[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a casting for low profile fireplace heat exchanger, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a casting for low profile fireplace heat exchanger showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

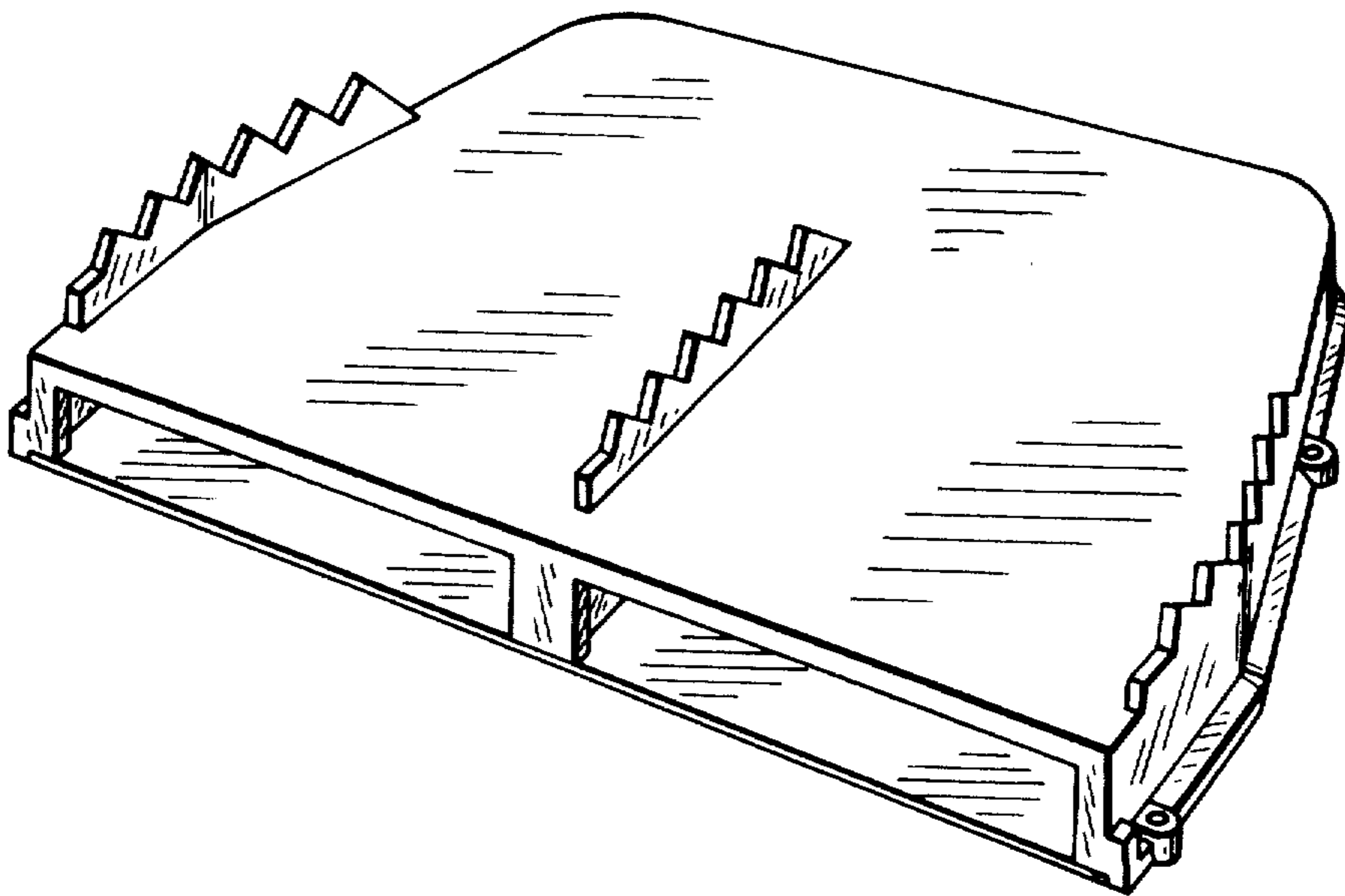

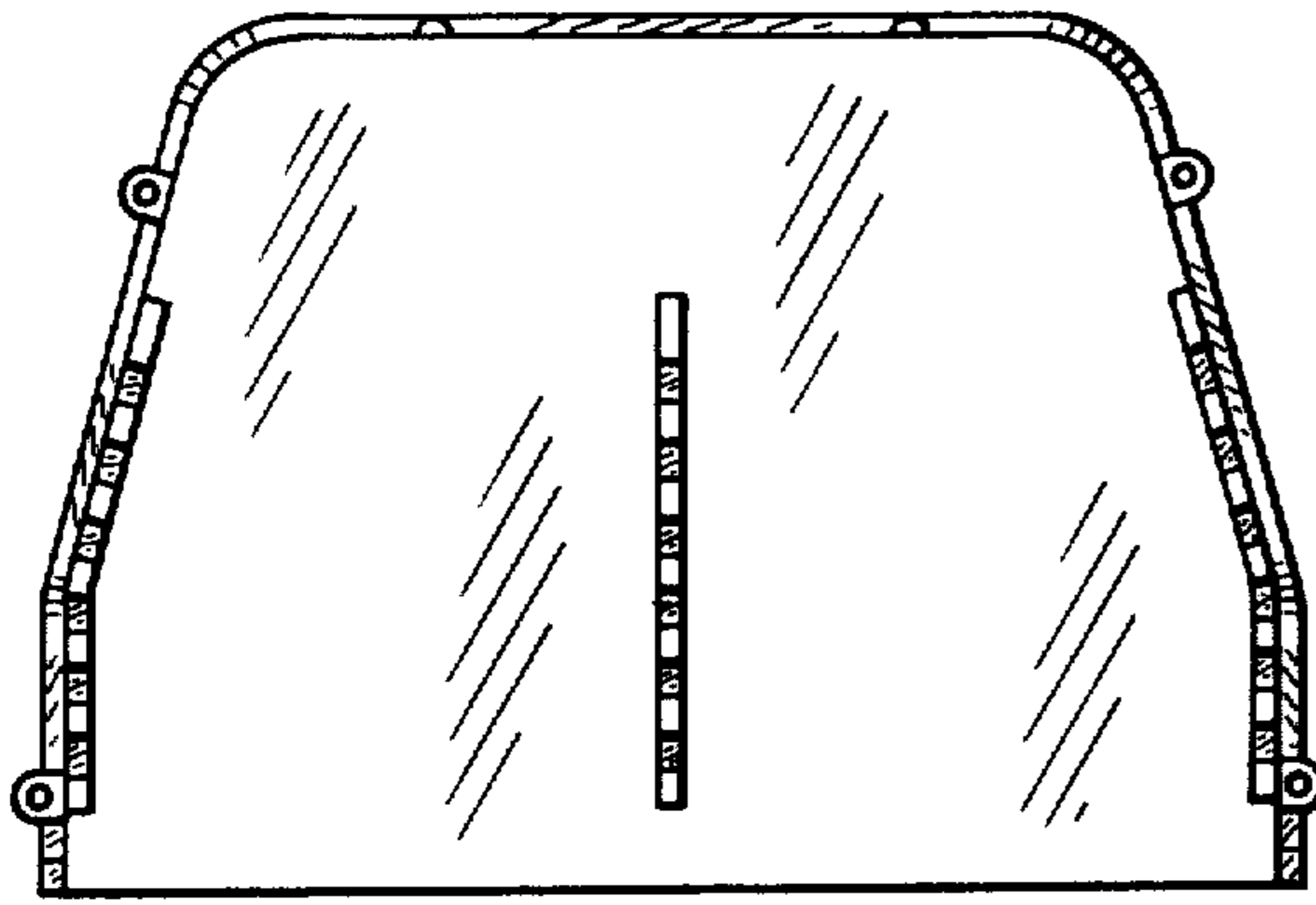
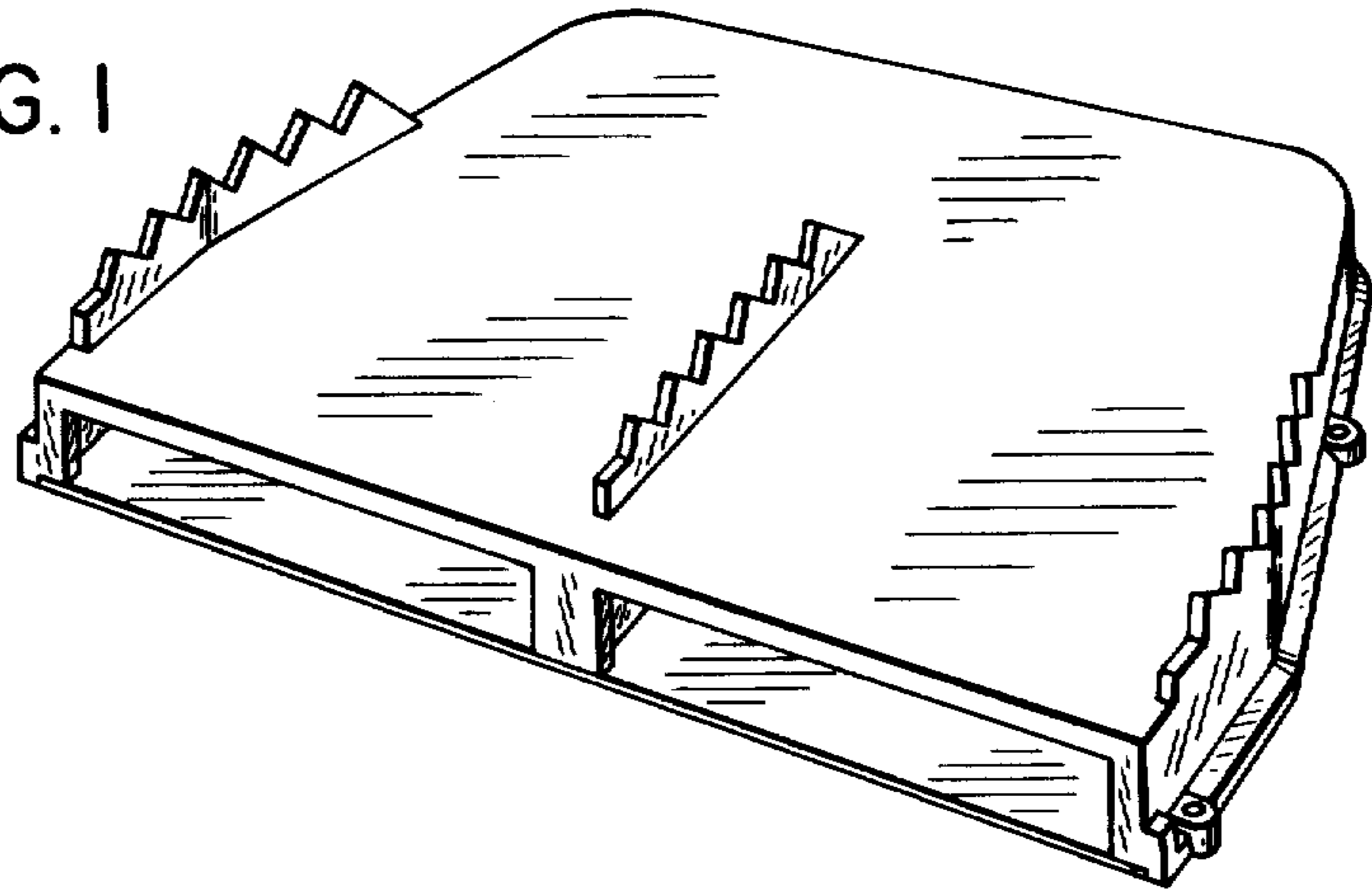

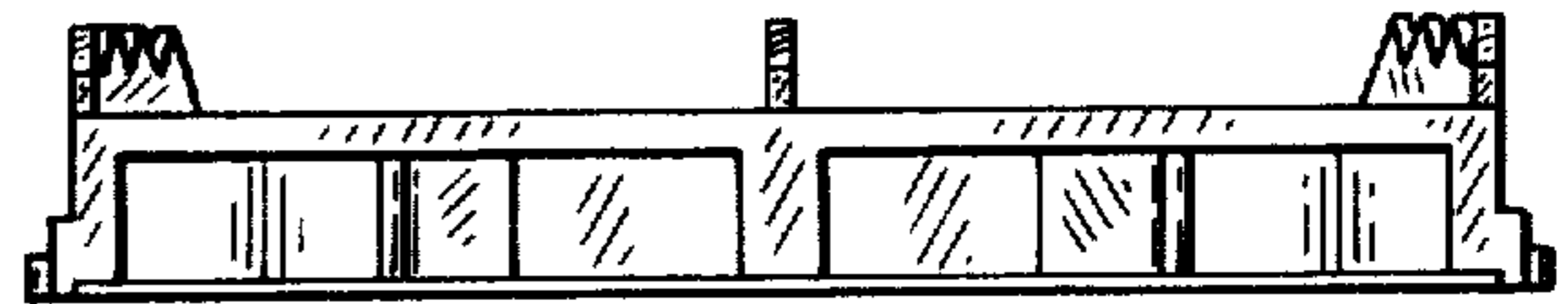

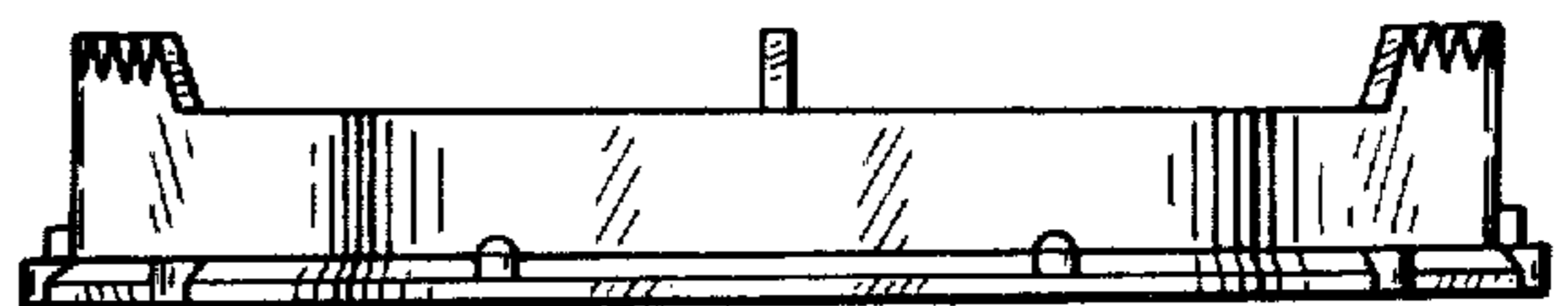
