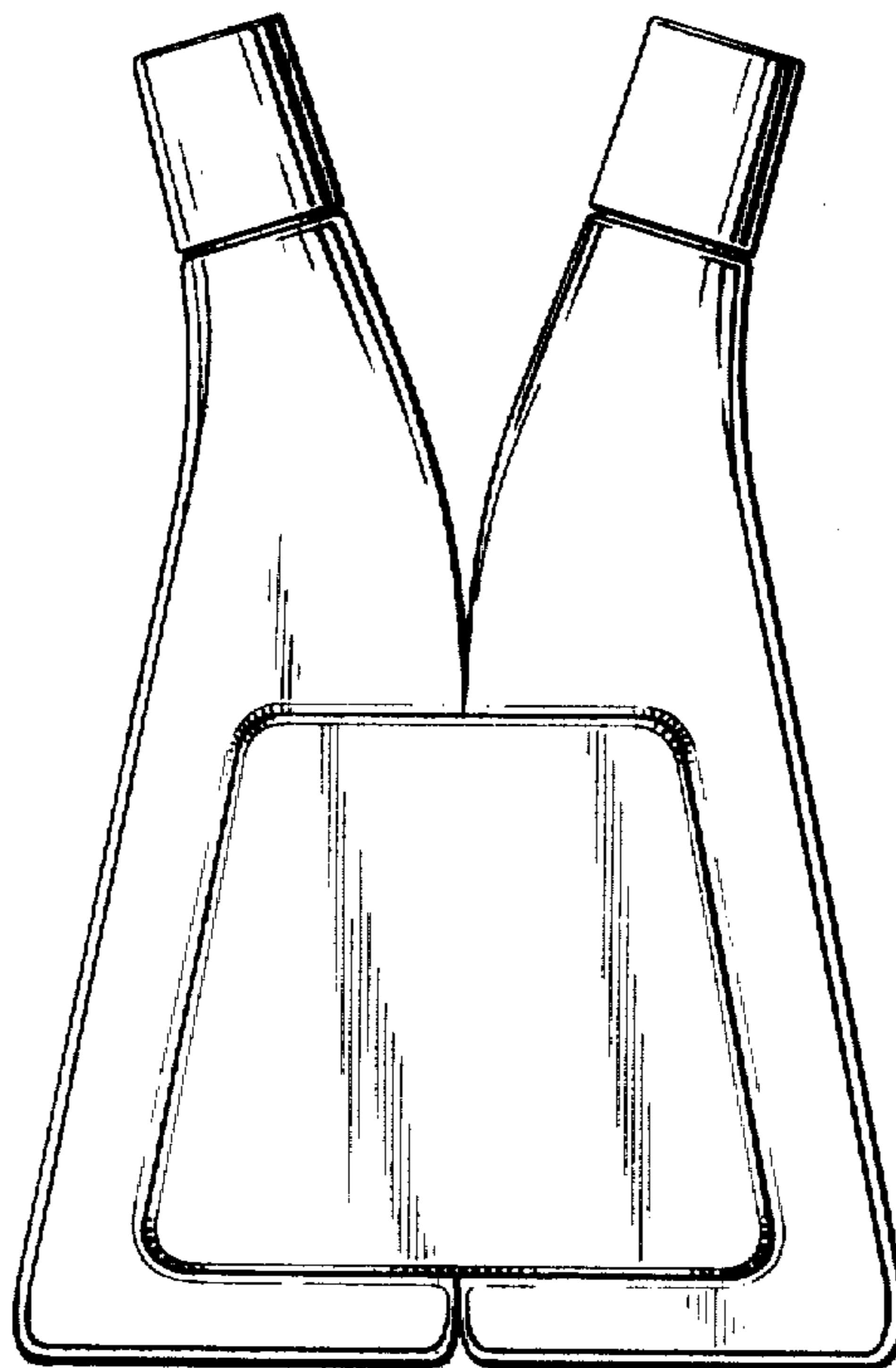

The ornamental design for a dual compartment bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a dual compartment bottle showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance; FIG. 3 is an end elevational view, the opposite end being the same in appearance; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



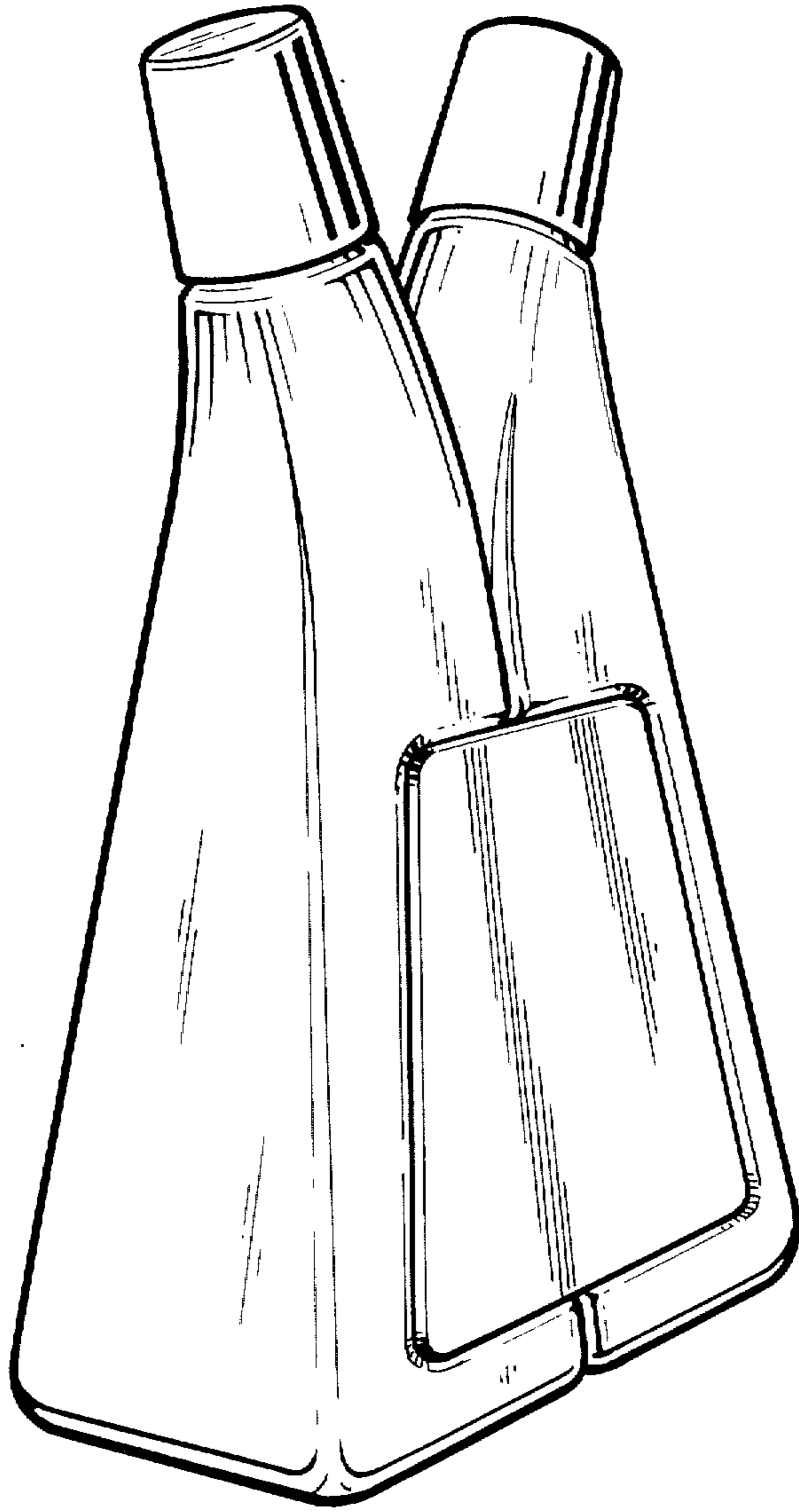

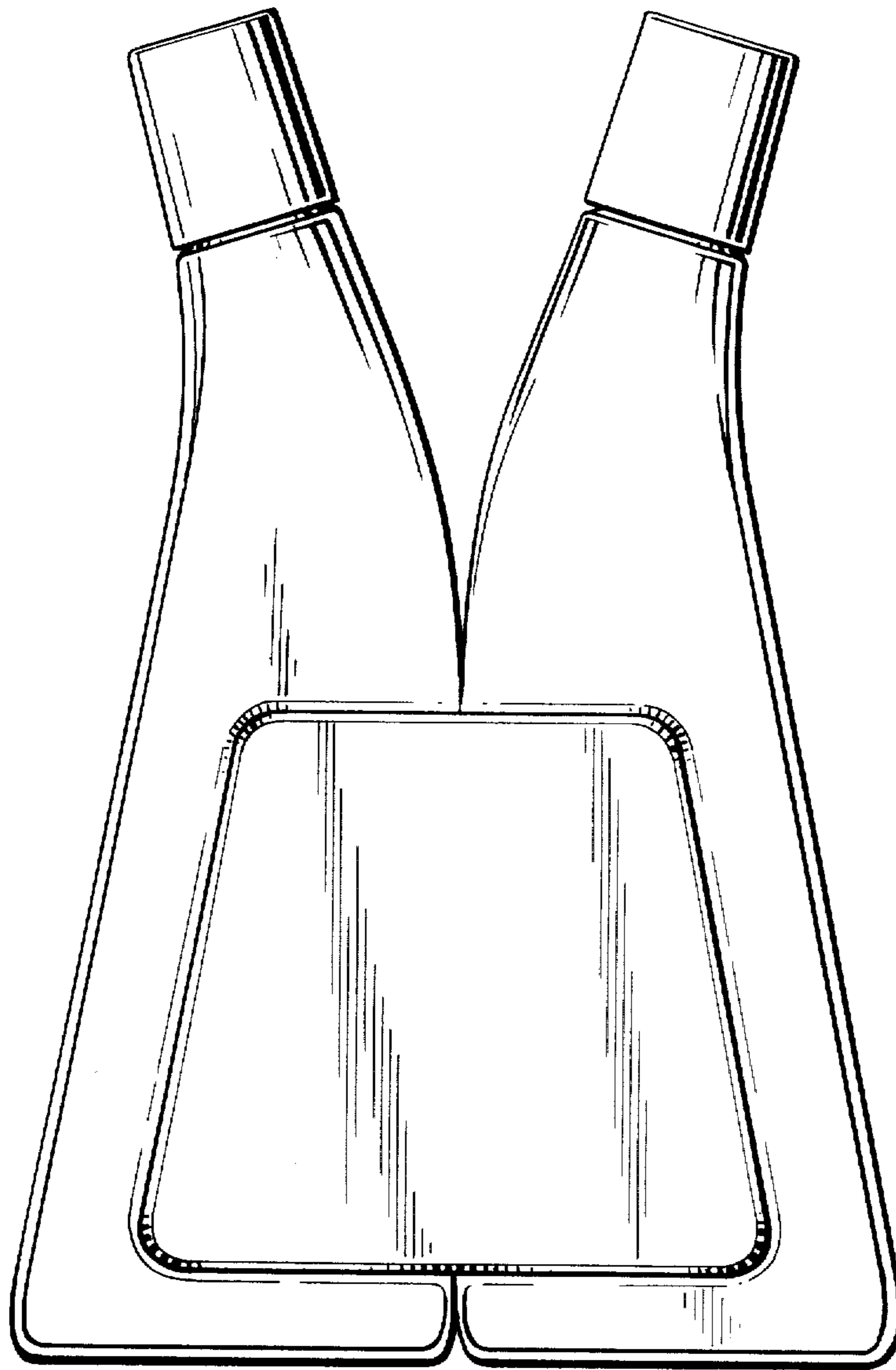

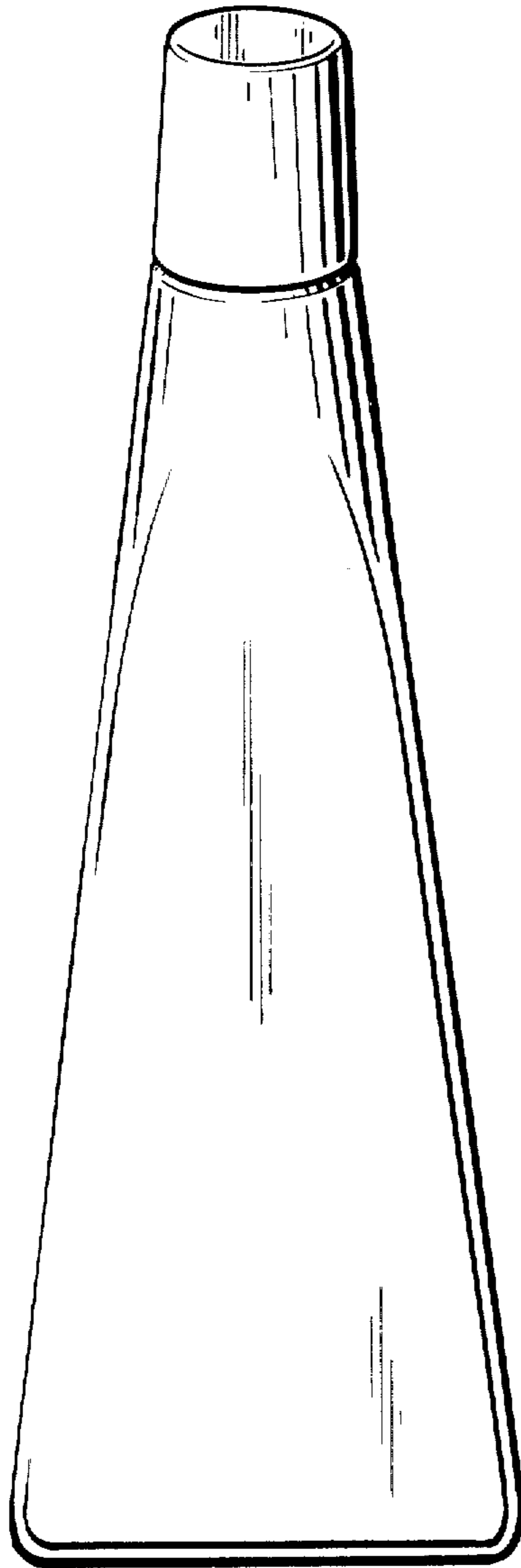

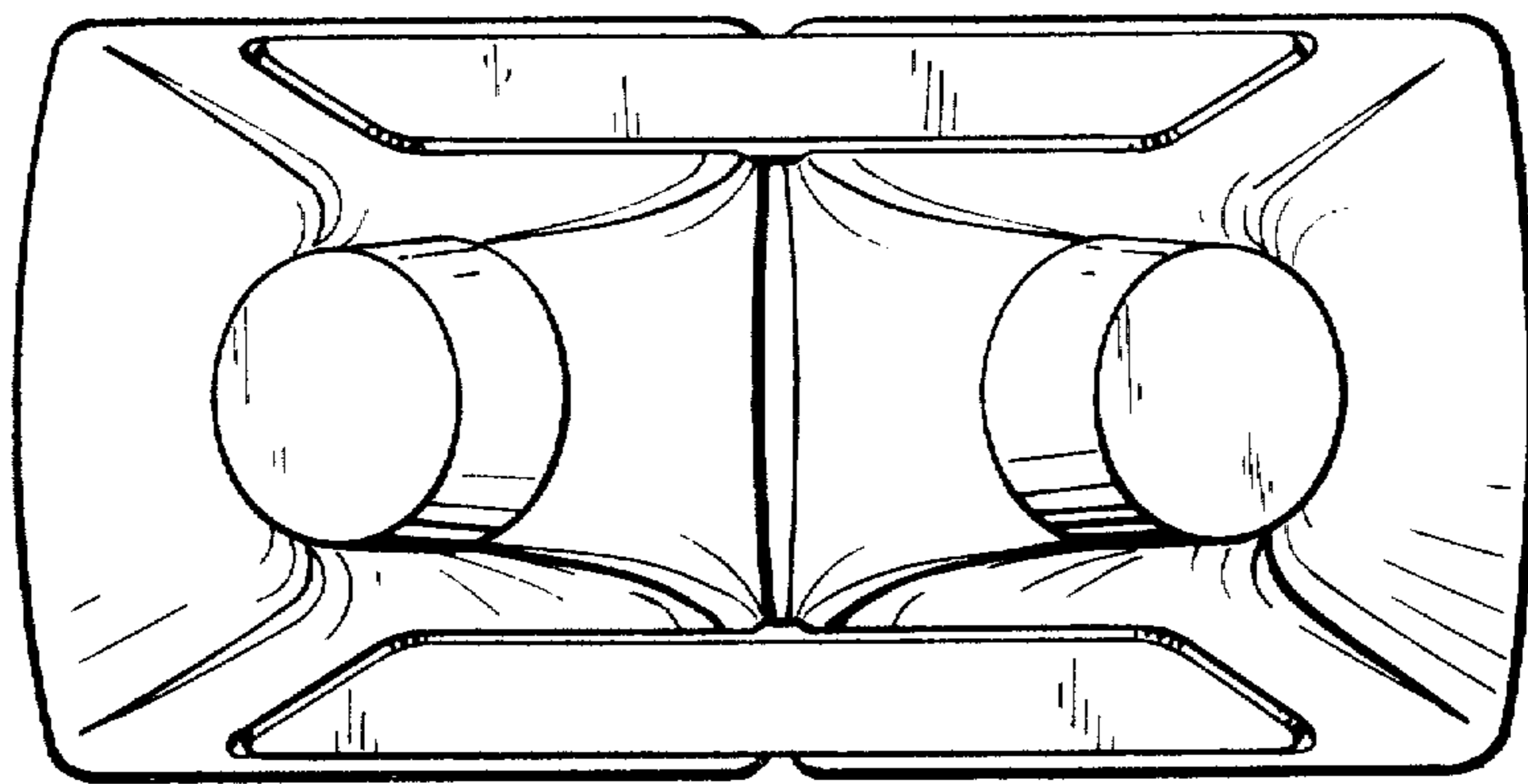

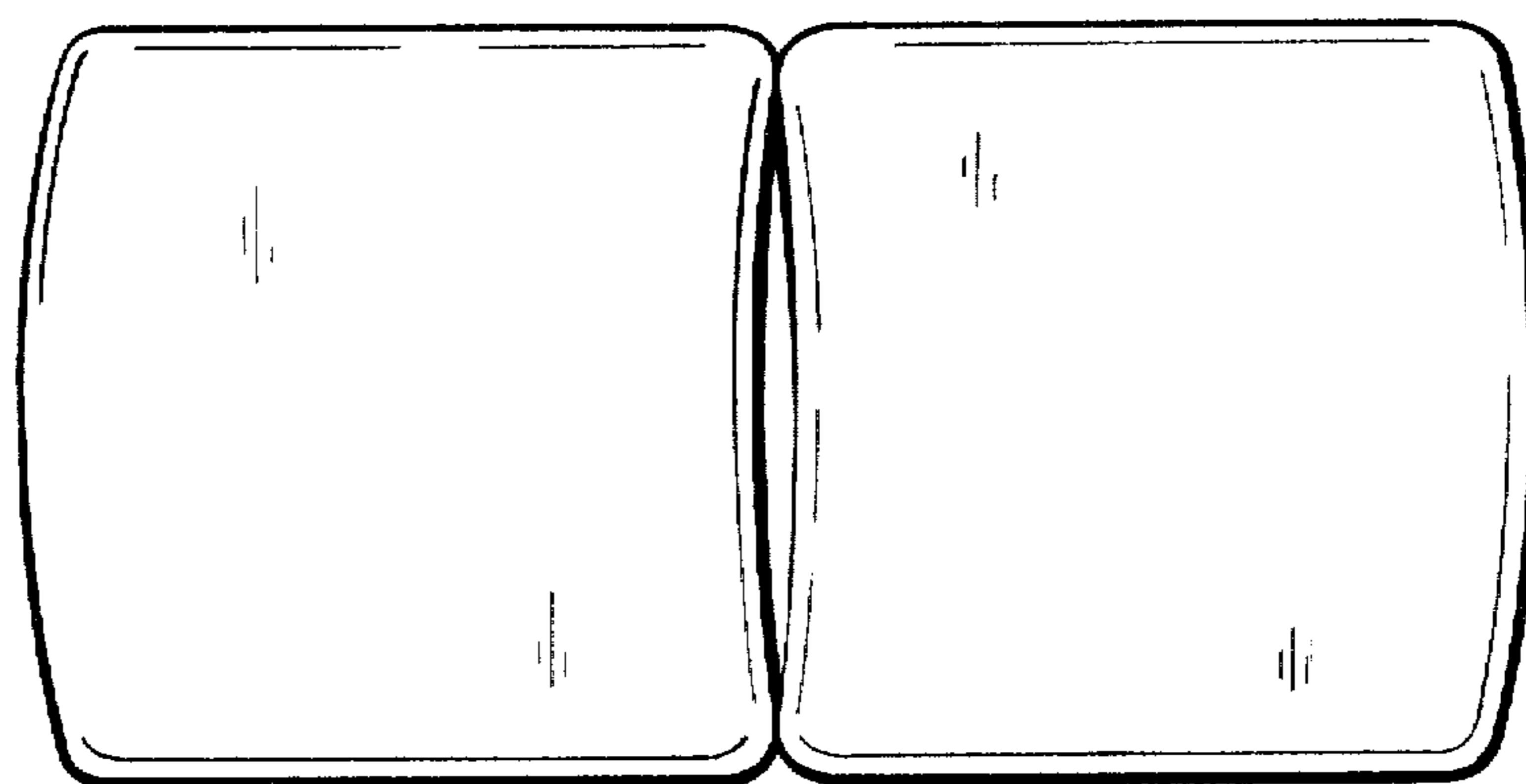
