[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for medallions called zodiacal cusp medallions, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a zodiacal cusp medallion showing my new design, the medallion being of conventional thickness and having the back thereof plain; and

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a zodiacal cusp medallion showing a modified form of my new design, also of conventional thickness and having the back thereof plain.

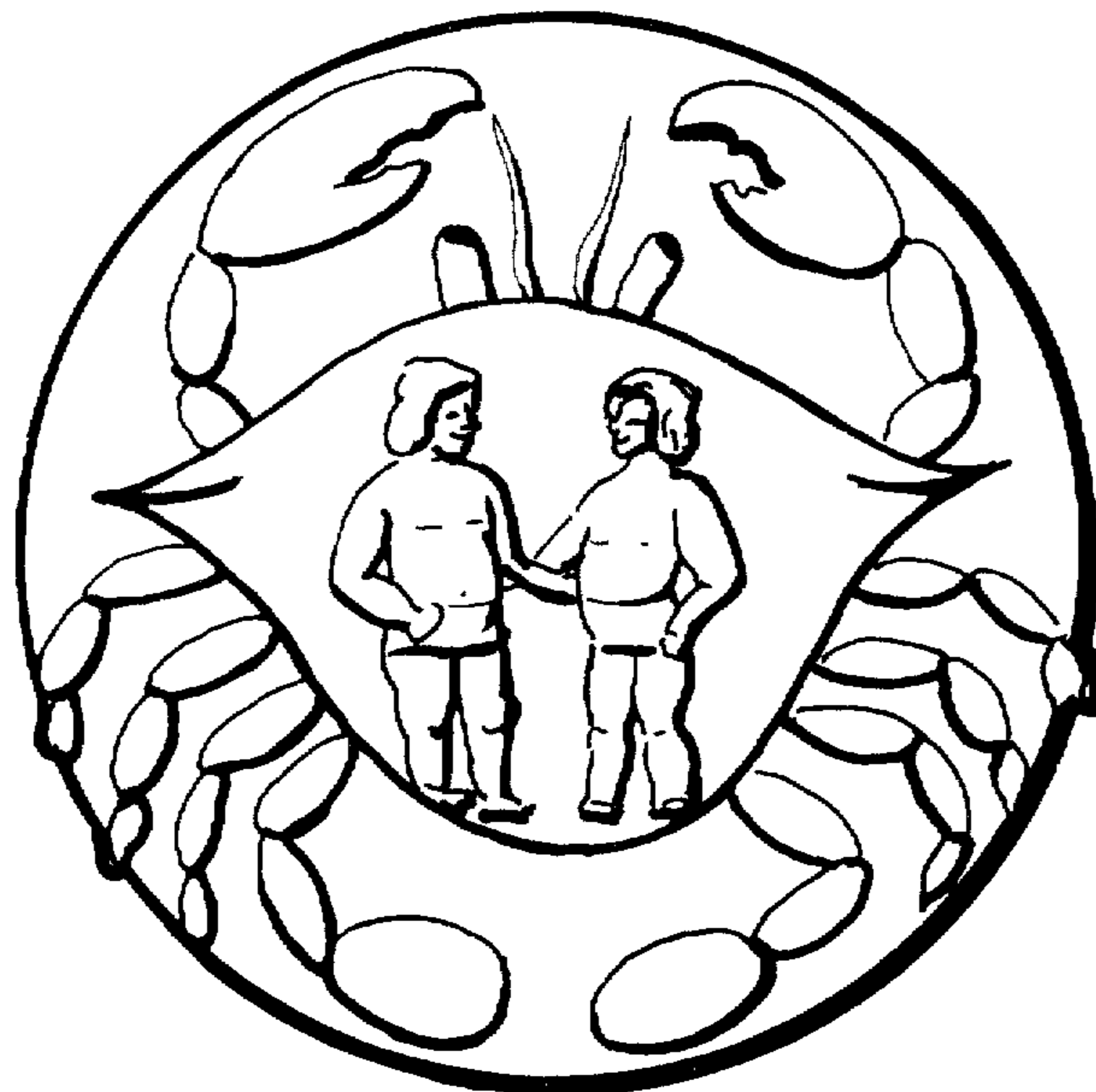

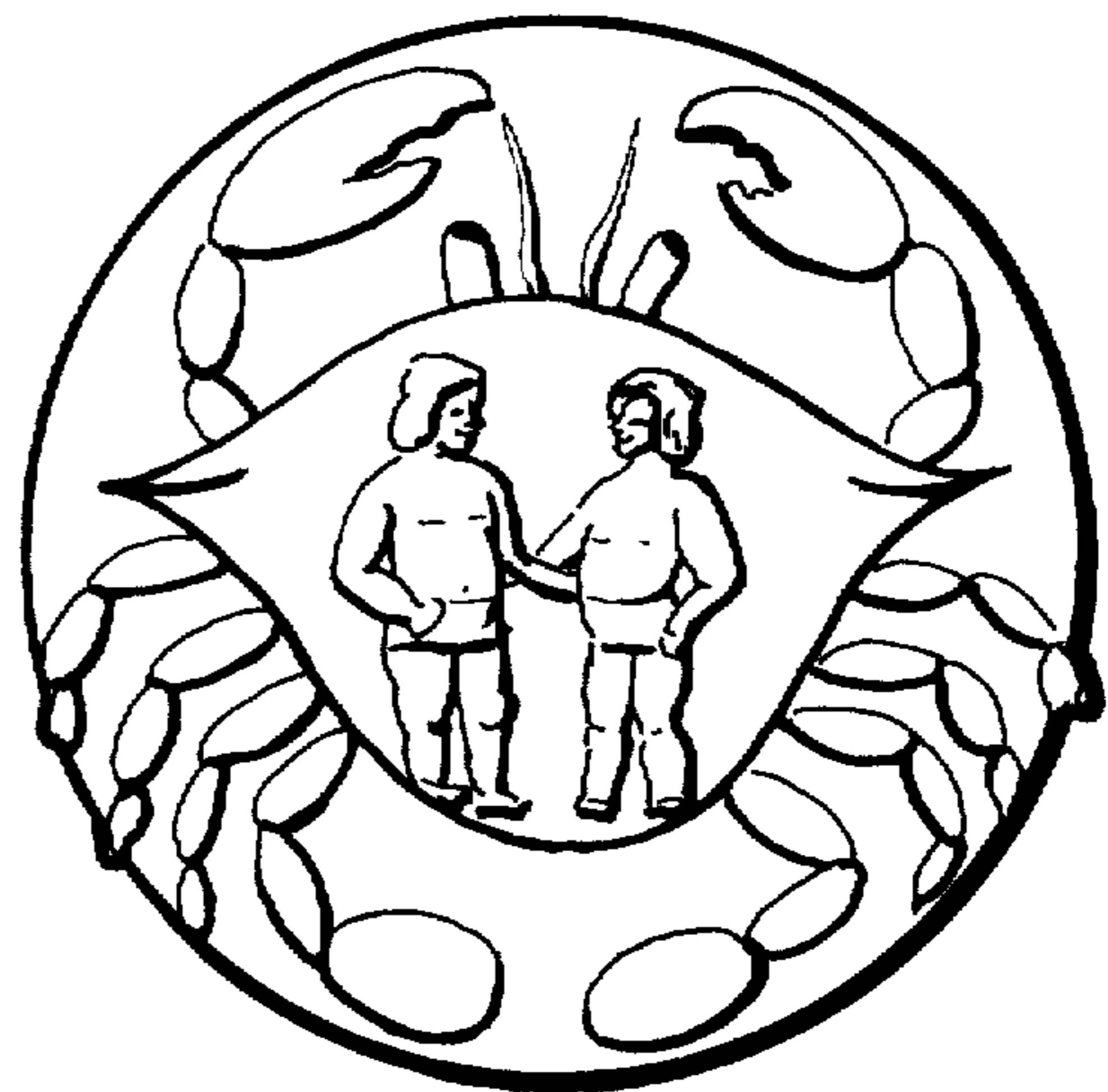
