The ornamental design for a simulative driving toy, as shown and described.

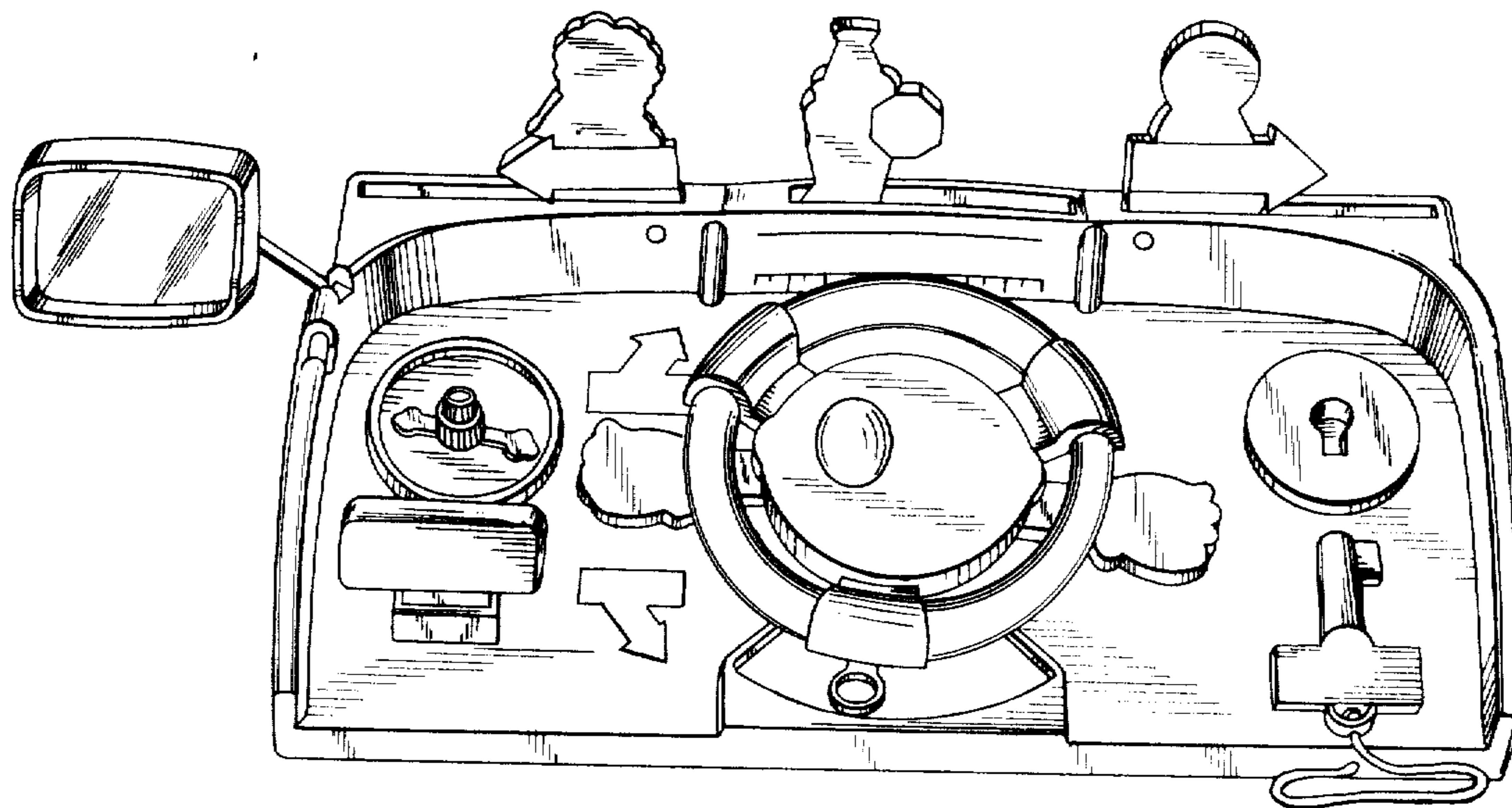
DESCRIPTION

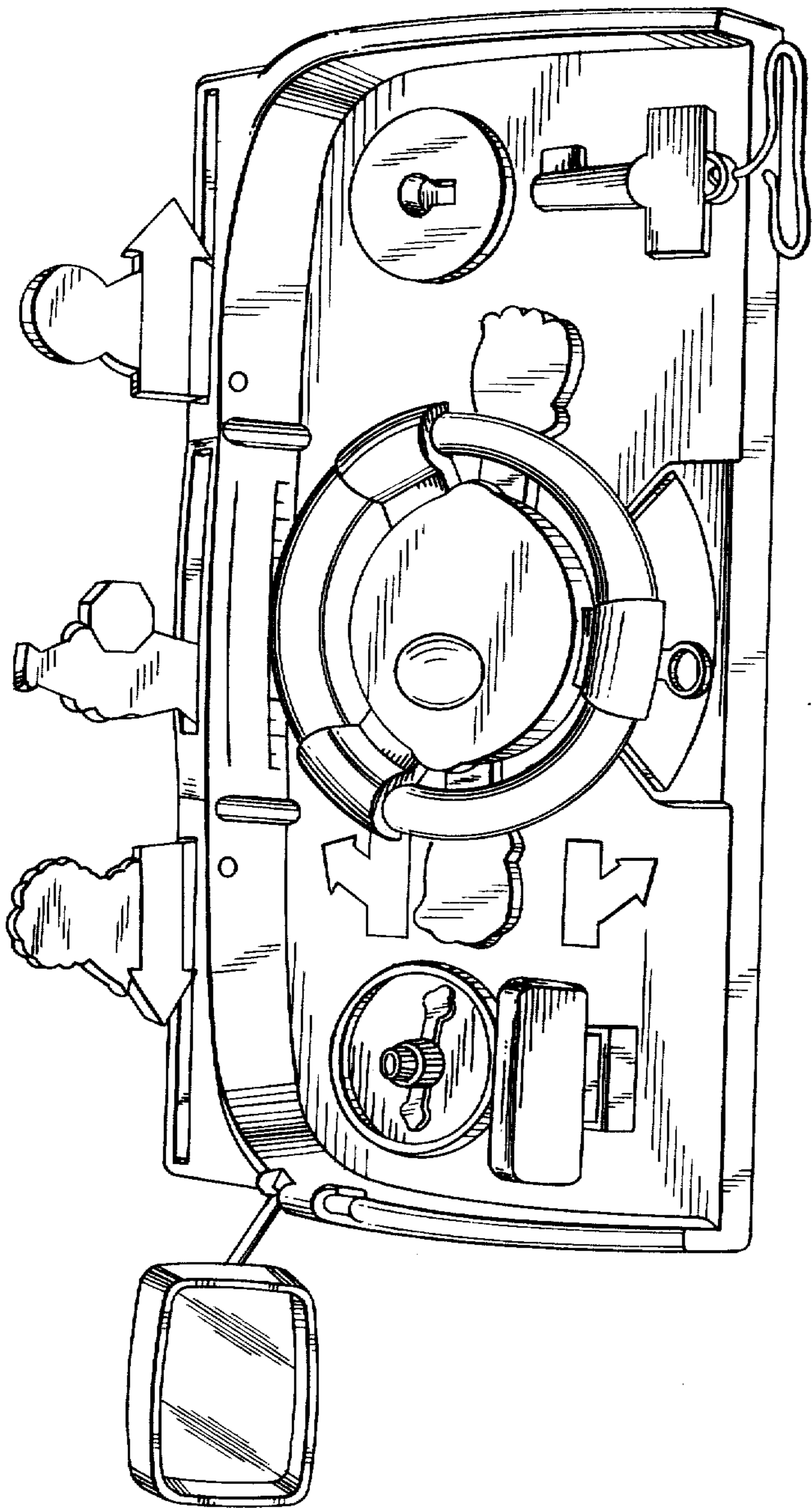

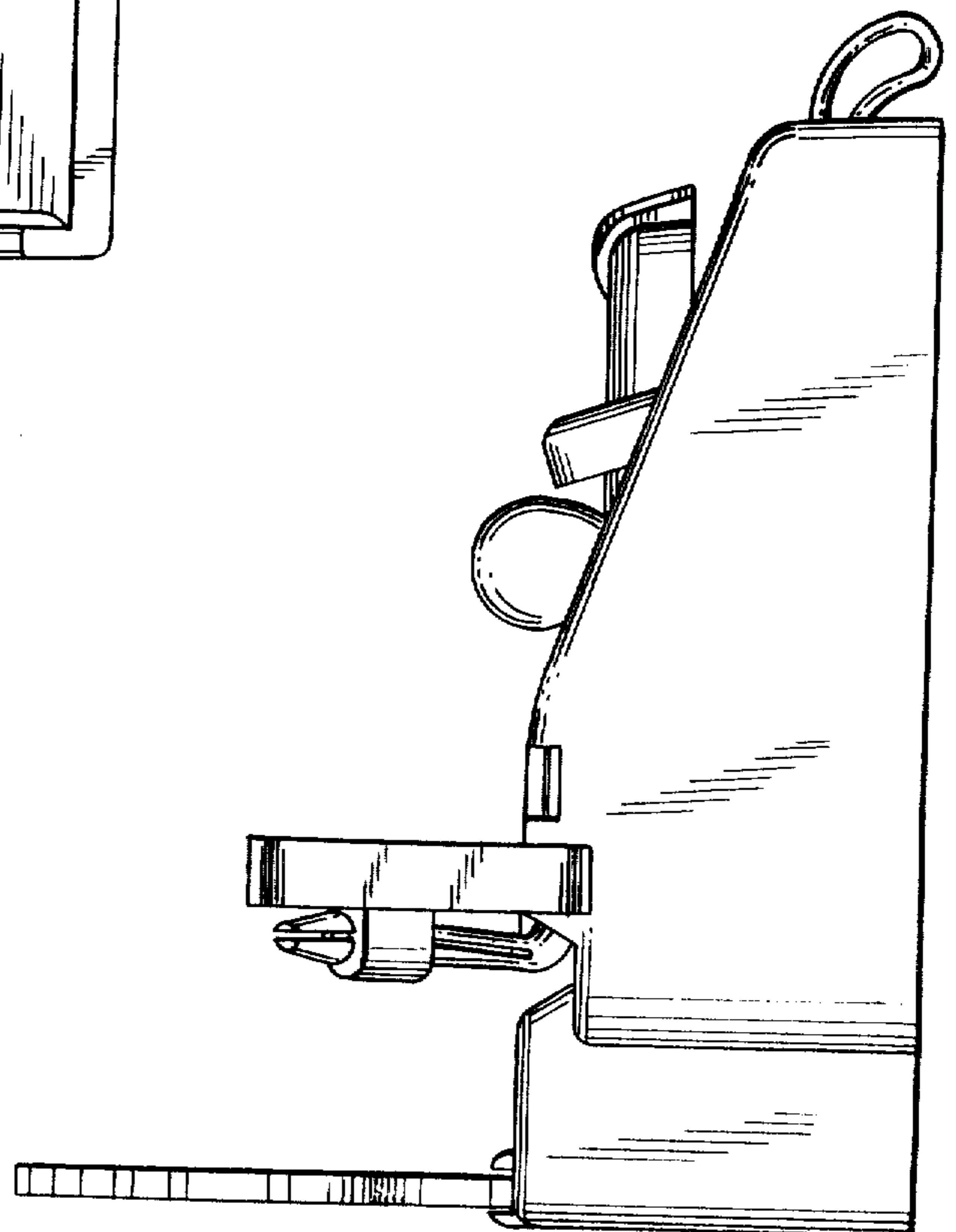

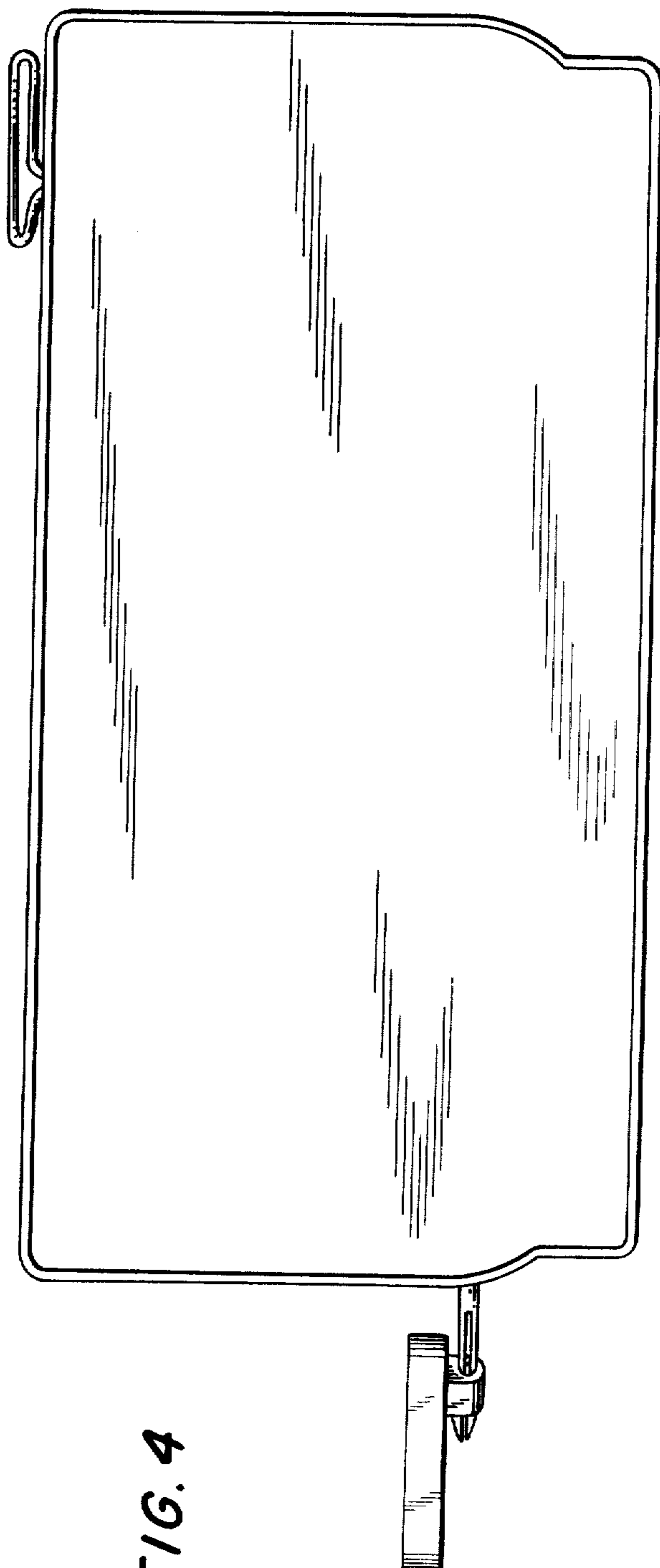
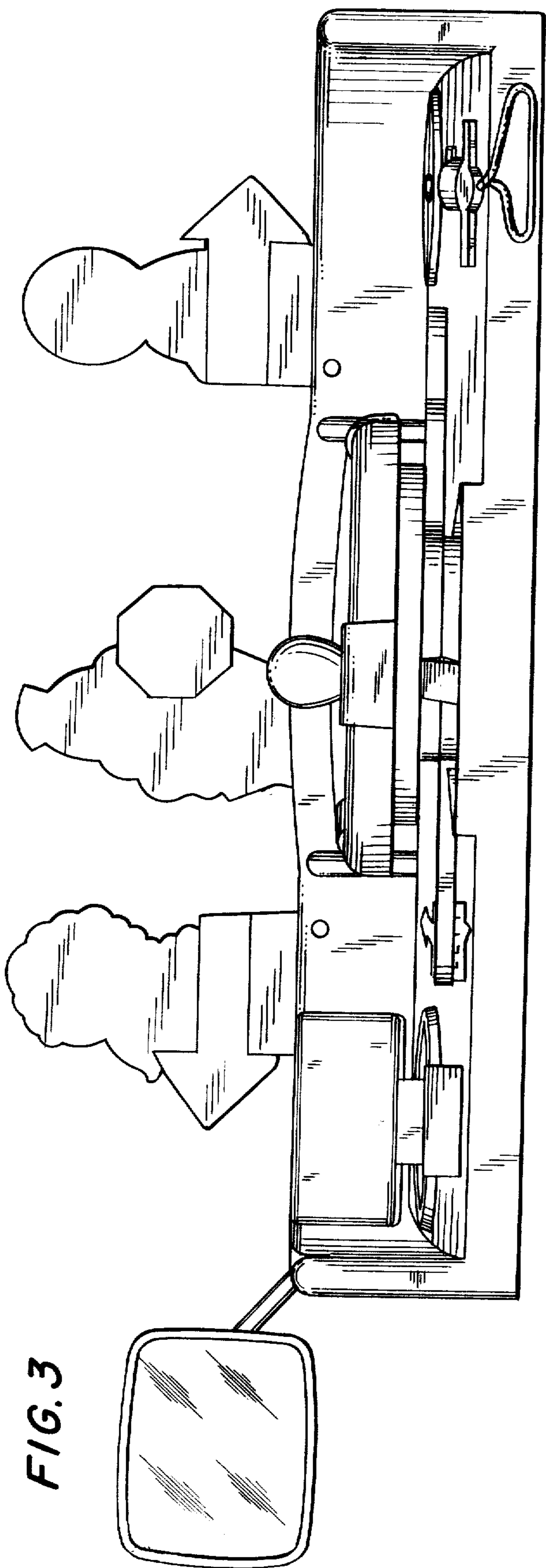

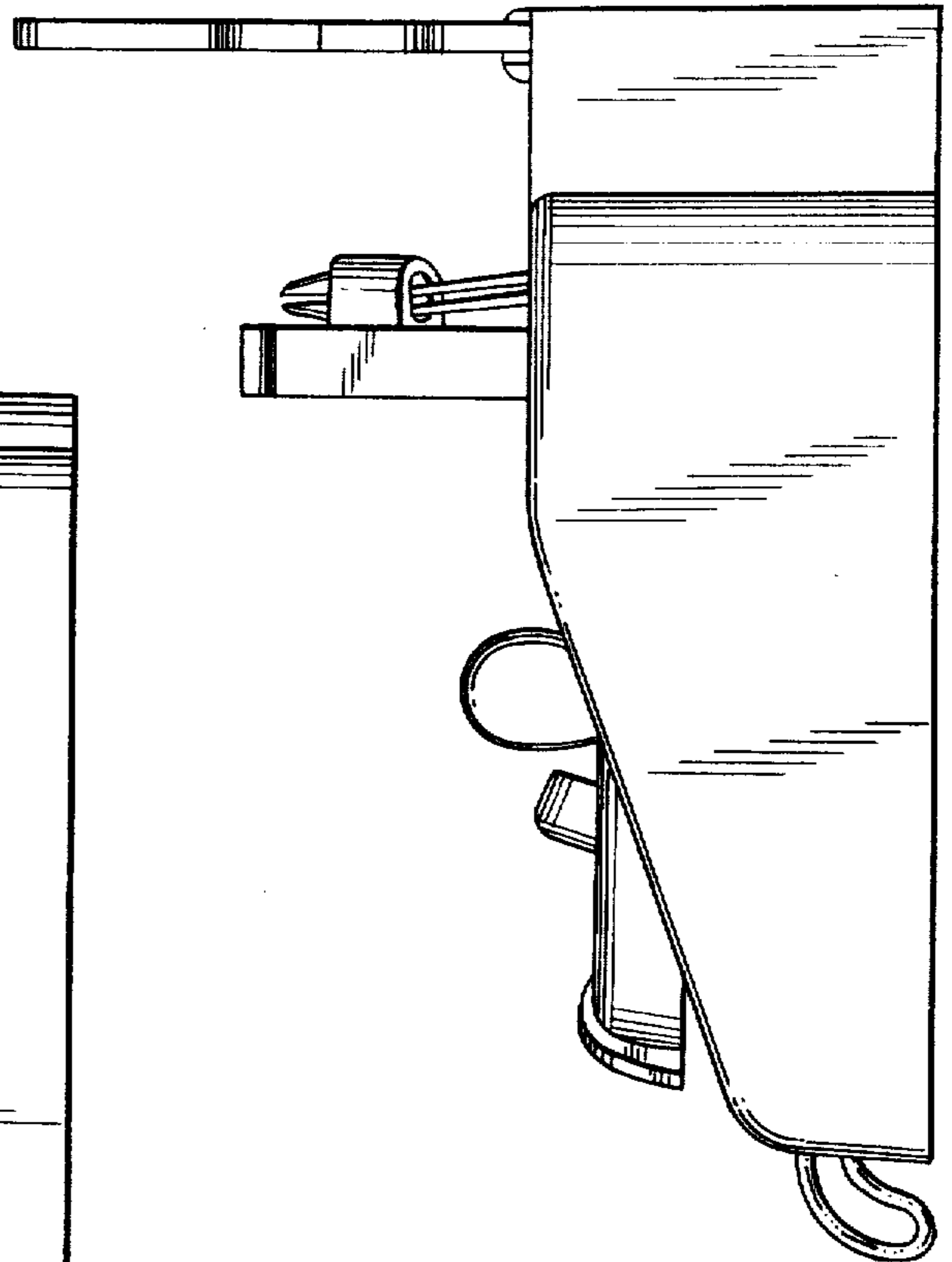
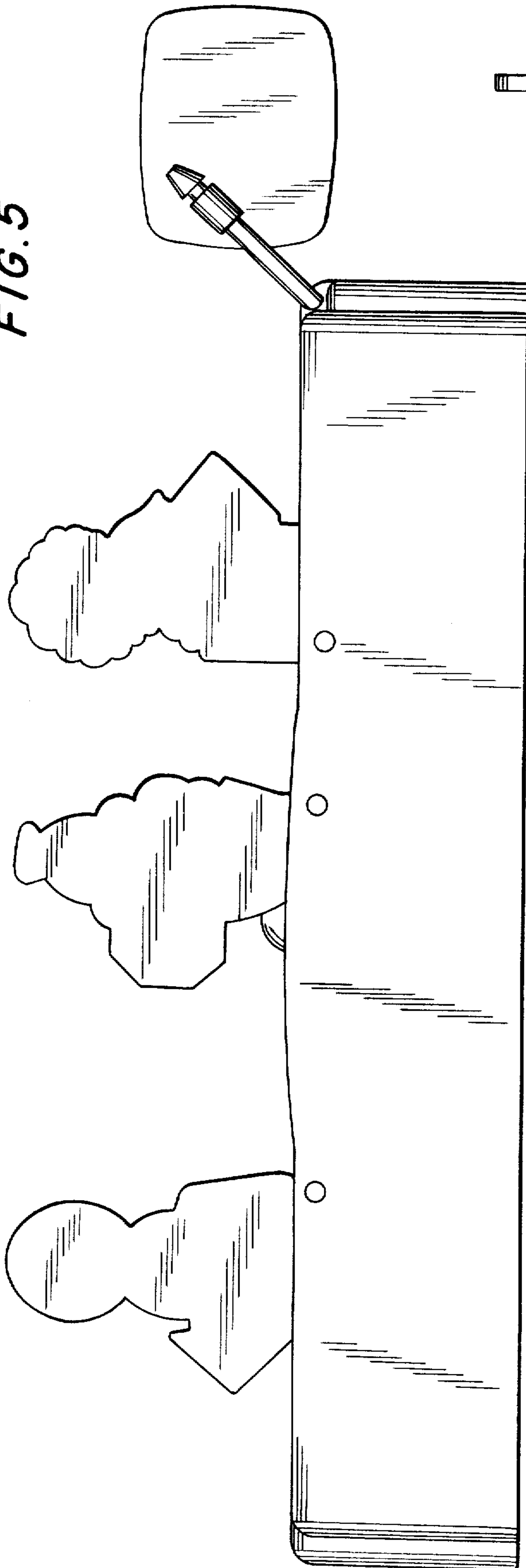
