[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a musical instrument stand, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a musical instrument stand showing my new design in extended condition; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the stand in partially collapsed condition; FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the stand in a collapsed condition.

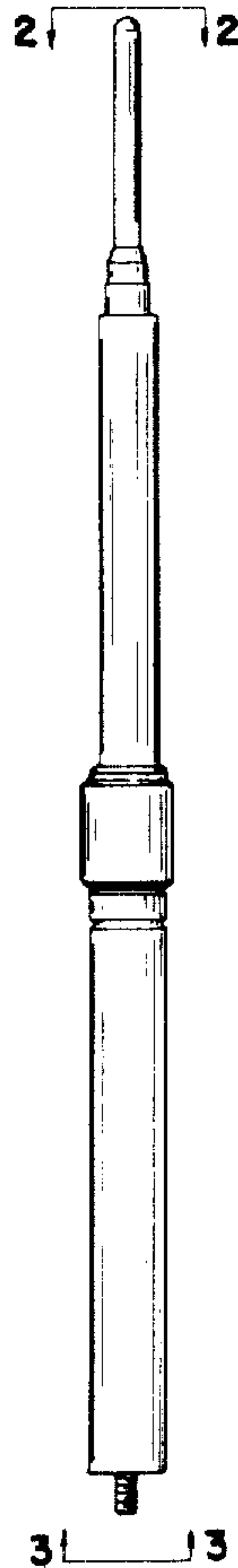

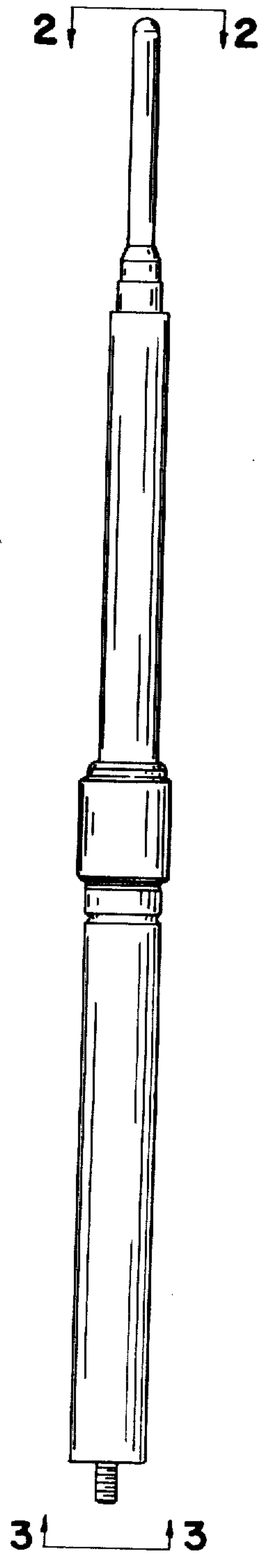

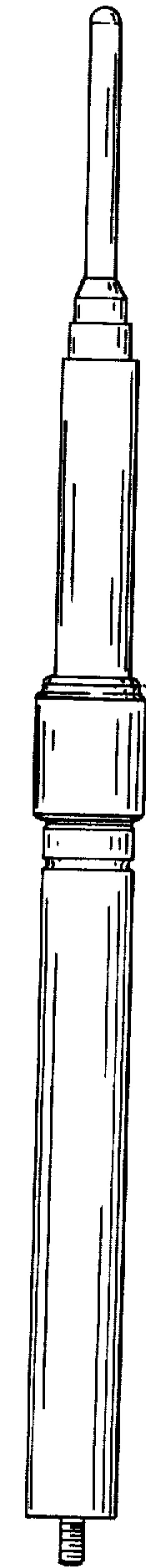

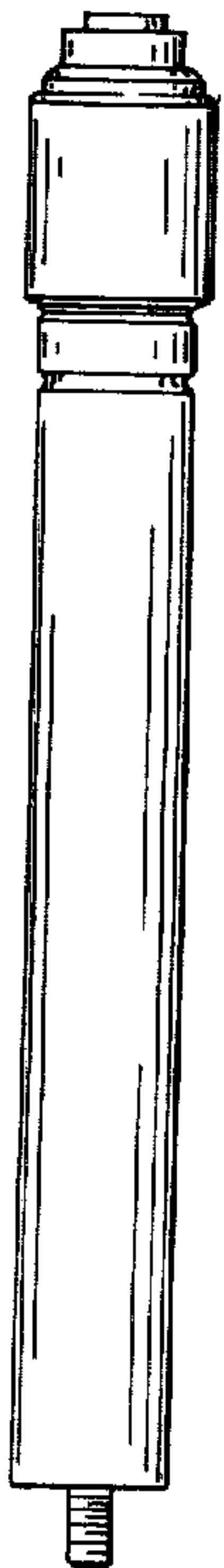
