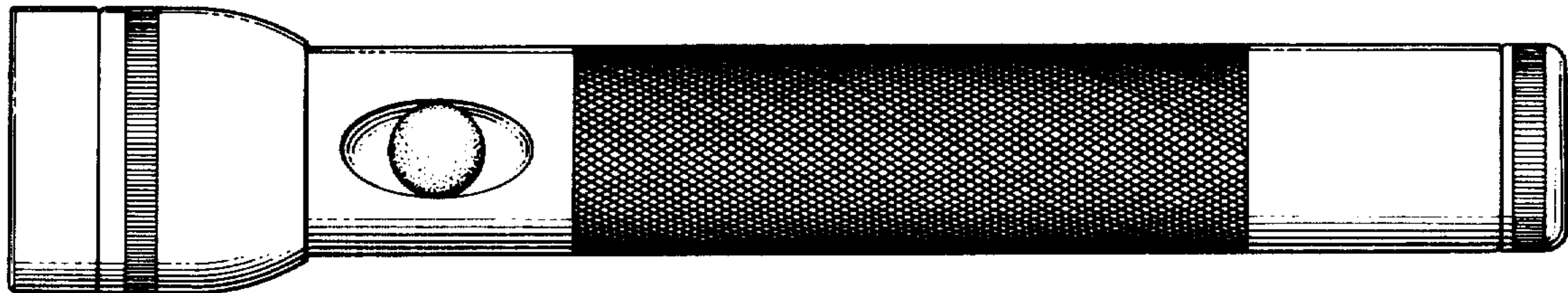

FIG. 5 is a rear end view of the flashlight.



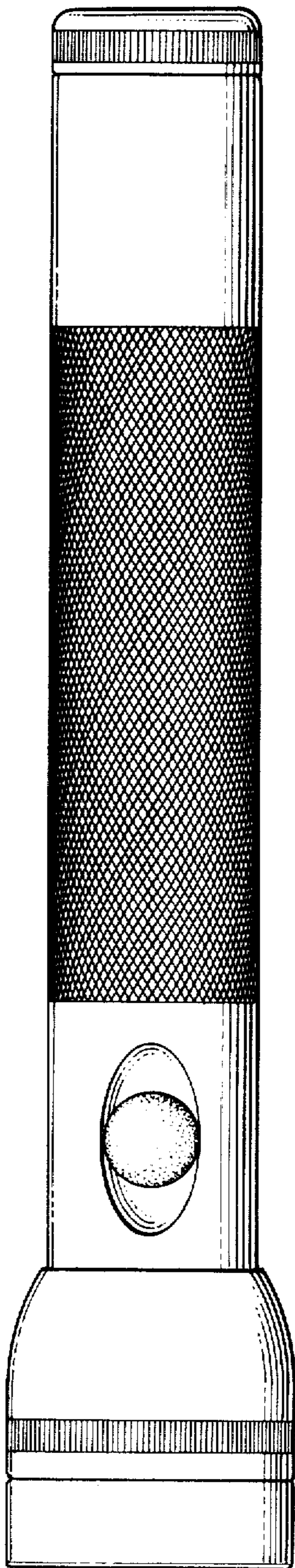

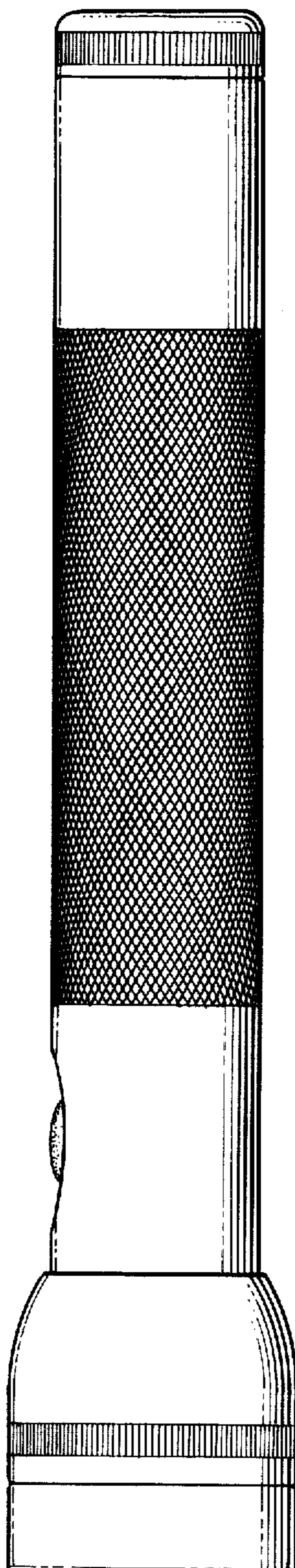

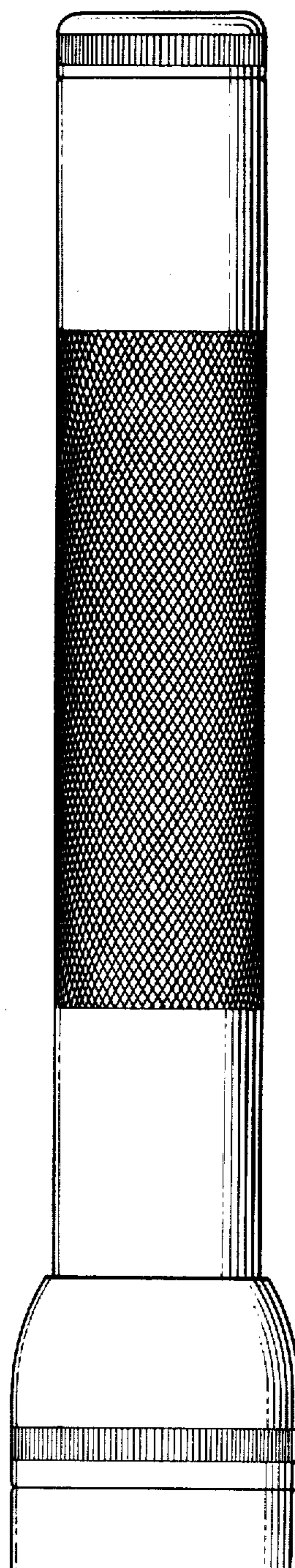

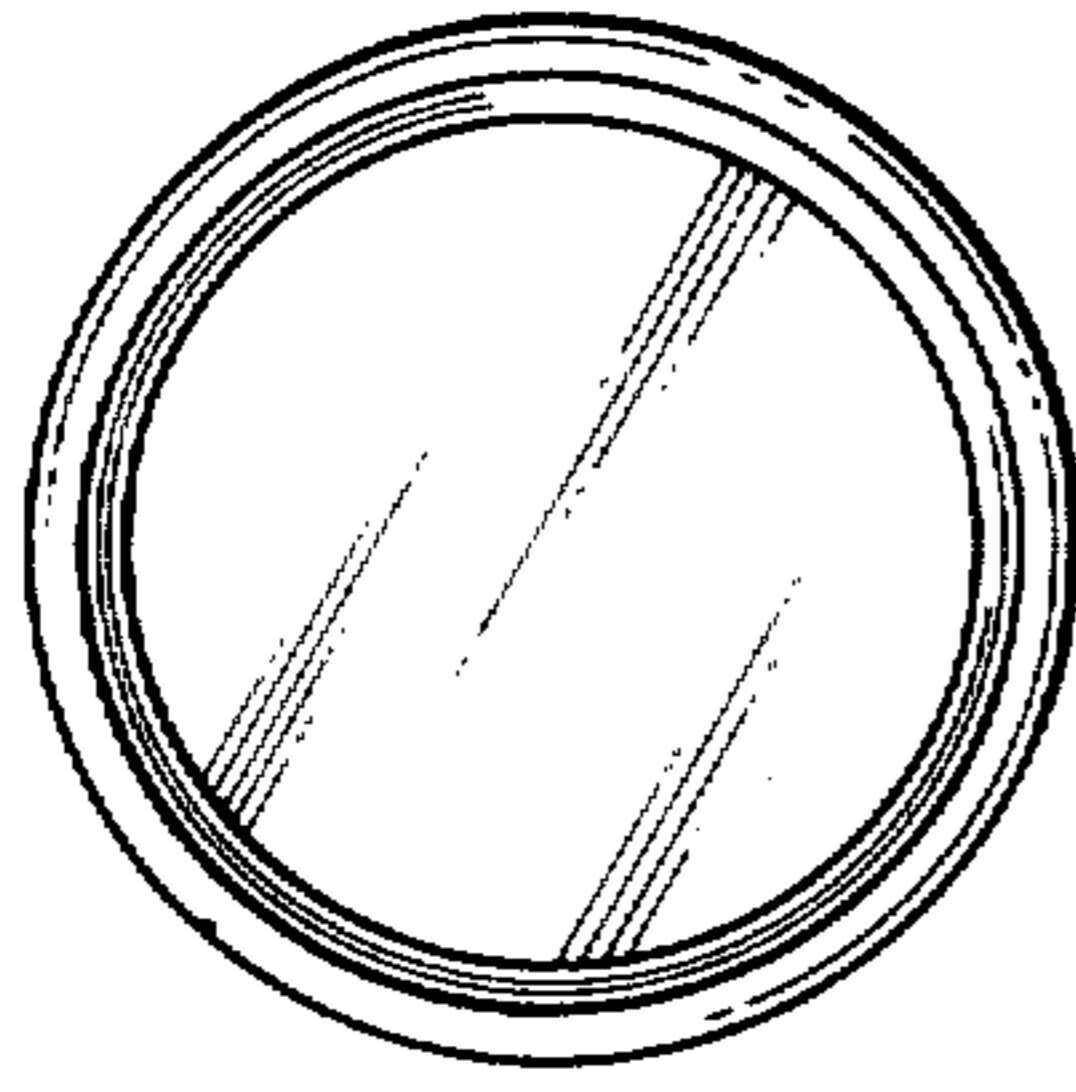

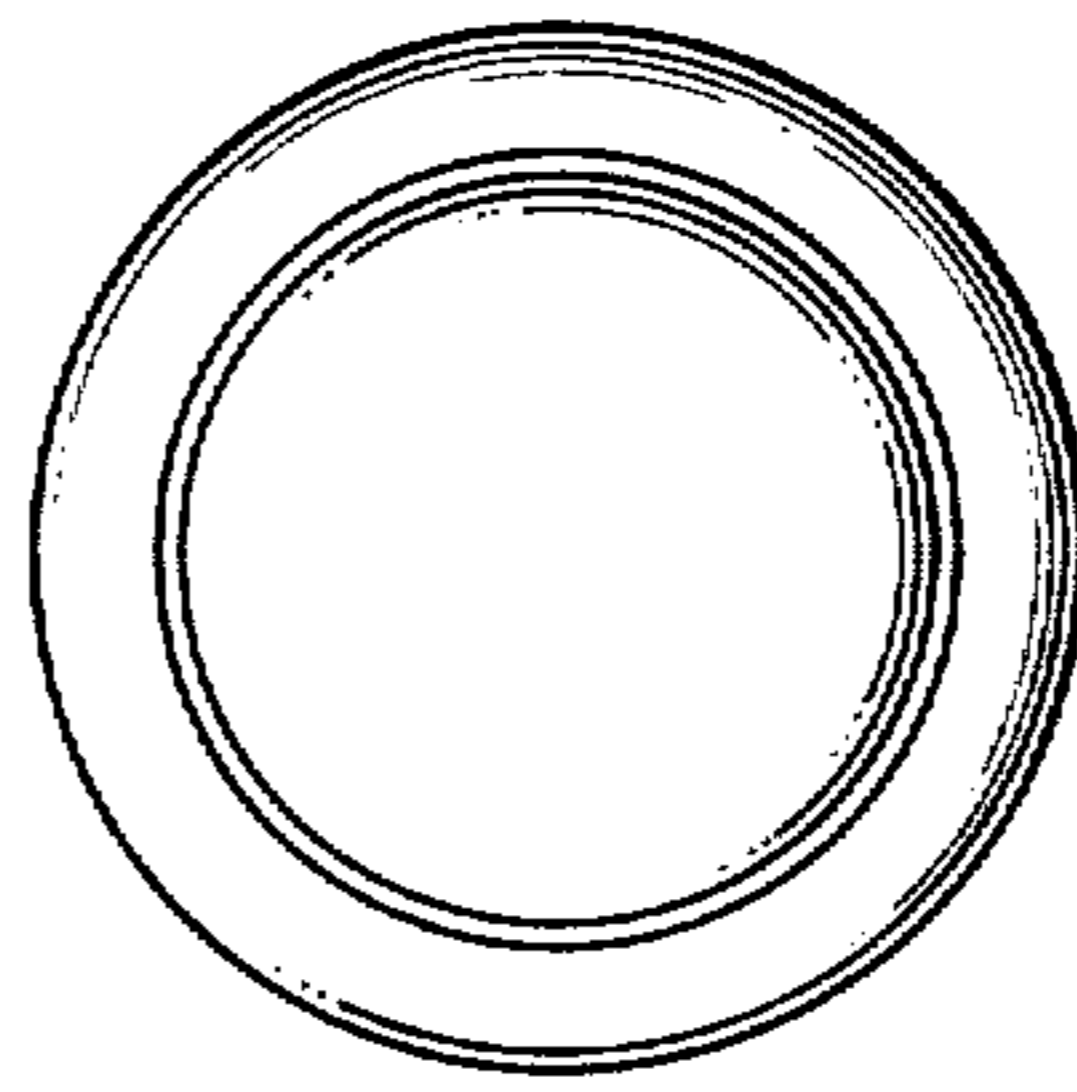
