The ornamental design for an oxygen humidifier, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 shows a perspective view of our new design for an oxygen humidifier looking downwardly on the top thereof;

FIG. 4 shows a bottom view thereof.

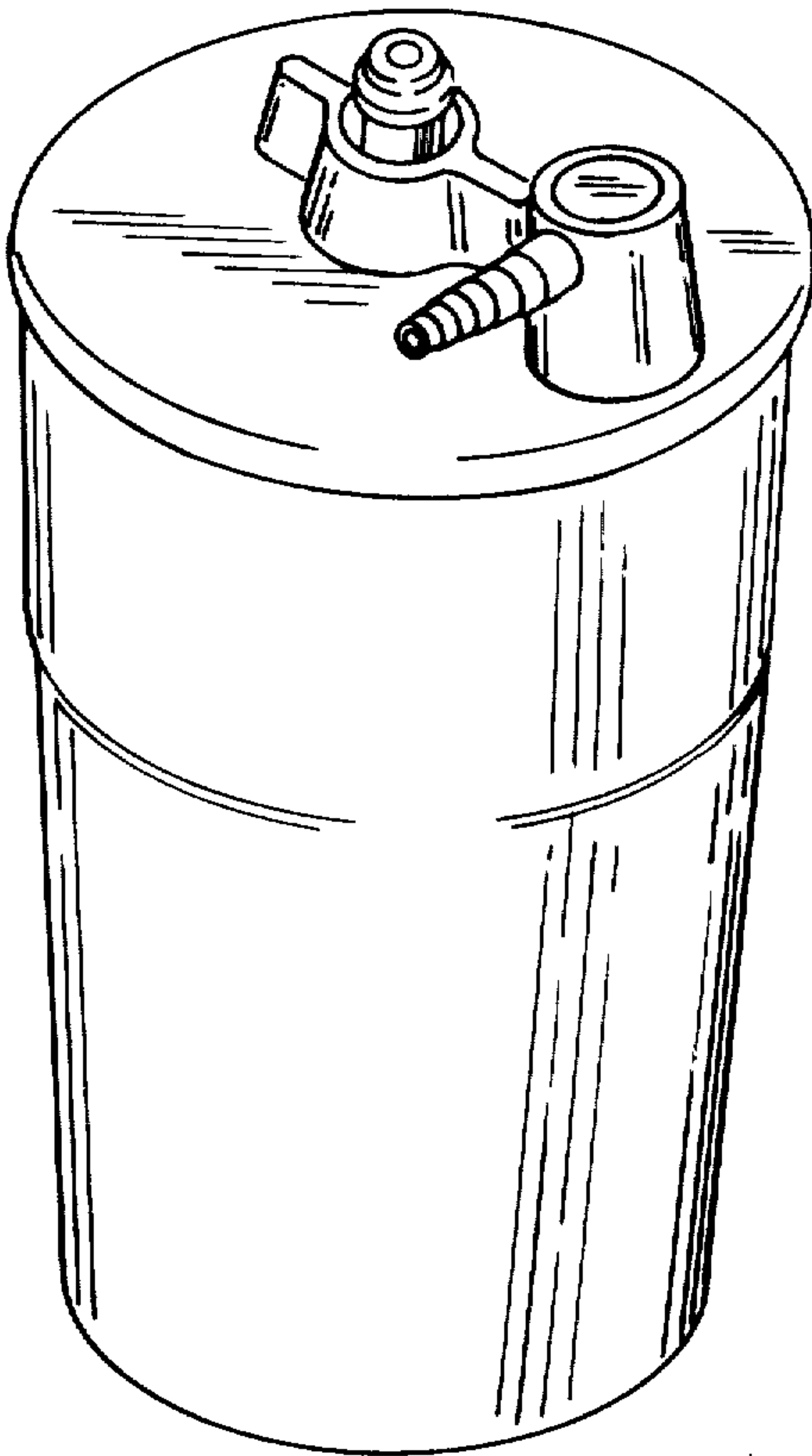

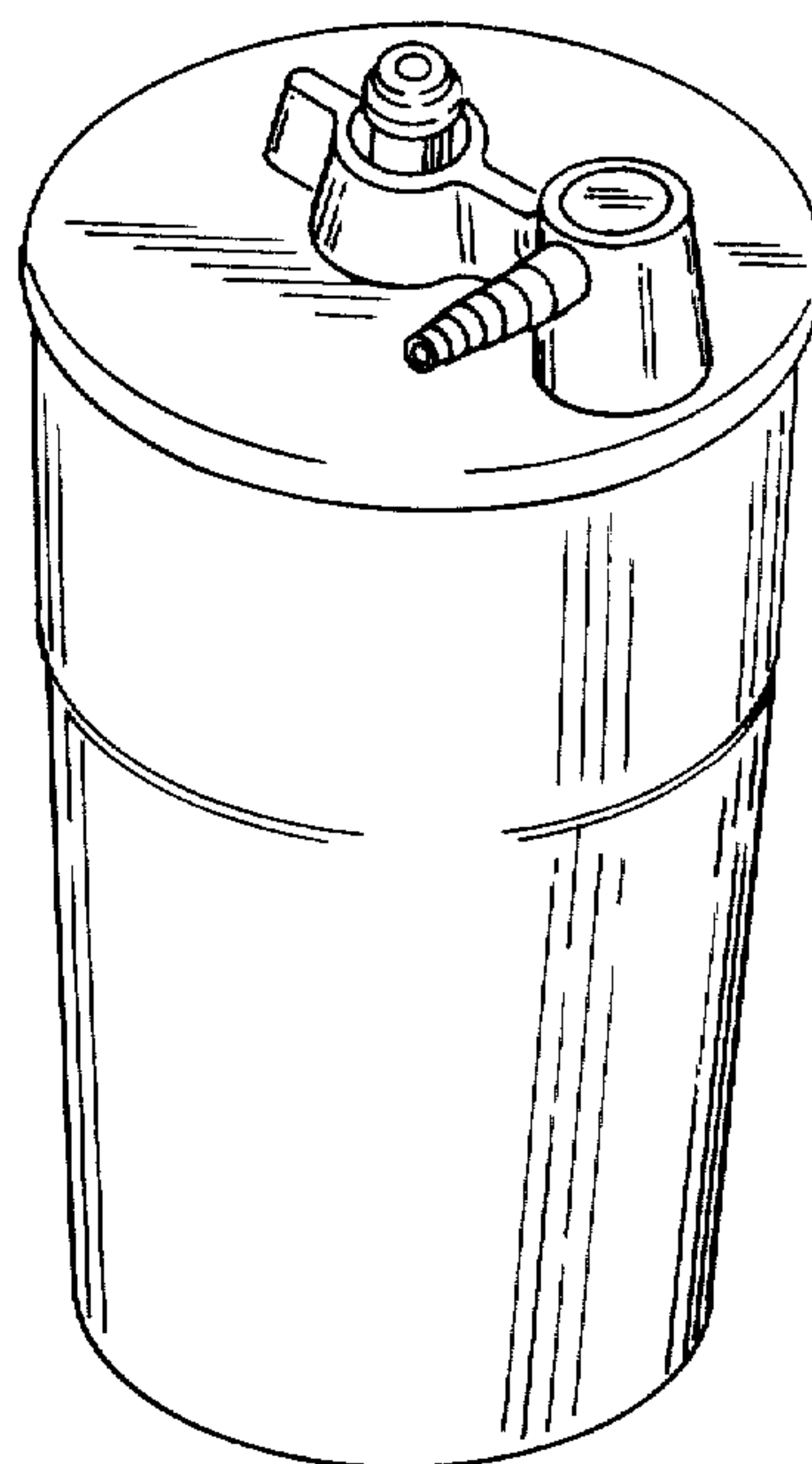
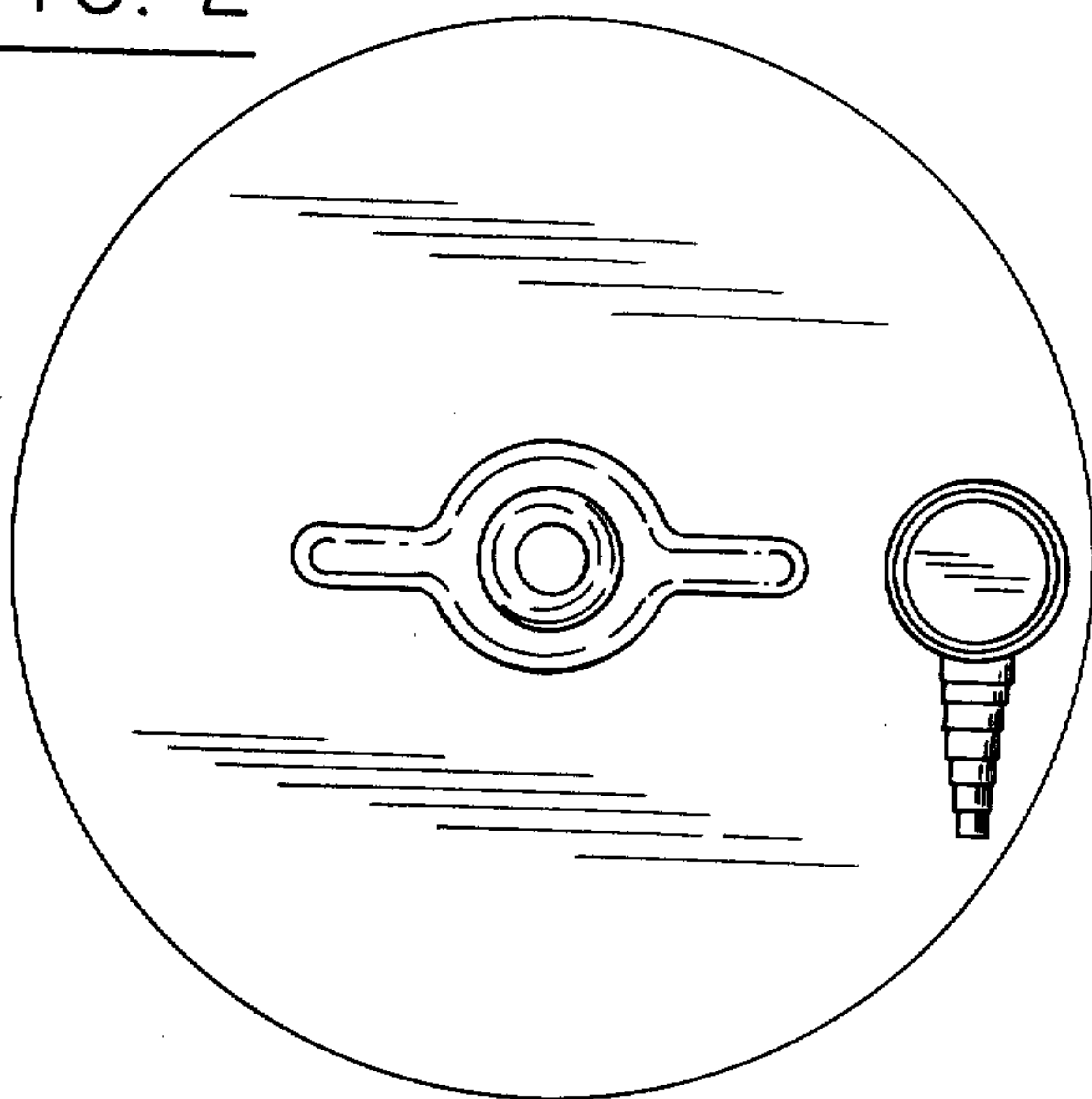

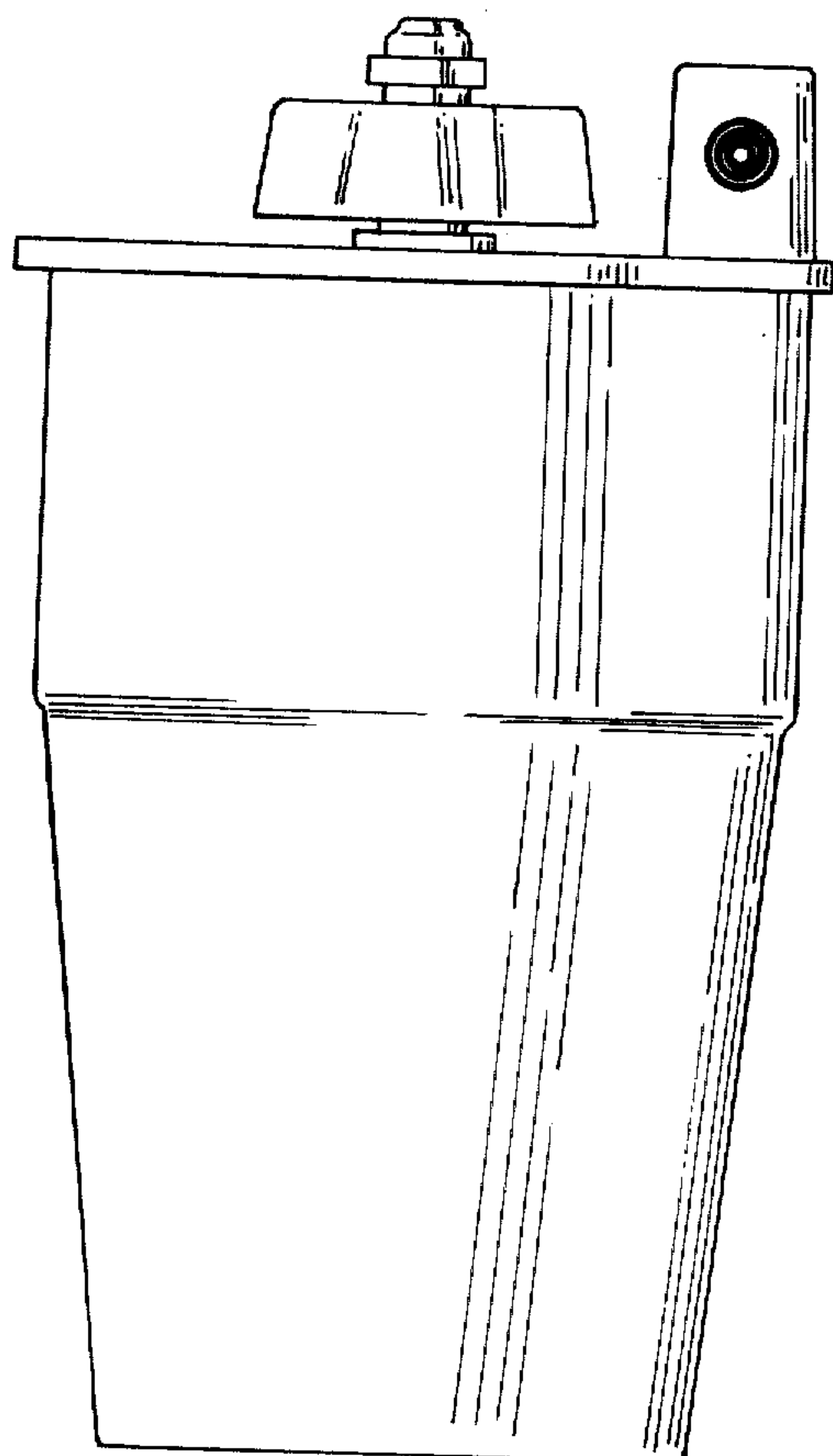

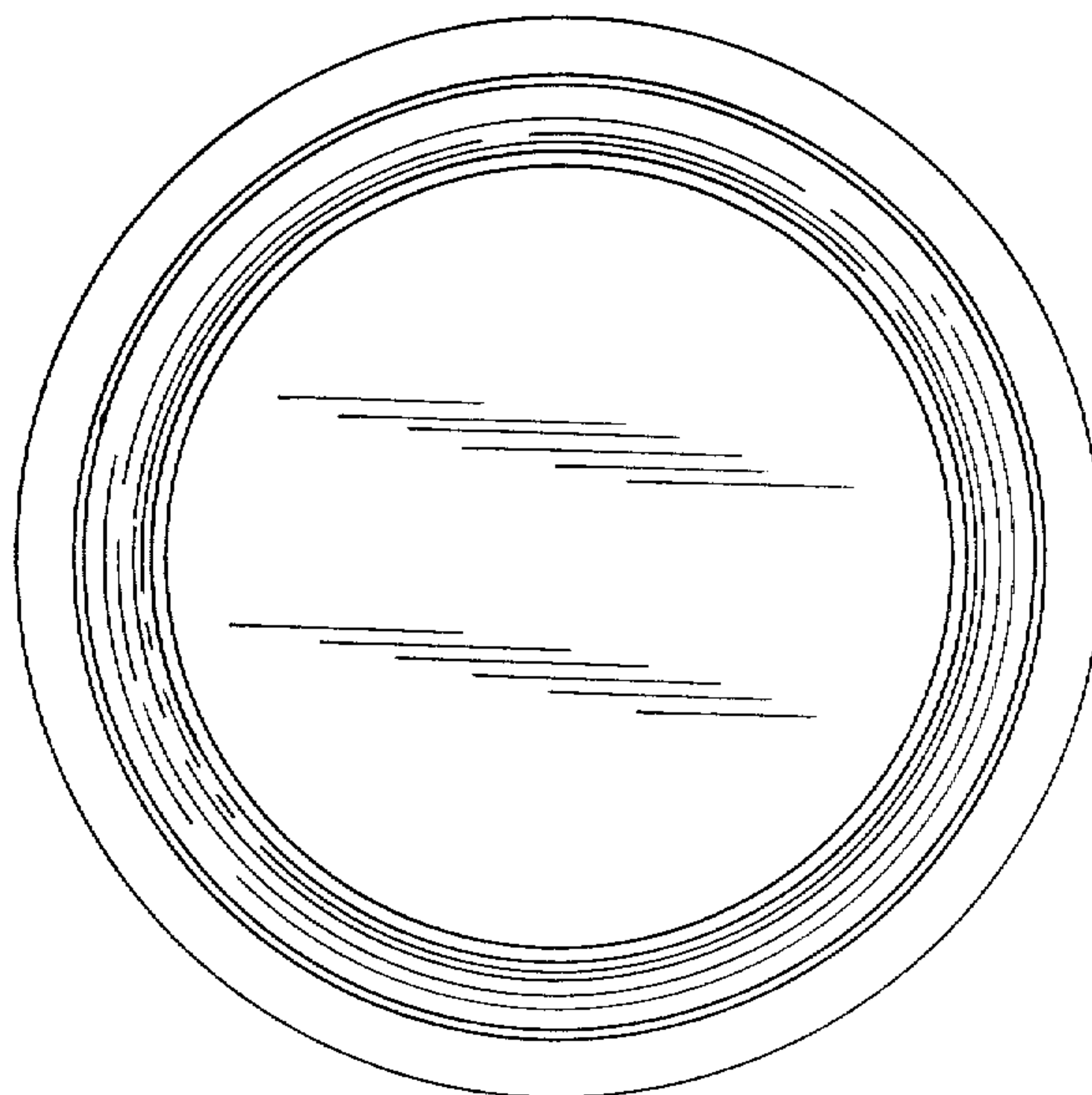
