the hinged cover in raised condition.

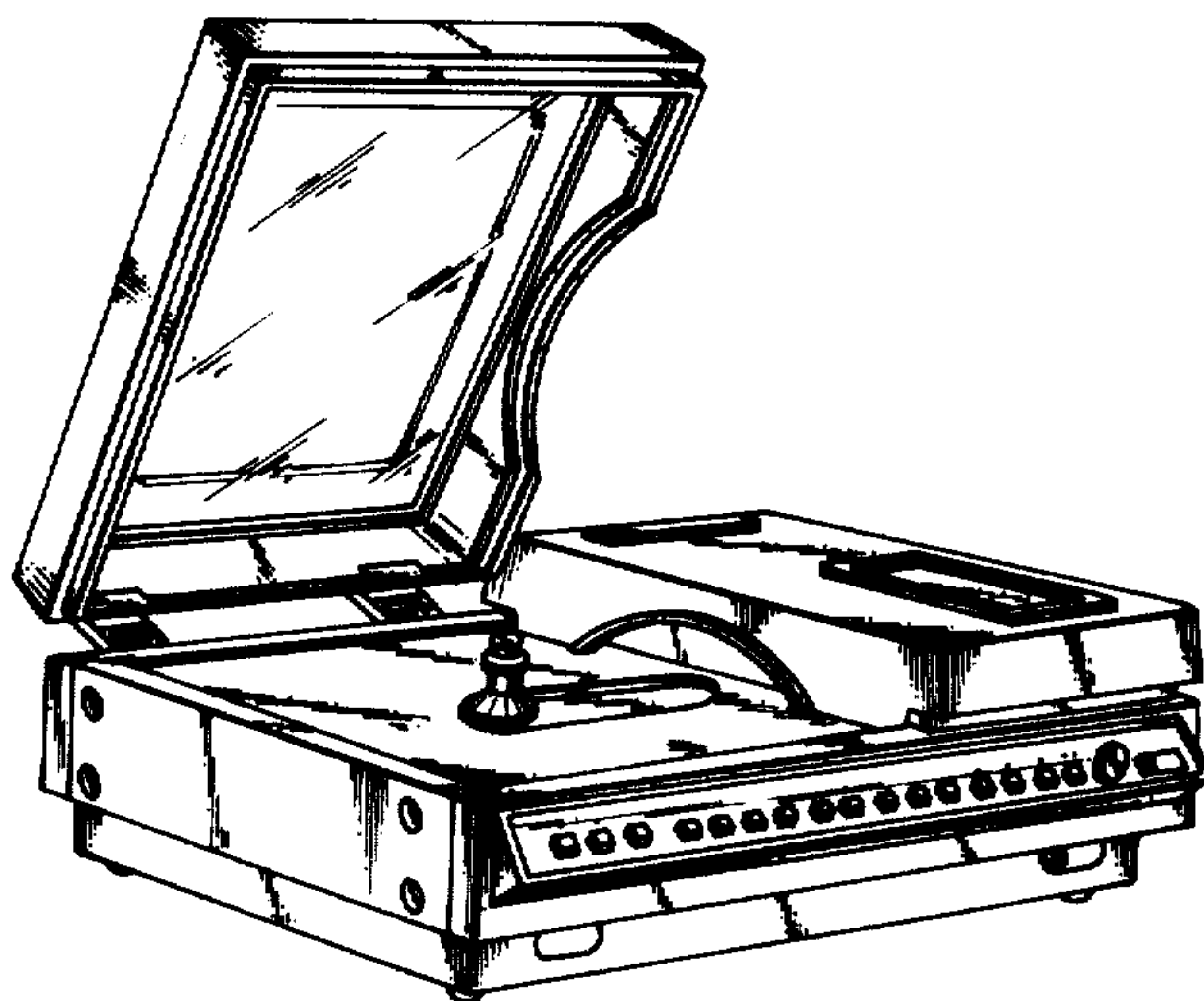

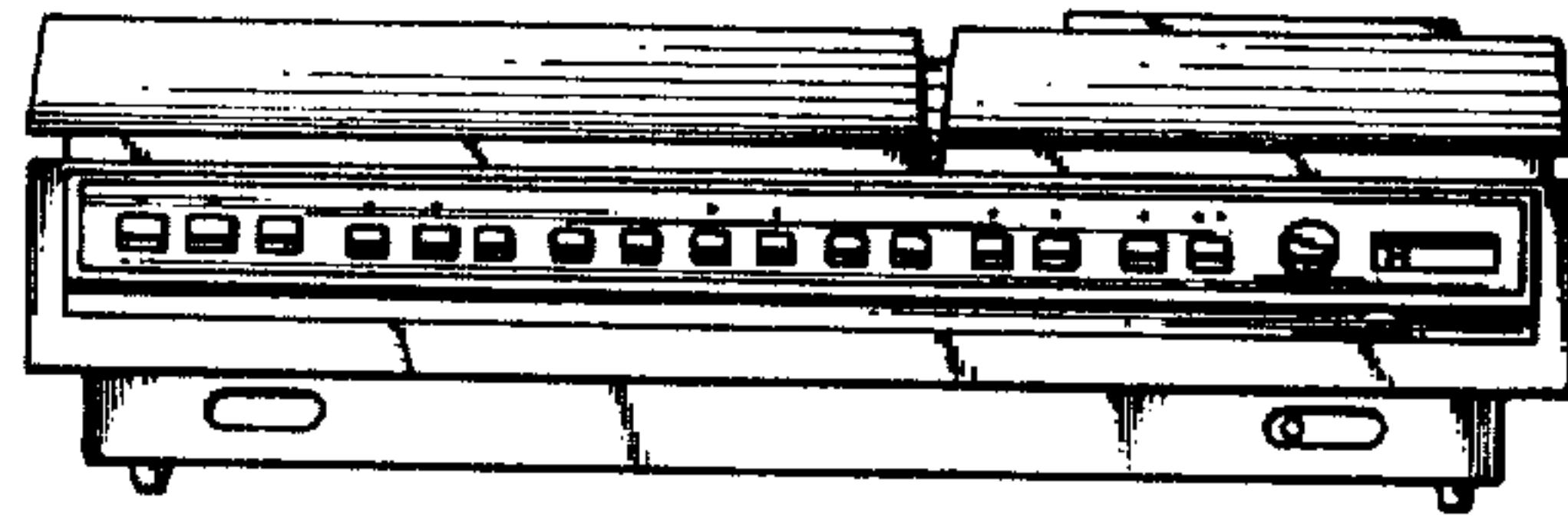

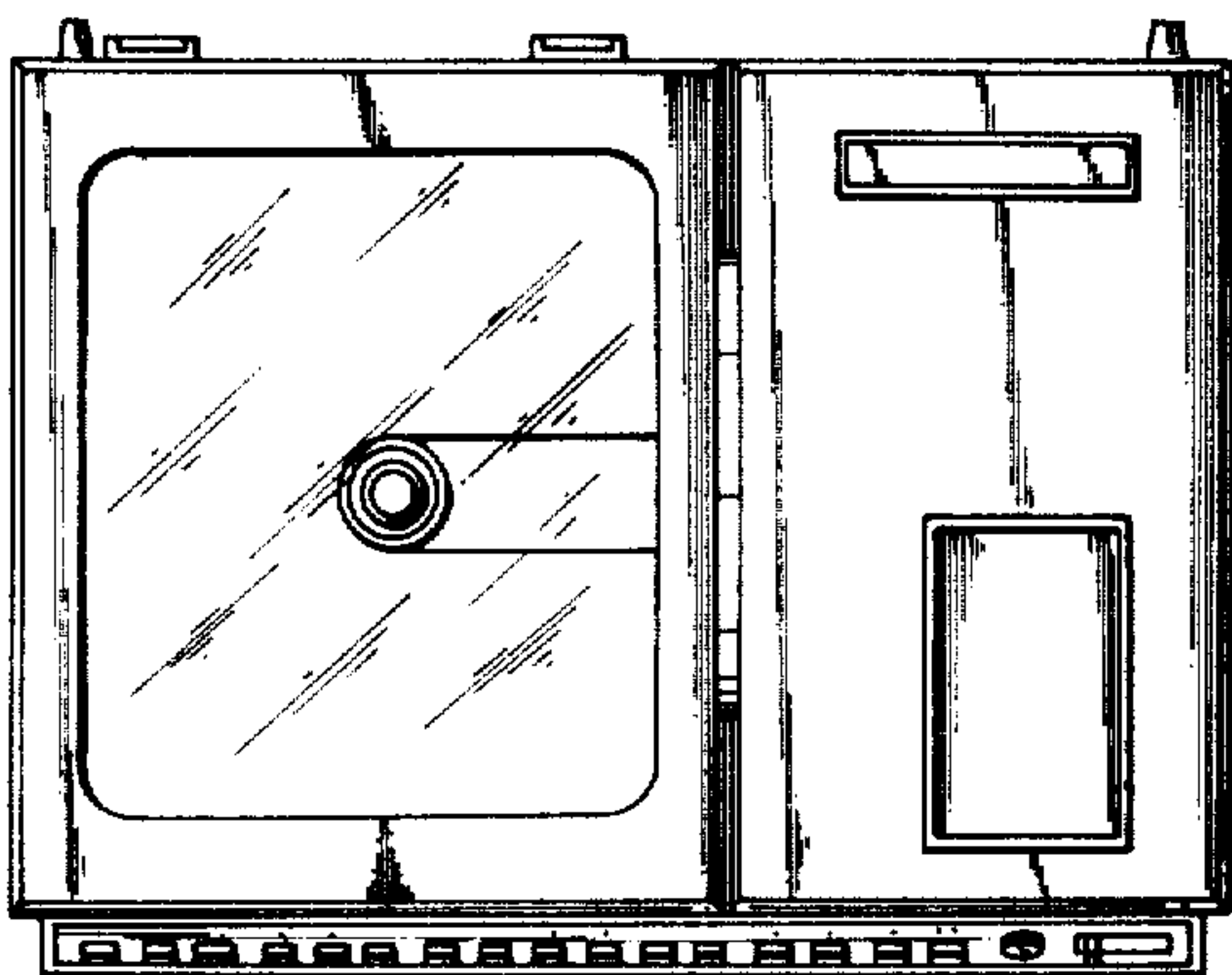

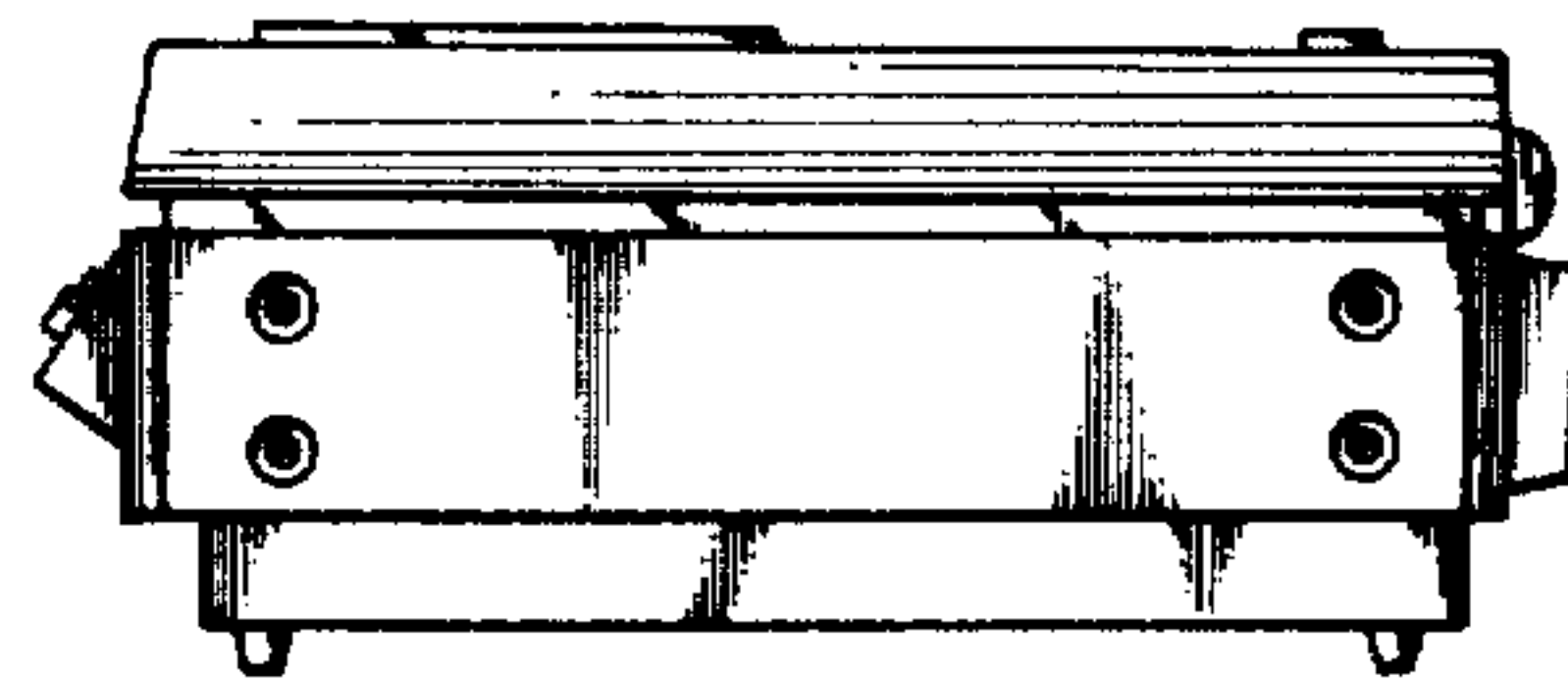
