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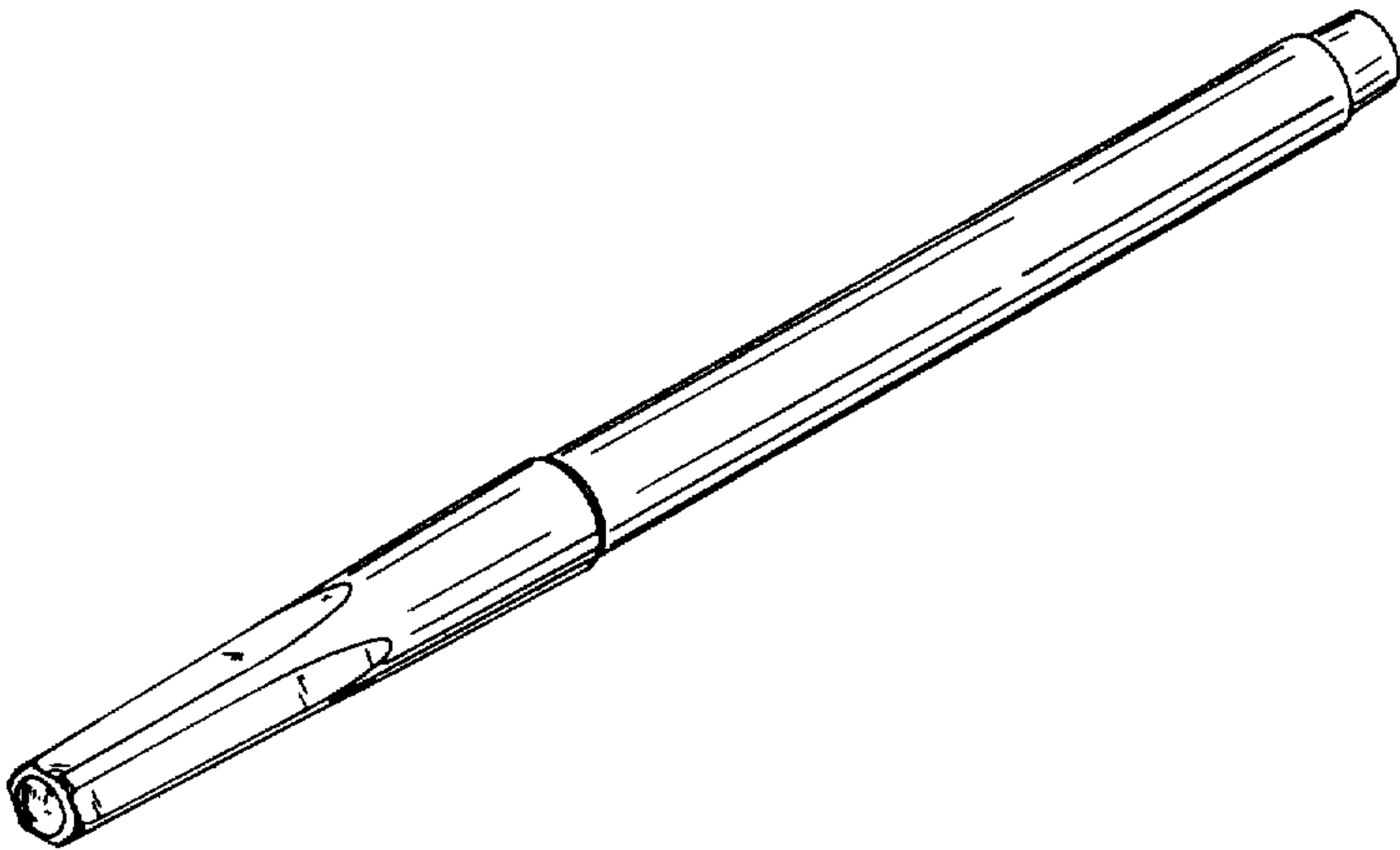

DESCRIPTION

showing my new design;

FIG. 14 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 8.



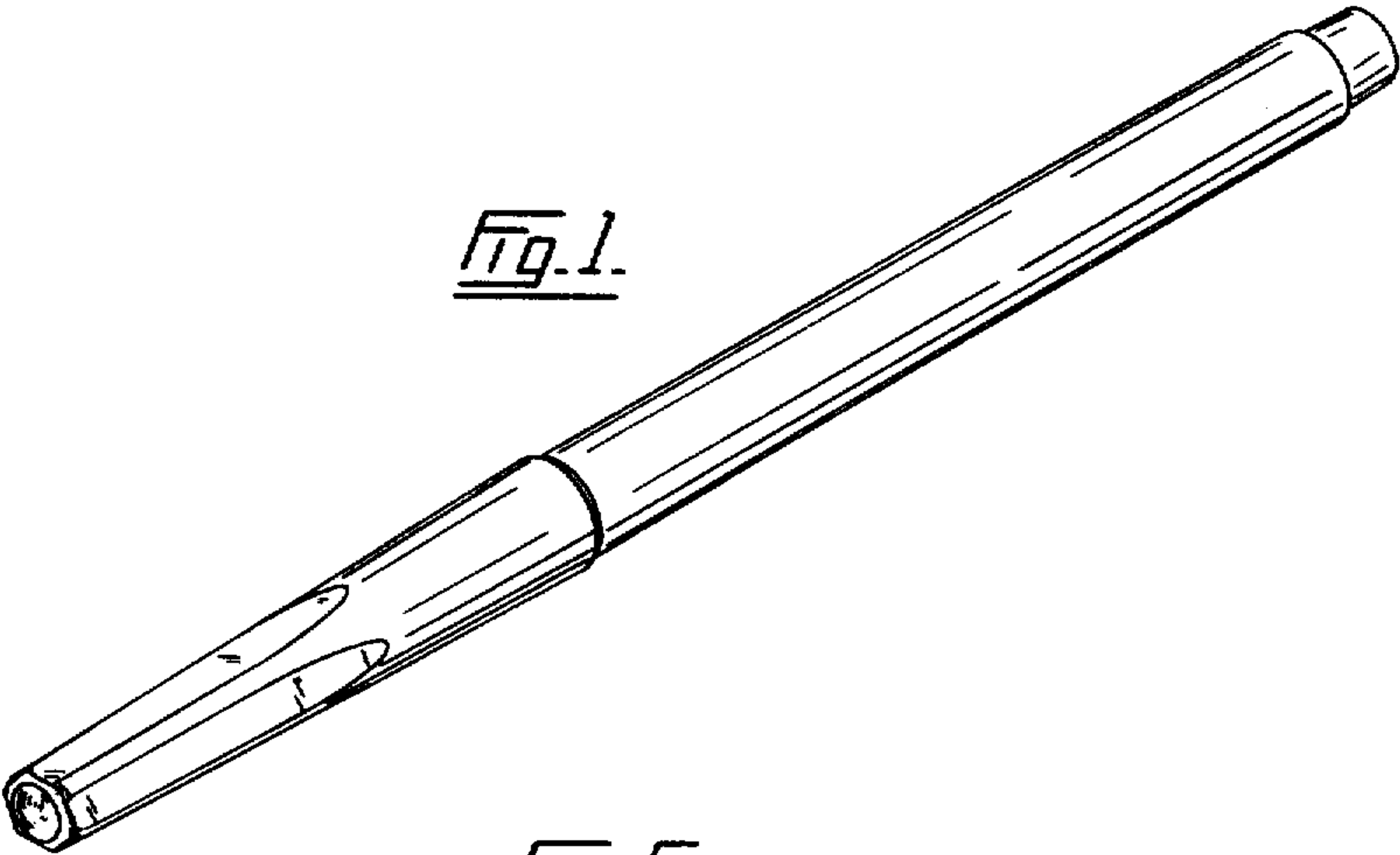

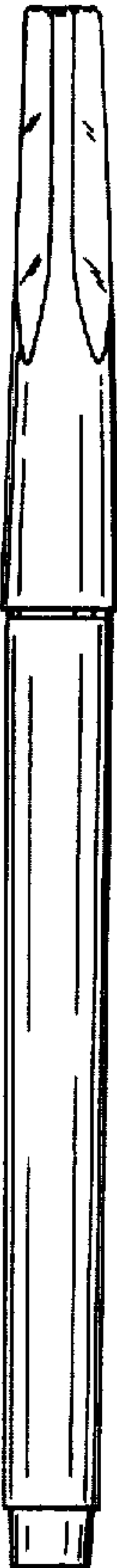

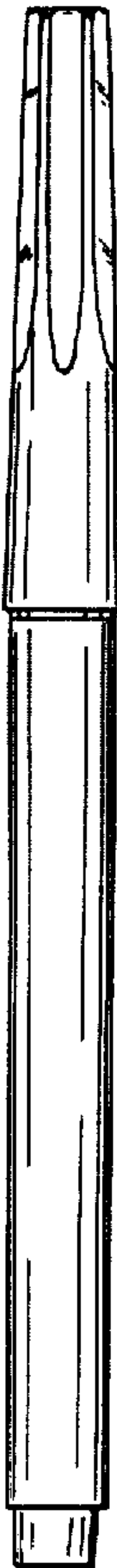
