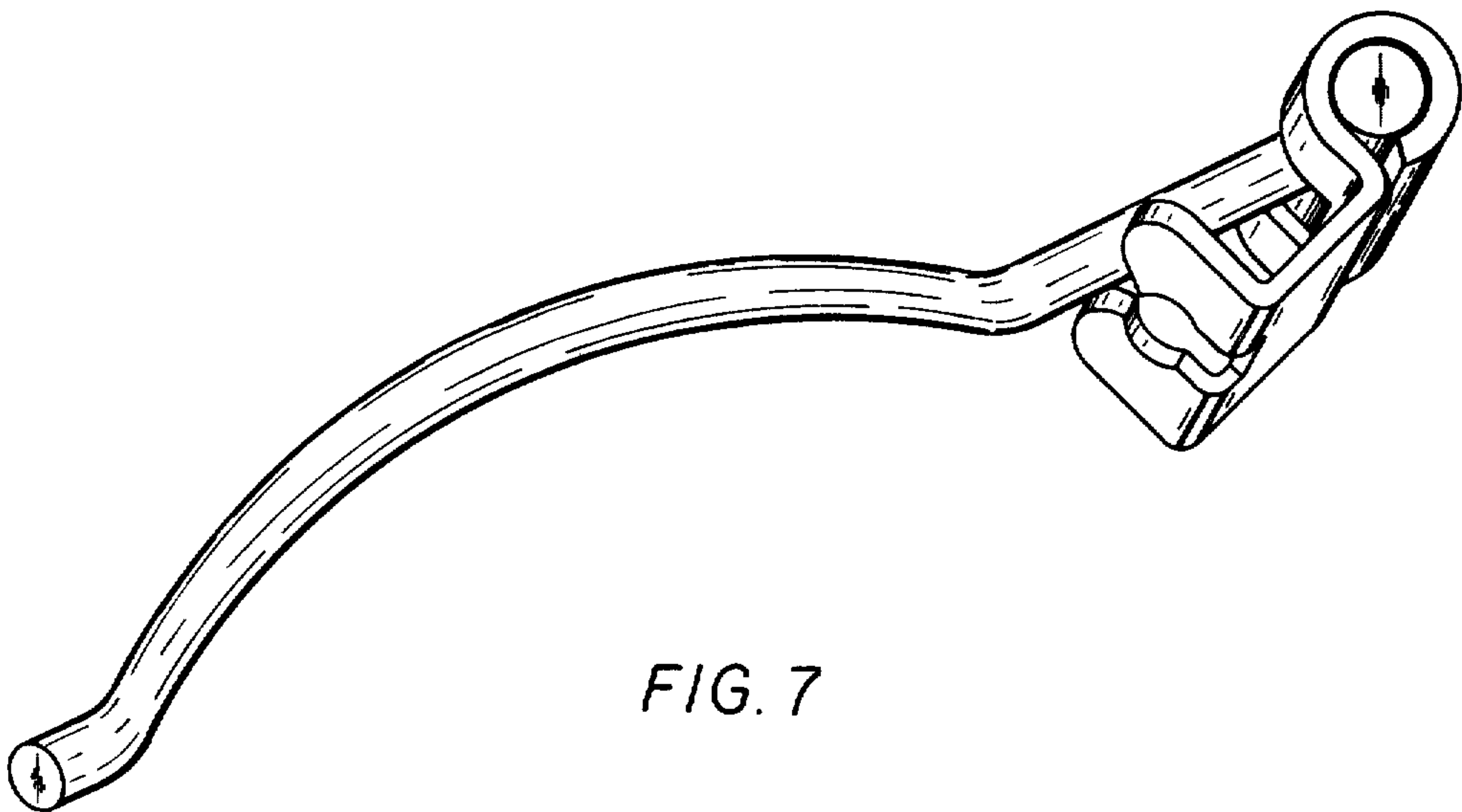
