DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a salad server showing my new design as embodied in a spoon;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top perspective view of a salad server showing my new design as embodied in a fork;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof.
