An ornamental design for a compost bin, as shown.

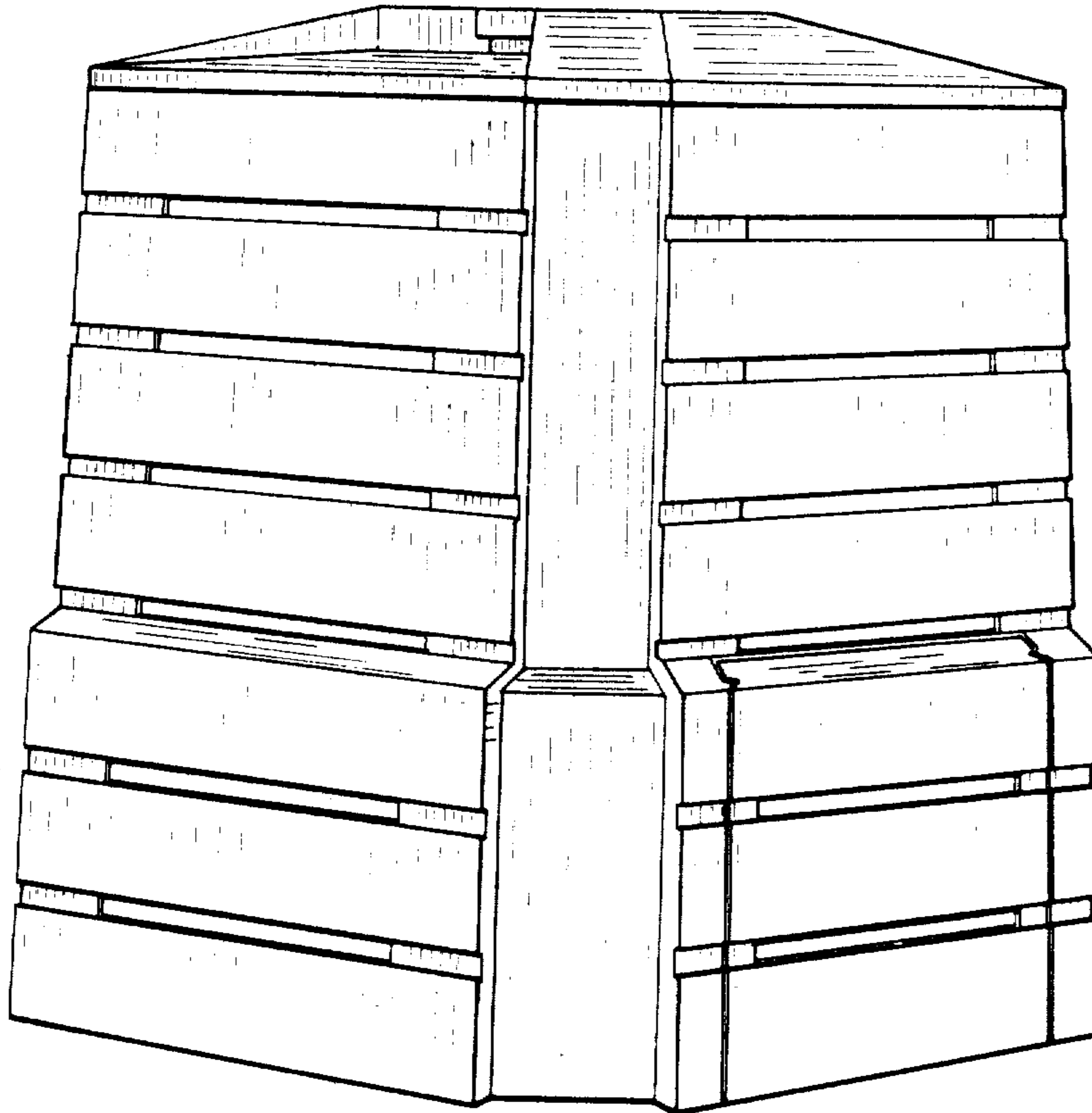
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a sectional view through one wall of the bin.



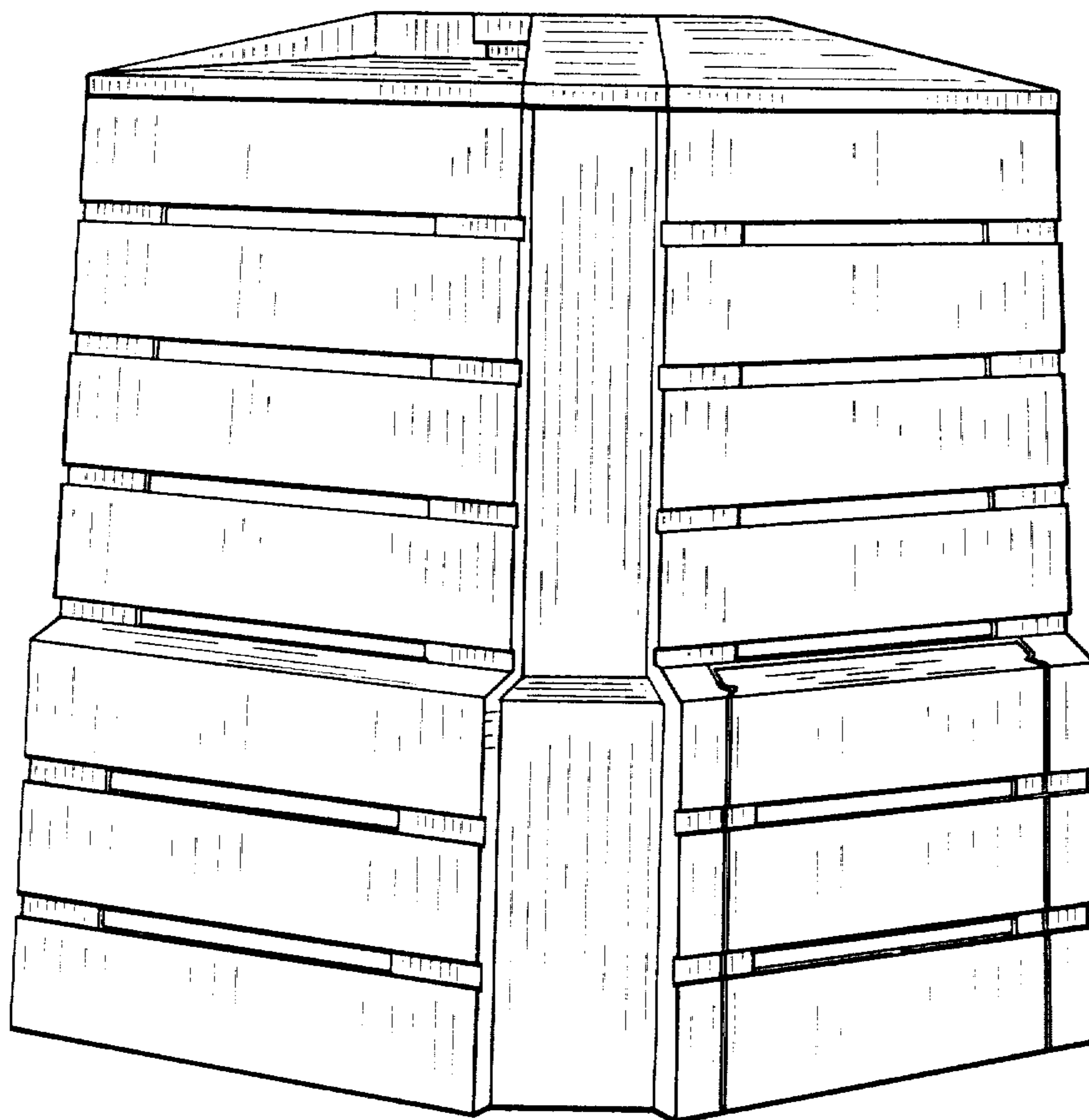

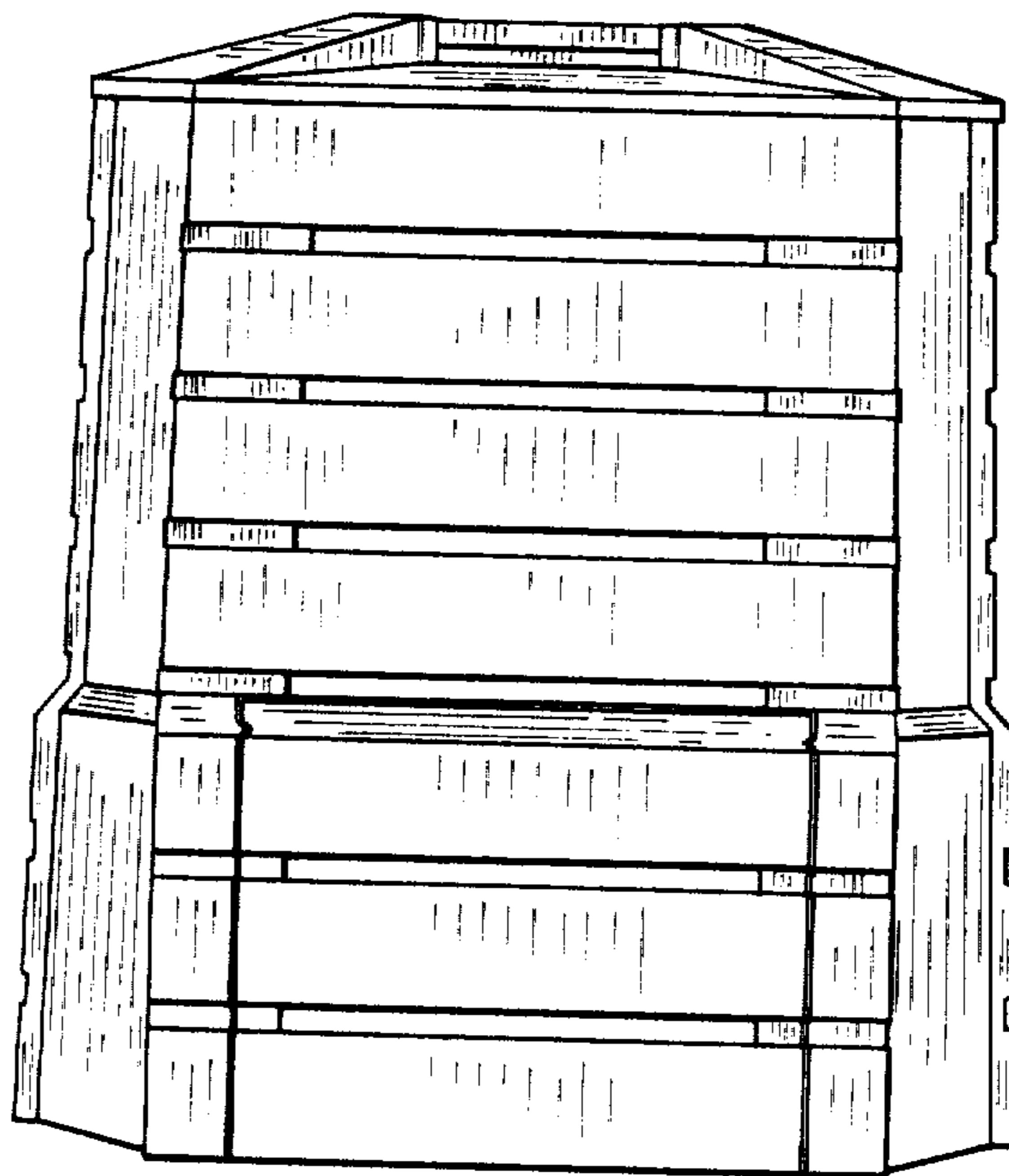
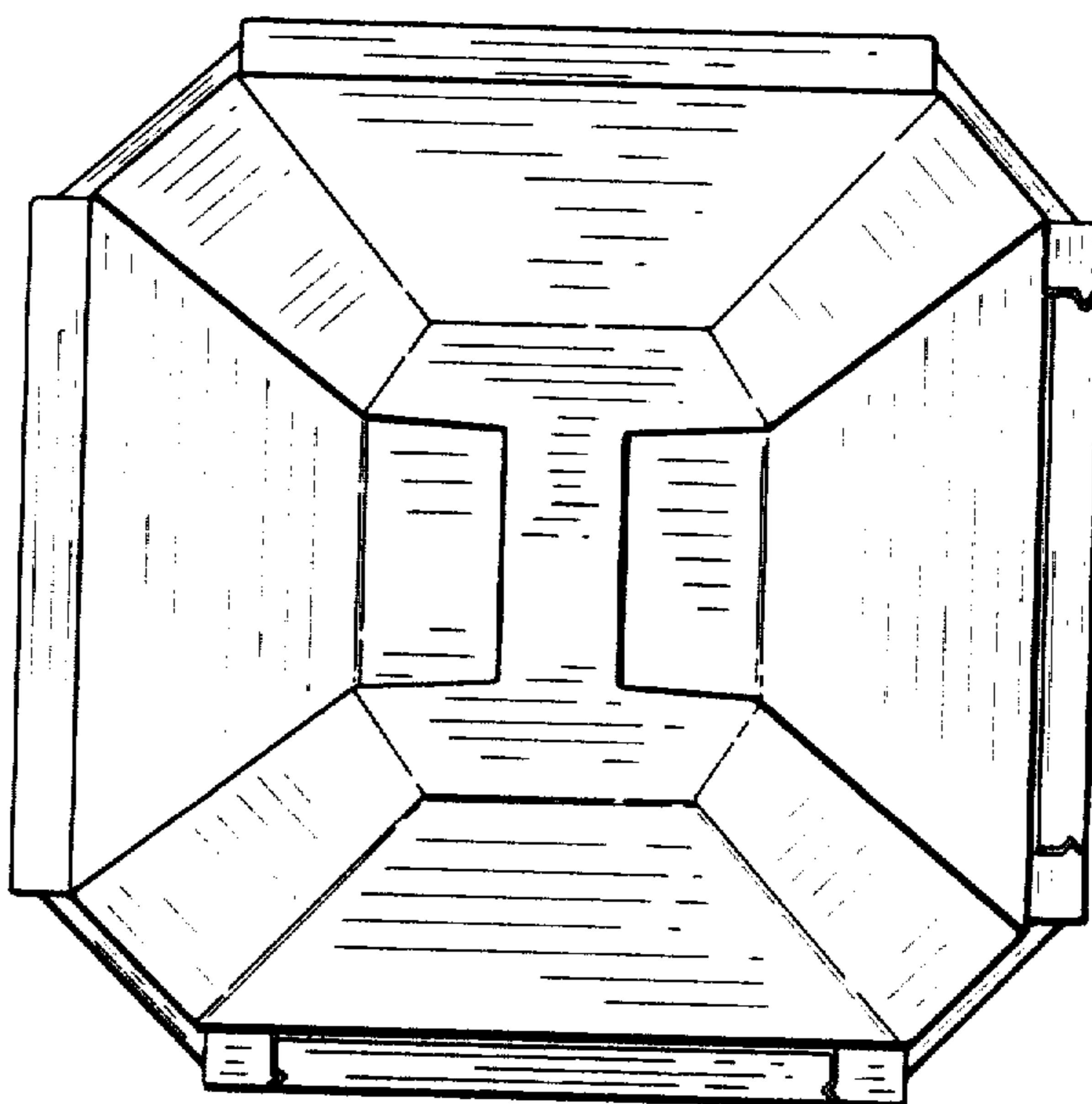

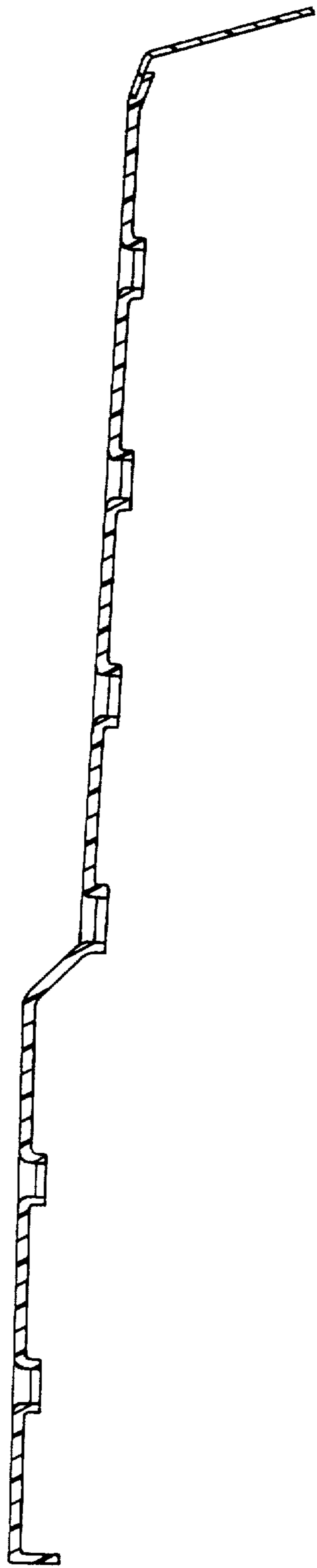
