FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an ovulometer showing my new design, FIG. 2 is a side view; FIG. 3 is a front view; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view, and FIG. 6 is a perspective view with a lid being in a closed position.

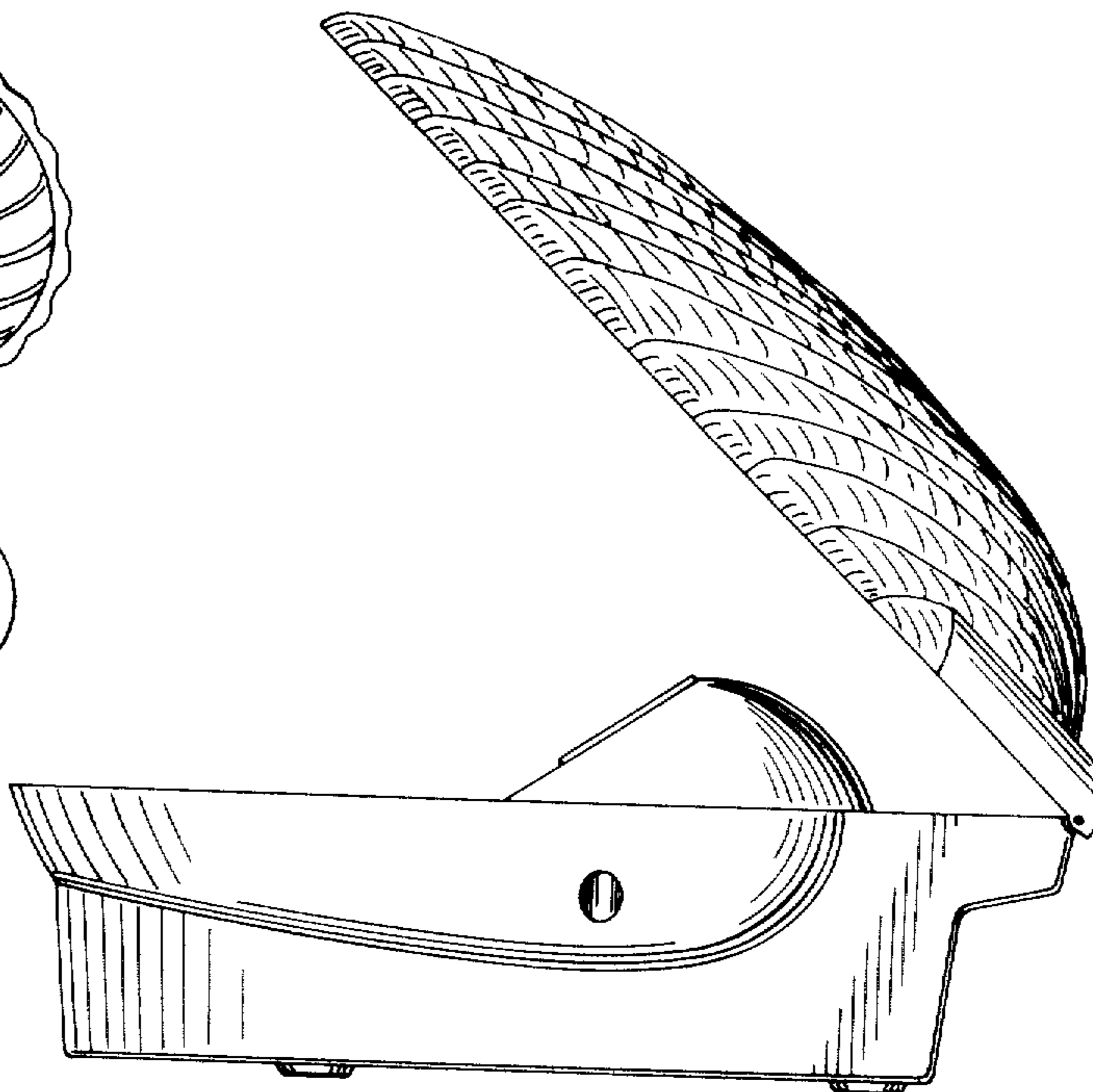
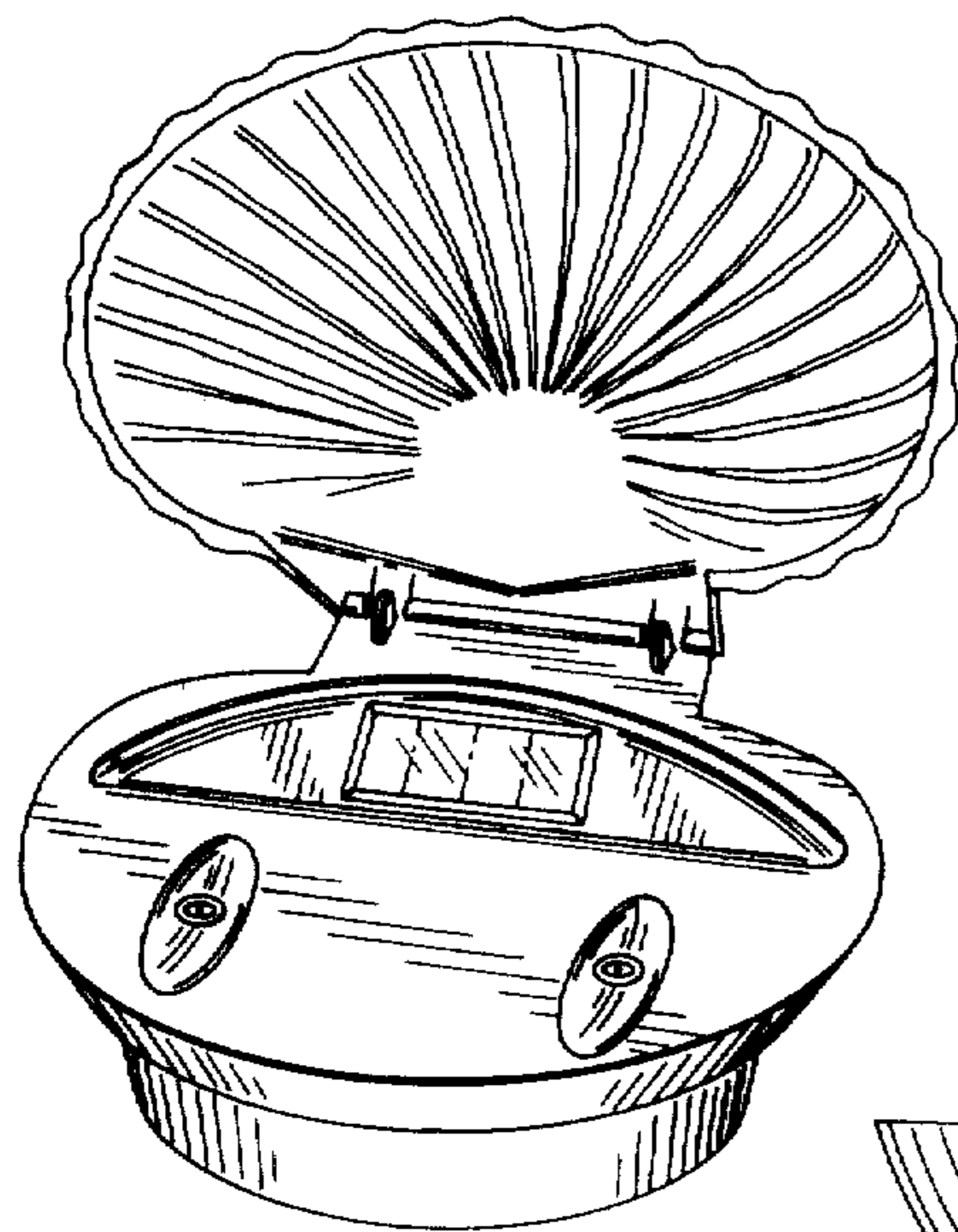

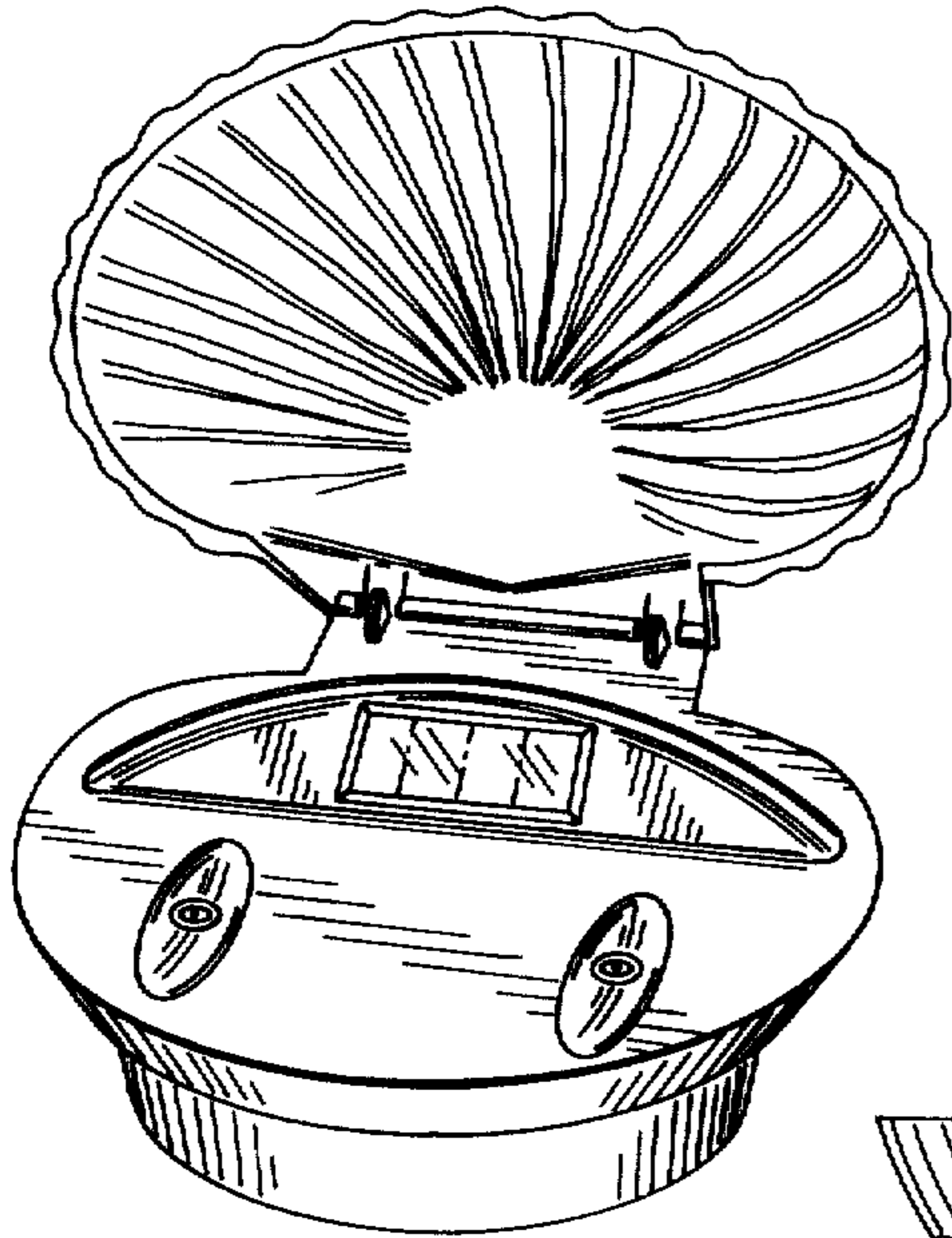

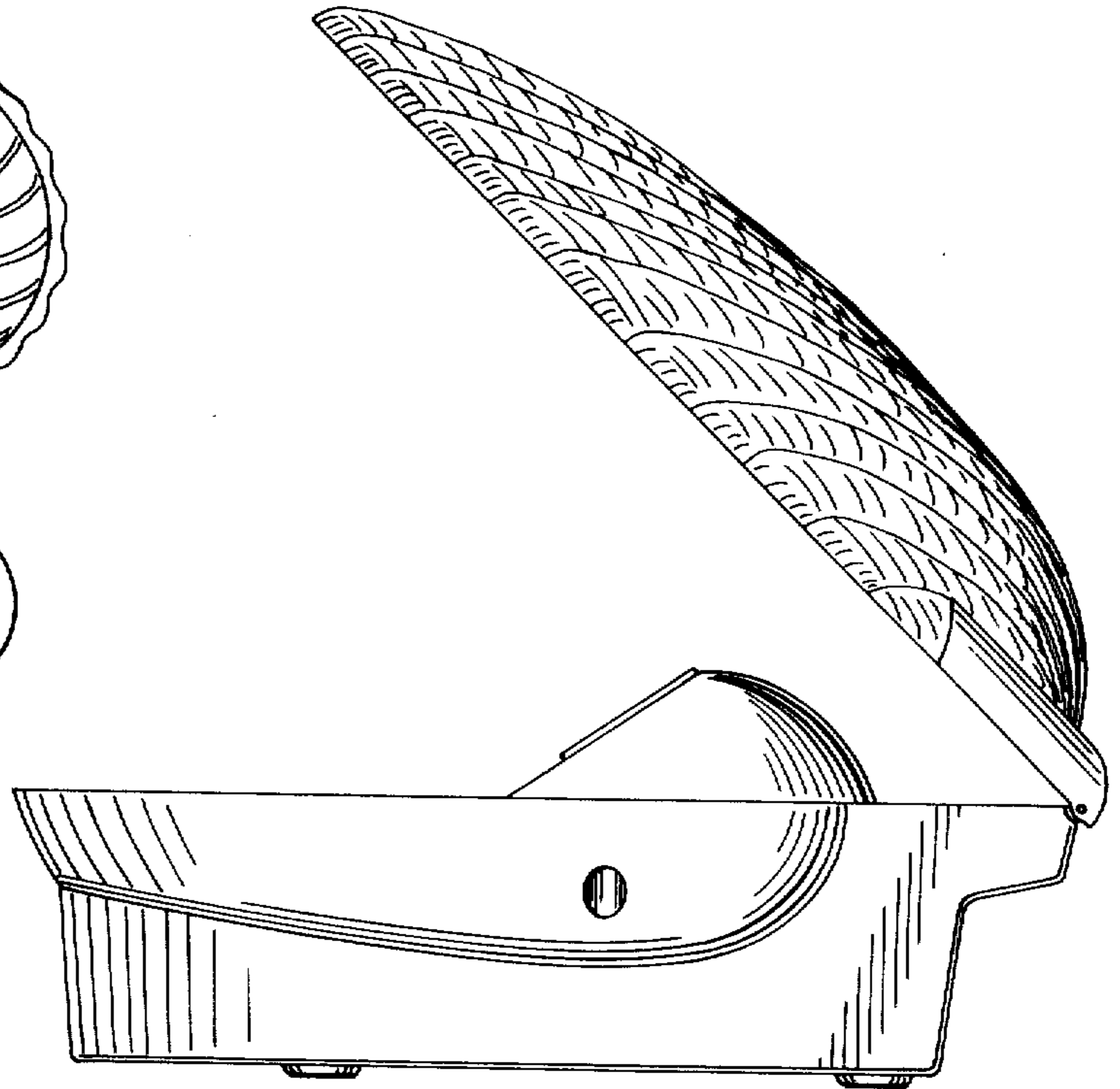

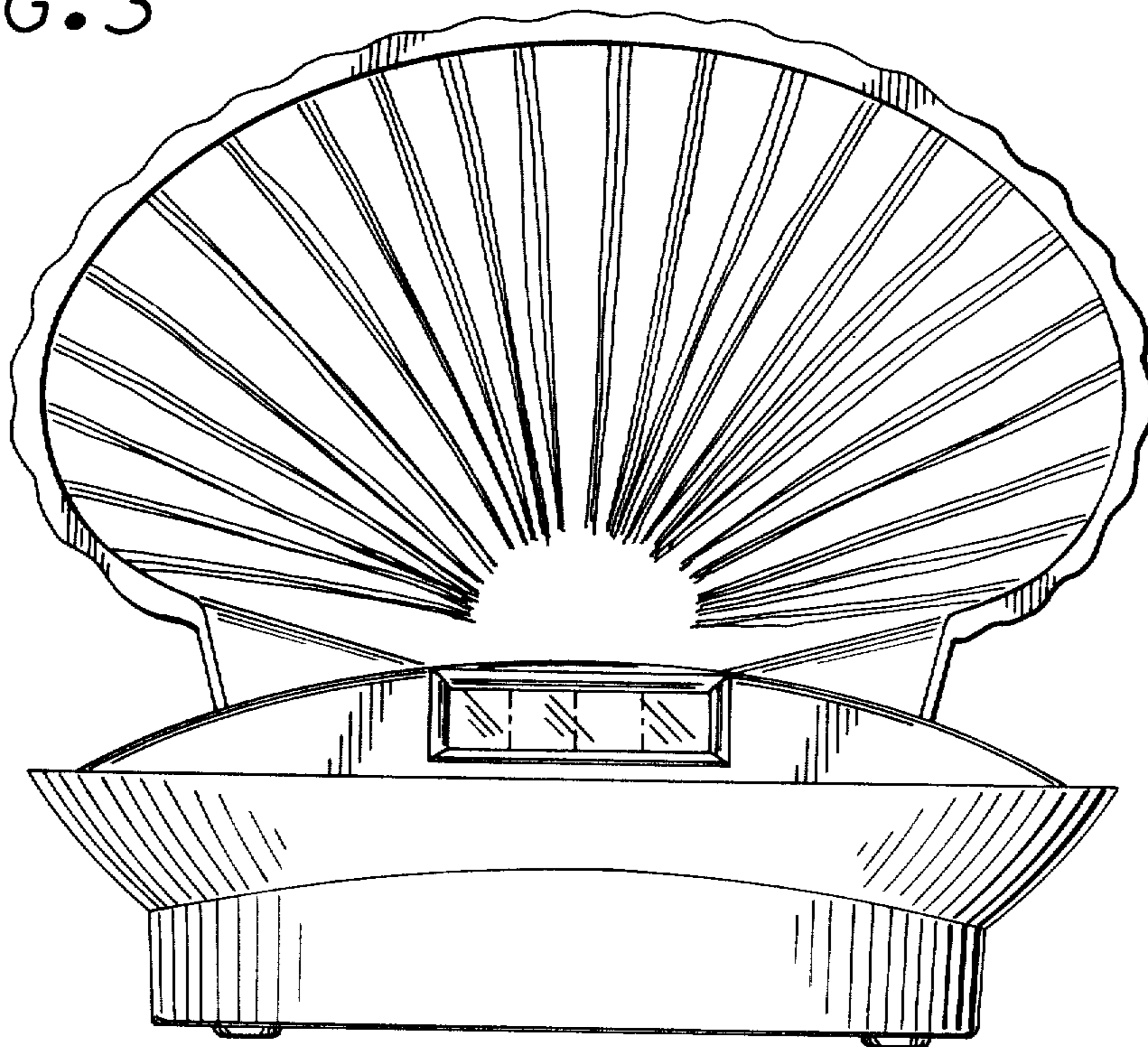

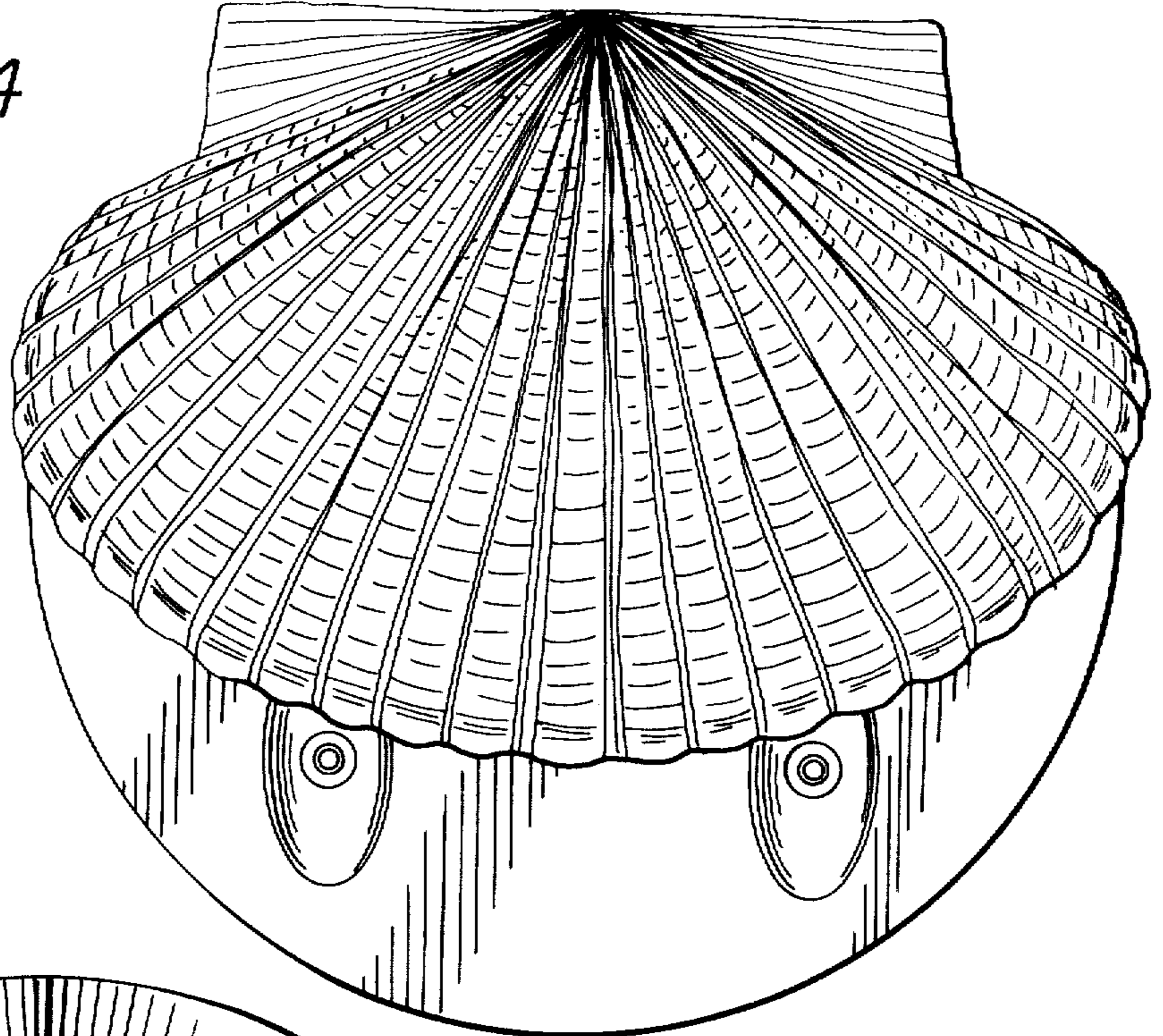

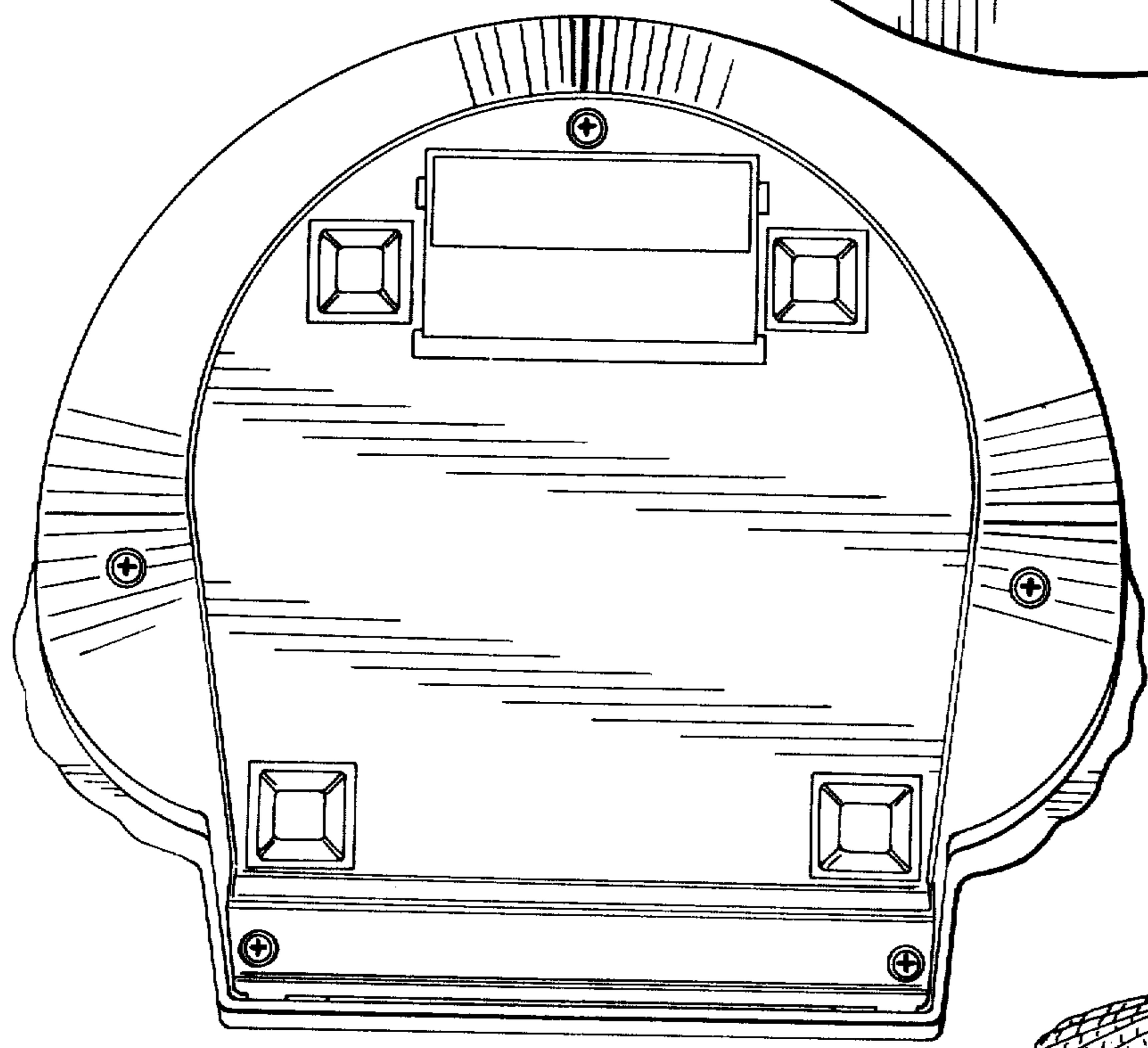
