[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a teller machine wall unit or the like, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of a teller machine wall unit or the like showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being identical; FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

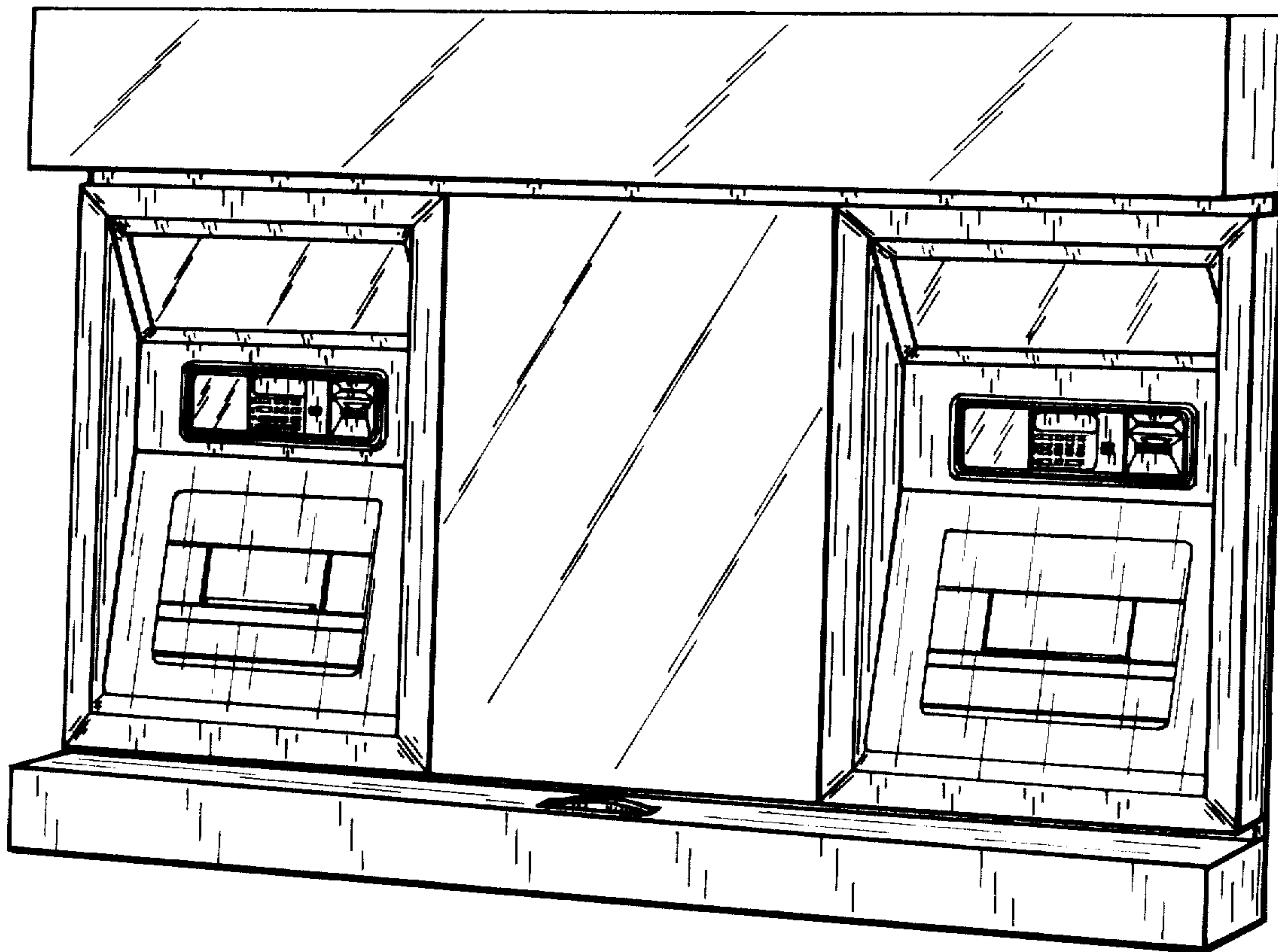

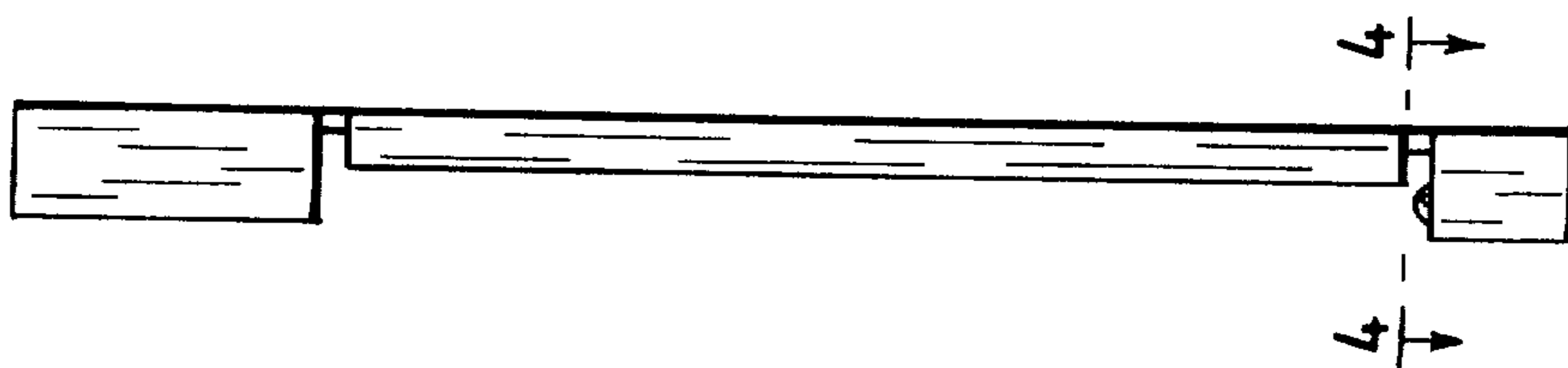

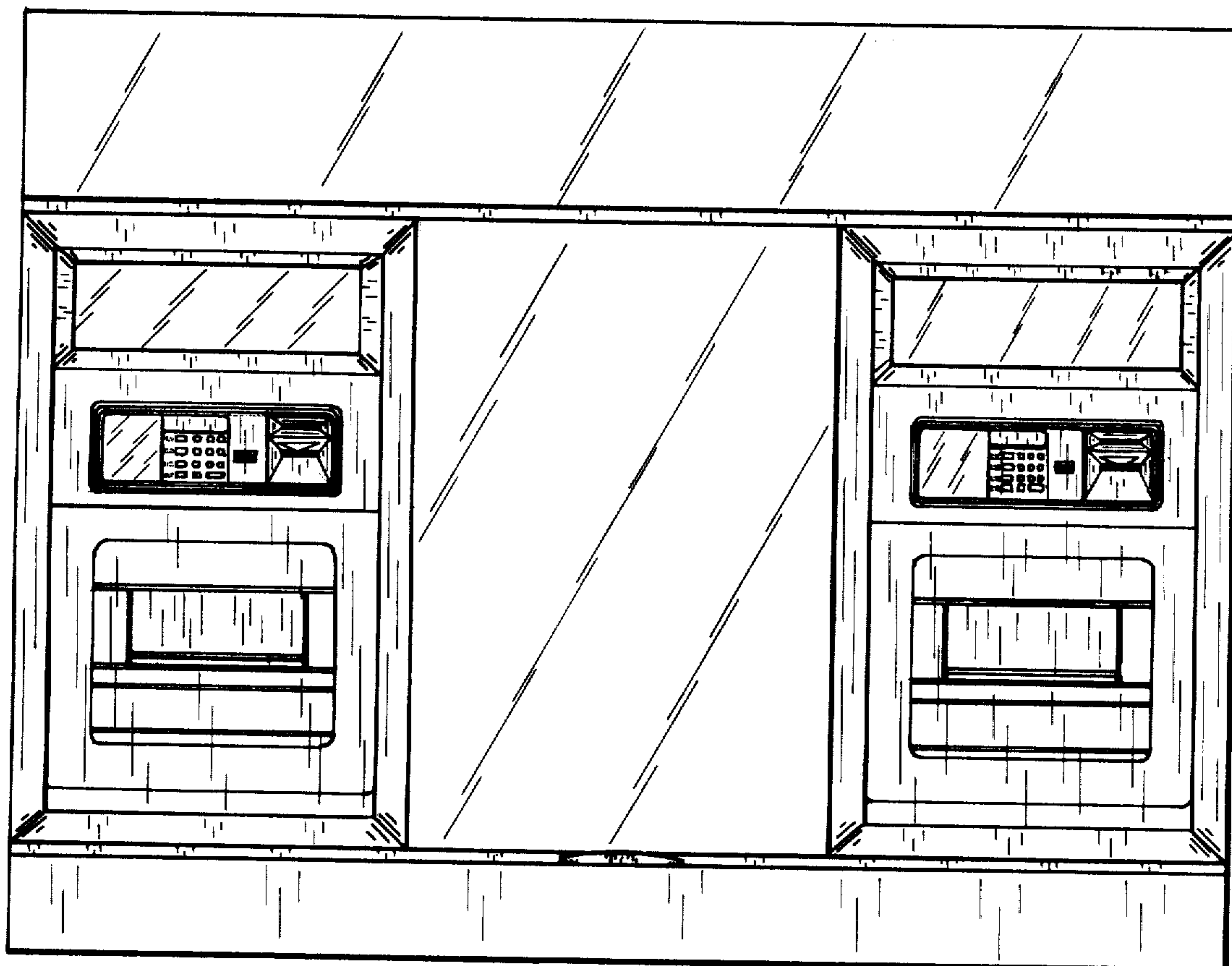

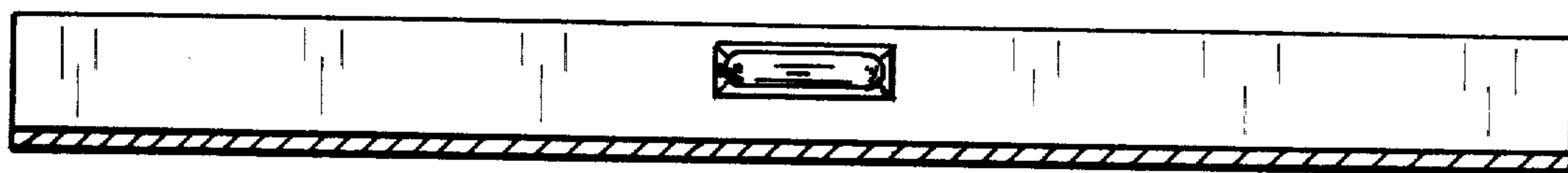
