

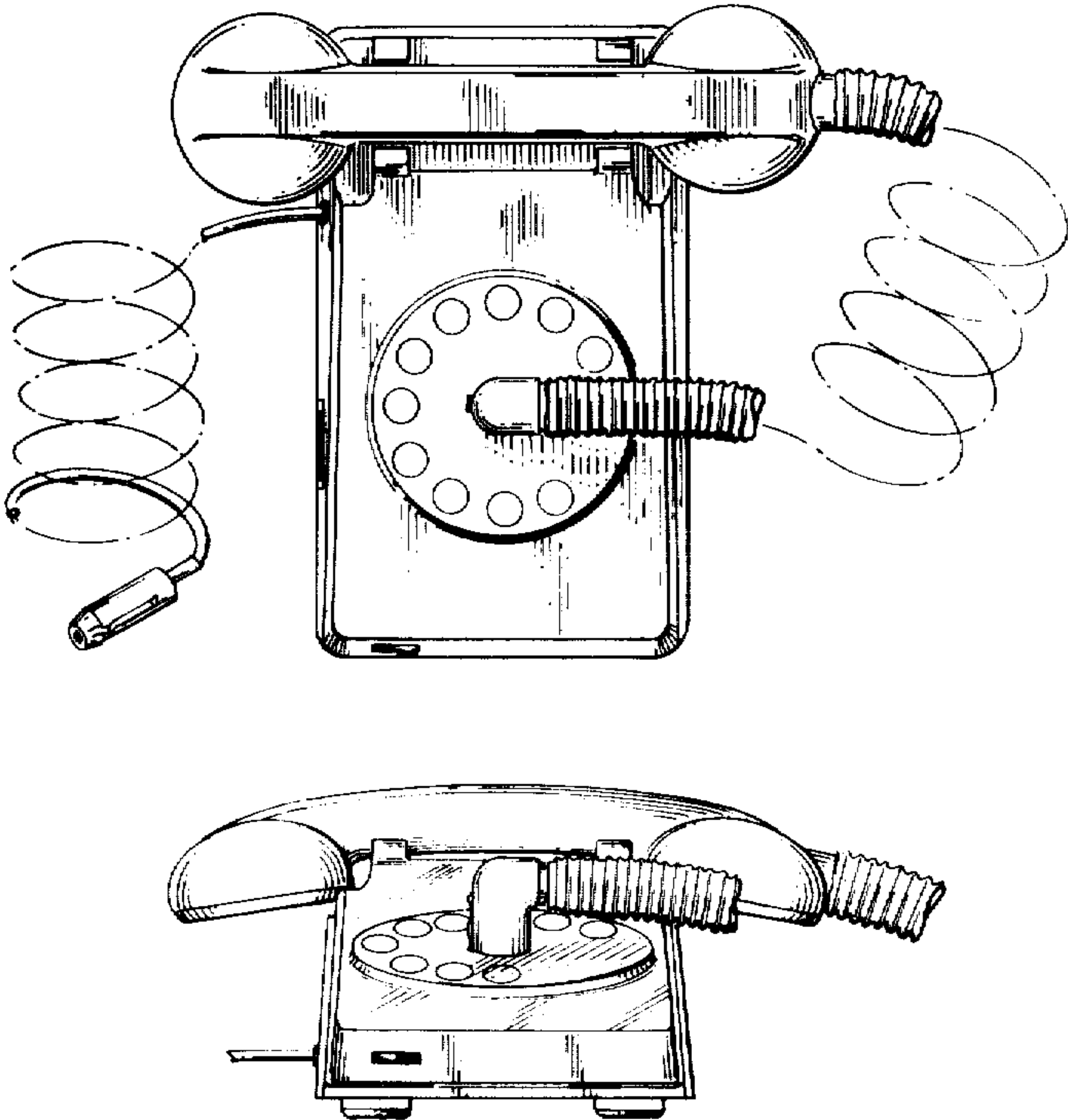

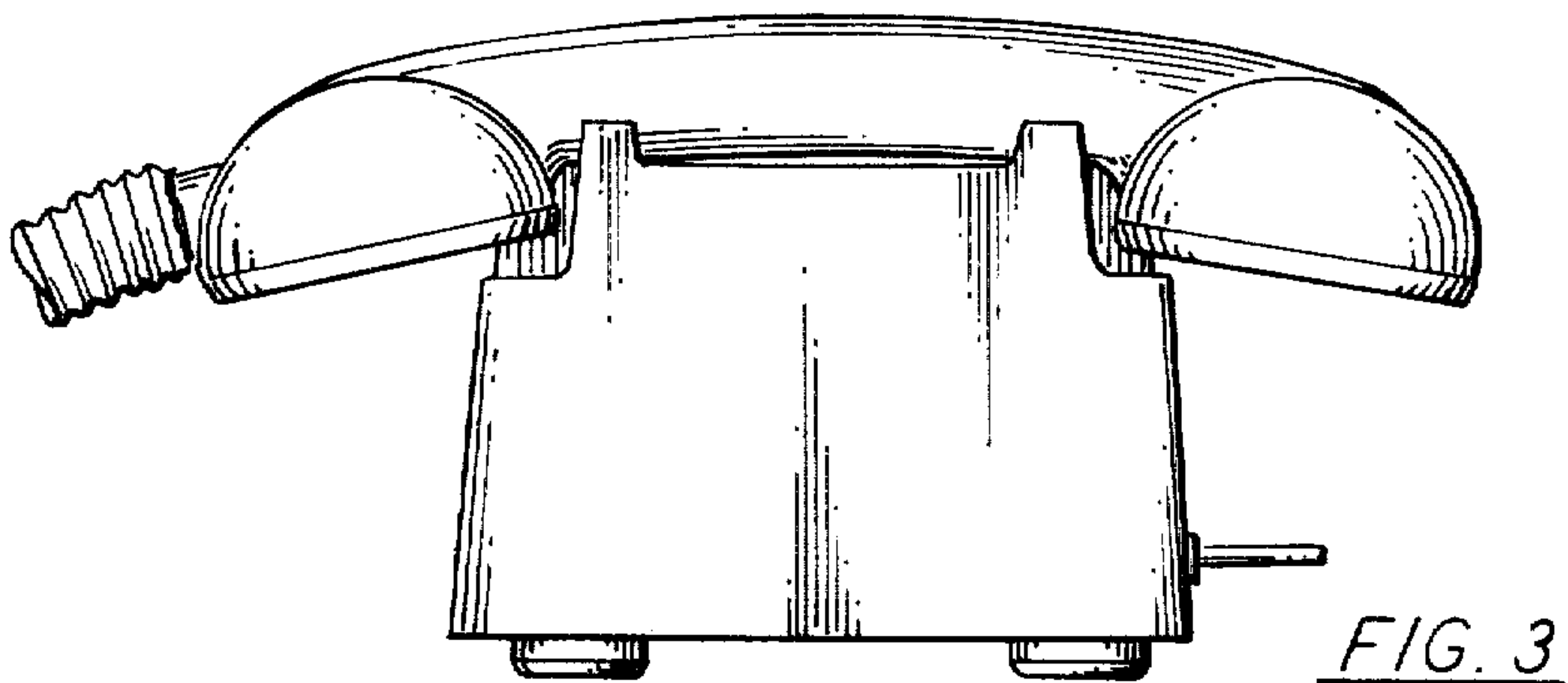
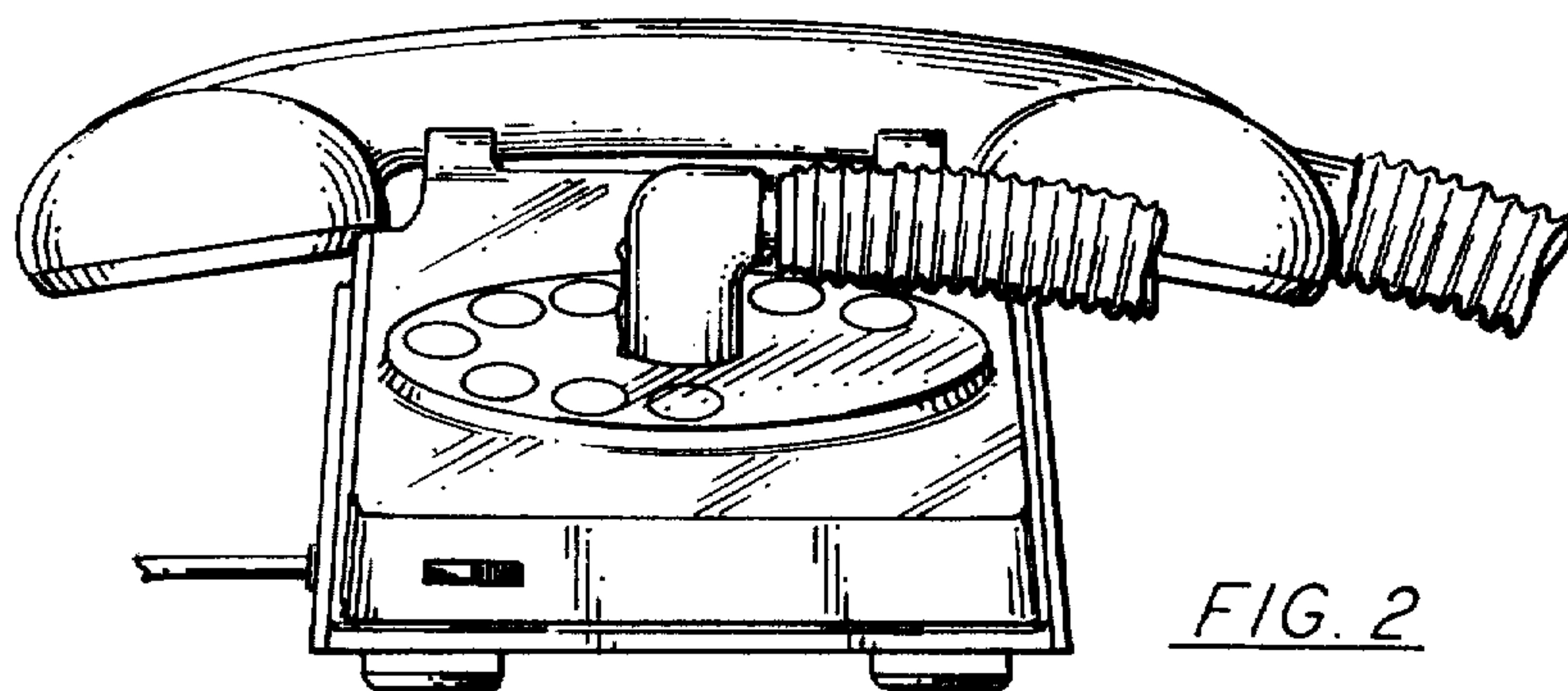
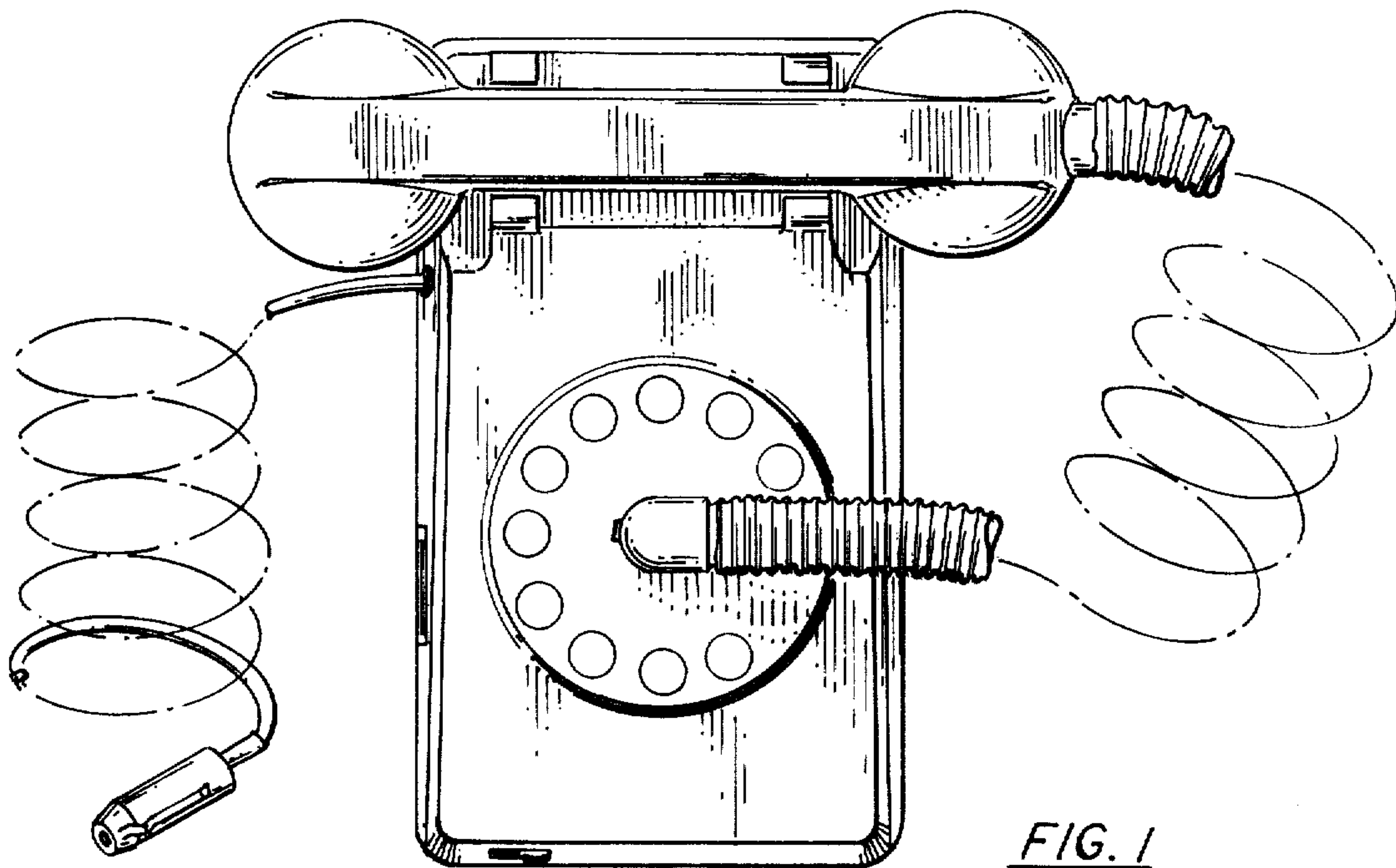

[57] CLAIM  
The ornamental design for a vacuum cleaner, as shown  
and described.

DESCRIPTION  
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a vacuum cleaner embody-  
ing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.  
The flexible vacuum hose and the electric cord are  
continuous throughout the area indicated in FIG. 1, the  
flexible vacuum hose has been broken away in FIGS. 2,  
3 and 4 and omitted from FIGS. 5 and 6 for conve-  
nience of illustration, while the electric cord has been  
broken away in FIGS. 2, 3, 4 and 6 and omitted from  
FIG. 5 for convenience of illustration.





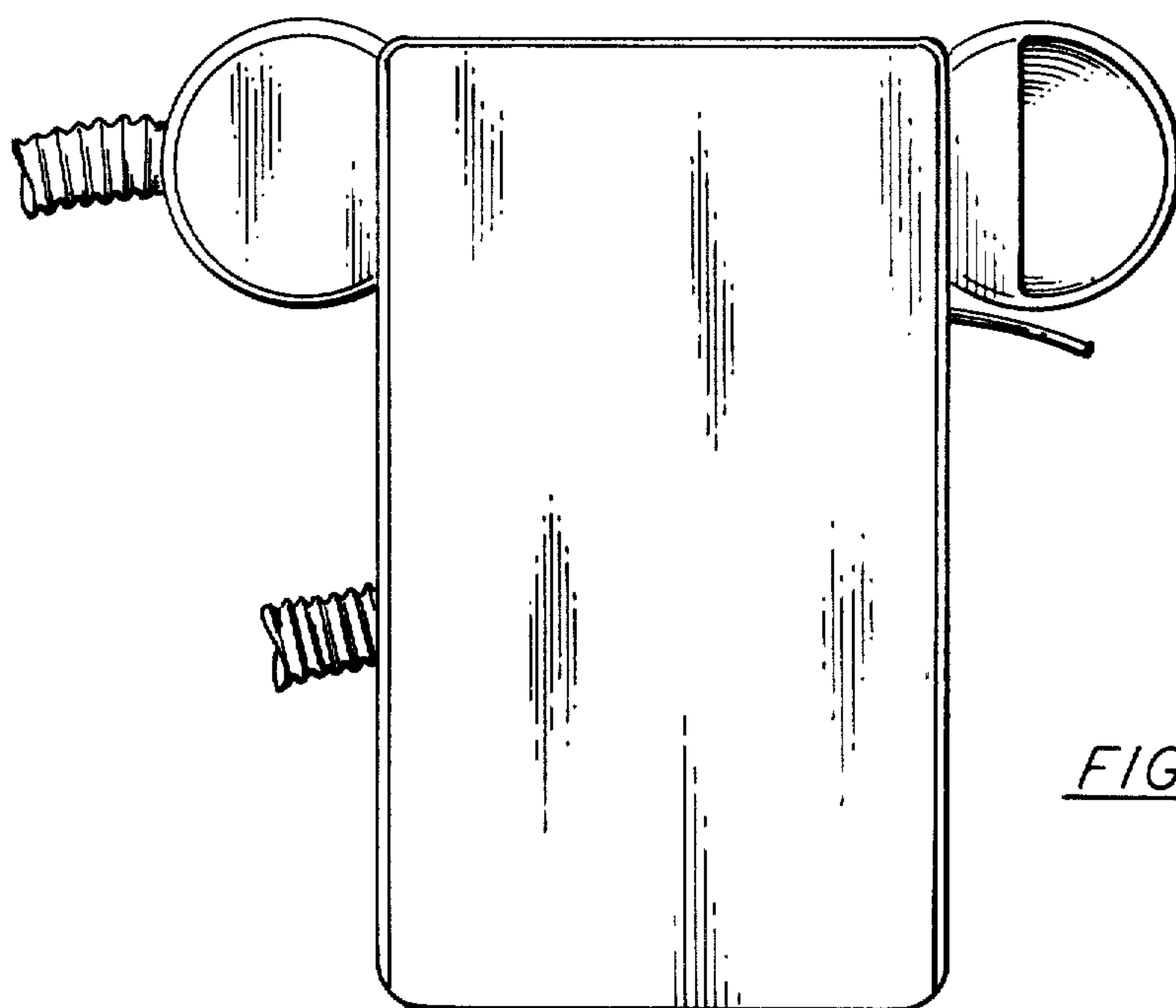

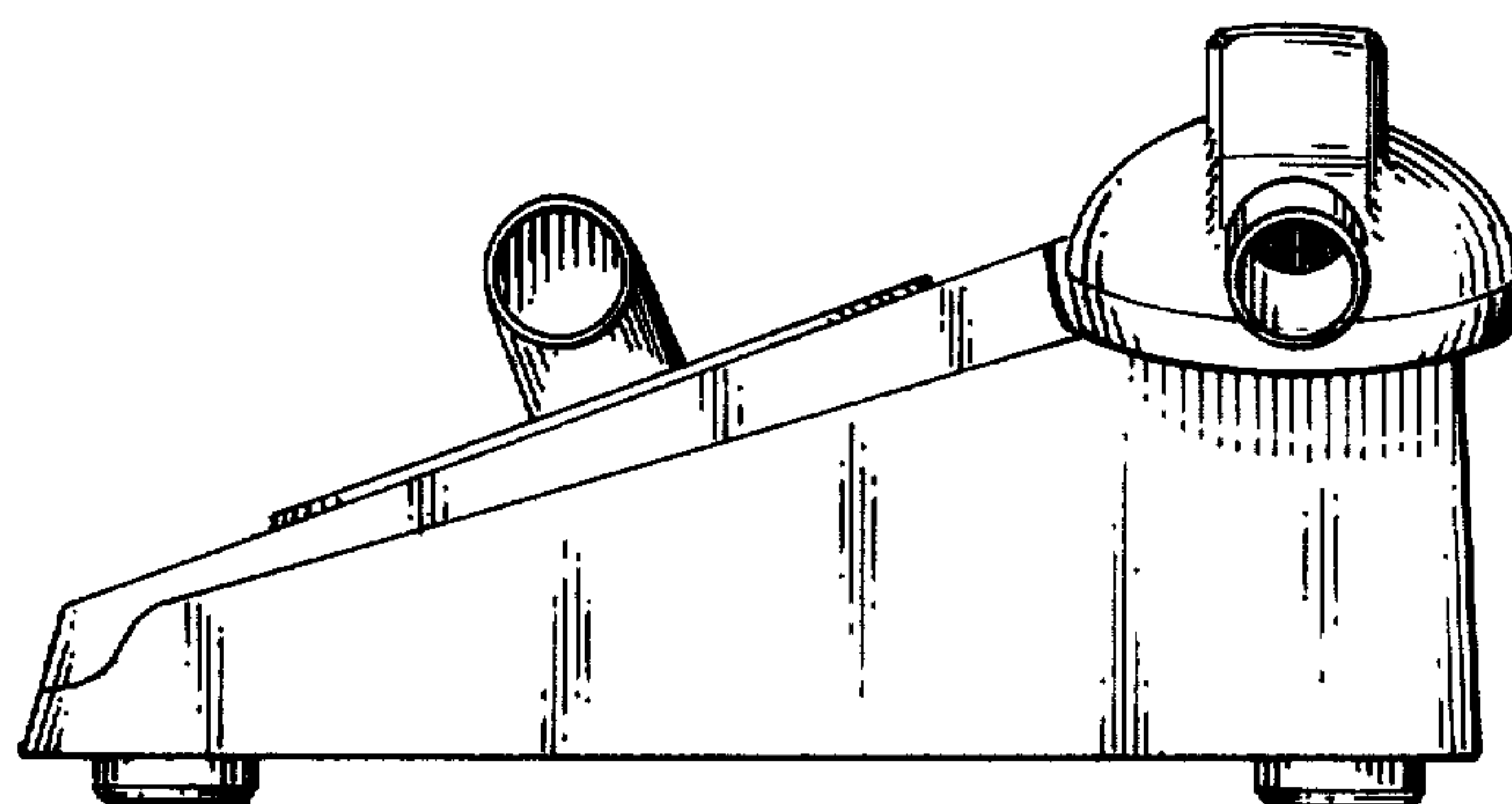

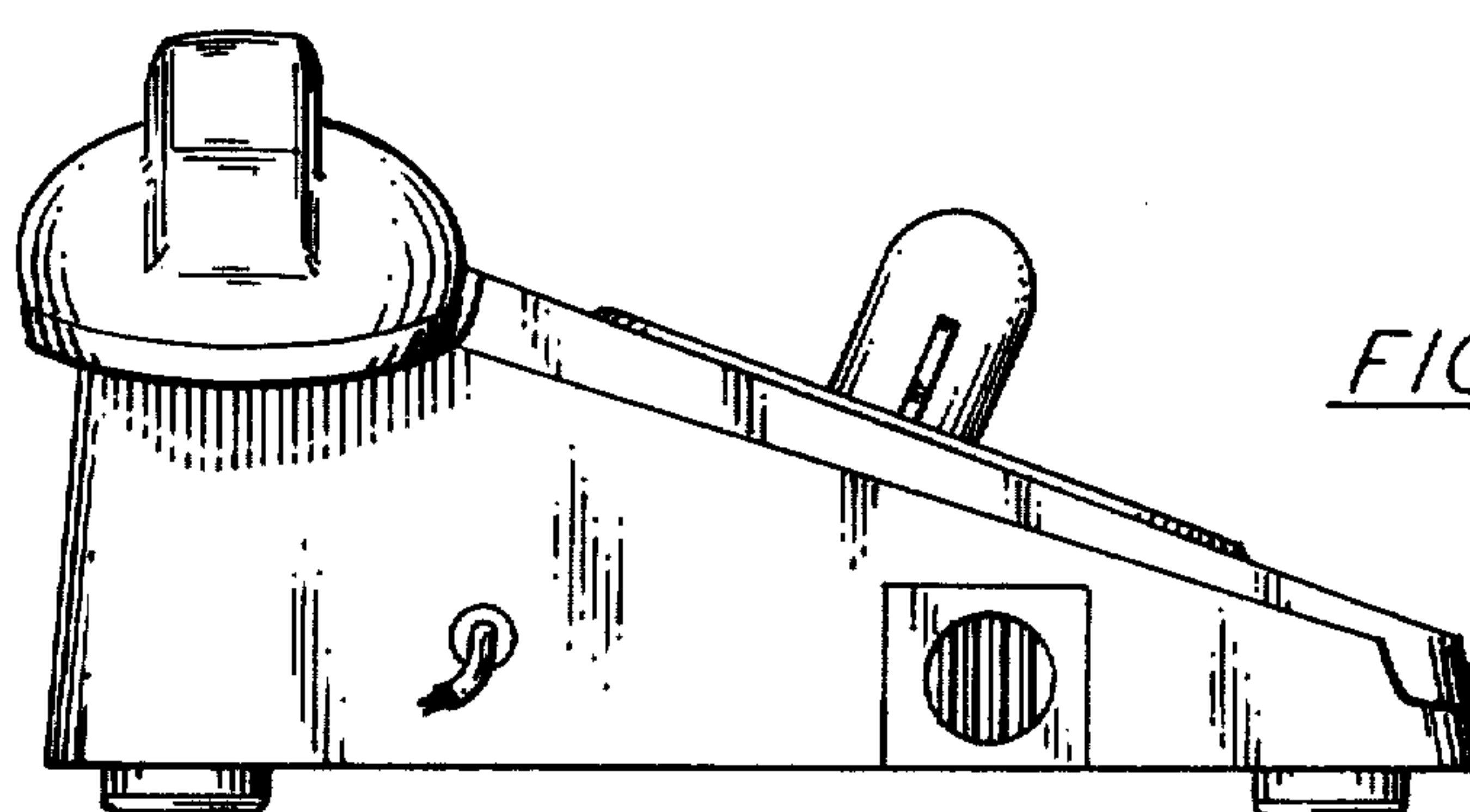
