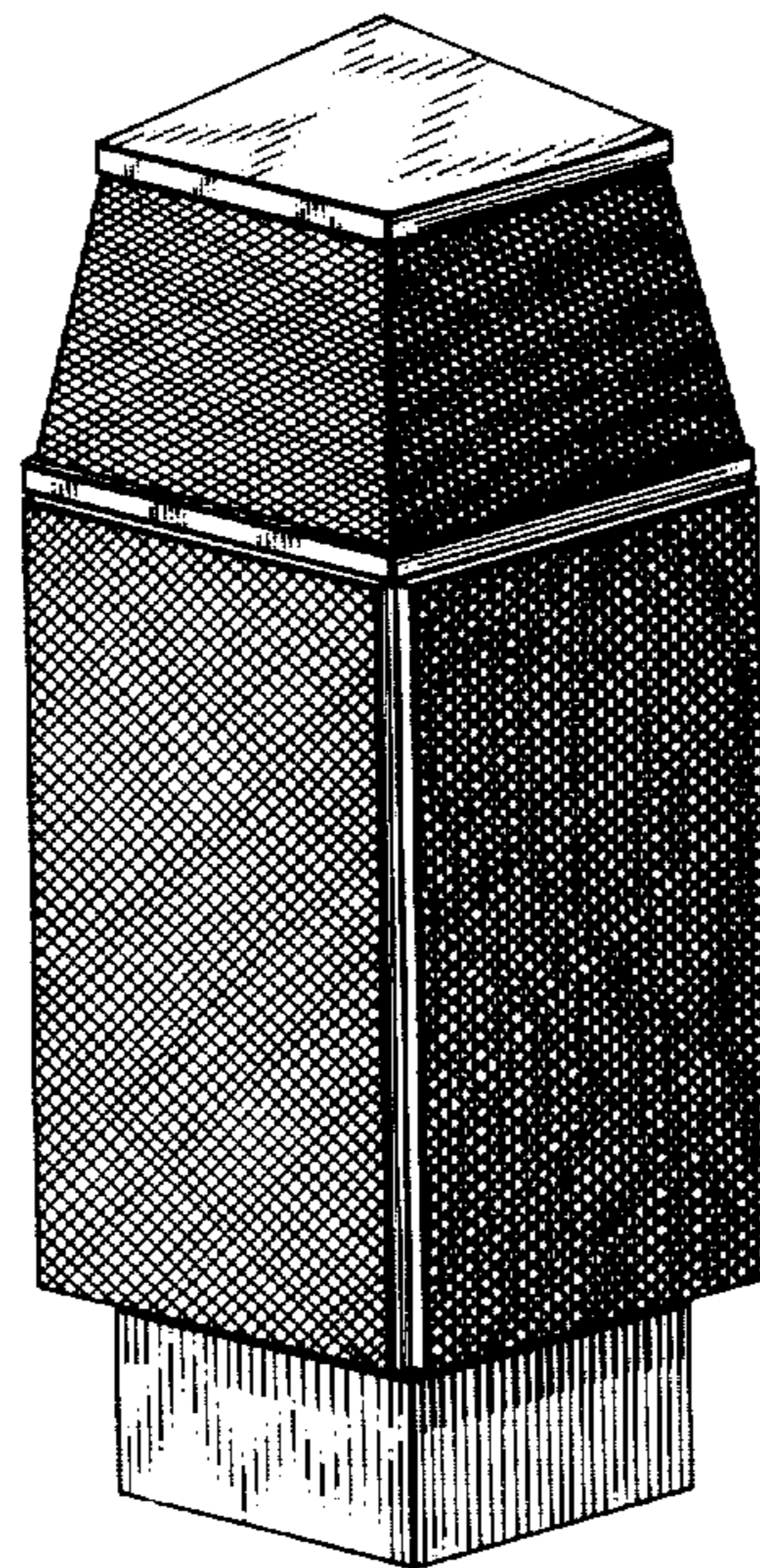

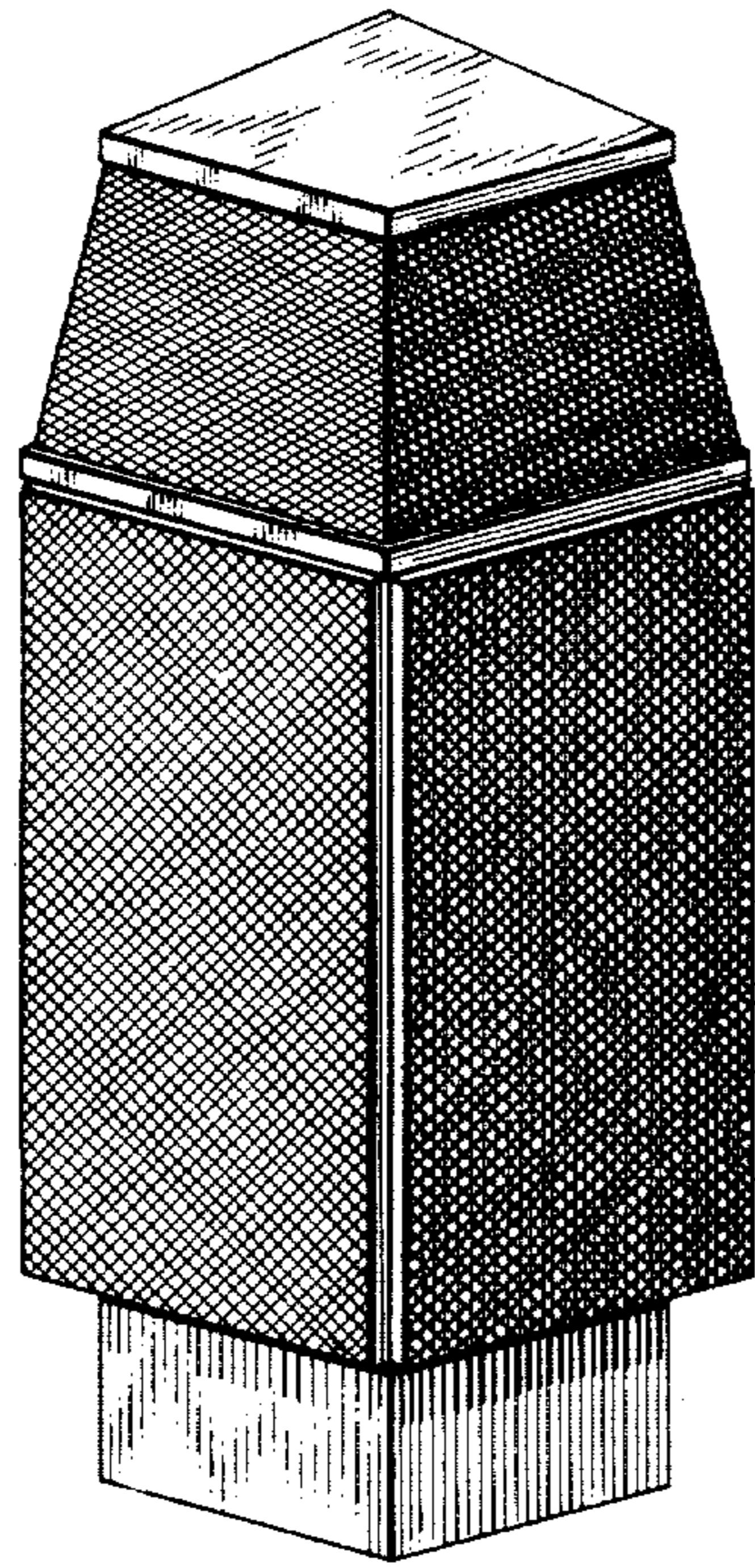
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a loudspeaker housing, as shown.

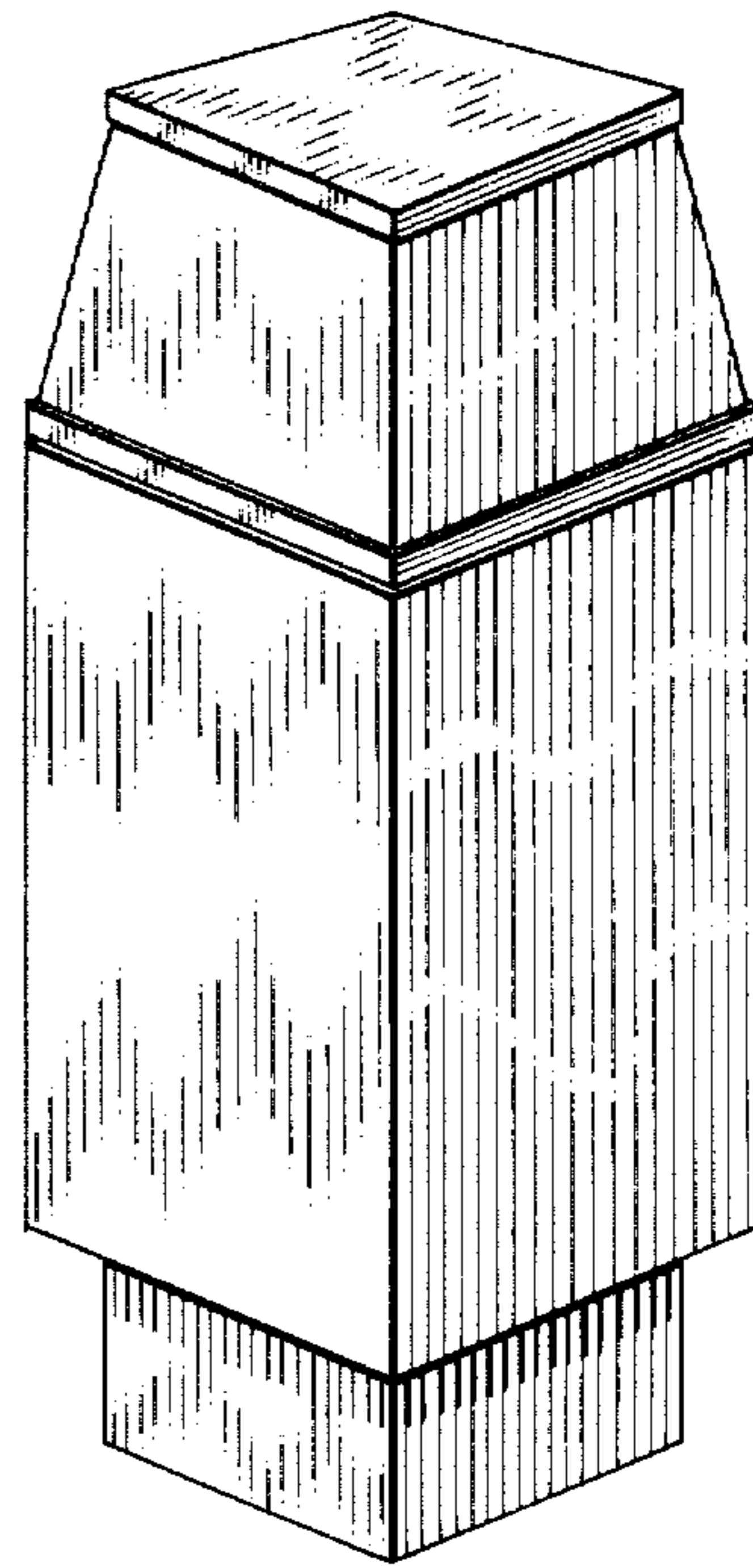
**DESCRIPTION**
