FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a sole for footwear showing my new design;

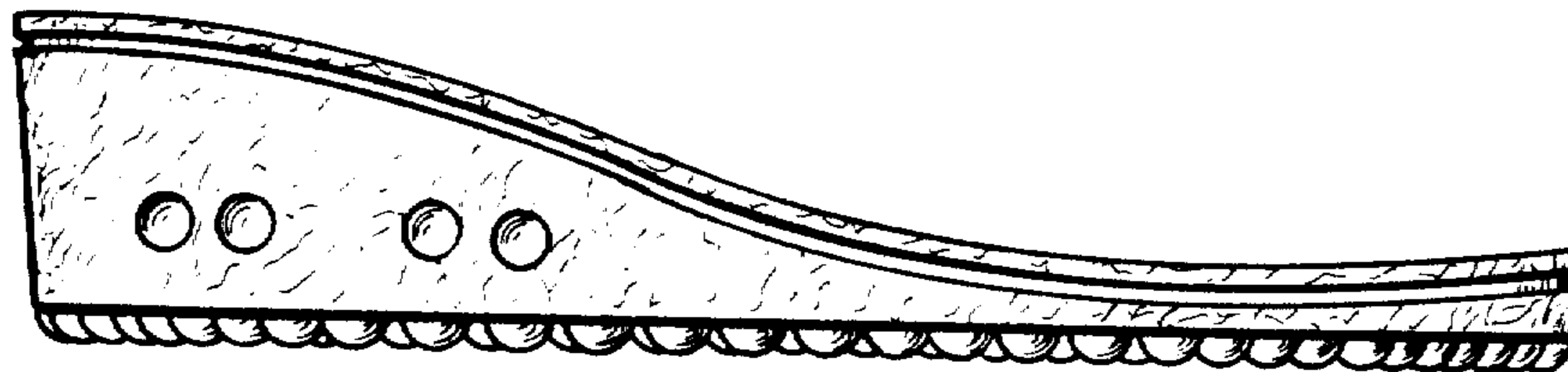
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



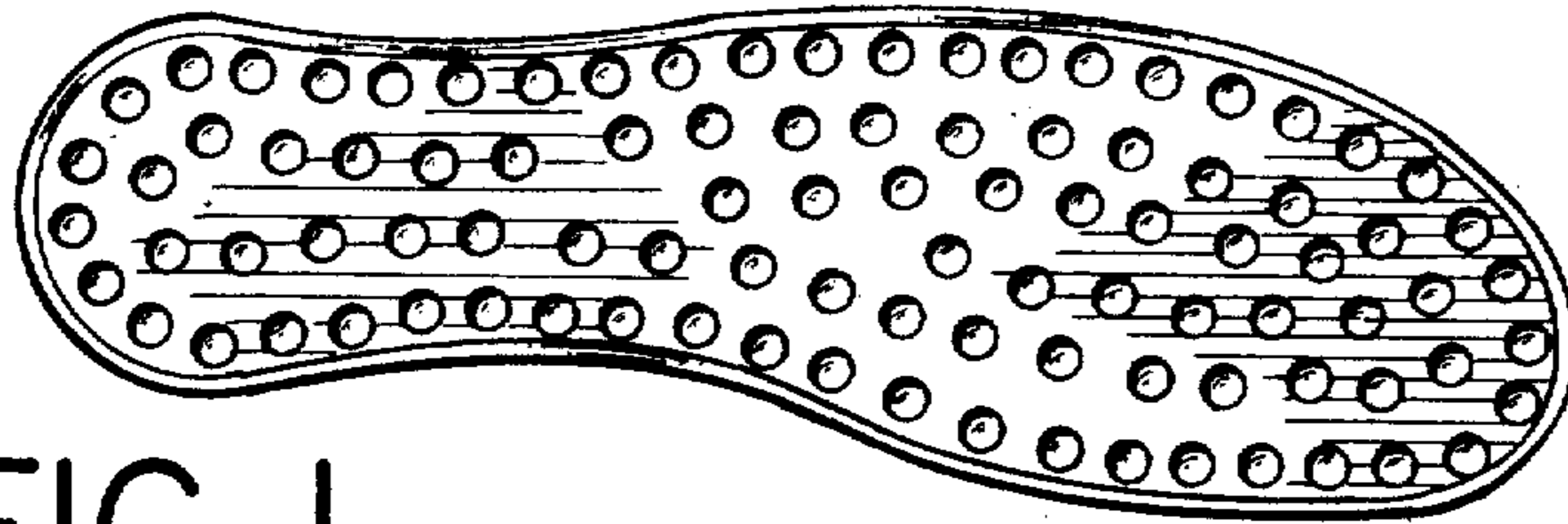

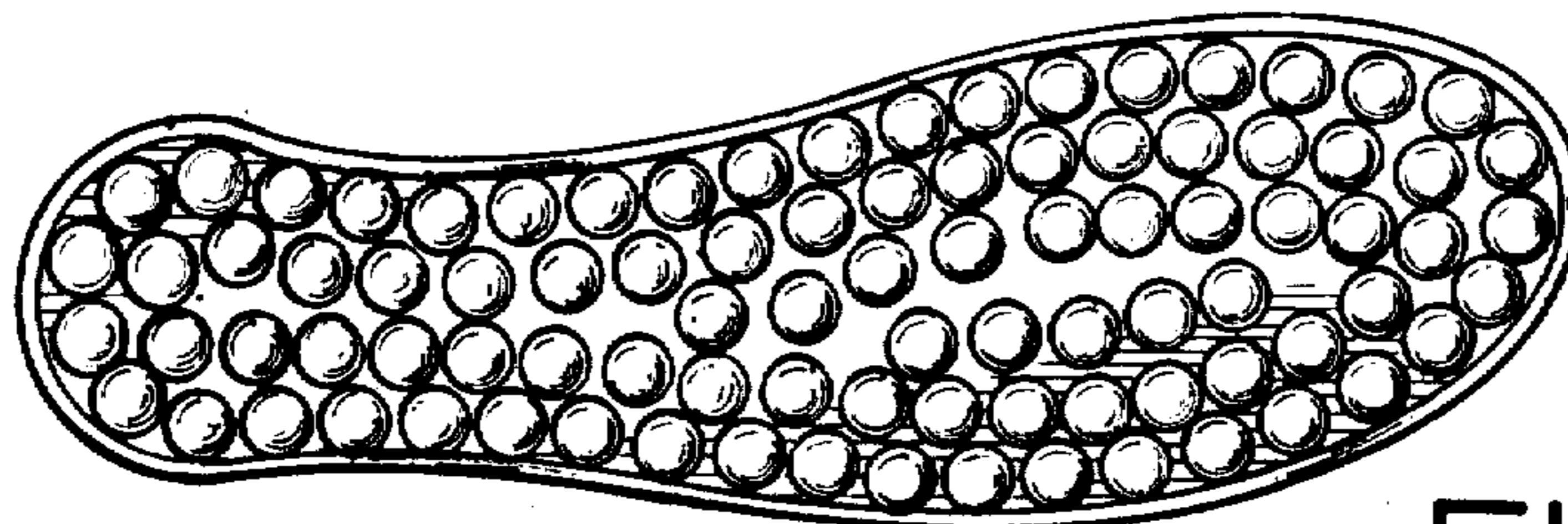

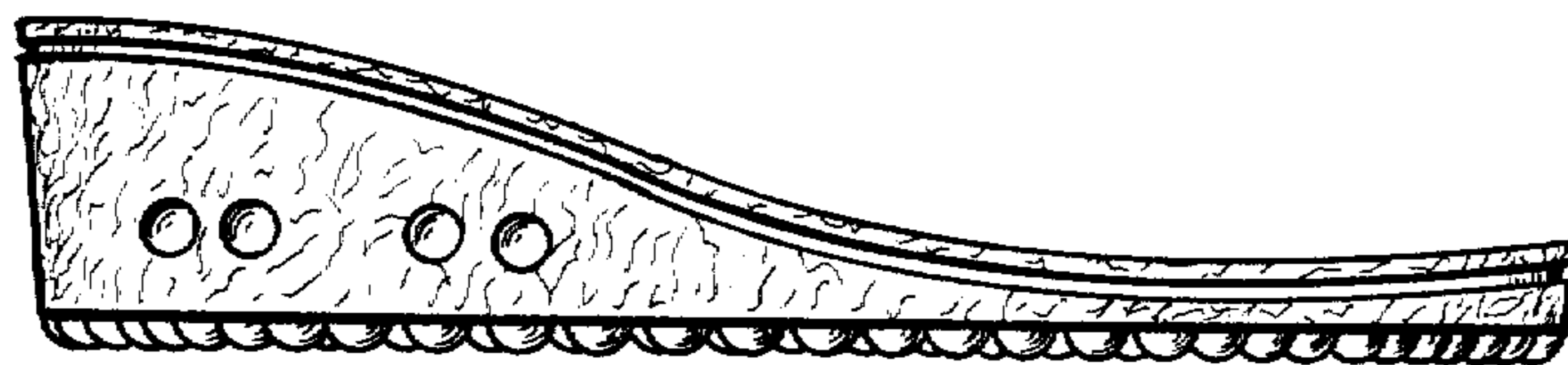

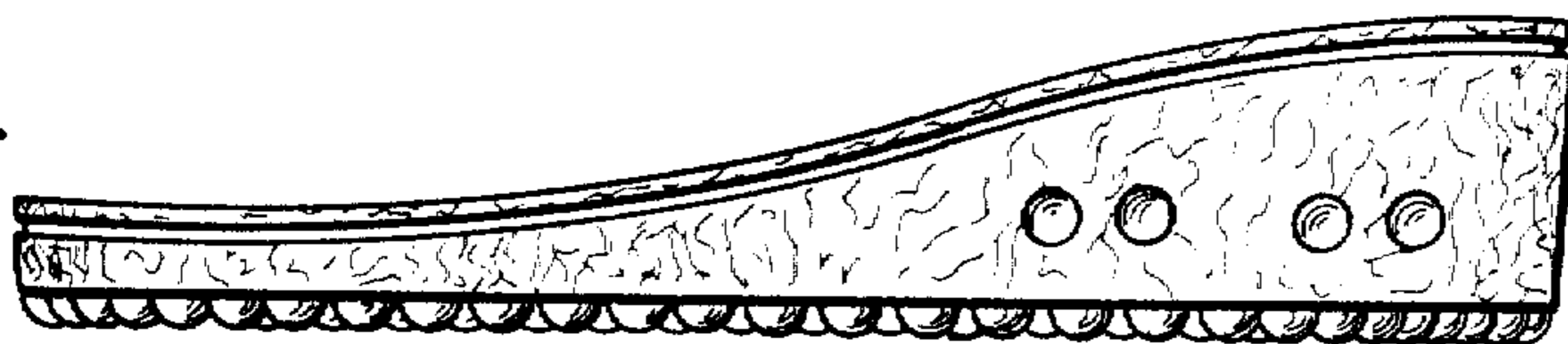

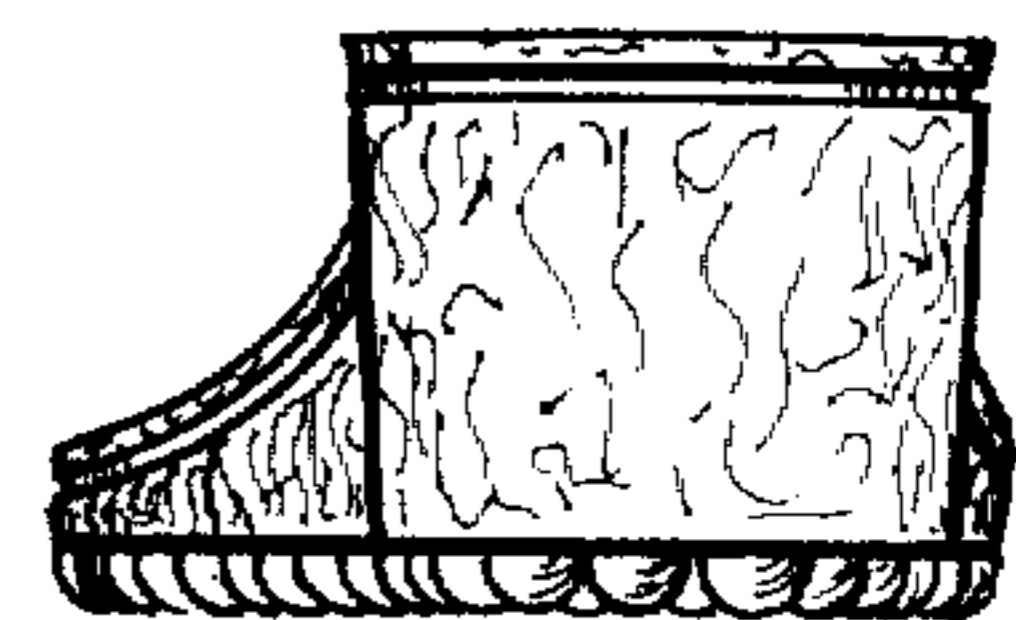

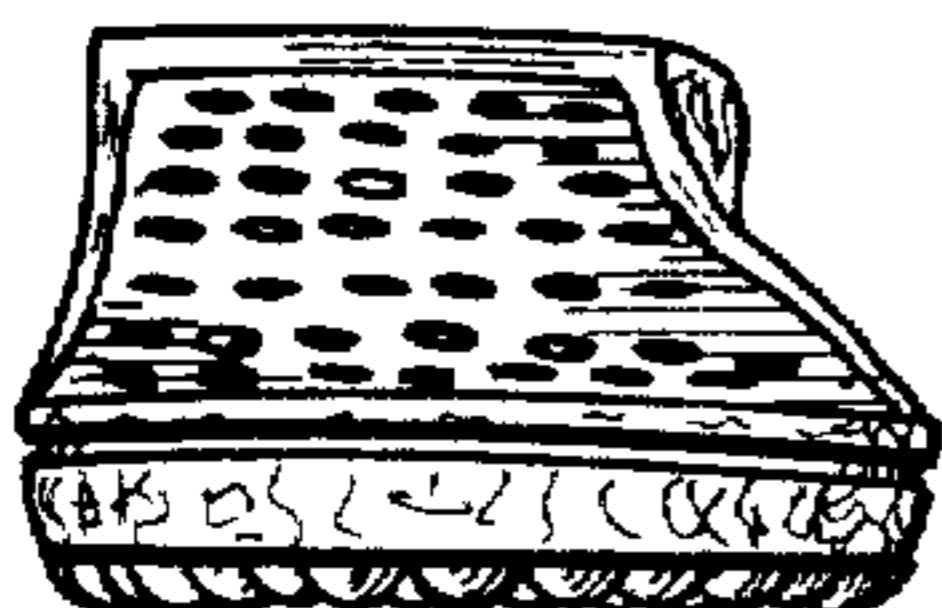
