[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toy dog in dog house, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy dog in dog house showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof, and FIG. 6 is a left side exploded perspective view thereof. In the FIG. 2, FIG. 3, FIG. 4 and FIG. 6 descriptions the rope is shown as broken away for convenience of illustration.

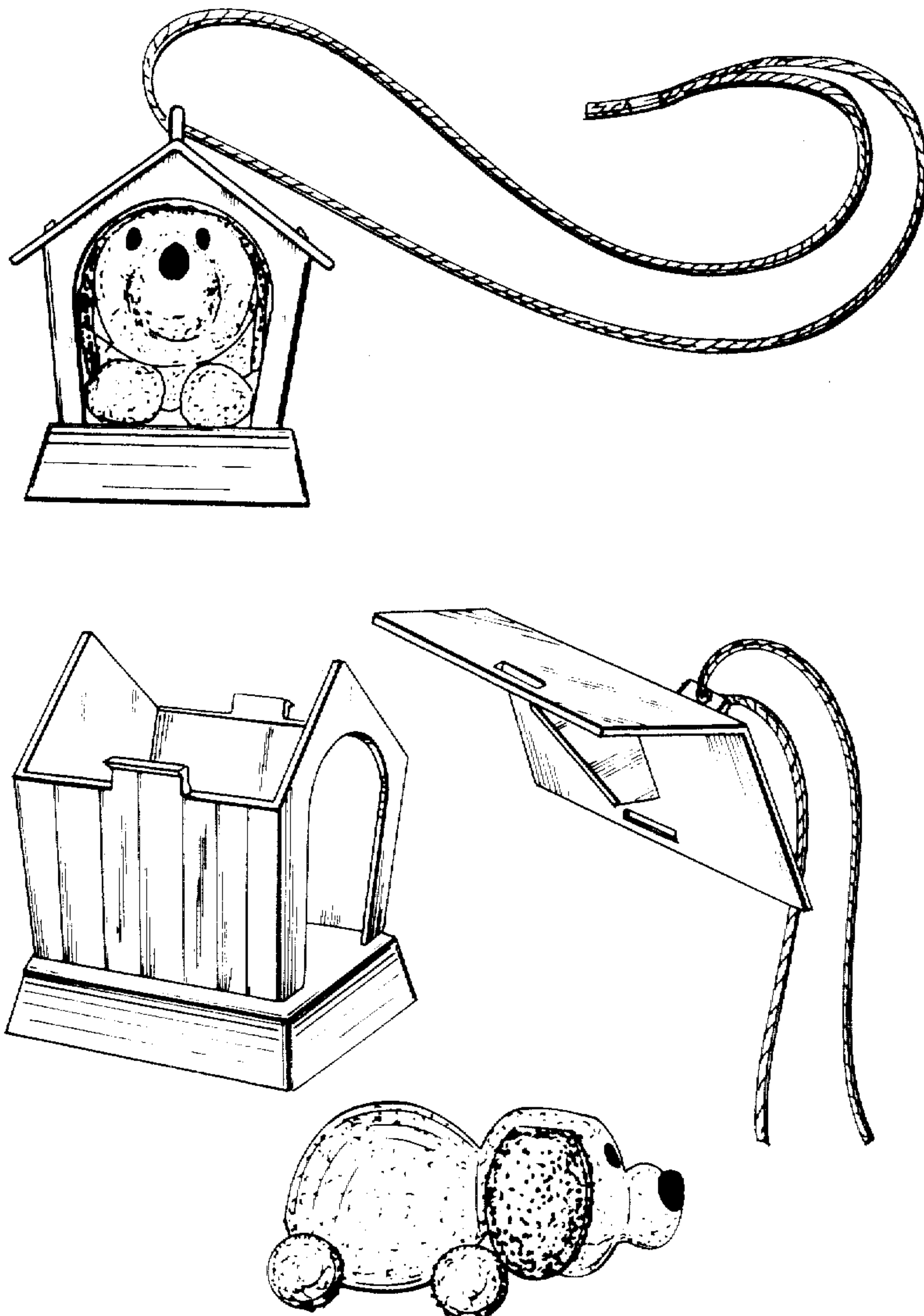

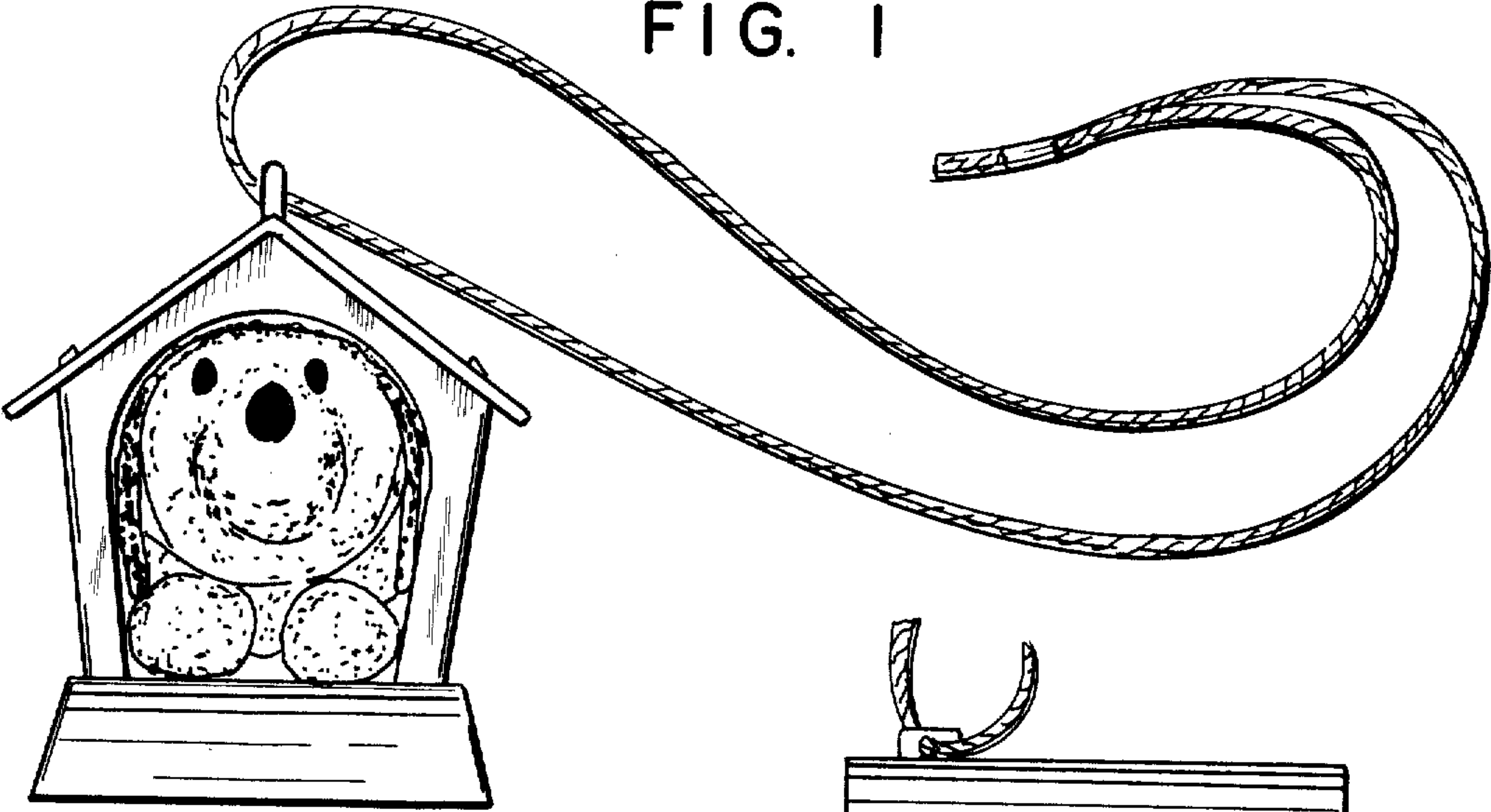

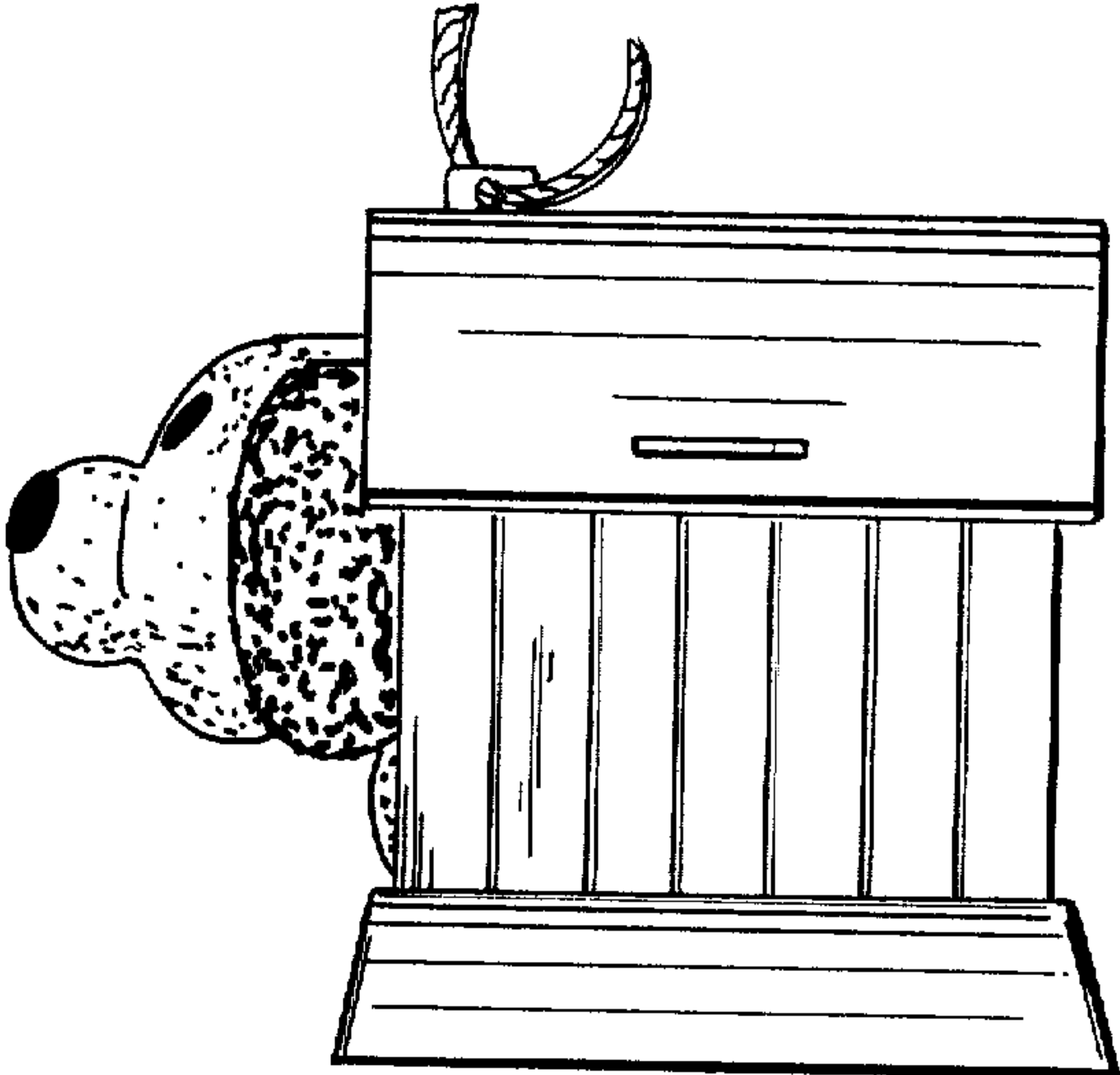

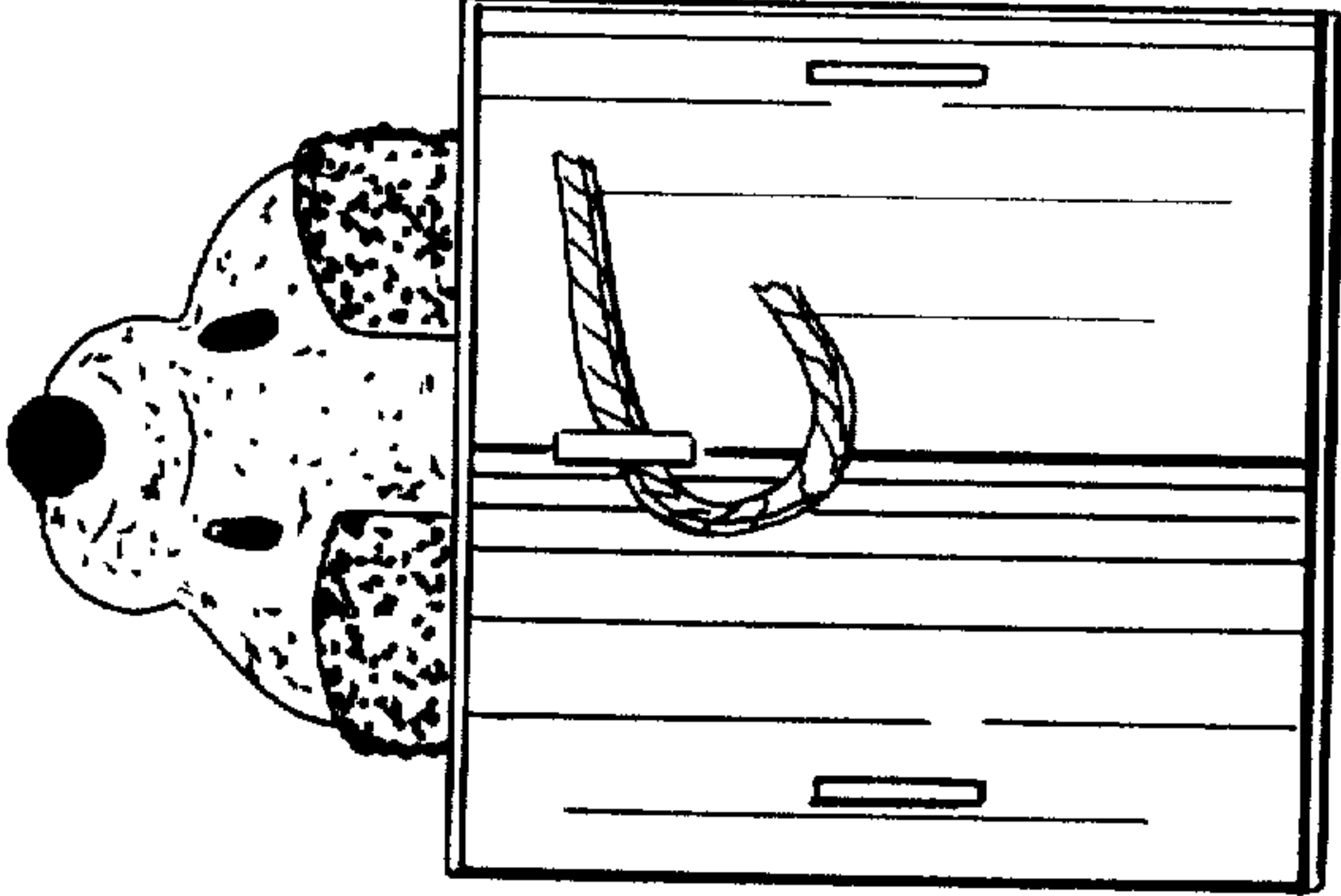

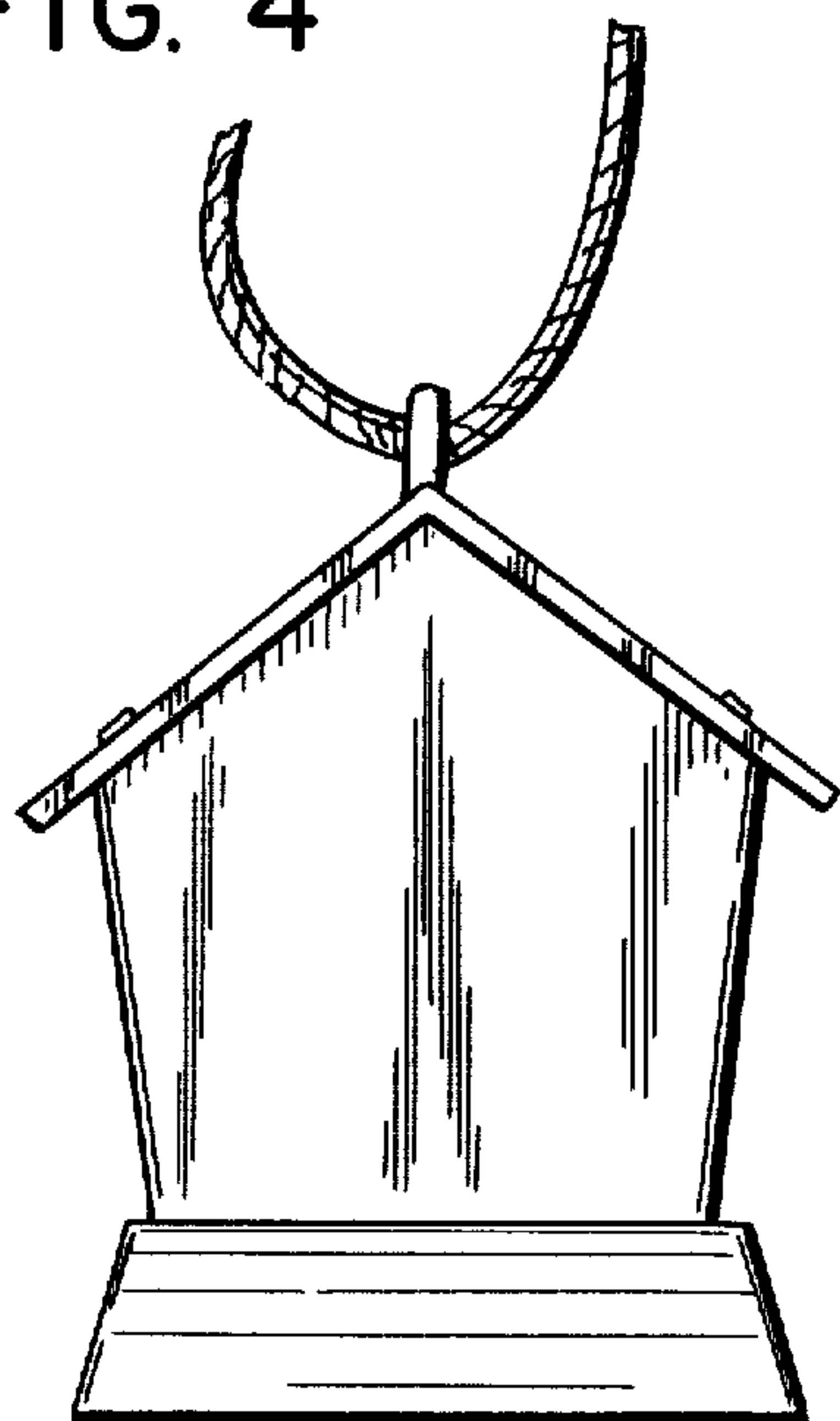

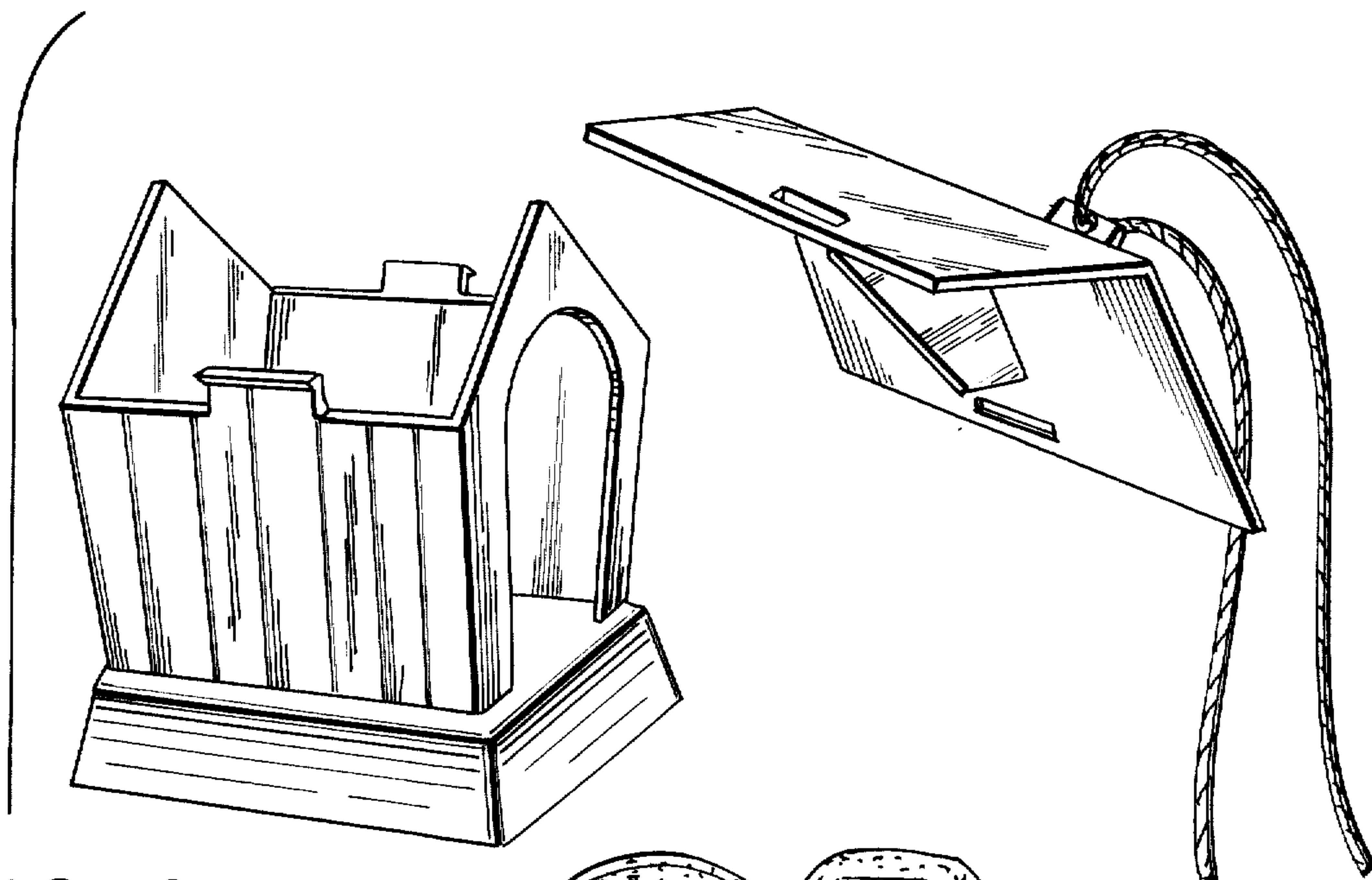
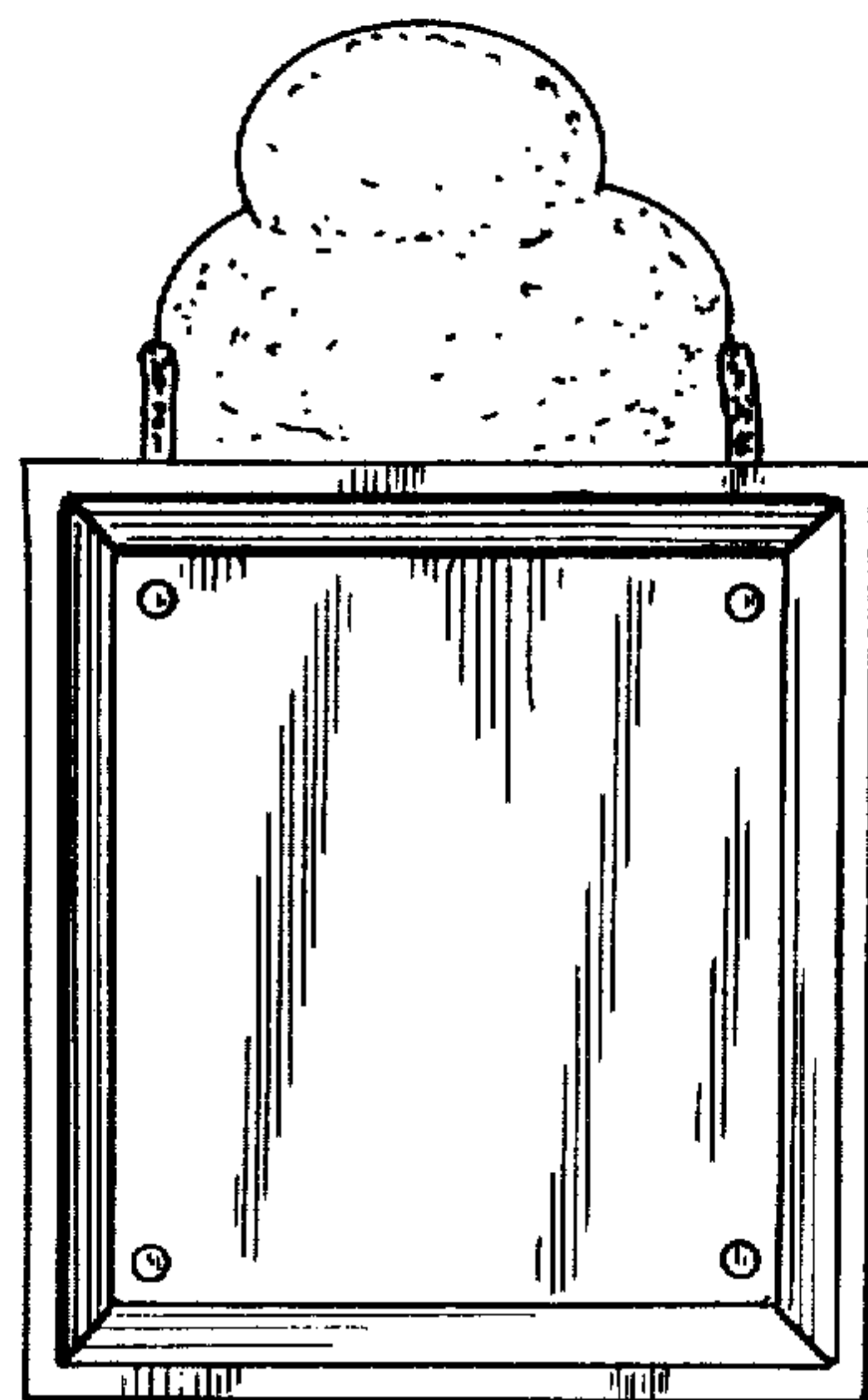
